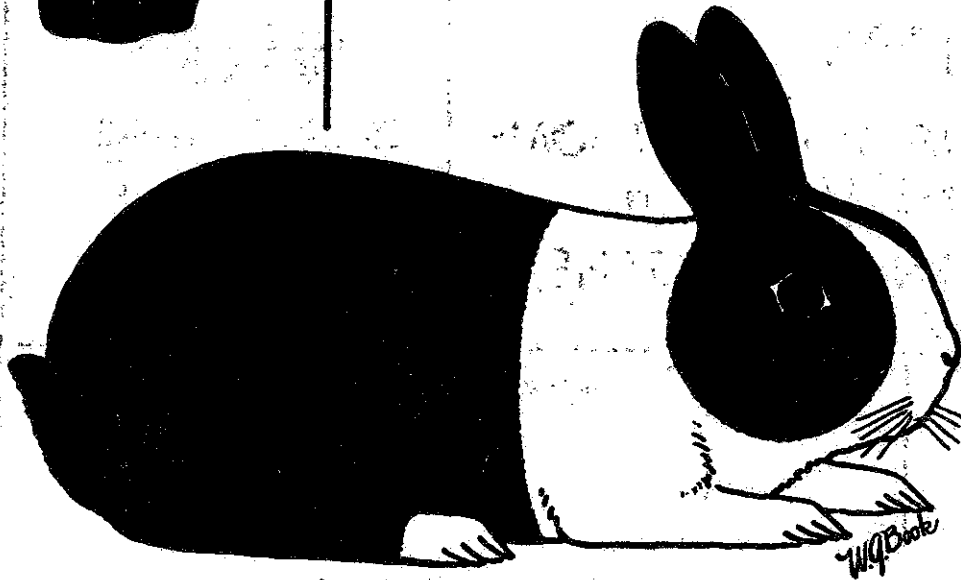

## A DUTCH BREEDERS OPINION

by J. C. Early

I read, with interest, Mrs. Weinhardt's article a few months ago in Small Stock on the proposed closed registration system and will say that I heartily agree with her.

I can't help but think that this proposal is just a scheme hatched up in the minds of some registrars to make more money from registering rabbits. Just how many articles have you seen written in favor of such a system by breeders who are not registrars? They all claim they want to help the ARBA, but have not stopped to think that this proposal would split the ARBA wide open, and leave no one in it except the well-to-do fancier. Take myself for instance, I keep thirty breeding rabbits, trying to work it so that half of those are replacements each year. That would mean thirty dollars in registration fees a year. Now just how many small backyard breeders and fanciers can afford that? Or how many large commercial breeders who keep over a thousand breeders can afford it? I raise rabbits because I like to raise them. I can't afford to have a hobby unless it is one that I can make pay its way - I know there are bound to be many others just like me, that such a system would ruin or force out of the industry altogether.

It seems a shame that after some of our pioneers have spent years trying to bring the commercial, the small backyard breeder and the fancier together that their work should be thrown aside by a small handful of selfish know-it-alls who have no other thought than that of personal gain. I say handful because that is all it will be when (and if) it is put over. It is true that it will have to be put over by a vote, but just what percent of the general membership gets to vote on a question like that? Only those that attend the National Convention, and just how many of us can afford that? I don't believe there is a one of those who advocate it so strongly that would agree to put it to a mailed vote of the membership and then shut up about it when it is voted down by the membership.

I wouldn't want anyone to think from the fore-going that I am against ANY registration. Whenever I keep an outstanding rabbit I register it, but whenever it gets to where I have to register all or none - I will be through.


