RAISE IN DUTCH CLUB DUES

In the previous issue of the Dutch Reporter, I mentioned that I would give you more details on the proposed increase in dues, as approved by the National Dutch Club at the ARBA Convention in St. Paul.

I hope none of our members get the idea that your President, George Bayliss, and the Directors, are so undemocratic as to try and put over this increase in Dutch Club dues without everyone first having their say so. Of course, you all realize that this must go to a vote of the membership before it is finally adopted.

My reason for mentioning that it was approved wholeheartedly by the members assembled at St. Paul, was merely to bring out the fact that most all of us realize that an increase in dues is long past due. I don't need to tell any of you that the value of the dollar is now down to around 50¢ as far as purchasing power is concerned. With this thought in mind, you can readily realize that all the Dutch Club can do with the money received today is about 50 per cent of what we could be doing if the dollars we received today would buy as much as it did ten or fifteen years ago.

Even though the dollar has decreased about 50 per cent in value, I certainly would be the first one to get up and argue against this size of an increase in the Dutch Club dues. Quite a number of us have talked it over, and we feel that a dollar increase in the dues will not hurt any of us to any extent. Any of our members who are active at all in Club meetings, Shows, etc., are putting out many dollars every year for all kinds of incidentals, such as raffles, trophies, etc. Our Secretary tells me that our membership is staying just about the same, so with our membership at 500, an increase of one dollar in dues, would give us about five hundred dollars more or less per year in the Treasury.

I know that a great many are going to kick like Texas steers about this one dollar increase in dues that is proposed by our Committee. As I mentioned in the previous article, George Bayliss gave this Committee the job of trying to increase the money in the Dutch Club Treasury, and, of course, there is only one way to increase money in the Treasury, and that is to get it from the members. Or find some rich financier around and ask him for a large donation, but I haven't been able to locate any yet!

There is no question that the vote, when it is put

to you, on increasing the Dutch Club dues, will be very close. None of like to pay out more money, if we can possibly get by for less. On the other hand, consider the fact that the Dutch Club is one of the most active in the country. We are one of the largest Clubs in the country.

We are continually trying to do things to improve, not only our breed, but all phases of the rabbit industry where Dutch are concerned. There has been thousands of words written regarding Dutch as the ideal show specimen of the world. There has been many articles written on the desirability of raising Dutch, even for commercial purposes. We have stressed the use of small fryers.

As chairman of the Ways and Means Committee, I am naturally, trying to do the job that President Bayliss gave our Committee, and I can truthfully say that I would sincerely appreciate the cooperation of everyone who reads this article. No one can be proud of an Organization that is always in financial difficulties! While we have managed to keep the Dutch Club on a pretty even keel, dozens of ideas that have come from our new members and the Directors that have had to be side-stepped because of unavailability of cash. I well realize, that many members, who are not active show members, who are not active in Clubs, will vote against the increase in dues on principle only, because it will cost money. But actually, one dollar per year increase in dues, as I have mentioned previously, will not hurt any of us too seriously. At the same time this increase would enable your Club to do a great many things for you that are not possible at the present time.


