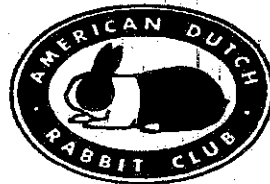

FROM THE DESK OF YOUR SECRETARY.....

Inside this issue of your DR, you'll find your final election ballots for ADRC officers. You will also find the nomination ballots for NDS and ARBA Convention judges. Please take the time to look over the instructions carefully and send in your ballot. This is your organization, so please participate by taking the time to mark and send in your ballot!

You will also find a listing of those members that will be expiring soon. Please check the list, your membership card or your DR label. Your expiration date is listed on each of these. If you renewed after this list was printed, your name will still appear in this expiration listing. You should also note to this office any change of address that you may have. Dutch Reporters are not forwarded and your mailing labels are printed directly from this office.

If you sent in an application for a sanction and the mailing was delayed, it was due to the arrival of our ribbon order. We are at a point where ribbons 'do not keep' as we have and are issuing a large amount of sanctions. Due to the cost of the ribbons, it is impossible to order a large amount at any one time! I think that we are very fortunate as I don't believe that there are many specialty clubs that still issue ribbons for their breed. We offer eight (8), one for BOB, BOS and six (6) for the varieties. Many of the clubs have discontinued them due to the additional cost in mailing and the fact that the ribbons are not inexpensive. The sanction fees will be increased by \$1.00 to help defray the cost of the sanction. This will take effect January 1, 1994. At the present time, there will be no increase in membership fees.

I hope the weather in your area has been a bit better than what we have experienced. It has been extremely hot and humid and very hard on the bunnies! Fortunately, we have an automatic watering system so they always have plenty of fresh cool water. This is a must!! They sometimes don't want to eat much, but they have to have plenty to drink in this weather. (any weather in fact).

Well, talking about bunnies, I guess it's time to do chores so I'm going to close for now and hope to see some of you in the near future.....REMEMBER... Success isn't how far you got, but the distance you traveled from where you started.....

The open division had Tracy Robinson winning Best of Breed with her black senior doe, and Jim and Fran Schettler taking Best Opposite of Breed with a blue senior buck. ## AMERICAN DUTCH RABBIT CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING APRIL 23, 1993 PLEASANTON, CALIFORNIA

The meeting was called to order by President Wenton Carlton. Fran Schettler moved to dispense with the reading of the previous meeting's minutes. Second by George Parmer. Motion carried.

Roll Call found President Carlton and Directors Christ, Gehr, Parmer, Schettler, and Hooper present. All other Officers and Directors were absent.

The financial statement prepared by Secretary Hart was read and approved.

### DIRECTOR'S REPORTS:

Gehr - There is more interest in specialty shows in the area. The Illinois Dutch Rabbit Club is considering a future bid for the NDS in 1996 or 1997. Many breeders experienced bad luck in breeding programs over the winter months.

Schettler - Most activities were in preparation for this year's NDS. There is much interest and enthusiasm in the area with many interested youth.

Christ - There are more Dutch being shown in his area. More youth are showing. No possibilities exist at the present time for a NDS in Arizona due to the limited number of breeders.

Parmer - No significant changes in this area. They have a lack of combined effort to hold shows.

Hooper - Many new strong youth breeders in his area.

President Carlton reported that breeders were down in New Mexico, West Texas, and Colorado.

OLD BUSINESS: The Northwest Dutch RC has taken on the breed secretary and ADRC booth for the Washington convention. Outlines for plans will follow in future DR.

Breeders from California have expressed their concern over the Midwest Dutch Classic show being held so close to the date of the NDS. They felt that some breeders may have chosen to attend that show instead of the NDS.

Director Gehr is planning to present an amendment to the ADRC constitution that would not require the club to mail out ballots when only one person is running for an office. This proposed amendment will be printed in the first DR for 1994.

Director Gehr moved to offer the open sweepstakes chairman's position to Jeff Andrews of New York. Second

by Director Hooper. Motion carried. Director Hooper is to contact Jeff and notify him that if the job becomes too burdensome, there is another interested member for the position.

President Carlton reported that he has received some complaints regarding the DR only being published quarterly. The reasoning behind the decision to publish quarterly was a time and expense situation, as well as a lack of material for each issue. This was also on a one year trial basis, so the DR will continue to be published quarterly for the 1993 year.

President Carlton reported on the Standard Committee. Tex Thomas, chairman of the ARBA Standard Committee was asking for our input. Kevin Hooper has been appointed chairman of the ADRC Standard Committee. Work has begun on updating our standard.

Guidebook chairman Kevin Hooper presented bids for printing our upcoming edition. Director Hooper made a motion to accept the proposal from M & D Printing (the company that prints the DR). Also included in the motion was to have Director Gehr do the layout. Motion was second by Director Parmer. Motion carried. The total cost should be about \$1,500.00 for approximately 3,000 copies if we do the layout and type-setting.

NEW BUSINESS: Director Gehr reported that the ADRC computer had problems. The current system is not presently working. A potential savings of \$1,500.00 could be realized on the Guidebook if we can use our desk top publishing. Director Christ moved that Director Gehr purchase a new computer system (486 with 120 meg hard drive and super VGA monitor, second by Director Hooper. Discussion followed, motion was passed.

A discussion was held on possibly raising the sanction fees (open and youth) by \$1.00 each. This would raise at least \$1,200.00 for the club in one year. This could be used for normal operations and would not directly affect the membership. It was decided to bring this up at the General Membership Meeting.

Director Parmer wanted to know if they should line up a motel for the ARBA convention in Washington for the Dutch breeders. Recommendations were that he pursue a motel for the Dutch people.

Director Parmer moved to grant the Upper Midwest Dutch Rabbit Club the 1995 NDS. April 28 - 30 at Oshkosh, Wisconsin, second by Director Schettler. Motion carried.

A discussion was held on items carried by our Publicity committee. It was felt some new items were needed. We may want to reduce the price of the items in stock to get some money back in liquid form.

Director Hooper brought up the potential problem of selecting judges for the NDS and ARBA conventions. Much discussion followed. Director Gehr moved that the following be placed in the show rules:

\* A minimum number of 5 nominations shall be required to be placed on the ballot for judge at a National Dutch Show or ARBA convention. A minimum number of 5 votes on the final ballot shall be required to judge at a National Dutch Show or ARBA convention. If host club is unable to secure enough judges from those receiving at least the minimum number of votes, then a committee consisting of the Directors of the ADRC from each District serving the second year of their term shall serve as a judges selection committee.\* Motion second by Director Christ. Motion carried.

Director Christ moved to change show rule # 10 to require that only the senior judge of a NDS or ARBA convention be a member of the ADRC. Director Gehr second. Motion carried.

The Board commended the California Dutch Rabbit Club for all the work that has gone into this NDS.

Director Parmer moved to adjourn, second by Director Gehr. Motion carried.

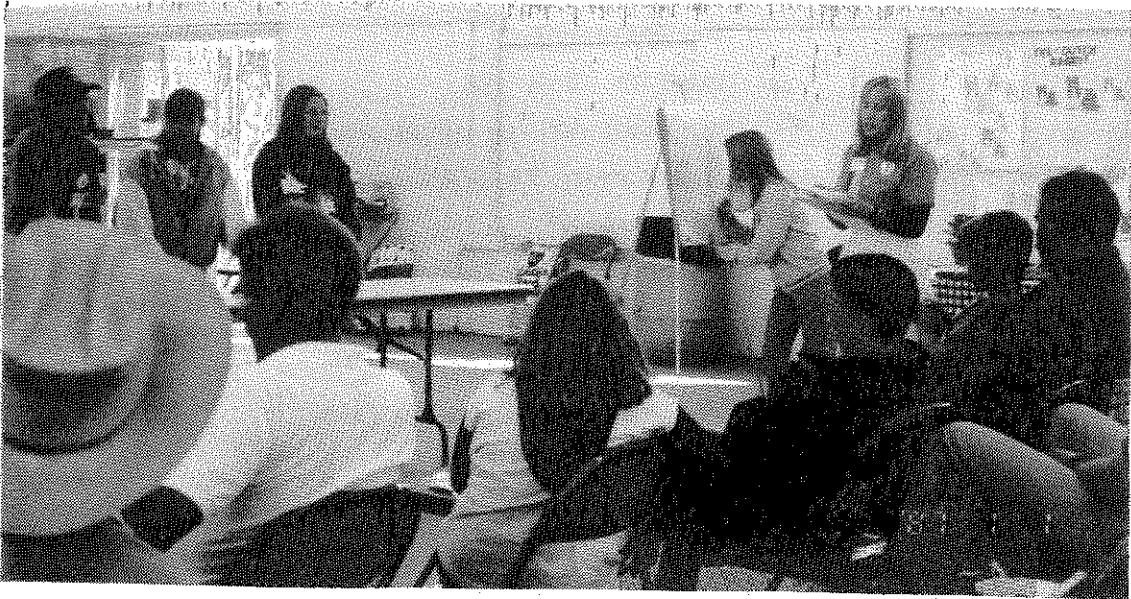

**Standards Committee Report**  
by Kevin Hooper, Chairman

The Standard Committee has been very active since the last issue. I have listed below items that we are considering for the general membership to vote on in the September issue.

1. The situation of the pigmentation on the nose. The entire committee has agreed that clarification of this is definitely needed. However, we have yet to agree on the exact wording or what areas shall be considered a disqualification. Debate as to whether it would be a DQ for pigmentation in areas where fur naturally occurs or for pigmentation anywhere on the muzzle continues. It becomes very confusing when we have pigmentation inside the nostril that can be viewed only when looking into the nostril while the rabbit is being examined.
2. We have agreed that the judge should be allowed to separate the toes while checking to see if an animal has a split stop.
3. We have decided that rewording the "body sidelines tapering" would make sense. (See proposed changes in last DR, No 9 )
4. Refer to No 10 last issue of the DR.
  - A. Agreement by the committee.
  - B. Agreement by the committee.
  - C. Discussion on terminology continues in this area.
5. Gray Dutch. Discussion has just begun on this and we are considering the changes listed in the last DR. Mainly the addition of a disqualification for any absence of complete ring pattern over the colored portion of the body. Also we are considering removing the word "light" under the "fault for light surface color." Below is a copy which I have forwarded to the committee.

Gray Simple word clarification here. I will list the current description with changes highlighted. Please refer to the current description enclosed for current wording.

Two words that I feel should be included in the Gray standard. I would like to see the word "Light" inserted prior to "Brown Gray". I feel this would describe our gray which has proper ring color over the entire body - very visible ring color over the back and a light amount of black guard hairs. The absence of the bold ring over the back and an increased amount of guard hairs is what has made the grays approaching the coloration and confusion with our steels.

The brown gray is to have an agouti coat, showing distinct bands of color when the fur is parted. The color of the fur at the base of the hair shaft to be slate blue, followed by a medium tan band, next to a thin charcoal brown, finished by a lighter tan band to the undercoat. Fine black tips on each hair of the undercoat. The entire body should be interspersed with a light, even amount of black guard hairs. The broadest ring should be the base, followed by the intermediate medium tan band, finished by an even balance between the charcoal brown band and the tan band. (No further changes until the last sentence.)

The top side of the tail must complement the body color with the underside of the tail to be white.

**Faults:** I suggest removing light surface color as a fault.

**Disqualifications:** If we can get nothing else changed in the gray standard, we need this addition.

**Any absence of complete ring color over the body or absence of slate blue undercolor on the belly shall be DQ.**

6. Three steel descriptions have been worked up. Two of which are very similar and have parts from the current standard and some clarification. Discussion on this has also just begun. I have also listed the possible descriptions below

#### STEEL DUTCH COLOR

1. The steel Dutch is a genetic agouti showing only the outermost band on the secondary guard hair. The color of the band ranges from off-white to cream and should not be yellow or brassy. The overall effect of a good colored steel is obtained when the background color is dark charcoal grey highlighted by the off-white to cream colored band on the hair. Undercolor is slate blue carried down to the skin. The belly, underside of the tail, and inside of hind legs should be as near as the body color as possible, but will tend to be of a lighter shade. Medium tan lap spots are permissible.

- Faults:**
- 1) Band not evident on the back or any other portion of the body.
  - 2) Overall brassy, yellow, or brownish appearance.
  - 3) Bright yellow or brassy color in the band.
  - 4) Animals that so closely approach the coloring of a Gray that the distinction from the Gray is not immediately and obviously evident should be severely faulted.
  - 5) Disqualification for visible agouti ring pattern.

2. Entire body black with light gray coloration near the tip of the hair forming a dark uniform Steel Gray. Slate blue undercolor carried down to the skin. Under portion of the tail, belly, and inside of hind legs to be as near as the body color as possible. Medium tan lap spots permissible.

#### Faults

- 1) Absence of Gray coloration on the hairs over the back.
  - 2) Brassy or yellow appearance.
  - 3) same as no. 4 above
  - 4) same as no. 5 above
3. The overall effect of a good colored steel is obtained when the body is dark charcoal highlighted by an off-white or cream colored band. The tip of the hair is dark charcoal. The desired band color is off-white or cream and should not be yellow or brassy. Undercolor is slate

blue carried down to the skin.

The underside of the tail, belly, and inside of the hind legs will be of a lighter shade than the body, however it remain as close to the body color as possible. Medium tan lap spots are permissible.

The Steel Dutch is a genetic agouti with a single band partially hidden due to the effect of the steel extension gene.

Faults:                    SAME AS NO. 1.

I feel that either the number one or number three description would be of benefit to the Dutch breed as well as the Dutch Judges.

The following is a copy of a letter sent to Oren Reynolds, Editor of the Domestic Rabbits magazine.

Dear Mr. Reynolds,

Delmas Cockey of Baltimore, Maryland dies April 29, 1993 after a long illness, at the age of 84.

Del joined ARBA in 1948 and was a life member of the ARBA, American Dutch Rabbit Club, the Baltimore and Howard RCBA, and the Eastern Dutch Fanciers club. He served as Treasurer of Baltimore and Howard for nearly 30 years.

He started in rabbits with Californians, but was best known for Dutch. He had to sell his rabbits in 1968 when the state bought his property for an interchange. He remained active in rabbit shows and the above mentioned organizations hoping to eventually purchase land to restart his rabbitry.

His wife Marge was also active in rabbit showing, and ran the kitchen for Baltimore and Howard RCBA's shows until a year before her death in 1985.

ED: I did not know Del, however I have heard Dutch breeders like Carl Decker, Bill Geitzenauer, Warren McNamara, and others speak of him. My perception is that he is the kind of man all organizations would be glad to have, as he was a good supporter and always willing to lend a hand whenever possible. We extend our condolences to Del's family, and to his adopted family, the Eastern Dutch Rabbit Fanciers.

## LETTERS TO THE EDITOR:

Greetings from New England;

After the roughest winter in years, the long awaited Spring has finally made an appearance. Breeding and litter problems abounded for all breeds this past winter. Even in our rabbitry, where Derek kept heat lamps and 100 watt bulbs going 24 hours a day to keep the temperature above freezing, we'd always seem to have a blizzard with high winds when does were kindling and they's abandon them. But, we're looking forward to a good crop of juniors for late Spring and Fall.

Dutch showings in New England continue to have healthy numbers, especially in the Youth. Open classes are showing a pickup also.

I'd like to spend a little time talking about Youth points being transferred to Open. Unless I've missed something, the discussion seems to be centered around shows that don't sanction Youth Dutch, thereby forcing youngsters to show in Open, and consequently miss out on their points and standings.

I guess in New England we're both unique and very lucky. We are lucky in that there are very few clubs that do not have Youth shows. If there agricultural fairs that don't sanction Dutch, usually a parent will donate that sanction and offer to do the paperwork for the show secretary.

I can understand how frustrating it must be for both the Youth and the parents to work hard, show very good animals, and then because of numbers only not have anything to show for it. Children, no matter how old, need a reinforcement and an incentive to do better. I notice with my own son that the enthusiasm and time spent with the rabbits increases whenever the DR is delivered and someone else has crept up closer to him in the standings. Points aren't all there is to showing, but it sure helps the healthy competitive spirit at our shows.

What needs to be asked, I guess, is why isn't a club sanctioning Youth? If it's economics, then a donation should solve that. If there's too much work for the show secretary, then maybe a donation of time would solve the problem. If it's shown that there is a reasonable Youth entry and the club flat out refuses to sanction the Youth, then I think it's time for the ADRC to start defending its members and for the non-parental adult members to do the same thing. Perhaps a By-Law change making it mandatory for a club to accept a Youth sanction if an Open one is applied for. Perhaps simple pressure from adult breeders on a club would be an easier route to take. In any case, I would encourage parents of Youth breeders to join their local club and join the ADRC. That would mean that for every Youth there would be two parents (two votes) that could improve the conditions for the kids.

Karen Sugalski Con't.

In New England, in 1992, Open entries hit an all time record high. In spite of that the Youth entries still equaled 21% of the total entries in New England. Can any club afford to lose 21% of its income if the Youth stop showing?

I read with a great deal of interest the article by Dr. Reed in the last issue of DR concerning getting does to breed. It was a very good article but I think Doc Reed misses the point a little bit. What the rabbit needs, (especially the does) is atmosphere. In our barn, our rabbits listen to WSRS, a light music station. In the evenings, this station plays a segment called "Love Songs After Dark". That's when we do our breeding. Since following this method, we've had a 98% successful conception rate. I would heartily recommend this method. It not only brightens the rabbits and your spirits but it also gives pause to any visitors to your barn. (I mean the world thinks rabbit breeders are nuts anyway, right?)

Best wishes to everyone for a delightful and fulfilling summer.

From Al Meier:

Dear Dick,

I have been reading with some interest the articles in the Dutch Reporter regarding the Standard revisions. I found, in my seventeen years as ARBA Standard Committee Chairman, that many changes submitted are efforts to describe what is being bred instead of striving for a closer approach to the ideal.

I've been breeding Dutch about forty years and have yet to see one with "freckles". I suppose if we forgive these tiny spots we will have to define how small, or large, they have to be in order to be called a "freckle" rather than a foreign colored spot. Since I've never experienced a "freckle" I'm wondering if there is a genetic tie. If so, it's a good reason to not allow them.

Steel is a favorite color of mine although I've never bred any because Dutch are kind of a side-line to my NZ Reds (60 years). My closest experience with the Steel color is in the early years of my life when my father bred Steel Flemish Giants. Like good Steel color breeders, most felt they had to have Light Grays (Pale Grays in Dutch), and/or Blue Steels in the barn. I tried some years ago to get us to recognize the Pale Gray, ststing Brown-Gray is preferred, with no success.

I'm sending some info from James Read's (Pres. of the British Dutch Club for many years) book on Dutch, first published in about 1942, I believe. Also, there's a good description of the medium Steel color, the preferred one.

ED: The following is a portion of the color descriptions sent to me by Al.

You don't breed Steel Gray to Steel Gray generation after generation. Steel Gray is a made color, and you are like the artist mixing his paints preparatory to painting his picture. Steel Gray breeders usually have Blacks, Blues, Blue Grays, Brown Grays, and Pale Grays in the litters, but do not seem to worry so long as an occasional good Steel or two are mixed in with the rest. Two Blacks carrying the required amount of Steel breeding in their ancestry can throw one or more Steel Gray youngsters from the mating. A Steel Gray buck mated to Steel Gray bred Black does is generally a sound combination to use in your efforts to produce good Steel Gray stock, but as indicated they are bred different ways, and we have breeders who swear that a dash of Blue in the Steel breeding efforts is worth while, and also we have fanciers who decry such recommendations. So, altogether Steel Dutch breeding, as such, calls for a lot of patience and is not the best line for beginners.

Al Meier con't.

For those who are in Steel breeding I recommend the good dark colored specimens for the show tables, as they are more attractive than the light colored Steel Grays, which might be described as stock which only just missed turning up as Pale Grays. The dark shaded Steel Grays are things of beauty, but often lack ticking on the ears, the ear color remaining somewhat solid, especially as they near the tips of the ears. Also sometimes these dark colored Steel Grays lack ticking on the spine.

Pale Grays and Brown Grays usually breed pretty true unless they are results from Steel Gray breeding operations, and then of course, anything may turn up. The Brown Gray is a rather more attractive animal than the Pale Gray, as the former has a more distinct undercut, whereas the belly of the Pale Gray is more or less white furred which often needs blowing into to trace the demarcation line of the undercut. The Brown Gray has a more established and nicer color than the Pale Gray. It is seldom one meets with a Dutch fancier that claims to be a breeder of either Pale Grays or Brown Grays, as any fancier dabbling in Gray Dutch production usually is in search of the fascinating Steel Grays, and the arrival of the Pales and Browns during the breeding operations is merely incidental.

#### STEEL GRAY COLOR DESCRIPTION:

Dark steel gray merging to pale slate blue in the undercolor. The whole interspersed with black guard hairs. The medium bright and evenly ticked shade is the one to aim for and the extreme tips of the full will be tipped with steel blue or gray. The mixture to carry well down the sides, flanks, and hind feet. Belly color will be a lighter shade varying with the top color; underside to tone with the belly color. Ears to match body. Eyes deep hazel.

ED: Thanks for the above Al. I guess it is no secret that those across the pond are supposed to be superior to us in color, however lacking type. As our judging of colors seems to be much from personal interpretation, I would find the above description hard for very many judges to agree upon, however, it must work for our Foreign friends. I would like to say that the first part of your letter (referring to the "freckles", and striving to approach the ideal more, are my feelings exactly. Can you believe it? After 20 plus years we have found something that we agree on! Only kidding, I think we have agreed on many things over the years, but those we differed on caused some intense opinions. I would have been anxious to know your feelings on the maximum weight for juniors. I believe it was during your term as Standards Committee Chairman that we did indeed have a maximum junior weight. Your comments are always welcome, considered, and respected.

From Bonnie Glenn

Dear Dick,

I am enclosing a clipping from our local club news letter. It was written by Susan Berry. I asked her permission to print this in the Dutch Reporter and she gave her OK. As there is two sides to every coin, I found it very interesting because what I wrote in my message was the opposite, as hers was selling since Easter was upon us, and mine was buying breeding stock.

Many times I feel people forget about what is best for the rabbit and buyer when it comes to pets, and we ourselves forget what we are looking for when it comes to purchasing animals for our own use. Especially someone new to the breed. We have found it to be much more rewarding to breed and raise table winners that to purchase one.

**BONNIE GLENN:**

This is the time of year that many of you will be looking to buy breeding stock. Remember - try to buy from reputable breeders! Some one whose rabbits show consistency not only on the show table, but in the nest box and rabbitry also. Try to talk to breeders ahead of time; this will help prevent impulse buying at shows. Before purchasing stock, look at your rabbits. What are their good points and faults? Set a picture of what you need in your mind and stick to it. Don't be afraid to pass by a rabbit if you are just not sure if it fits your picture. Ask yourself these three questions:

- 1 - What are this rabbit's faults?
- 2 - What are this rabbit's good points?
- 3 - Will it complement what I have at home to breed it to?

If you decide to buy the rabbit in question, it is fair to say you can expect to pay more for one of breeding age that 2 - 3 months of age.

If the pedigree shows quality stock in the background, expect to pay quality prices. You are buying that breeders hard work and time - try not to insult them by expecting them to take less than a quality stock price. Don't ask to see quality animals if you are not prepared to pay more than a \$5.00 - \$10.00 pet price.

**SUSAN BERRY:**

Please remember that not every bunny is meant to be a pet and not every person is meant to be an owner of a bunny. Be honest about what you sell and if you don't have the breed or color someone is looking for, send them to someone that does. Don't sell bunnies with any kind of illness, buck teeth, and yes, even beware of selling the runt of the litter. Such animals tend to be frail and are most likely to die. If you do sell a runt, make sure it is well fleshed and sporting a healthy appetite.
