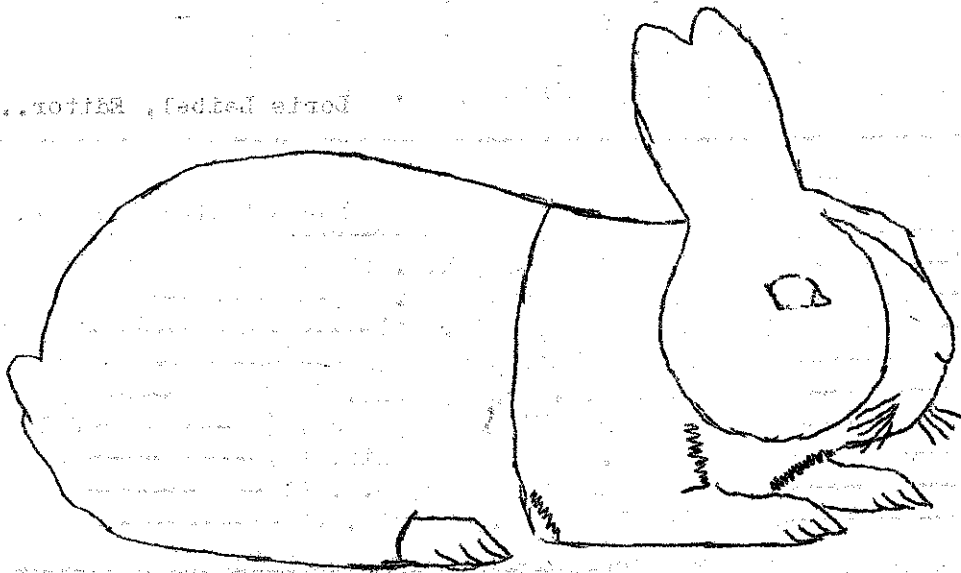

FROM OUR MEMBERS:

To my fellow fanciers:

Being quite disturbed by our new method of show reporting, in our Reporter and realizing why an economy move is necessary, I believe a new method should be devised. This method would be less lengthy than the old yet quite complete. First, eliminate all non members by the notation N.M. Why should we publicize an outsider, when they contribute nothing toward the propagation of our Specialty Club? Free advertising is not what we need at the present time. Secondly code all show reports with the code after each, sounds tough doesn't it? It really sounds worse than it is and yet it is quite simple, even a non technician can absorb the information. Here is how it works. All classes whether Black, Blue, Tortoise or what start with Sr. Buck, then Sr. Doe, Jr. Buck then Jr. Doe. These can be coded A, B, C and D in the preceding order. The members will be coded 1 to A finite amount dependent on the exhibitors. An example; Black (21) A(9) 3,5,1,2,5. B (4) 1,4,1,3. C(5) 5,2,3,3,5. D(3)2,1,4. etc. all colors. Sweepstakes Points: (1) Don Jones, 130. (2) Doris Hart, 47 etc.

Using this method complete show reports could be communicated. I for one spend a lot of time absorbing all information possible. A 4th place winner's rabbit in a class of 20 can be "practically" perhaps not "theretically" equal to a first place rabbit in a small class. (this can be highly disputed by our many fine Judges.) The switch from show to show class placement is a well known fact and can be proven by most show men. I contend all members deserve equal publication rights and the show reports being discriminated by their very nature. Perhaps I am spoiled being a member for so many years, receiving complete reports during that time. Damn it! the Dutch Reporter is a Reporter. It's purpose in life is to communicate information to it's members which I believe that it is not now doing.

While on the subject some years ago, it was thought by a past president or Editor, that all Board of Directors should successively submit an article to the Reporter on the Dutch Rabbit. Most all of the Directors have raised Dutch for many years and are respected for this or they would have not been voted into office in the first place. The rank and file, I feel, would look forward to these articles containing short cuts, hints or color breeding in general. It's too bad that most of the articles that the Editor HAS to use are from 15-20 years old. Something must be new! I find new habits or traits in my bunnies every month that I didn't know about 10 years ago. I guess that I must be the only one who does. Let us know what your thoughts are on this and the preceding section are.

I do know that our President, Don Reid, did request articles from our Directors and Don Lovejoy came through with a dandy on Color-Crossing. Remember your Editor needs inspiration too, and good constructive articles would go a long way. Ed.
