YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH

#### WHY SHOULD I EXHIBIT MY STOCK?

(Editor's Note: I do not know just when this article first appeared as it is listed as a "reprint" in the March, 1947 issue of Small Stock Magazine. It certainly is just as pertinent today as it was when the ink was still wet. JW)

Why should I exhibit my rabbits at our local shows? Many are the times that this question has been asked. Maybe you know that your rabbits are good, but it sometimes takes more than your word to convince other people. And that "something else" is blue ribbons.

The weakest argument I can think of, (one that I have heard quite a few times) is that they can show their rabbits enough at their rabbitry. This creates an unfavorable impression, or convinces all visitors that you are afraid to exhibit your stock. It is for this type of breeder that I entend this article.

People see your rabbits in the show room. When a visitor to your rabbitry sees your best stock, he understands it only as the best of your stock, but when he sees it at the show with a first-prize sticker on the coop, he realizes that it is better than any that the other breeders have. If he is at all interested, it will be considerably easier for you to make a sale. More people will learn about your rabbitry from the showroom, consequently you will have more visitors. The more visitors you have, the more sales you will make, and that is what you want.

People are beginning to realize that the swindlers in the rabbit game sell scrub stock. Naturally, they will not show their stock if they know that it will be disqualified, and so they don't show. We will say that a visitor comes to your rabbitry, looks around and is naturally wondering how your rabbits compare with others. The best way is for him to attend some shows, where, if you haven't any stock there, you will fall down considerably in his esteem. He will think that you are interested only in raising scrub tock and getting the beginner's money for some worthless stock. The way to avoid anyone getting that impression is to exhibit at local shows, appear in the showroom, and to be a good winner or a better loser.

Blue ribbons win sales. When a beginner comes to your rabbitry, he usually comes for a purpose. That purpose is, many times to get information. If you can show him some blue ribbons, he will think of your rabbits as superior to others, and this will greatly influence him in giving you his future orders.

To the prospective beginner, ribbons are something to be regarded with awe. If you can show him a good collection of them, he will be greatly influenced in your favor, which will usually result in your receiving his first order. If you can satisfy him, and he finds that they are as good as you said they were, you will probably receive his second order, and continue to do so as long as you do not misrepresent your stock.

Every good thing has its enemies, and the American rabbit Standards are no exception. But almost all breeders of any consequence will admit that the rabbit that wins first prize at the shows is also the best from a commercial standpoint. Its fur is better, and its superior type in many cases shows, that it is a better rabbit.

If your rabbits are not prize-winners, you will be able to see where they are falling down. You can compare them with the winners and see how they excell yours. You can learn more about the faults of your rabbits by listening to the judges remarks.

It is your duty to show. You (that is, the majority of the readers) will admit that the local, state and national clubs do a lot to futher interest in the rabbit industry. Of the many publicity schemes the local clubs, the one that you can aid the most is the show. Your club gives you entertainment, publicity, information, etc., and then calls on you for help in making their show a success. The publicity is for

YOU, not so much for the association, so it is up to you to help yourself.

The moral of this article is that it is your duty to yourself, to the association and to the rabbit industry as a whole, to exhibit every time you can.

Dear Mrs. Weinhardt:

I have a comple of suggestions for the Dutch Reporter which I feel would be helpful to some of the newer breeders.

1. I would like to see a breakdown of how points are awarded in the sweepstake standings, who is eligible for points in the shows sanctioned by the club, etc. you know, the rules in general.

2. Incertainly would like to see some short articles from some of the experienced Dutch breeders on tips of the type you can't find in any book on rabbittoreeding. but are only learned by being in the game a while. A few examples I have discover-\_ed\_or\_heard\_aboutofollow:Unit landing of the control of the contr

a) The use of willow twigs to clear up scours.

b) Replace your rabbits in the hutch tail end first to avoid scratches when the rabbit sights home.

c) Have a small stalk of alfalfa or any greens for each rabbit when inspecting or feeding them. Rabbits that are gentle and friendly and come to the door, not hide in a corner when people come near can do much to sell themselves.

- d) Most feeding plans put out by feed manufacturers are slanted toward the large commercial breeds. I know some of us new guys would like to know what the feed requirements of the Dutch is. Some for doses of penicillin and other Medications for the sick ones we all have once in a while.
- e) Put in the feed before the water so the occassional ornery one won't have the water upset before you even get the feeding done.
