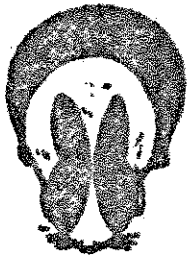
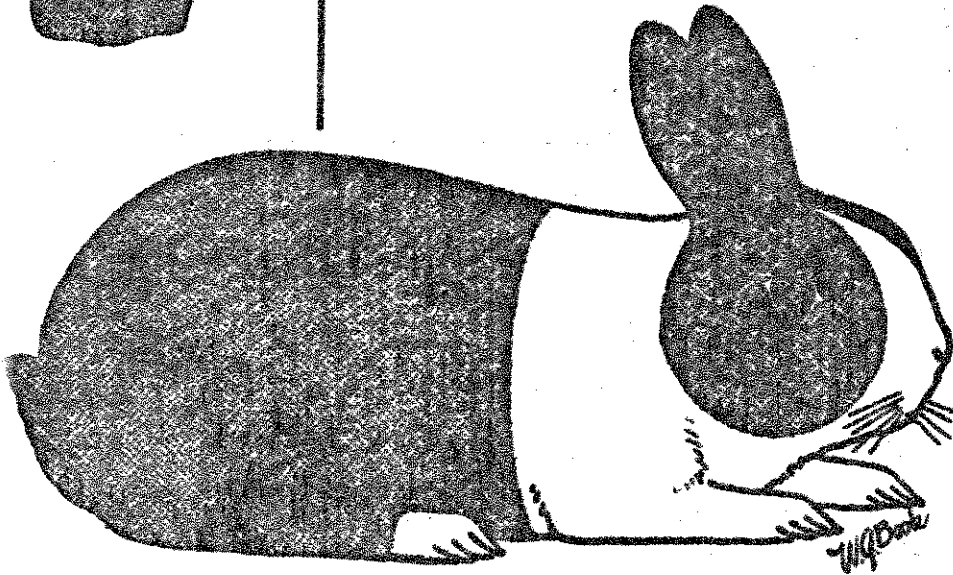

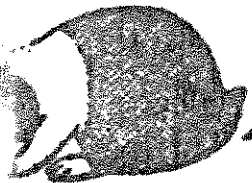

B R E E D I N G D U T C H by Keith Mall,....

Here are some further thoughts to my last article on breeding that may be of benefit to Dutch raisers.

I seem to get better young out of animals that are in good condition. The does nurse better and the young develop better. Also the percentage of quality young seems to be reduced after the breeders reach three years of age. There are exceptions, of course, if the buck or doe are exceptionally viril or retain top condition to a later age. If one can get 4 or 5 good ones a year to put into production they can maintain their winning ways. My herd produces their best quality young beginning about 6 months of age, when they get their first "bloom" (when they are in the peak in looks and condition) until their first moult. I don't like to breed a moulting rabbit. I sacrifice showing my best does many times to breed them when they are at their best. I feel that one needs to be a breeder first and a showman second, otherwise one can be on top for awhile but then fade out in later years. When one keeps does in show condition beyond a year they can become fat and difficult to get bred.

R A B B I T Y A R D E X P E R I E N C E S by Doris Leibel

It seems that each spring brings a different set of problems in the rabbit yard. I sometimes wonder how the rabbits stand the noise and pollution in our area. Pollution is becoming a noticeable thing, sulphur in the air. The city is growing around us, apartments, a super market right across the street etc. Strangers think nothing of walking into the yard and looking things over, planes buzz above us, we are 20 minutes from the air port. Kids on motorcycles buzz around the roads and in the winter it's the snowmobiles. Yet through all of this the rabbits go on and raise their young and live out their lives. (didn't mention the Schnauzers that bark at every stranger) Because of all of this distraction I spend extra time each day staying acquainted with the stock. The does seem to be contented with their new litters and all signs point to a good productive spring. Litter size is good and a minimum of misses, like one out of ten. I had one doe that scattered her first litter on the wire, the second litter of ten are in the nest box, but the ears are chewed off on each one, outside of that it's the most beautiful litter one would want. I'm going to let her raise what she will and hopefully the next round will work out normally. She's a good doe and not flighty, guess she tried too hard. I note a couple does that are inbred quite tight that have like 2 out of six that are small and weak in the litters, I just destroy them and the balance grow unusually fast. I find that a good inbred line goes well when sold to raisers that are also inbreeding.

Several raisers in the area have had problems with vermin. Rats are breeding now and the females will get those bunnies if they can, get out the rat poison and start the battle. Get your supply of lime on hand for spring cleaning and the disinfectant for washing the crocks etc.

Purina has a new product, Rabbit Plus, that looks interesting, but so darned expensive. The idea of vitamins and minerals in a booster pellet is a good one. I have become a bit disenchanted with antibiotics except in special cases. Years ago I had been told that animals build up a tolerance for antibiotic when used daily and then when help was needed the drug wouldn't be effective, I have seen this.....

YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH

In the very early fifties while serving the very best country in the world, I wrote an article challenging my very best rabbit friend I have in the world and it was all over the very best rabbit in the world.

Well, for the many rabbit fanciers who never met me personally, you probably are all wondering what country, what friend and what rabbit? I am going to say it now friends and it is very easy for me to do as it would be as easy for any good Dutch judge to pick best Dutch in a show with only one entered. It happens to be the good old U.S.A. good old Tom Shufflebotham and good old Dutch.

Now for the article of the fifties, it was named so because I strongly felt it was Tom's and for this one which I am about to write, it is so named because of being mine.

Our very capable secretary was asking in our recent Dutch Reporter what was happening to our Blacks as far as color goes. Doris, back in the forties we eliminated the A. O.C. class from our standard and there was much noise raised over this by many breeders. In fact, many said that it would be the downfall of the Dutch Club and Dutch rabbit. Time has proven these people wrong because our club has grown and above all else, our colors improved tremendously in our Dutch. When I say our color improved I mean up till the early sixties. I say this because I honestly feel up until then we only had Blacks, Blues, Tortoise and Chocolate. You ask, what about our Greys and Steels? Yes we did have them too, but to the extent that only capable and experienced breeders hobbled with them. What I am trying to say as far as answering the question, what happened to our color in the Blacks? Well friends, after tearing up probably 20 writings up to now and not saying what I would have said twenty or thirty years ago, I am going to try and say this. Back in the days when we had the A.O.C. we had many breeders who were mixing colors and were coming up with every color in the rainbow. We had Blues that looked like lilacs, Blacks that looked like dark Blues, Chocolates that looked like the cinnamon bear, you name it, we had it. Yes, I did show in the class, but they were a Blue Fawn, a color that I still say we needed to keep our shadings on the Tortoise at that time. (Tom here is an opening for you, but remember, I said, at that time.)

For you who are wondering why and how our colors started to improve, it is as simple as this. The vast majority of our breeders had to strive towards the colors our standard called for and with strict culling, selective breeding they accomplished this. I must say here and now that a few fanciers did not have to do this and to mention, not all, but maybe a couple they are as follows: Shufflebotham, Bayliss, Lewis, Bernhart, H.C. Gillie Gilbert, Dr. Hart, Charlie Williams, John Furrer, Pop Sautters, Bob Scott Sr. and Gaddis.

We are now up to the late fifties and early sixties. So what has happened? Are you ready? Well here is my opinion.

When we started to really escalate breeding Grays and Steels (any of our show records will prove this) and by the way for no other good reason for having them this will prove it did start going down hill.

I feel that many of our breeders did this to keep up with the Sweepstakes gimmicks which we have to-day. I say gimmicks, because they didn't care what color they had as long as they got numbers. After all, it is the name of the game. More colors and more in the class is what points are given for. Now we must all admit, Blacks are seen in Gray litters; they are seen in Black and Steel litters and mix these three colors up in any way and we can still find Blacks in any of the litters, Right? Well, do this for ten or fifteen years and after awhile our Blacks paint is going to start to show weakness.

I at no time want to sound as though the Greys and Steels should be eliminated from our standard, but I will say, any breeder who sold a Black out of any of the color crosses etc. for a Black, should be.

Before I turn off, Doris, do you remember a Black Senior Buck I thought so much of at an A.R.B.A. Convention that you and Tom judged first and I believe Best Black that I thought should have been best Dutch, but lost out to a Steel Jr. What was it's breeding again? Out of a Grey, right, Thank you for the space, also the opportunity to come alive again.

Whoops! before I forget I must make clear that when I say Tom is my greatest rabbit friend, I should of said, alive today, because nobody and nobody will ever replace the old probation officer, H.C. Gillie Gilbert. Doris, you will never have print large enough to use on this mans name. So.....God Bless You...I love you all.

I remember having a lot of fun with the A.O.C. class and the Blue-Grays. For some reason they carried the darnest good type. I called them "kitchen sink Dutch, but those we had around in those days made many a Judge look twice for Best of Breed.

I think that one of the reasons that I am getting so interested in colors is that I have several other breeds that have been imported from England and you wouldn't believe the assortment of colors that show up in the litters. It's nothing to have five colors in a litter of 9. Then I get to wondering just how did the English develop this, I can see some of the shadings that were used and I can duplicate the colors but, of course it is strictly for my own information and experience. Of course I am not advocating this experimenting on the Dutch, I am aware that the Dutch raisers have gone through this stage, but the reasons we have evolved to the present stage should be discussed for the benefit of the many new raisers that wonder "WHY"

My husband, Gordy and I were discussing our experiences recently and he remembered an encounter with R.J. Bernhart. Bernhart was judging some show in Iowa and Gordy, (at that time we were new raisers) asked R.J. to show him a good Dutch when he came to one. Gordy stood in front of the judging table for 3½ hours and at the end of the judging again reminded Bernhart of his promise to show him a good Dutch, replied Bernhart, " I will, when I come to one." 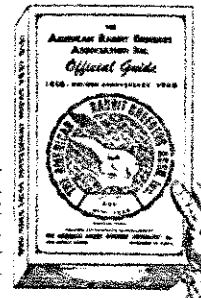
