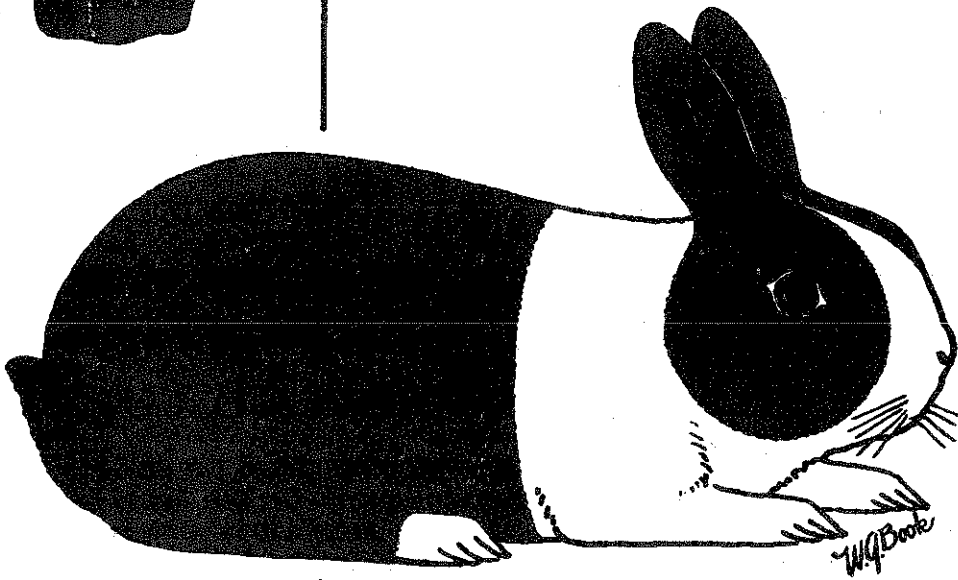
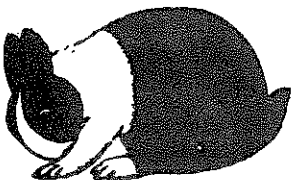

## SECRETARY'S CHIT-CHAT

This being the final edition of your Dutch Reporter for 1961, it seems in order to do a bit of reflecting on what the past year has brought about. Forward progress by your Club has been slow but steady. We have established a few "firsts" and "bests" during 1961. Some of these things came about at our National Dutch Show at Colorado Springs. That event produced the biggest All Dutch show the American Dutch Rabbit Club has ever taken part in. At that show, for the first time, the rabbits were all carried by six lovely girls dressed to match the six varieties of our rabbit. For the first time the judging of a National Dutch Show began in the wee hours of the dawn, 6:00 A.M. and was all completed in one day in spite of the size of the show, freeing the remainder of the time for meetings, the banquet and the usual activities that take place when the serious business of judging has been finished.

Although the number of Dutch at Louisville was smaller than we have had at previous Conventions, we could well be proud of the quality of the display. We had one of the most attractive booths at the Convention and much satisfaction was expressed over the smooth operation of the show and the meetings.

We have sanctioned more sweepstake shows in 1961 than in any other year in the recorded history of our club. Interest in Dutch has increased tremendously as proven by the fact that we now have 390 paid up members, many of them old-timers who have decided that they just couldn't stay away from Dutch. One reason for this has been the expanded operation of our Publicity Committee, which has a year behind them to be proud of. A Guide Book Committee has been appointed and is beginning to function.

It would be wishful thinking to say that everything had gone smoothly, we have had our ups and downs as must be expected, but I think it can all be summed up in the words of that great novelist, Fanny Hurst, who once said, "It is better to regret what you have done, than to regret what you have not done."

In 1962 we have room for much more growth and development in the size of our organization and in the quality of its service to it's members, which will take the full cooperation of every single member and officer of the ADRC.

May I take this opportunity to wish each and every member and their families the very best wishes for a joyful Holiday season and may the Peace of the Lord gently touch your lives.

YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH

LET'S GET ACQUAINTED

(Condensed from letters from Wayne MacKinnon, of Brockton, Mass.)

Our rabbitry, which is located on the outskirts of Brockton, a city of 70 Thousand, isn't very large having 33 hutches of Black, Blue, Chocolate and Tortoise Dutch.

We have been raising Dutch since 1955 having raised White New Zealands, Reds and Blacks, Giant Chins, Flemish Giants in White, Black and Sandy, Silver Martens, Rex in White, Blue and Black, and a few Californians and American Blues. So you can see we have been through most all of the popular breeds. My reason for having only Dutch now, outside of because they are my favorite is because we live in a well settled area, near a shopping plaza, and with all the new homes, we, like so many other breeders have had to go to a smaller breed to save room. But even if I had a farm I would still like the Dutch above all other rabbits as I am very much a showman and like to go to the shows and find a lot of interest in Dutch in Southern New England.

The quality of the Dutch here is very good -- expecially in Blacks and Blues, but does get a bit thin outside of these two colors.

In the next year you should be receiving some new members from new Dutch breeders in the New England Area. There is considerable talk of starting a New England Dutch Club and having an all Dutch show. It looks like in a year's time we might have both.

I think some of the articles in the Dutch Reporter are most interesting and you do a marvelous job with it. I expecially like the articles by Tom Shufflebotham and Oliver Milliken. I am starting to put the Milliken method of breeding into practice, as my space is limited and find that the young do put on the weight as fast when weaned at 3-4 weeks of age. Also the doe is in much better condition for breeding than if I left her litter in with her for 6-8 weeks as I had been doing.

I guess I could write about Dutch all day long, and the fun I have had raising and showing them. I'm sorry I didn't write sooner, but I have been one of the guilty ones -- letting others do the writing for me.

I would like to read about other rabbitries in other parts of the country.

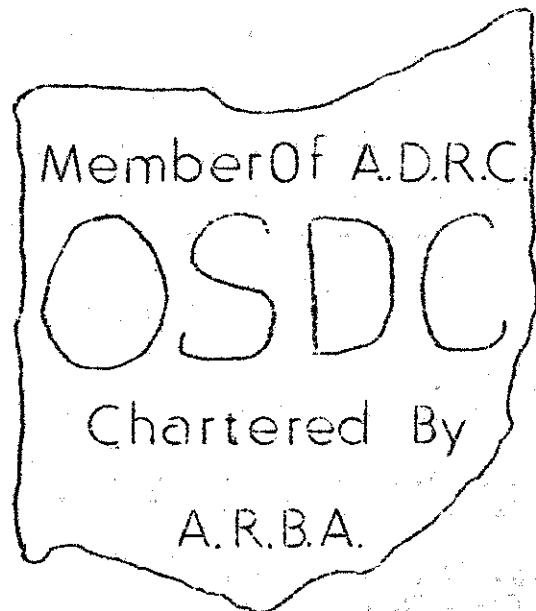

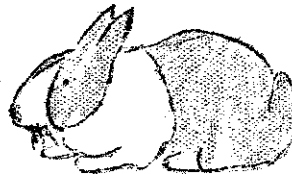
