

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR SECRETARY

This may sound a little garbled and confused as this is all a new business to me. Heretofor, all I have had to do is copy what someone else has written, and hope I didn't make too many typographical errors. Now the whole responsibility rests on my shoulders. If I err in judgement and print something which offends someone here and there, you can blame my inexperience. I assure you I will try to remember a lesson I learned at my mother's knee. She used to tell me, when I asked her if some action was right or wrong, "There is one rule that will always answer that question for you. Is it unkind? The kind thing is always the right thing." All I ask of the membership is that they will please be a bit patient with me, and I will try to do my best. I will probably learn some things the hard way, and perhaps tread on some toes, but believe me, it will not be intentional and I hope the injured member will let ME know and not condemn the whole American Dutch Rabbit Club for my mistakes. Enough of that.

Now to a few things I have on my mind: First, I know there has been much confusion as to who to write to for Sweepstakes Sanctions which as accounted for the lateness with which I have been receiving applications. It is really too bad for the club sponsoring the show that this should happen. As you know we publish these coming Sweepstakes Shows in the Dutch Reporter and if you will check through the list in this issue, you will find some listed for the first time, that are already over and more that are practically upon us--much too late to write for catalogs and to get entries in on time. Our Show Rules state that all applications must be made to the Secretary at least sixty days prior to the date of the opening of the show. If you who are members would please keep your local clubs informed of this it would help me here and would also give your club the benefit of this extra advertising.

You will find elsewhere in this issue a report of the voting in the recent nomination election. You will remember that one of the things that was voted on was a raise in the dues for the ADRC. This amendment was passed, and after some correspondence with President Bayliss, it seems that this amendment is to go into effect the first of the year (Jan. 1, 1958). I have already received several renewals at the new rate of three dollars per year, some came in that way even

before the ballots were counted. This makes it necessary for me to write a letter and refund the extra dollar. With all of the work piled up in front of me I could well do without this extra chore, so I hope the rest of you, whose dues are about to expire will PLEASE send two dollars for one years dues, only. After Jan. 1, 1958, it will be necessary for you to send either three dollars for a single membership, or five dollars for a husband and wife combination membership.

I know there has been quite a bit of dissatisfaction over the announcement of Dutch judges for the AIBA Convention, and I feel that some explanation is due the membership. As soon as I read the list of judges in the trade magazines, I wrote to Mr. Wade asking him why our wishes were not honored in this matter. He wrote right back telling me that my letter was the first official word he had received concerning the ADRC's choice of judges. I feel partially responsible for this myself, as it should have been one of the first things I checked into after taking over as Secretary. However, I knew the results of the election of judges had been announced in the Dutch Club meeting at St. Paul, and had been published in the April issue of the Dutch Reporter. It never occurred to me that the original OFFICIAL notification might have been lost in the mail, and if it had occurred to me I wouldn't have given it much thought as I would have been certain that Mr. Wade would have consulted our very efficient Breed Chairman, Clinton Dennis. I assure you that another time, such an important document will be sent by registered mail, with a return receipt requested. If the ADRC's desires in such a vital matter are ignored another time, you may rest easy, it will NOT be the fault of the ADRC.

I am publishing in this issue, all of the One Day Sweepstakes reports that have been returned to me, up to Aug. 10th. All ribbons have been mailed out on these shows. I had hoped to be able to announce the final standings on the old two day series that ended with the National Dutch Show at Oklahoma City, however there are four show reports that either have never been returned or have become lost. I have written the secretaries for these shows, notifying them that I do not have any record of their shows and requesting new copies, if they were sent. I will be forced to close the series and announce the winners in the Sept. issue, with, or without these reports. The Sept. issue will also bring both series up to date, insofar as the reports have been received. I wish to thank all of you for your patience with me in bringing these matters up to date. I have received many letters of confidence in recent weeks, all of which I have tried to find time to answer personally. If I have missed you, please accept my humble apologies and consider this a THANK YOU! There are only twenty-four hours in each day and no matter how hard I try to stretch them, I still can't find an extra one anywhere.

I'm looking forward to meeting all of my old friends at Little Rock and making lots of new ones. My greatest pleasure at any Convention, is fitting faces to the names with which I have become so very familiar in publishing the Dutch Reporter for the past two years. I was very happy the other day, to receive a visit from J. Russell Hall and his wife from Hornell, New York. I only hope that any of you who might be vacationing in this "Water Wonder Land", will find time to look us up, too.

NOTES FOR BEGINNERS

According to an article which appeared some time ago in "Small Stock Magazine", our Dutch are hybrids from a genetical standpoint. This is the reason that Dutch breeders have a greater problem than other breeders when making selections for future breeders, also a greater problem when culling. We breed for good color and type which are a MUST for all Dutch; but the markings are hard to come by if perfection is desired.

Dutch breeders with much experience find that the perfect animal still is to be bred, although some really good ones have been raised, and have won at the shows. The challenge of trying to breed perfection has made fans of some people for most of their life span. We do have a better breed now, than in the past.

Many novices in the raising of Dutch no doubt have questions on their breeding, but hesitate to ask older breeders for one reason or another. Now we have a man who has had much experience with Dutch in our A.D.R.C., whose job it is to answer questions. That man is Tom Shufflebotham, and he can set you straight on many problems. Don't be afraid to ask--he will be glad to help you. I can speak from experience, for he has given me good advice several times. His address is on the front page of the Dutch Reporter; and many of you should take advantage of this opportunity.

GRAY DUTCH

To all Dutch Club members, may I offer my opinion on the Gray Dutch. As all this fuss comes up time after time and it is not the Gray rabbits fault at all, as I see it, and have seen it with my own eyes on the show table, I feel I must express my feelings.

Now we all have to work for a living and therefore we must learn a trade to make a living. Some of us are salesmen, doctors, plumbers, etc., so let me make myself clear, this statement mostly concerns our Judges. How can any Judge, have the knowledge to judge, not only Gray Dutch but any breed, if he does not raise them himself? This is ESPECIALLY true of Gray Dutch. I myself, have been a Gray Dutch breeder for the past 18 years and my Grays are pure-bred Grays. It hurts me, deeply to read so much fuss about them.

As for the standard on Grays, may I say some parts of it should be corrected. I would like to know from what dictionary the word "brassy" was picked up. That is the first word out of most Judges mouths on their remarks on Gray Dutch. To me brass is a word used only for metal products, not in fur color. Many of our Gray Dutch are not Grays, as I will explain. I've bought Grays from Coast to Coast and may I say, many were not Grays at all. Some had Steel undercolor showing, many are too light in color, some are too dark, ad as a result in breeding them, the litters show the result of poor breeding practices. From the young they have, you may get any, or all colors. I have argued again and again with various Judges on Grays and hope I have made them understand what I mean about color.

May I please offer my description on a good standard for Gray Dutch, as I see them after my 18 years experience: Color should be Sandy Gray, not Brown Gray as Brown is a dark color. The body color should be Sandy with a large amount of black guard hairs, evenly distributed over the entire body, with color being darker over the rump. Black lacing around ears, and undercolor-white, but if you look close, this undercolor is a light cream, therefore the belly color is not a pure white, and Grays should have a V-shaped brownish color band between belly and hind quarters. This band, the Standard does not mention, and many of you think, on this account, your Grays are not good, as the Standard calls for white. Also when a Gray is in moult it should look light Sandy, not brassy as Judges state.

I can't see why this fine color can't make Best of Breed. I raise Grays that have plenty of type but have never seen them placed Best, the Judges just brush them aside.

I also raise Steels, cobby in type and what I call good Steel color, fur texture--short, weight  $3\frac{1}{2}$  pounds, this also applies to my blacks, blues, chocolates, Tortoise and Golds. As I see it a good Dutch should weigh between  $3\frac{1}{2}$  and  $4\frac{1}{2}$  pounds. At this weight the Dutch have the best type. As for ear length, the shorter the better. I like them right about  $3\frac{1}{4}$  inches. As for heads: Dutch should have short rounded or bull heads. These are the only strains that you will find with nice

round cheeks.

I'd like to comment on 5½ pound Dutch--at this weight, as I see it, you may find type, but that type will show up better on a 3½-4½ pound animal. The 5½ pound Dutch may be better as a commercial rabbit as it comes up to weight for meat and laboratory stock more quickly, but that is all. In my opinion the 5½ pound Dutch has too much length of body and is more apt to have a loose flesh condition, and often has too long ears. As I see it, this long Dutch may have been good enough once, but we are going ahead, not backwards, and this small, typey Dutch with short ears, comes nearer to being what is wanted today.

In closing, I would like to say, let's get together and get our Grays and Steels up to the front as Best of Breed. Let's make up our minds what WE want and then insist that our Judges learn to know what WE mean.

We realized that this would be close, because no one wants to pay out more money, but I don't think this slight increase is going to hurt any of us, and will certainly do the Treasury a great deal of good. To those of you that voted against it, I don't blame you a bit, because as I just mentioned, nobody wants to pay out more money, but to those of you that voted for it, our Ways and Means Committee wants to thank you very much, because with your cooperation this is the only way that we can do the job that we were assigned.

Now we ask your cooperation on this "Sellers Class", and we as a committee will appreciate it ver much if each one of you breeders that exhibit at the Convention will put up a few of your rabbit to be auctioned off in this "Sellers Class".

In addition to this, other breeders around the country will have a chance to get a hold of Convention quality stock, thereby giving additional publicity to your herd. As a last request of your Ways and Means Committee, your cooperation in making this "Sellers Class" a big success will be more than appreciated by all of us. Be seeing you at Little Rock.

AMERICAN DUTCH RABBIT CLUB

RULES TO GOVERN "SELLERS CLASS"

1. All entries in this class subject to sale to the highest bidder. Owner to receive 25% of bid price, Dutch Club to receive 75%.
2. No entry fee charged for this class. Rabbits MUST also be entered in OPEN

competition, upon payment of regular entry fee.

3. Entries to be given to Breed Chairman. Entries accepted up until judging time, which will be after completion of open classes.

4. All pedigrees to be turned in to the Secretary prior to the time of Auction if possible. All pedigrees and cash specials guaranteed by the ADRC.

5. Senior Judge to judge all Bucks.

Junior Judge to judge all Does.

Five to be placed in each class, final placement to be made by both judges working together. First place Buck to be compared with First place Doe for First of "Sellers Class". Next Best Buck and Doe to be compared for second and so on until five have been placed.

6. Bids to be open to all during entire show. Bidding to be by written bid, giving cage number, ear number, name of bidder and amount of bid. All bids to be dropped into bid box provided by Show Secretary at Dutch Club Booth.

Minimum bid \$5.00.

Bids will be closed just prior to judging.

7. Auction and final sale will be held at the Annual Meeting of the American Dutch Rabbit Club. The Show Secretary shall determine the highest bid on each rabbit and so advise the auctioneer, bidding minimum \$5.00.

8. Any rules or regulations not provided for in the above to be decided upon by the ADRC Board.
