

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Fact Sheet: Volume 42, Number 1

As we start another new year for the American Dutch Rabbit Club, we can be proud as we reflect upon our accomplishments and look forward to a bright future. The growth of the American Dutch Rabbit Club continues and the advancement of our total program may be placed in high esteem by other specialty clubs. Although we do not have the largest membership among the specialty clubs, we are the number one club raising the number one breed -- "You Can't Beat the Dutch."

Some items that merit our attention are summarized in the following outline:

1. Sweepstakes

- a. When entering a show, be consistent in the name you use. (Name, rabbitry, or both) This is a must to insure that you get proper credit and transfer of exhibition points for the sweepstakes standings.
- b. YOUTH: Results from the youth opinion poll indicate that district divisions are still favored. In addition, an overall sweepstakes listing as in open will be reported. Rosettes will be awarded to district winners and suitable plaques or trophies will be presented to the top ten youth "point-getters" overall.

- b. Membership of the American Dutch Rabbit Club voted on brown gray; pale gray description only should supplement and clarify "gray" breeding efforts.

4. Dutch Reporter

- a. Three ad spaces remain available before the inside front cover can be printed. The cost of these ads is \$25 each.

Vicki Hertel is the Dutch club's new Sweepstakes Chairperson. She and her husband, Charlie, operate a dairy farm in Forest Grove, Oregon near Portland and about 50 miles from the ocean. Vicki has two children Christopher, age 9 and Stephanie, age 7 who has been on the cover of Domestic Rabbit holding a Dutch and is pictured in the new rabbit book from Oregon State! 

ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS ON THE DUTCH STANDARD by AL MEIER

There has been some questions raised by the ADRC Secretary about changes in the Dutch Standard after its submission to the ARBA. I feel, since I had some part in the changes, that it would be best if I clarified the ARBA's position on the two matters.

1. The stop description as sent in by the Dutch club read as follows: "from the toes to a point one-third the length of the foot as measured to the heel of the foot".

Answer: This was changed to read: "from the toes to a point one-third the length of the foot as measured to the point of the hock".

The word "hock" was substituted for "heel" because the rabbit does not have a heel as such - and if it did it would come before the hock. My Webster's defines the hock as: "the tarsal joint or region of the hind limb of a digitigrade quadruped corresponding to the ankle of man but elevated and bending backward."

This change was made at the suggestion of Dr. Reed, who certainly, as a vet, would know the proper definition.

2. The belly color for the Gray Dutch, as submitted, read in part, as follows: "The belly should have a white or cream surface color with a slate blue undercolor...."

Disqualifications: "..... absence of slate blue undercolor...."
(no mention of color showing on surface other than white or cream)

Answer: This is almost the same description as the 1955-60 standard which resulted in every Gray Dutch but one being disqualified for showing surface belly color (I was there) at the 1956 Convention. Cream belly shows on the surface, as would a straw, or anything but white - one of but two positive colors we have.

When the controversy over Gray color arose, I sent an article to the Reporter citing the British description in effect for over one hundred years. The result of this vote only strengthens my belief that only breeders of a color should vote on it. The alternate, which lost in the voting was almost correct. It called for: ".....cream or straw surface color with a slate blue undercolor..." It did disqualify for a white surface.

The belly undercolor as approved by the ARBA calls for "light straw" surface color. The ARBA version also mentions the Pale Gray color which is not preferred but is acceptable (it is useful in the breeding of Steels). The Pale Gray is the Dutch that has the white belly surface color.

3. I agree that the only correct eye color for the Blue should be "blue-gray" but in the interest of those ten percent (your figures) that have brown eyes I prefer to remain alive rather than reap the wrath of those who have Blues with matching brown eyes - God knows that breeding Dutch is tough enough without picayunish disqualifications.

Following is the description of the "Brown-Gray" that appeared on the A.D.R.C. ballot. The ballots totaled 91 for and 25 against:

Brown-Gray: The brown-gray is to have an agouti coat, showing distinct bands of color when the fur is parted. The color of the fur at the base of the hair shaft to be slate blue, followed by a medium tan colored band, next a thin band of charcoal brown, finished by a lighter tan tipping to the undercoat. The entire body color should be interspersed with an even distribution of black guard hairs. The broadest ring should be the base, followed by the intermediate medium tan band, finished by an even balance between the charcoal brown ring and tan tipping. The agouti color should be carried as uniformly as possible over the colored portion of the body. Narrow black lacing on the ears is desireable. Eye circles should be narrow and medium to light tan in color. (Option insertion) Medium tan lap spots are permissible. The topside of the tail must complement the body color with the underside of the tail to be the same as the belly color.

Following is the belly color option that appeared on the A.D.R.C. ballot and passed. 85 voted for this option. (28 voted for the cream or straw surface color).

The belly should have a white or cream surface color with a slate blue undercolor extending from inside the rear legs over the belly to the undercut. When the belly surface color is white, the undercut is determined by blowing into the fur.

Disqualifications: Absence of ring color, absence of the slate-blue undercolor on the belly.

Following is how it appears after being submitted by the A.R.B.A. Standard Committee for our approval:

Steel-Gray - A dark uniform steel gray. This color is brought out with a moderate amount of light gray tipped guard hairs evenly distributed over the entire colored section of the rabbit. Slate-blue under color carried down to the skin. Under portion of the tail, belly, and inside of hind legs to be as near the body color as possible. Eyes - dark brown.

Faults: White hairs, sandy, brassy, or brownish tints. Extreme brassiness on head, ears, back, and feet too dark or not enough gray hairs distributed over these sections.

Gray - (brown-gray, as described, is the preferred color). Pale gray, lighter in surface color and lacking agouti banding is acceptable but is to be considered as being a fault.

Slate-blue at base followed by a band of yellowy orange capped by a thin black line, finishing with a lighter tan tipping to the undercoat. The entire body color should be interspersed with an even distribution of black guard hairs. The broadest ring should be at the base. The color should be carried as uniformly as possible over ears, cheeks, body and top of tail, hind legs. Narrow black lacing

on the ears is desireable. Eye circles (small as possible) and belly color to be a light straw color. Belly undercolor to be slate-blue; medium tan lap spots are permissible. Underside of tail to match belly color. Eyes - dark brown.

Faults: Brassy tinge, white hairs, light surface color on body, white belly surface color, lack of banding on hair shaft.

Disqualifications: Absence of belly undercolor.

The eye color for the Blue Dutch was voted on and passed. The vote was for the eye color to be "blue-gray". 107 voted for this color while 23 voted against.

The eye color for the Blue Dutch in that presented by the A.R.B.A. Standard Committee now reads: Eyes - blue-gray preferred, light brown acceptable.

NOTE* (I cannot find where brown eyes were ever acceptable in the Blue Dutch)!

I questioned our ARBA President, Dr. Terry Reed, regarding some changes that were made in the Dutch Standard. I sent a copy of this letter to Mr. Al Meier, ARBA Standard Committee Chairman. Mr. Meier sent an article for publication in the D.R. regarding the items mentioned. Although I feel that the stops are best described as "from the toes to a point one-third the length of the foot as measured to the heel of the foot", I will not expound on it being changed to "as measured to the point of the hock".

I do feel that the changes made in the brown-gray description and the blue eye color are not correct! Mr. Meier stated in his letter to me that, "as far as who is best qualified - I feel that breeder-judges (and we have those on the ARBA Standard Committee) are more qualified than the average Dutch breeder who does not breed grays or does not know enough about the rabbit anatomy to make a judgment".

I would like to make mention, at this point, that the majority of our membership did know what the proper color of the brown-gray Dutch should be. Many of us do not raise them as our "priority" color of Dutch, but we do raise a few. The brown-gray description submitted to the ARBA Standard Committee, I felt, was the best description we have ever had on this variety. Evidently, I do not know enough about it! I evidently have been mistaken in the proper color of the blue eye color. I always thought that a blue with brown eyes was disqualified. (At least they usually have been)! I can't find where brown eyes are permissible in the "English" standard!

In any case, the gray description has been completely gone over and our majority votes cast aside.

NOTE* In the steel-gray description, it states, "under portion of the tail, belly, and inside of hind legs to be as near as the body color as possible". Since the body color description calls for a dark uniform steel gray, are we supposed to raise these grays with as dark uniform steel gray as possible on the underside of tail, belly and inside the hind legs? Our grays have white or light cream in these areas!! Possibly I'm misreading the standard!

NOTE* Regarding the light straw color as described by the ARBA Standard Committee, here in Illinois, we have several different types of straw, each possessing a different color. Which one of these "straw" colors are we supposed to use according to the description?

I DO NOT regret that I have in my rabbitry, all of the wrong colors of gray,.....and NOT a blue with brown eyes!

TO BE COBBY IN TYPE, COMPACT IN FORM AND LIMB. GOOD DUTCH TYPE CONSISTS OF A NICELY ROUNDED BACK, BEGINNING ALMOST IMMEDIATELY BEHIND THE HEAD AND PROGRESSING OVER THE SHOULDERS, LOIN AND RUMP TO TAIL. SHOULDERS SHOULD BE ROUNDED AND SLIGHTLY NARROWER AND LOWER THAN HIPS. RIB SPREAD SHOULD BE SO THAT THE SIDE LINES CARRY STRAIGHT THROUGH FROM THE SHOULDERS TO THE HIPS. A GOOD DUTCH SHOULD HAVE NICELY ROUNDED HIPS, VERY SMOOTH, ROUNDED UNDER VERY GRADUALLY AND SMOOTHLY. THE DUTCH SHOULD RETAIN THE COBBY, STOCKY APPEARANCE WHETHER IT WEIGHS 3½ POUNDS OR 5½ POUNDS.
