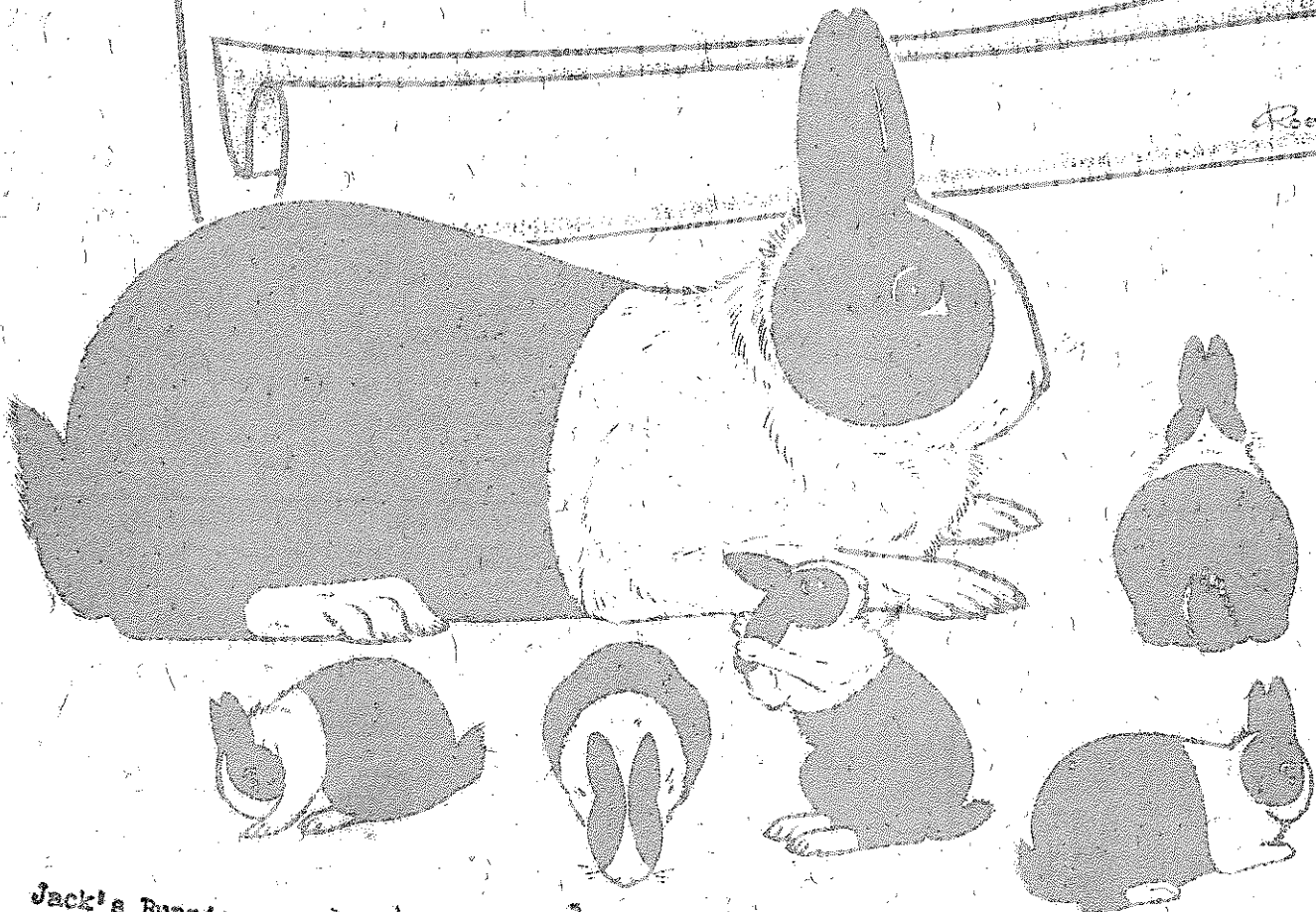

YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH

I just finished reading the June Dutch Reporter, and I must say I enjoyed the articles for the Junior Department of the A.D.R.C. I have a few comments to make on this big thing for the little ones.

I am the 4H advisor for our 4H Junior Rabbit Club here in Paulding, Ohio, and also leader of the Paulding Junior Rabbit Breeders Ass'n. I have 17 members in the 4H Club, and 24 members in the Junior Club. (Some of the members are too young for 4H work.) There have been times I've pulled my hair out, and other times I'd like to have pulled the hair of some of the members. But we all lived through the summer and had a grand Junior Department of 73 head of single entries; 2 meat pens; and 3 doe and litter entries at our recent sho in Paulding. Some entries were also entered in the Open classes, and did well. We are proud that we had the first Junior Department show in this area, and many fine comments were made upon it. Because of this show, it looks as if our Junior Club will be larger next year.

Now for my comments about the Junior Department of the A.D.R.C. The cost of one of these shows is well worth the money. To watch the kids sweat out a class will pay the ones who put up the prizes much in return. Yes, Bill Stedman, you are right; the Dutch Club must provide a way for these youngsters. They are the future backbone of our Club. I only hope all other Specialty Clubs follow the ADRC's trail, and get on the ban-wagon soon. These kids are also the future backbone of the Rabbit Industry.

Mr. Hord states that exhibitors of the Junior Department should not be allowed to exhibit in the Open Classes, "because of the remarks of two different Judges" will up the kids. I ask you---"Why DO WE HAVE A STANDARD, if the judges do not follow it??" All remark cards that I have seen from the two departments, Open and Junior, on the same rabbit, were very similar. After our show last week, Bobby Burns and I compared many of the remark cards on the rabbits that were in both Junior and Open Classes and found very little difference in the meaning of the remarks. The wording may have been a little different. I say let the kids show in both classes. It will make him or her proud to win in the Junior show; then come back in the Open class and beat Dad. I think that closing the Open class to Junior exhibitors will do more harm than good to the Club, the rabbit, and most of all the kid. As to entry fees, let the judgment of those sponsoring the show decide that. They know what they can afford. I do not say that we should be very strict in the quality of the rabbit, and in judging by the Standard. This Junior Department shall and must be educational. Let us NOT teach the kids to use foul means in order to win, such as plucking or clipping.

At Detroit last April (1954 National Dutch Show) Ray Grables and the 1954 National Dutch Show Committee set up a fine set of rules for the Junior Department. Let us use them. They are the rules I tried to follow at our recent show, and I think we had a successful show. It takes good planning to run two shows at the same time, with rabbits entered in both shows; however it can be done. Shorty (Mr. Boroff's brother) and I did it with very little mix-up, if any.

Just received my copy of the Dutch Reporter and was so pleased with the idea of forming a Junior Department, that I thought I would just let everybody know how I felt about it right away.

I have been raising rabbits since 1937. I started out with New Zealands and while I was at one of the shows my eyes spotted some of those little Dutch rabbits and right away I was sold on them. Soon after that I had to move and did not have the room for as large a breed as the New Zealands so I immediately purchased a bred Dutch Doe and later a Buck and have been raising and showing Dutch ever since. Nearly twelve years now, and I hope I shall be able to continue to for many years to come. But to get back to this Junior Department. I think it is the best thing yet in Dutch. Last Fall I gave a youngster near me a trio of Junior Dutch. This spring he started raising them and he raised some very nice Dutch. I have already sold a good number for him, which has made him very pleased. Also this spring I invited him to attend one of our local spring shows and helped him select two of his Dutch that I felt quite sure would place at the show. He took 2nd. in one class with one and picked up a special and a prize for being the youngest exhibitor. Needless to say this youngster was one pleased fellow. The expression on his face when he received the prizes and the way he talked about the show on our trip home was pay enough for all I had done for him. Also his teacher next day asked him to give a short talk to the rest of the school about the rabbit show. This day at the show was sure a red letter day for him. This is just to let you breeders see what can be done along this line if we try, as you read how it paid off for me.

I shall by all means be donating a Dutch rabbit for the Junior Department Show at York, Pa. Another thing for us to think about, in regards to these youngsters, is the more young people we can get interested in something like this the less trouble we are going to have in this country with young people doing things they should not. Give them something to do and think about with their spare time and we will have better men and women in later years.

Lets get behind this fellows, and put it over BIG. Why not each breeder make a pledge to give a youngster in his community that is interested in rabbits a pair of Dutch to start with. Also take him along to one of your local shows and if you are not convinced that you are well paid after watching him enjoy the show, I will be surprised.

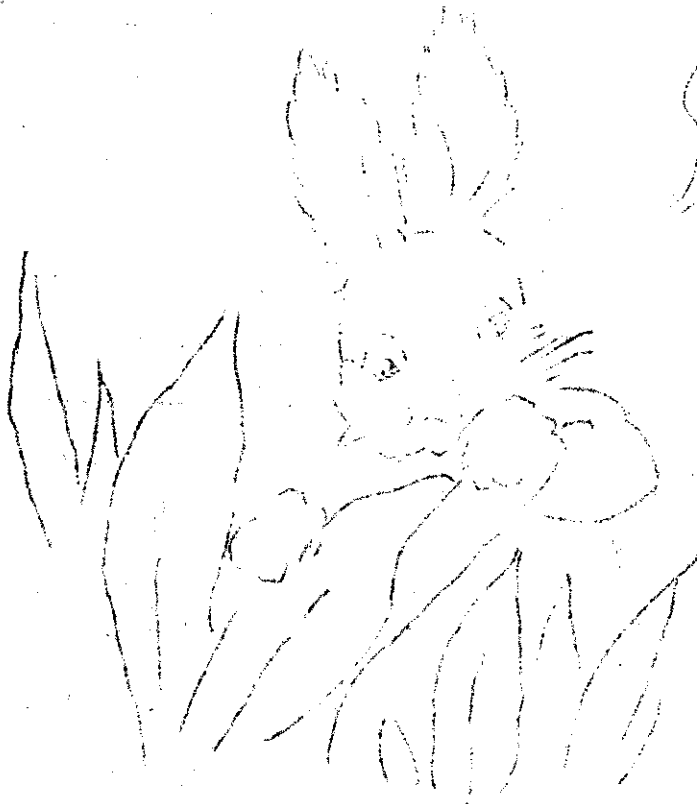

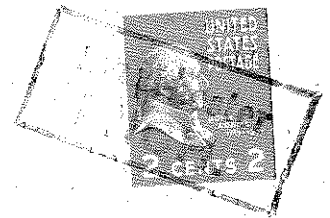
