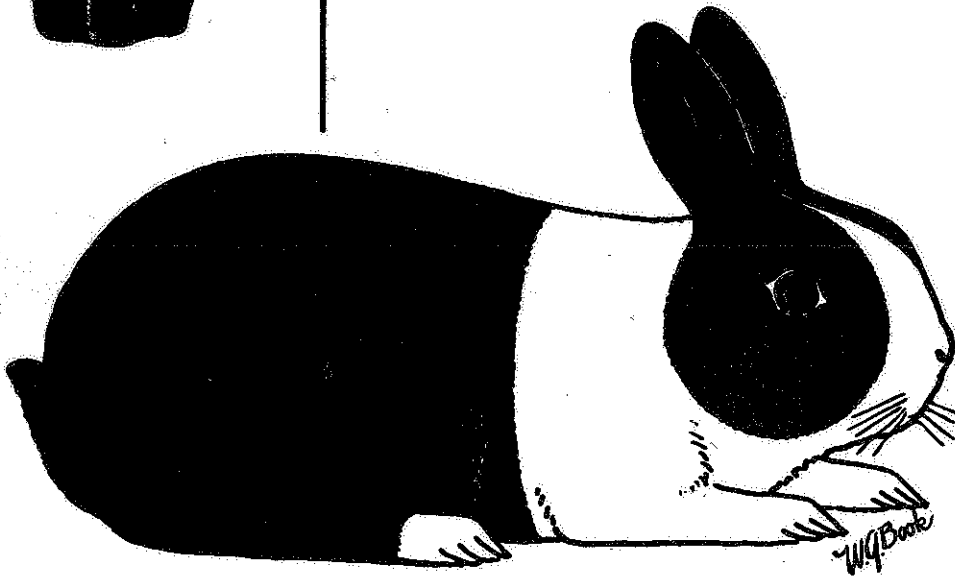

Dear Mrs. Weinhardt:

I noted with some interest the recent correspondence regarding splitting the Dutch Sweepstakes into sections. I would very definitely be opposed to such a move. We have enough divisions as it is and I think that this would be a bad one.

As I see the situation in order to win the Dutch Sweepstakes you have to want to win it enough to make a lot of Shows that you ordinarily wouldn't attend and be prepared to spend a little more than you should making trips that are just a little further away. In winning the last Sweepstakes there were twenty four Dutch Sweepstake Shows in California and Arizona. I made twenty three of them. I missed the ARIZONA State Fair Show as I was one of the Judges. In addition I took a few to the Convention in Louisville. It was very rewarding to me to win this Sweepstakes, but one I don't think I can afford again in the immediate futur. I might state that I did a little research into the number of Shows in some of the other sections of the country and I found that there were a lot of places that had opportunity to make a great many more shows than we could out here. For instance there were thirty-six Shows with Dutch Sweepstakes in the State of Ohio. Nearly that many in Indiana and Illinois. So it bears out that any Dutch exhibitor in those three States had three times as many potential Shows in less traveling distance than we have to go in California and Arizona.
