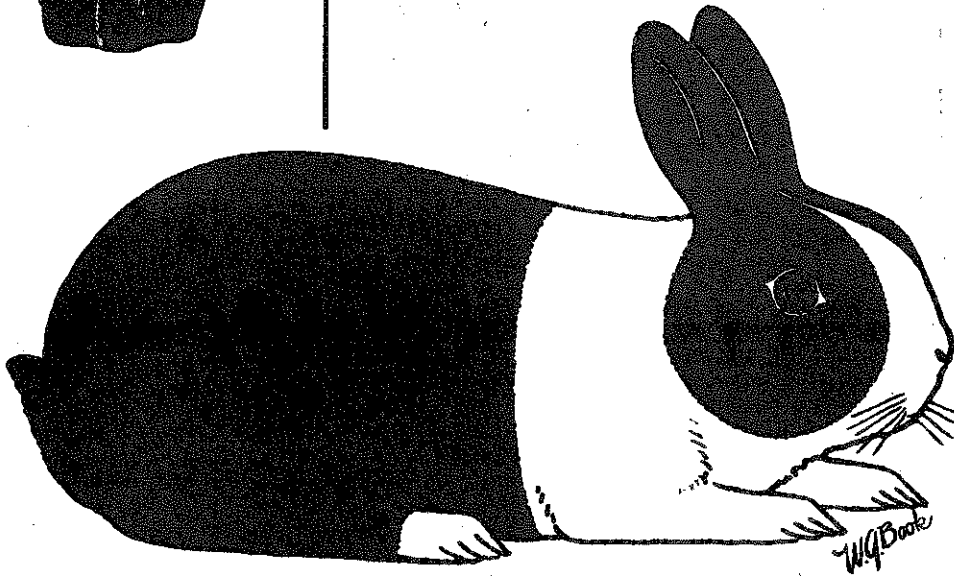
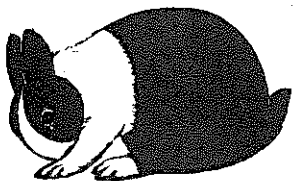

The Convention as you know will be held this year in St. Paul, Minn. The site will be the beautiful Agriculture Building on the Minnesota State Fair Grounds. Breed Chairman for our DUTCH have been chosen and we are very fortunate in having two most capable men representing our breed. They are; Mr. Gunnard Cronk; 2695 E. 7th. St., St. Paul, Minn. and Mr. James Trunzo; 2668 Brand St., St. Paul. I am sure these men will do everything possible to put the DUTCH at the top in St. Paul come October. They will be responsible for checking in, feeding, watering, and in general looking out for the interests of your Dutch while at the Convention. They will also be responsible for soliciting Specials for our breed, here is where we as members can ans should do our part by sending our Specials, Cash, Trophies, etc. to them as soon as possible and help these two Breed Chairmen set the stage at St. Paul for another record breaking entry such as our breed enjoyed at Columbus, Ohio last year.

Now that our spring show season is at a peak no doubt many of you are hearing the following Judges remarks quite often--TOO MANY WHITE HAIRS--this, in my way of thinking, is the most serious fault we have in our Dutch today. Much progress has been made in the past few years toward improving type, but there is still very much to be desired in our Dutch colors and of course color reverts to the aforementioned fault. White hairs in body color and ears. In nearly every show that I judge or have the opportunity to attend, I see one or otherwise good Dutch that are spoiled by the appearance of scattered white hairs over their body and ears. This very serious fault is highly hereditary and is handed

down from one generation of Dutch to another. In my Dutch breeding operations I have done a great deal of research on the subject of white hairs, and I am thoroughly convinced that this fault CAN be eliminated, but only through strict, rigid culling, and may I say at this point, that the results in a very short time of a strict culling program, by eliminating all animals from the herd as breeders, that possess white hairs in their body color or grizzled ears, will be most gratifying to you as a breeder of Dutch, for in doing so you will definitely improve your colors, and what is more beautiful to see than a truly good colored Dutch. Try it my friends, and I am sure you will not be sorry.
