President's MESSAGE

The 2001 National Dutch Show is a thing of the past, but it will be well remembered. The Illinois Dutch Club led by Dick Gehr and company did a bang up job of putting on a well-run show. The fur class was held Friday night so we did not have to cram that into Saturday's schedule. None of the judges had to judge over 180 animals so the show was not as rushed. The seller's class still put us up to banquet time, as the class was large with good quality. The prices in the seller's class were very reasonable for a class that seemed like it had mostly does.

Congratulations go out to the winners: Danny and Cody Lape from Ohio took home the top honor in the youth show with a black junior doe, while Megan Kline had BOS with a tort Sr Buck. This was the largest youth show that we have had yet. The open honors again went to Rick Billups with a Tort Sr Doe, while Marty Preede of New Jersey had BOS with a nice Black Sr Buck. Marty has been forced out of rabbits for a bit due to an unforeseen job change, so it was nice to seem him get the credit that he is due. We will miss him and we look forward to having Marty back in Dutch in the future.

Several items of business were discussed at the Board meeting on Friday evening. The website does now exist, but is still being developed. It is www.Dutchrabbit.com. Eventually this will have everything from sweepstakes standings to recent board action. Check it every week or two to see what has been added.

Other issues at the Board meeting dealt with what does the membership get for its money. This comes up from time to time, and it usually coincides with the Dutch Reporter not being on schedule. The last issue came out about a month late. This one should be to you on time. We are working to keep the DR on a regular publication schedule, as we know that this is

the majority of what you get for your membership dollar.

Lets look a bit further into what you get for your membership fee. The constitution spells out how the memberships are to be divided, with a portion going to the contingency fund (\$1), the secretary's commission (25%), and publicity committee (12.5%). The DR will cost \$6.75 per year, half of which is paid for by sanction fees since show reports fill up about one-half of the DR (\$3.38 per member). The Guidebook which is put out every five years will cost \$3.40 per member.

If you add up all of these costs, the youth membership has a total cost to the club of \$10.78, while the fees are only \$8. The ADRC looses \$2.78 per youth member. The single adult membership costs the club \$11.53, while the fee is \$10. The ADRC looses \$1.53. The husband/wife membership costs the club \$13.03, while the fee is \$14. The club makes \$.97 per membership. The family membership which we put in a few years ago costs the club \$15.28, while the fee is \$20 (for two adults and as many children as they have). The ADRC makes \$4.72 per membership.

So when you look at it, the club is not making a bunch of money on memberships. The ADRC does make some money on our sanctions (\$3.92 per open sanction, and \$1.67 per youth sanction). The money that is made here goes towards sweepstakes awards and the

general treasury. Our sanction fees are in the middle of what most National breed clubs charge.

That leads me to the next question. What does the membership want for its money? We have added several sweepstakes contests the last few years. We provide continuous membership pins for 5, 10, 15 etc. years of membership. The DR, the Guidebook (which is in production), what else should we be doing? This was not a big issue at the show, but this was passed on to me by a member who was hearing this in their area. I rarely hear anything from the membership as for as ideas or what the ADRC should be trying. Do not hesitate to pass your ideas on to one of the Board members or me. This is your club, make your voice be heard.

There was a heated discussion at the general membership meeting on two issues. The first was the judge selection process for the National Dutch show. The complaint was that even though the membership votes on the judges, the top ones are not being secured for the show. The National Dutch Show guidelines, state that "The judge receiving the most votes shall be secured as the senior judge. If the judge receiving the most votes is unable to judge, the sponsoring club shall contact the judge with the next highest number of votes. The other judge(s) will be selected by the sponsoring club with consideration given to those judges receiving the most votes." This was set up this way to encourage the sponsoring club to try to get those judges that the membership selects. At the same time, this gives them the flexibility to get different judges if those on the list were not available, or were all from areas that would require all of them to fly to the show, thus driving up the expense of the host club. A wording change was made to this rule that would make it more specific that the host club hire from the list provided by the ADRC.

The secretary of the ADRC was also instructed to notify the judges that they were selected by the membership to judge in year 200_?. That way, the judge can keep that date open for the show if they want.

The real answer to all of this is to get our National Dutch Shows lined up further in the future. We currently don't have a host club for 2003. One or two clubs are considering it, but nothing has been proposed yet. Ohio is planning on 2004. If we can get the show scheduled in further in advance, then we can get who we want.

The last big issue which was also very heated at the Board meeting, was a decision that was made regarding the DR. In the Oct-Nov-Dec issue of the DR there was a whole page allotted to the report on the Harlequin Dutch Show that was held in Pennsylvania last fall. I received several complaints on the fact that this was in the DR, and it looked like the ADRC was promoting the Harlequin Dutch. After consulting with some other breeders/officers in the club, I made the decision that we would not put any further show reports for the Harlequin Dutch shows in the DR. It would be okay for there to be articles on the breeding of the Harlequin Dutch, the genetics of, or any other educational article that someone wanted to write on the Harlequin (or other variety). Much discussion was held on this at the meeting. We have a provision that provides for a Dutch Reporter committee to oversee what goes into the DR. That committee will be appointed and they will have sole responsibility for what goes into or does not go into the DR.

One last note, The California Dutch Club is the host for our Dutch at the ARBA Convention this fall. They are in need of any donations for awards that you may be willing to give. Anything from \$1.00 to \$100 would be appreciated. Send any of these to Fran Schettler.

The membership numbered 762 at the National Dutch Show. So we have reached quite a good number. And in that vein, let me talk a little about what it costs to service a member of the Dutch Club:

That is the cost for a new membership. The guidebook is only included for new members, so the cost to process and member renewal is \$3.40 less.

The costs for sanctions stand at:

Ribbons -	\$1.28
Forms -	.25
Mailing -	.55
Counter -	\$1.00
Sec Com	\$2/open, \$1.25/youth
Total	\$5.08/open \$4.33/Y

So we have \$3.92 from an open sanction and .67 cents from a youth sanction. I feel that 1/2 the cost of the DR production should be taken out of the sanction fee and since it costs about \$3.38 per year for each DR, we are now at .54 cents in the plus column for an open sanction and \$2.71 in the minus column for a youth sanction.

I have heard some question about what you get when you join the ADRC, and as you can see, I think it is value for your dollar.

NEWS FROM SUE

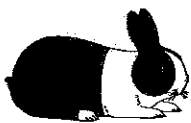

A Tribute to a Doe

May 4th was a sad day in my rabbitry this year. I lost my oldest and probably most productive doe ever. The following is her story and history.

She was a gray doe who was born on June 25th of 1995. Her ear number was KG184. She had a really nice deep body and was well marked, but her stops were just a bit long. She had an ugly head and very nice color. She had her first litter in late January of 1996. She was the meanest most protective doe when she was bred, and when she had bunnies. But, she produced well.

In total she had:

18 litters

1 litter lost - her last one on 4-10-01 of two babies

106 bunnies born total

4 bunnies died from the 1st 17 litters

2 from her last litter

98 bunnies were raised for an average of 5.77 bunnies per litter

47 of her babies were tattooed 23 bucks - 24 does

8 different bucks were used with this doe

6 legs she won including 1st place Sr Doe at the '96 ARBA convention

2 offspring (at least) were Best Gray at the NDS and ARBA Convention

1 offspring were Best opp Gray at the NDS or ARBA Convention

2 Grandsons/daughters were Best gray at the NDS / ARBA Convention

This year, the Grays were the 3rd largest variety at the National Dutch Show. I have sold quite bunch of grays the last few years, many of which went to those of you who exhibited a lot of those grays. The grays have improved in the last several years in quality and number. She was a big part of the boom in the grays.

The winnings that her offspring won were nice, but that she has had such a part in the building of the grays is what made her special. I have lost many rabbits over the years, but I don't know if any have saddened me like losing her. Look at your Gray pedigrees. If you have any of my line in them, you'll probably find KG184 or her son, KG213.

HALL OF FAME 2001 WINNER REGGIE SHULL

It was indeed a great honor to be inducted into the Hall of Fame. It was also a great surprise; this is something I never thought too much about or expected. so when Kevin calls my name it caught me completely off guard.

I first started with rabbits when I was about 7 or 8 years old. My father raised and showed. Checkered Giants and my brother and I would take the baby bunnies

out and play with them in the back yard.

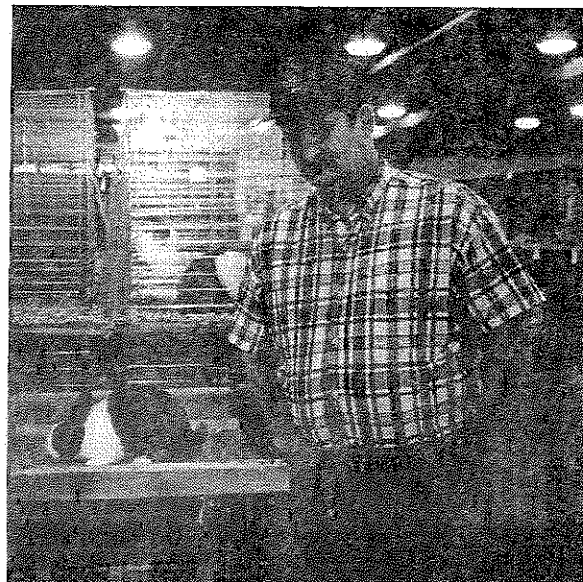
Briony and Eric did a great job judging and the best part was seeing all of my friends from out of state.

I am looking forward to the NDS in Indianapolis next spring and the ARBA Convention in Peoria in 2002.

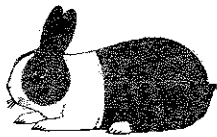

DUTCH IN THE SOUTHWEST

Dutch Rabbit Club of Arizona held a specialty show Feb. 10, in conjunction with the Arizona State Convention Double All-Breed Show. 41 Dutch were shown in each show with all varieties represented. Wenton Carlton's Black Buck captured BOB and his stunning steel doe earned BOS in the DRCA show. Dutch numbers are down this year in Arizona, but we are working to reverse that trend.

April 7 & 8 was California State Convention triple show. Some 60 Dutch were entered in each Open show plus a good showing in Youth. Youth breeder Beau Williamson, who shows in Open, had BOB Dutch in all three shows as well as BIS in two of the three open shows – once with a Black Dutch and once with a Chocolate. Had not met him previously. He appears to be a courteous exhibitor and gracious winner.

April 21 we held a rather unique show in Arizona. The county fair was running April 18-22 in Phoenix. The Fair personnel agreed to allow us to hold a one-day carrier double show on the fairgrounds without requiring us to leave our rabbits on exhibit. Rabbits entered in the Fair were cooped at the opposite end of the building from where the show was held. It's a good thing the show was small – under 300 total for both open and youth. Fair goers interfered with exhibitors trying to get rabbits to and from the tables. Our show area was roped off, so it cut down on some of the traffic. 29 Dutch were shown in each Open show plus several in Youth. A big dust storm came up mid afternoon causing an influx of people into the building. Power was off for a brief period suspending judging. It was an interesting day. Of course, we all had a good time anyway.

California R&C Shows held a double benefit show April 29 in Pomona. 52 Dutch were entered in each Open show and 6 in Youth. Joanne Purpus was in charge of the great raffle. While she is doing well, she stated that she had not yet had a complete recovery from her surgery. She has cut back on her rabbits.

However, she is looking forward to being actively involved with the 2001 Convention in Del Mar.

Linda Pavey has been missing some shows due to her mother's illness. Sincere hopes that her mom will have improved health soon.

Fran Schettler has notified area regional Dutch clubs that she and Karen Leonard are working on providing Dutch awards for Del Mar. Any donations would be most appreciated and should be sent to Fran.

May 5, Southern Calif DRC held a specialty show in conjunction with the Antelope Valley R & CBA show at Lancaster, CA. 41 Dutch were entered in each show with all varieties exhibited. John Eubank won the open show with a Black Dutch and Specialty with a Blue.

Blast furnace heat arrived in Arizona by early May with temps near 110. The higher elevations in the northern part of the state are still comfortable. The rest of us in the desert regions of Ariz and Calif are running our coolers full blast and praying that we do not lose rabbits. Rolling blackouts in Calif are a reality and a major threat to the rabbits. They say we should be OK in Arizona for now. Of course, the show reason has ended in Arizona. 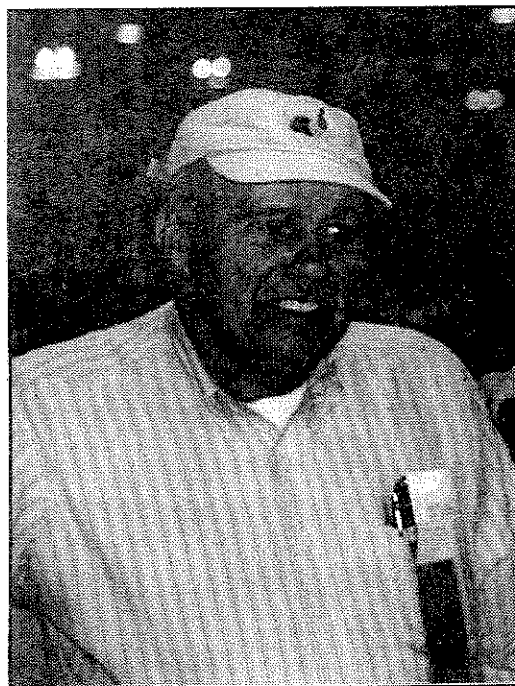

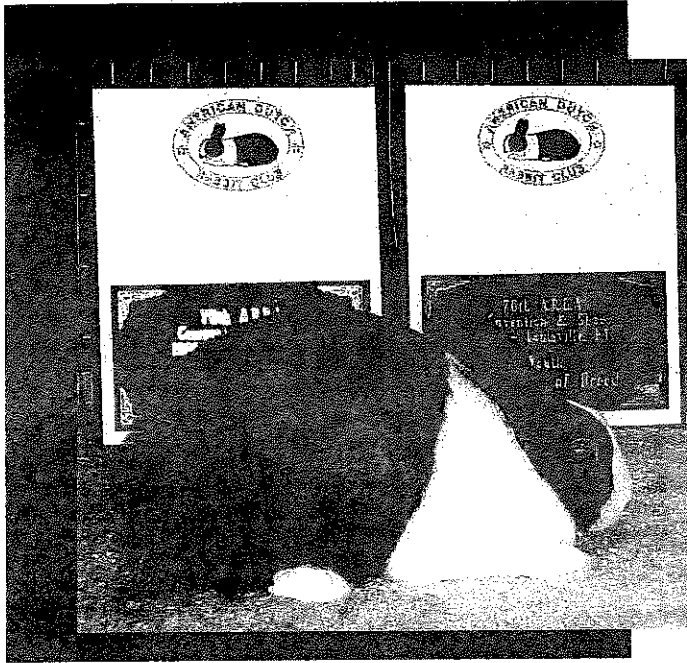

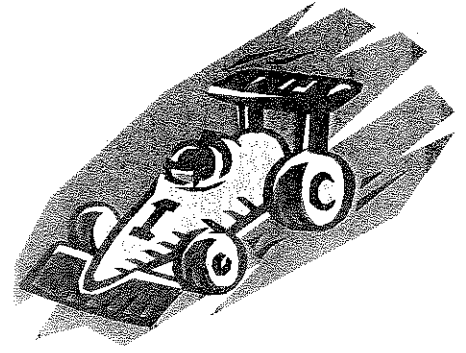

I saw a lot of really good things on the table this year. Overall I noticed that the consistency and quality of type has improved a lot in the past few years, especially in the Black classes. The old saying, "you have to build a house before you paint it," is true. There were a lot of animals placing lower down in the class that still had the type to be excellent breeding stock. I was also impressed by the color on the Blues. I didn't see any with faded or washed out color. Fur overall has improved as well. I saw a lot more short, thick coats as opposed to long and thin coats.

I also saw some things that can be improved on. Color on Chocolates tended to be faded, especially on the senior bucks, many of whom were sunburned and had patchy coats. I also saw a few Grays who looked like Steels at first glance and vice-versa. I was disappointed to see several rabbits brought to the show table with hutch stain on their feet and rear ends. I also saw a lot of vent abscesses. It's easy to fall into the habit of knowing that your rabbits are fine and not looking them over before loading up for the show, but giving them a glance can save you some embarrassment and entry fees.

I owe a big THANK YOU to all of my table help, who were literally my salvation. Before lunch break I'd strained my right arm, making it hard to lift the rabbits out of their holding coops. So for the rest of the show, Danny Hulva handed me every single rabbit as it came up to the table, then when I lined them up Cody Lape handed them back to me to give comments. Those two were really on top of things and were the reason I could keep up the pace. I also had a wonderful group of comment takers: Roger Guetschow, Kelli Slack, Sara Lape, and Jessica Aisbet. Thank you again, to the Illinois Dutch Club, the youth breeders and parents for the privilege of judging your animals this year!

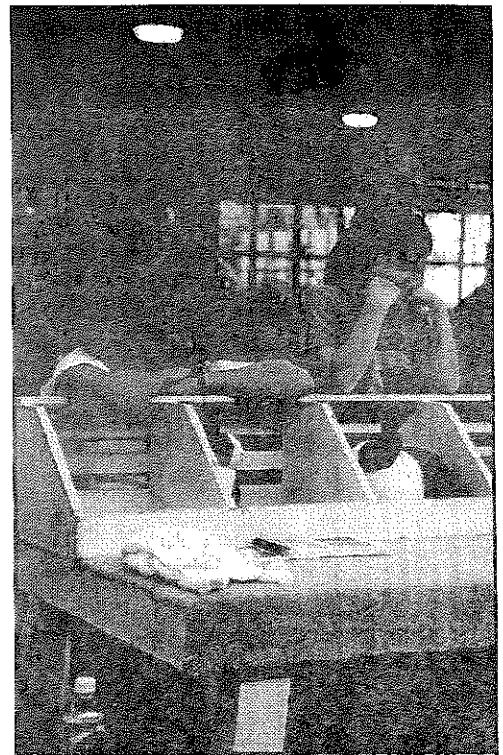
