

IMPROVING OUR DUTCH

For several years I have corresponded with people

who raised Dutch rabbits, trying to induce them to enter our shows. The response has not been heartening, to say the least. Some wrote that it cost them too much to ship and enter shows, some wrote that they were disgusted with Dutch, some wrote that they had none "fit to show", and many did not answer even when they had a stamped and addressed envelope at hand to use. There were just a few affirmative replies.

Now what can be the reason for this lack of enthusiasm, when we have a very good and popular Dutch at the present time?

Part of it could be due to the lack of rigid culling by nearly all breeders. By that I mean a lack of culling for not only type, color, and markings, but also for good healthy animals to propagate the strain, good litters of more than four, does that are not timid or pugnacious, does and bucks that will breed easily, and other desired traits.

All of the above mentioned traits, I believe, can be bred into a strain; and when animals are culled enough to do this I think we can have better Dutch and better Dutch Breeders. But this takes time; and many breeders of Dutch become disgusted with them before he gives them a chance. If many of the Dutch were nearer to perfection (in all ways) their owners probably would be more enthusiastic about them, and would want to show them. This perfection can be more nearly attained by rigid culling. First, the animals should be culled for type and color, for without this foundation there will be no really good Dutch.

Den Strickland, one of our deceased old-timers, once told me that he always culled rigidly for type and color; and he would not "fool" with an animal which had poor eye color or which had white hairs in the black parts of his stock. In the October 1956 issue of the "Dutch Reporter" an old-timer's article goes into this subject, also, very well.

When a particularly well-marked animal is raised, its owner either tries to sell it, or else uses it for a breeder, not taking into consideration whether it has other desired qualities. In either case it should be culled if many other bad traits are present. Some of our members with many years of experience can tell of instances of culling where it hurt; but they were pleased later with beneficial results. Trying to breed out a bad fault takes a lot of time and patience. Chas. O. Lewis, one of our former officers, once told me of his efforts in breeding out an eye spot in some otherwise fine animals. It took him several years to eradicate that one fault.

Quoting from an article by a former A.D.R.C. President, W. W. Hawthorne, "if you are a red-blooded American man, woman or child, and you have initiative, a desire for adventure, a bit of sporting blood, respond to a challenge, thrive on adversity and opposition, possess patience and determination, and are interested in rabbits that will spark your imagination and demand your best efforts, you can't beat the Dutch."
