

SECRETARY'S CHIT-CHAT

So many interesting letters have been coming to me during the past few weeks that I just feel that I must touch on some of the material in a few of them. have just moved their rabbits into new quarters. She says, "It's 90 here today but the rabbits are comfortable. We have them in all new welded wire coops, self feeders and are installing dew drops. Some are in but not hooked up yet. The center section has to come down to get them between the 3 decked rows in the middle. We had to get the animals back in them until Sunday. Also have some more hutches to go in. It's shaping up nicely. We have metal trays under the upper ones and may put fishworm bins under the bottom -- haven't decided yet."

She goes on to say, "If you know of anyone out here (in the vicinity of Pueblo) who needs hutches they are \$20.00 per 3 coop section, trays extra. Buck cages 24 x 36, doe cages with baby saver wire 30 x 36. This man also charges the same for smaller developing pens. I can't see any difference between them and commercially made ones. He had made the ones I bought for himself and then had to dispose of his rabbits due to his wife's health as he has to help care for three children besides working an 8 hour day. I am thrilled to death with mine. It is a 20 year dream come true." Mrs. Pierce will be more than happy to put you in touch with this worthy man should you find yourself in need of his services. And I know she would be more than delighted to show off her new rabbitry. Congratulations, Virginia.

Mrs. Pierce also puts in a word about the Colorado State Fair which is in charge of H. F. Pedigo, assisted by A. L. Hambrick. Show secretary will be Mrs. Jack Vaughn with Mrs. L. L. Earle as her assistant. The judges will be C. E. Lewis and Don Guthrie. She goes on to say that their club is planning a fried rabbit dinner for their next meeting and they will invite the State Fair Manager, Clyde Fugate and his wife to attend.

I also received a correction on the report of the Niagara Frontier Rabbit Club show, held on April 9th. Mr. Zimmerlay of the South Eriz Rabbitry tells me that he won Best Tortoise with his junior buck and not the junior doe as reported in the July Dutch Reporter.

A letter from Lee Oelka of Wayne, Michigan requests help with a problem which he and some of the other Dutch breeder members of the Auto City Club are having trouble with. He felt that if this problem were presented to the membership at large, perhaps someone might have an answer. It seems that a source of supply of small size (2 lb.) meat cartons just cannot be located since the ARBA discontinued handling them. He says they do not like to use the trays and cellophane, but would much rather have a carton, prefferably one with a window as these stack easier in a freezer and are much more distinctive. Should any of you know where such cartons can be procured kindly drop Mr. Oelka a line, or write me and I will see that he gets the information. I also had a letter from Bruce Nicholson regarding the August issue of the Washington State RBA's monthly Newsletter, The "Bunny News". I think this is a very commendable project and hope it will stimulate interest in Dutch rabbits in that part of the country.

I suppose most of you received a letter from Mr. Bill Hobin of Cranston, R. I. requesting your vote for him for the office of Director in the ADRC. It was my unpleasant duty to inform Mr. Hobin that due to the fact that his membership in the ADRC was of less than a year's duration, he was not as yet eligible to run for any office. Many a lesser man would have turned his back on our club and said, "the heck with you. I've spent a lot of my own money for postage, etc. and that is all it is appreciated." Not Mr. Hobin! My hat is off to him for the sportsmanlike manner in which he accepted my reproof. I'd like to share his reply with you --

"Dear Mrs. Weinhardt:

"I would first like to express my gratitude for calling to my attention the fact that I am ineligible for the office of Director of the American Dutch Rabbit Club.

"Second, if it is at all possible due to the fact that it is past the 15th. of the month, to put this letter in the August issue of the Dutch Reporter I would appreciate you doing so.

"You called to my attention on page 14 of the ADRC guidebook, section 4 under Voting proceedure, 'Any member, to be eligible for office, must have been in continuous good standing at least two (2) years prior to certification date of election October 20, and————! As my membership dates from Octover 22, 1960 this would make me ineligible before next years election.

"The reason why I thought I was eligible for office was, because of the following: Page 8 Article V-Officers Section 2 - The officers shall be elected from and by the membership by mail ballot. ANY MEMBER TO BE ELIGIBEE FOR ANY OFFICE MUST BE THE OWNER AND BREEDER OF DUTCH RABBITS. HE/SHE MUST BE 21 YEARS OF AGE.

I would like to thank the many letters of well wishes from members who pledged their support in my behalf, and also apologize to them for wasting a most valuable vote.
