THIS 'N THAT

I was interested in several comments that I have read in recent articles in our Dutch Reporter, and thought I might make some comments that might of interest to our readers.

There was one article, a reprint of an earlier article by a Canadian on the blue color which I have to agree with. It was his contention that we have two shades of blue color, each desirable in its own right even though only one conforms to our standard on color. Our standard on blue color calls for, "a uniform medium dark blue". This color was referred to as the exhibition color. Occassionally a blue will pop up with extremely dark color, this blue would be extremely valuable in our breeding program, but should not be given extra credit on the judging table. I know this color will catch a judges eye, but is not the color we are actually striving for. The natural tendency in Blue Dutch is for the color to lighten, and the extra dark blue can be used to help your breeding program. I can see no danger in getting the color too dark because of the lightening tendency.

Was also interested in several written comments on judging and the results of the present judging. My opinion is now and always has been that the future of our Dutch rabbit lies in improving our present type. Cobb type is the most important drawing card of the Dutch Rabbit. I get a tremendous amount of mail requesting stock, most of them mention that they want a small cobby animal. Seldom is good fur or color qualities mentioned, but small cobby type is a must. I feel it is a grave mistake to disregard these other qualities, but the point I wanted to get across is that Dutch people all across the country are striving to improve their herd type. For my own personal likes or dislikes I have always been drawn to the cobby type. I have also found across the country, bu big plurality that the breeders are in favor of a cobbier, stockier animal. I don't, however, want to convey this as an unanimous opinion, as each and every person has their own opinion. I will say that the Dutch rabbit is cobbier today than it was five years ago, and was cobbier five years ago than it was fifteen years ago. In my opinion five or ten years from now we'll see a vast improvement over our present type. It is downright discouraging to me to see a rabbit take best Dutch when personally if the rabbit belonged to me it would find its way to the stew pot. The reason advanced for arriving at the better marked animal placing above the better typed animal is because there are more points on markings than there are on type.

I would like to quote two sentences from our Guide Book under instructions to judges----"Strong consideration should be given the animal that carries balance of type and markings." --- "The only reason for allotting points or figures on various sections is to bring out their importance." It is only natural for a judge to fall back on the allotment of points in a close decision, which is as it should be. However, if our judges will pay heed to our instructions to the judges it could help keep our B.O.B. Dutch in the breeding pen rather than the stew pot.

I had hoped to be able to take care of those chores long before now, but it seems that there are a few wrinkles to be ironed out before it can be done, such as securing a copy of the Convention catalog so that I know what the specials were on. I have been told that the list of donors of specials on Dutch which was taken up at Springfield were not included in the catalog. I do not know why this was omitted as it was sent to Mr. Lutes along with other material which was printed. I'm sure the omission must have resulted from an oversight by someone which I hope we can forgive. My name was one of those on that list and if it was omitted from the catalog I couldn't care less as I did not make the donation for personal advertisement but for the betterment of the show and I'm sure that was accomplished.

This is a total of \$41.00 and if any of you who were not in attendance would care to contribute to this fund, it will be accepted by this office and credit given in the pages of the Dutch Reporter.

Like our president, I too would like to enlarge on a theme we have been reading about in these pages in the past. My concern is also with judges and judging but for a change I would like to give a well deserved pat on the back to one of our younger judges. It was my pleasure, this past week-end to watch Bob Byrne judge the Dutch at the Indianapolis show. It was a moderately large show there being over 100 Dutch entered and the quality was exceptionally good -- not one single disqualified rabbit and most any of them could have held their own in any show. I had seen Bob judge Dutch about a year ago and we had a talk afterwards. I don't say that I did anything to contribute to the fine job he did this time but I did recommend that he go home and really study his Standard. Evidently he did and it paid off gloriously. I think one of these days soon we will find Bob right up there with those who are rated tops. One thing I would especially like to comment on was his careful attention to color. Most judges comment on the color of the majority of the rabbits they handle, but I don't think I have ever heard a judge remark on EVERY Dutch, not only the quality of the top color but he blew into the fur inspecting and commenting on the quality of the undercolor of almost every one. I think this is something we need to pay more attention to and that we could profit by watching it more closely because no top color is going to stand up if it has the improper coloring toward the base of the hair shaft.

Another fault that I have noticed becoming more predominant in our Dutch is a spreading out of the cheek markings onto the shoulders of the rabbit -- oh, yes they are nice and round but if you run your finger along the jaw bone where our Standard says the color should end you will find a good half inch of color spreading out like a shawl beyond the proper line. To me this is an uglier fault than runs down under the chin at least they don't show until you pick the rabbit up.

I wish to correct an error in the last issue of the Dutch Reporter -- G. A. Burke judged the Dutch along with George Bayliss at the Convention in Pomona, not Don Reid as I had it listed. Guess I thought just because Don was there he might as well have worked too, but I'm grateful to him for setting me straight.

Keep the home fires burning -- it's going to be a long cold winter before the date of the next show.

One other thing I wanted to talk to you all about. I've been told that many of you are not getting the show listings until it is too late to get a catalog. I realize that part of this is my fault because your Dutch Reporter has been going out late more than early the past few months, however it is not entirely my fault and when your club starts to plan its shows remember that our rules call for application to be made for a sweepstakes at LEAST 60 days prior to the opening date of your show. There are two cases in point right here. I have two requests for Sanctions in this month's file for publication in this issue -- one came in on Nov. 8th. (too late for the last issue).
