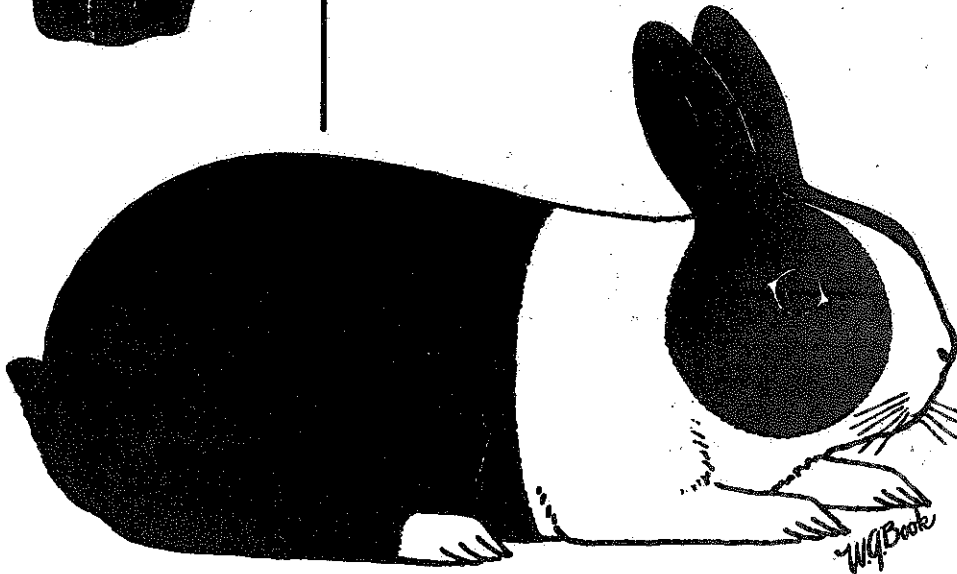

SECRETARY'S CHIT CHAT

I seem to be making it a habit of introducing our young, new judges to the membership and I've got another dandy to present to you this month. When any judge can judge two shows on consecutive week-ends and place even two rabbits identically in relation to each other he is doing pretty well, but I say Stan Freed do this with no less than six rabbits which he had judged at the Ft. Wayne show and the Michigan State Show at East Lansing. I think consistency is the trait that I admire the very most in any judge especially when he thoroughly knows our Standard and then judges the rabbits time after time according to that Standard. We need a lot more judges like Stan and Glen Carr.

Now I've got a couple of things to gripe about -- There have been several letters in the trade magazines lately complaining that breeders advertising stock for sale are lax about replying to inquiries. Well, you can believe me there is another side to the story, also. Most of us place advertising in our Specialty Club bulletins in order to support that organ, many times admitting that they have no stock to sell, but stating that they want to do their part to keep the magazine as near to breaking even as possible. This is a fine gesture, but these ads should (and some do) contain the words "no stock for sale at this time", thus avoiding the problem of wasted correspondence. Some of us, however do have stock for sale and sometimes many letters are exchanged before any stock is shipped. Alright, you make a deal and ship the stock. Then you wait, and wait, and wait and then wait some more to hear if the purchaser ever got the stock and if he was satisfied with it -- probably if he didn't think he got his money's worth you heard right away! I have shipped three rabbits and one trophy since the first of February and not one of the recipients has ever let me know if they got them. If I should hear in another month or two that they never arrived it would undoubtedly be everlastingly too late to put in a claim for them anyway, but I would like to know what became of them. The same thing happens each year when I send out the trophies for our sweepstake. I send ten trophies and if I'm real lucky, then one member will drop me a card to say theirs arrived. Cooperation can't be carried on by one person, there always has to be at least two individuals involved so next time you think you've got a gripe stop and ask yourself have I done my share?

Another thing that bothers me no end is the business of false advertising and sell-stock under false pretenses. I received a letter the other day from a new member and

I'd like to quote from it: "I was reading the Guide Book and maybe I misunderstood it or maybe not. Anyway it says that on page 48 that the Dutch rabbits eyes should be the same color for both but I bought two pedigreed Black Dutch about 7 or 8 months ago from _____ and the female's eyes are brown on the right side and blue on the left. The buck's eye is blue on the right and brown on the left. So is this bad or is it normal?" It made me feel very badly to have to tell this novice that he had been had. The person from whom he bought these rabbits is one of our advertisers and his stock doesn't come cheap. (I might not feel so strongly about this except I get letters and verbal reports about this person two or three times a year. He advertises that he has "Champion", and I've never been able to understand what kind of "Champions" he is talking about. In order to get ARBA Grand Champions it is necessary to meet the ARBA requirements of winning in three shows under at least two judges in classes of five or more with three or more exhibitors. Well, when you only show once or twice a year and then don't win all the classes you are going to make very many ARBA Grand Champions even over a period of three years which is about the show-life of most rabbits. Maybe they are Champion Eaters, or Champion Jumpers, or Champion Thumpers but they certainly aren't ARBA Champions which most people would interpret the advertising to mean.

I saw another novice exhibiting at a show I attended recently and every single rabbit on their entry disqualified. I have no idea where they bought their stock or what they paid for it, but if the breeder knew they were buying stock with the intention of showing it and deliberately misled them to think they were buying show stock he is doing us all an injustice and hurting our breed, our Club and most of all himself, because these people (or others like them) are going to talk and when others learn that he has done this kind of business they are going to say "I don't have any stock to sell at this time, but I'll recommend some breeders who might. Just don't ever buy any from so-and-so as he sells inferior stock, or stock from which you are liable to get every color but the one you want." There is a place for every single rabbit that is kindled in this country, but believe me they are NOT all show rabbits, they are NOT all potential producers of show rabbits and unless an established breeder knowingly commits himself to buy a certain disqualified rabbit to fit certain needs in his own stock -- PLEASE, don't foist these disqualified rabbits onto someone just because he is a begginer and doesn't know what he is getting -- you just might spoil a good breeder before he even gets started. If he doesn't have much money or can't meet your minimum price for good registerable stock then either tell him, that you are sorry you don't have anything for sale at the price he wants to pay or if you really want to get him started then give in and meet his price, but don't cheat him because it is only yourself that you are cheating in the long run.
