He told of a new club in Des Moines, Ia. The ladies of this club, set up a display and manned it for the day at a Super Market, giving out samples of cooked rabbit etc. C. Jay was able to sell over 100 fryers because of this (at this time of year yet!) shows what a good group of people, joined together, can do to help a processor help the rabbit business. Many of these fryers were Dutch. C. Jay buys Dutch bucks at 2 3/4 # and claims that they are more in demand than the larger fryer. This would stand to reason due to the many apartment dwellers that buy at unit prices for one meal. If you raise your Dutch to standard with ideal weights, these fryers should be available about the 10 week stage. Here is an idea for those mismarks, eat them.....The laboratory market also seems to demand Dutch, C. Jay could sell many Dutch Does from three pounds and up. If you will note his ad in the Dutch Reporter, it starts out with "We are in Dutch" beleive it, folks, it's true.....

Every so often I receive a phone call from a person interested in Dutch breeding stock etc. Have you ever wondered how I handle that? I pick up the latest copy of the Dutch Reporter and read off the ads. How else will I know who among you has stock for sale. There seems to be a demand for Chocolate Dutch.
