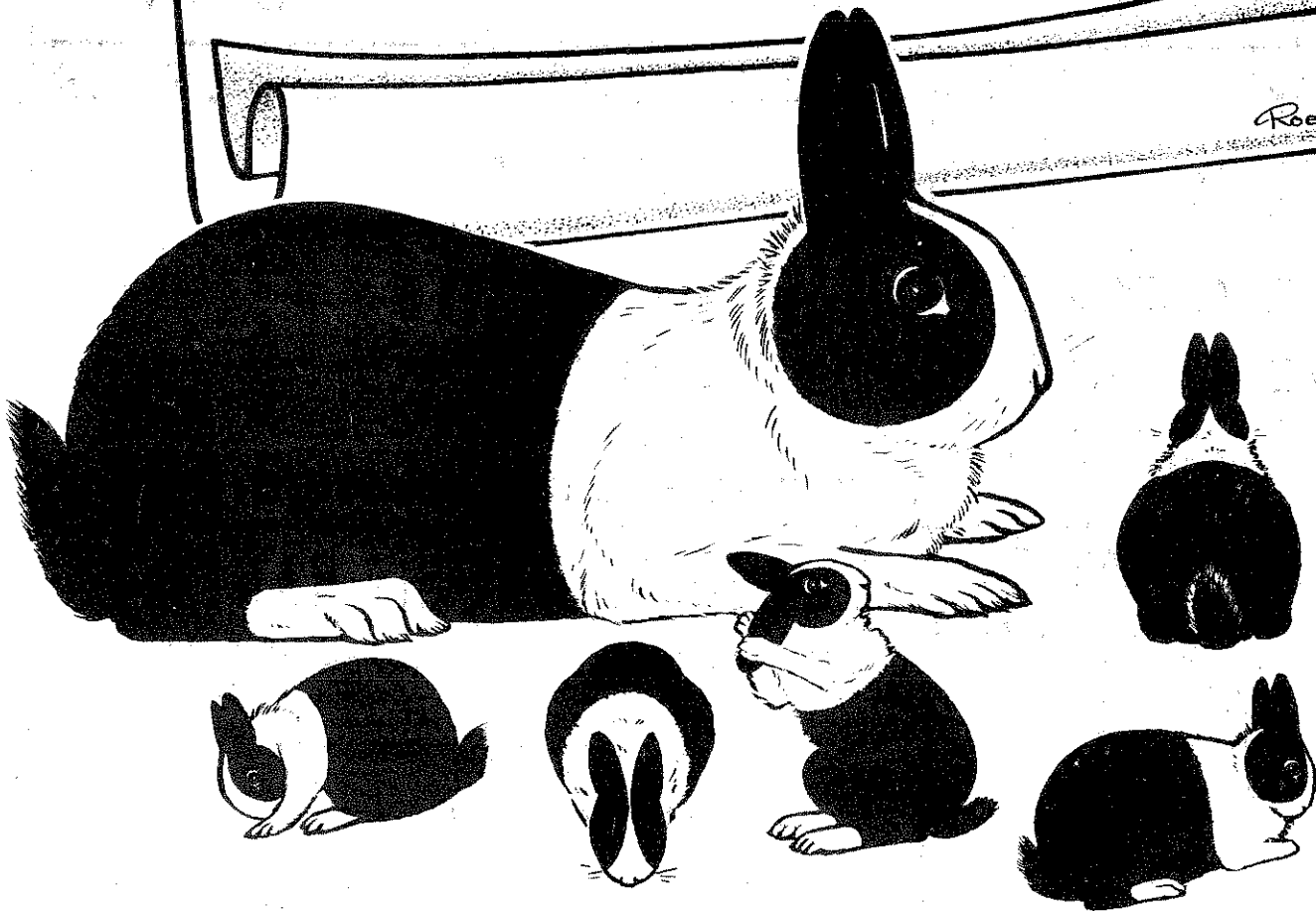

DUTCH RUMBLINGS

The month of February finds us in the midst of our winter and there will be many cold days ahead. Each year at this time there are many fine DUTCH lost through freezing at kindling time. It is well worth the extra effort and time spent in providing the doe with extra comfort during this period in the way of ample supply of nesting material. I have also found it a very worthwhile practice to save the extra fur pulled during the summer months and provide it for the does that are due to kindle during extreme cold weather. Also wherever possible, move the doe into a heated building to kindle. After the young are a few days old they may be returned to their original hutch. I have raised some nice show animals by practicing the above methods that I would have otherwise lost thru freezing before the doe had a chance to cover them with fur.

GOLD DUTCH AT THE YORK CONVENTION

Nine Gold Dutch were exhibited at York by three exhibitors. One Senior buck, two Senior does, two Junior bucks and four Junior Does.

These were carefully checked by the A.R.B.A. Standards Committee under the direction of Chairman Dick Parker and their official findings are as follows: "It seems to be that the Head, Ears and Tail of the Gold Dutch is carrying a color similar to the Tortoise and should be cleared up if possible before the next Convention, or at least improvement must be shown by that time on this particular part of the Working Standard."

From this statement we can see that there is still a bit of perfecting to be done on the Gold Dutch and it behooves all Breeders that are interested in this color to pitch in and help eliminate these serious breeding faults so that in due course this Color can take its rightful place in our Standard.

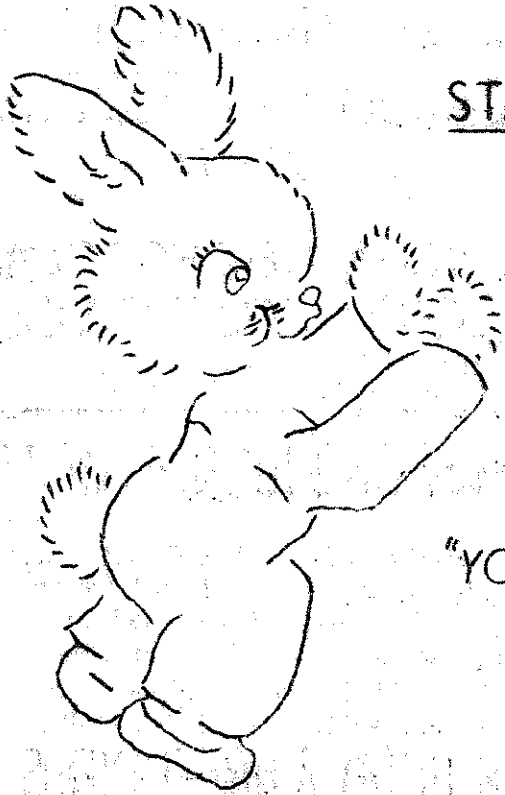
