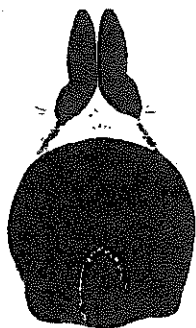
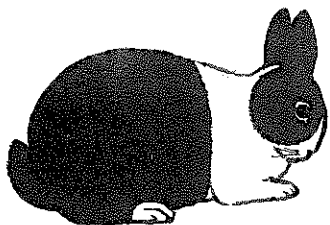
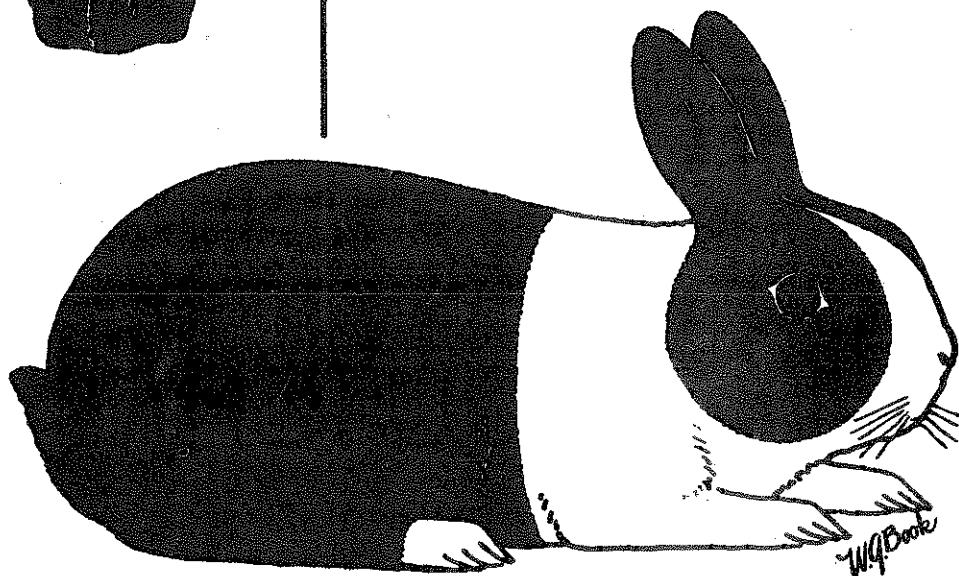

JUDGING DUTCH

by Wm. Earl

The objective of the true fancier is to raise rabbits that conform as nearly as possible with the Standard of Perfection for his chosen breed. The Dutch breeder is doubly fortunate because he is not only raising one of the best and most popular breeds he also has in my opinion, one of the clearest and most concise standards in the ARBA Standard of Perfection.

The Dutch Guide Book has several excellent articles on judging Dutch that cover the various sections of the rabbit, proper handling procedure and some very good suggestions in the instructions for judges and it would certainly be beneficial to everyone if all judges would read and study each of them carefully. Each judge places rabbits according to his own interpretation of the Standard and due to the human element involved the placement of the same rabbits will vary. This also applies to the other breeds. I believe that the description of type and the various sections of the Dutch Standard and the allocation of points is excellent and very clear. I also believe that personal likes and dislikes should be disregarded although this seems difficult to do. I could write pages on the subject of judging Dutch but I will confine this to my views on three points -- relationship of importance of markings and type, interpretation of type and questionable disqualifications.

The Dutch is a marked rabbit yet I have seen well marked rabbits beaten many times by another that had a very nice head with several bad faults in markings. There are only five points on the shape of the head plus two for ears and fifteen points on the shape of the body for a total of twenty-two and this includes condition which seems all-important at times. This is one point less than there are on fur and color alone. Cheeks and saddle or cheeks and stops have points that equal the shape of the whole rabbit, including condition and there are many combinations of three markings that will exceed the twenty-two points. This does not take into consideration the five points on eyes, feet, legs and tail as these factors are very minor except of course in the case of disqualifications. I think that a judge should make every effort to keep the various sections of the Dutch rabbit in their true perspective according to the Standard and always bear in mind that the Dutch is a marked rabbit. With equal fur and color an animal with good markings and fair type and head should beat another with only fair markings although it may have good type. We would all like to see good type, head and markings but when these are not present we should make our de-

cisions accordint to the allocation of points according to the Standard and not what we like or dislike.

The section on type in the Dutch standard is very well written. This is the conformation or shape of the body. The Dutch rabbit is meant to be a thing of beauty to be admired. Type is visual and the body described in the standard is to be observed after being properly posed. "A good Dutch should have nicely rounded hips, very smooth, rounding under very gradually and smoothly". This sentence is taken verbatim from the official standard and like every other sentence in the entire Dutch standard, with the exception of one, calls for visual examination. The exception is the description of condition under Weight and Condition and this refers to the general flesh condition of the whole rabbit. The points on flesh condition are included in the fifteen for Type and it is left to the discretion of the judge how important condition is as compared to type. One other exception could be in the determination of fur quality although it isn't difficult to determine fur quality by merely looking at the rabbit. It is certainly much easier to determine fur quality and even flesh condition by looking at a rabbit than it is to evaluate type by feeling the animal.

ARBA rules state that a rabbit should always be given the benefit of any doubt. There are two points where disqualifications are sometimes questionable. -- where body color extends below the first joint below the shoulder of the foreleg and a split stop. These decisions can only be made to the best of one's own judgement. Many times it seems that an animal with a run or stop that is very close will be passed but later when judging the class it will be cut with severity that is out of line with the fault's real importance. Sometimes it appears that it even eliminates the animal from further consideration for Best of Variety and sometimes even first in it's class. If an otherwise outstanding animal has an extremely short stop and he is not disqualified for a split stop he should receive full and fair consideration and judged for what he is -- an outstanding animal with a very poor stop -- and placed accordingly.

The above are my personal opinions but of one thing I am certain -- the Dutch is a fine little animal and he definitely deserves better than being judged as a little meat rabbit.

SECRETAR'S CHIT CHAT

I know you will all be glad to hear that I have made only one New Year's Resolution and that one pertains to the ADRC. I have resolved to make every effort to get your Dutch Reporter to you a bit earlier in the month that it has been coming the past few months. Of course this means that I must try, personally to equalize the gradually increasing delay caused by the Post Office Department, which of course is not my fault. In order to carry out this resolution some changes in procedure will be necessary. I will have to close out my books on coming sanctions and new members before the end of the month, perhaps as early as the fifteenth. This is going to mean that if local club's want to have their coming shows listed in any given issue their secretaries are going to have to get them into this office much earlier than they have been doing. Our rules call for "at least 60 days", but more time is beneficial, not only to your club via the freed advertising given your show, but to our membership as well. With an ever increasing number of new members, some of whom have never shown Dutch before, these listings are the only knowledge they may have of your show. They haven't had time to get onto any mailing lists yet and must write your secretary for a copy of your catalog. I hope you will all help me live up to my resolution.

I would like to bring th your attention the ruling passed at the last Convention adding one sentence to the ADRC's required printing in your show catalogs. This is to the effect that our rules call for the payment of \$1.00 minimum on best of each variety of Dutch. Your Board's reason for this addition was that all too many clubs were failing to offer and/or pay this minimum amount. Some would offer good specials on Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex, or perhaps specials on each first place, but it does not seem necessary to point out that none of these fine specials take the place of one on Best of Variety. There are few clubs that do not have one or more ADRC members on their membership role and it seems to me that it is up to these mem-

bers to give their show secretaries a helping hand by seeing that our rules are complied with. The above is the very valid reason why all clubs MUST send me a copy of their show catalog. Those clubs located within range of our ability to attend, these catalogs are appreciated in time to place an entry should we be able to go, also if the catalog is mailed to us early and there IS something left out, I can then notify the secretary that such omission can be posted in the show room so the show will not be disqualified. If everything is in order it is perfectly alright to enclose the copy with the show report and thus be certain that it has not been lost in the mess of cheaper rate mail.

1964 has been a terrific year for the American Dutch Rabbit Club. Our membership is at its highest point since July 1957 and we sanctioned more shows last year than ever before -- a total of 245. The fact that approximately half of these shows are bunched in the peak periods of March-April-May and Aug.-Sept. creates quite a problem in publication of the reports. We must keep the weight of the Reporter under certain limits for the sake of economy and hence at times we drop quite far behind in publishing them. Again on Jan. 1 the cost of mailing has gone up another 1/8 cent per copy. This in itself doesn't seem like much, but this is the third such increase in three years and it is bound to add up.

I hope you are all getting your good ones picked out for the National Dutch Show in Atlanta in April. To date we have had no further word from the committee that is working on this show but hope to have plenty for the February issue.

Another item we have had no report on is the recent balloting in our Standard. Perhaps word will come in before the last stencil is cut and I can get it to you in this issue.

I would like to point out to you that our new Publicity Director has taken over his duties as of Jan. 1. I know that Stan Goeglein is going to do just as fine a job as Bill Hobin did. You will find his address at the bottom of page 1 of this issue and also on the back cover along with a listing of the items he has for sale.



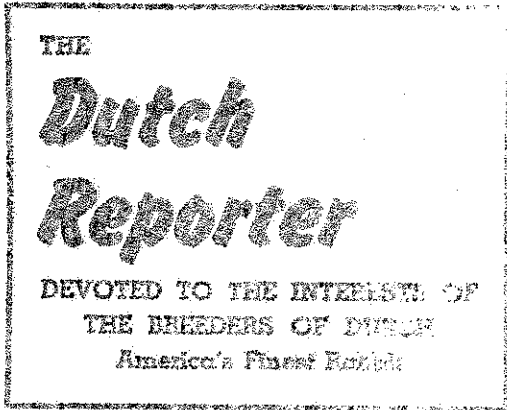

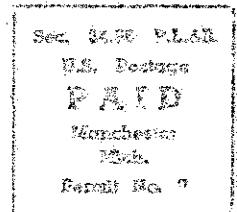
