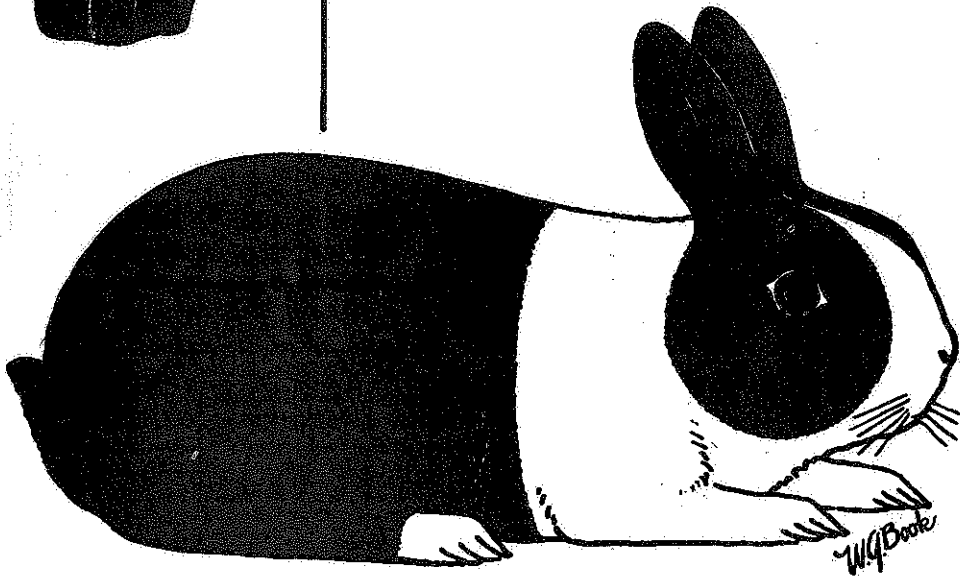
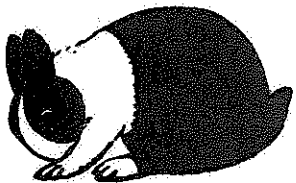

SECRETARY'S CHIT CHAT

We had mailed our entry for a show in Springfield, Ohio and early Saturday morning I called the show superintendent and told him it looked as if we wouldn't make it for the Sunday show. Along about noon our Standard Oil man came through with his four wheel drive pick-up and his tank truck and plowed out our road and our driveway so that he could deliver us some much needed fuel oil. We called the State Police Post and learned that all roads south of the Ohio line were clear so decided to risk it. After we crossed the Ohio line we hardly saw any more snow until we got back home. They had had a real bad ice storm in northern Ohio that week, but the roads were clear and dry. Of course everyone was surprised to see us after they had had the report that we couldn't get out. Bless that Oil Man!

We found a real good crowd present at the show with over 400 rabbits and over 100 Dutch. We learned that those Ohio boys are really working to put on a good National Dutch Show for us in April. "Mac" Thatcher and Don Weeks were really talking it up, but they sure need a lot more help from you, the members. Do you realize what a terrific prize list we could have if each one of you contributed just \$1.00 each? Of course if you can do more it will be greatly appreciated, but get in there and do what you can even if you find you won't be able to attend the show wouldn't it be nice if you knew you had helped to make it a success?

Next month the shows begin in earnest. How many nice little untried juniors do you have in your pens? Don't hold back, take them to the shows and find out just how good they are. The more Dutch that are shown the more people that are going to want to get in there and have some of these popular beauties to show themselves.

I had a real interesting discussion with one of our Dutch Club member judges at the Springfield show. I had noticed that certain rabbits produced an up and down show pattern, but I'd never given it much thought. This judge cleared the picture up for me, and I feel sure that he is completely correct. He said that all judges could be divided into two categories: Those who looked first for the good points of any rabbit and gave them full credit for those qualities, not cutting too severely for slight faults. The other group looks first for faults and then discredits the good qualities because of the faults. This very likely accounts for why a certain

This show is for the young people and will be run by them. Their advisor will be Clarence Shock, a successful Greene County 4-H Leader. Youth Co-Sup'ts. will be Gary Lewis, Larry Shock, Mike Adams, Bruce Kucharski, Tom Pitstick, Eddie Yound and Scott Wells. Youth Secretary - Mary Jo Shock, assistants, Debbie Russell, Sandy Hoy, De'ie Walker, Diana Southworth. Trophies - Ruch Shock.

There will be trophies for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best of each color in the Youth Division -- you may pay for one of the Bests of color if you so desire.

You will notice that the name Shock appears quite frequently in this set-up. They show under the name of Country Acres Rabbitry, and it is a family affair. Another nice thing about the Shocks -- most of our shows are on Sunday. They bring their rabbits, then go to church. Later on they return. How many of you can say, "I do too!" Wish I could.

I realize that your young people won't have too much notice of this show, but bring them and their Dutch along. They will need entries to fill those classes and I am sure no one will object if the Judge is just a little bit lenient. There may be tough competition as these youngsters show against us right along and Debbie Russell, Gary Lewis and the Shocks have all won Bests of Breed. I know that all of the youth committee have really good Dutch.

The youth may enter some in each show if they want to -- but NOT the same rabbits. They would pay the same entry fee as the rest of us in the senior show.

We have placed no money in the Youth Division, but will leave that up to your generosity. Don't forget to hurry. We do have to get that catalog to you.

As sponsors of specials, you folks are all related to me. I wait until it is too late. Now I'm sure that none of you want to be related to me, especially that way. So!! Get busy and send them in now. You are in the 98% group. Get out of it!

We haven't heard from a majority of the club's officers, directors, state publicity committee (they don't write articles for the Reporter, either do they? Shake them up Bill.)
