Speciality Club recommendations are not binding on sponsors of A.R.B.A. Conventions, but they try to cooperate if and whenever possible. This is Rule #3A of A.R.B.A. Convention Rules. These rules are given to members interested in sponsoring A.R.B.A. Conventions or by request.

The magic number for 1973 is 400. 400 Dutch at National Dutch Show in Sidney, Ohio in April and 400 Dutch at A.R.B.A. Convention at Detroit, Michigan in October. We will need a lot of SPECIALS to get this size entry.
