

Dear Dutch Reporter Editor,

You asked for something from a very inexperienced Dutch breeder, so here are some questions I would like information on.

I would appreciate some advice from experienced breeders on some very basic things. How do you get a doe to "receive" the buck if she doesn't want to???: Techniques? Feed? Environment? Time of day? Whisper in her ear? Etc.

I started out this spring by buying two bred does. One had three bunnies, the other a retained fetus. What causes this? The largest litter I've had is six bunnies. What can I do to increase litter size?

How often should a doe be bred? Will she breed and reproduce better if she's worked hard or if she has a long rest between litters?

Just a few answers or opinions would be very much appreciated from experienced breeders.

SOME ANSWERS

In the Nov.-Dec. issue of The Dutch Reporter, Frank Hutchinson asked some questions about breeding and raising Dutch, so here are my answers:

1. If the doe does not accept a buck, you can wait a few minutes to see if she'll settle down (she usually will), force-breed her by raising her rear quarters into position for service, or you can leave her in the bucks cage over-night, put the buck in her's or a "spare" cage and try again in the morning. Don't leave the pair together alone, they may fight. You also can simply try another day.

2. As for still-born babies, a lot of things could have happened. Maybe the fetus was too big for her. If it was her first time, maybe she should have been bred earlier, around 6 months. Or, maybe something was wrong with the fetus itself. As I said before, a lot of things can go wrong. A detained or difficult kindling time can be a big cause of still-borns.

3. DUTCH RABBITS JUST DON'T HAVE LARGE LITTERS. Six or seven is about the largest you'll get. Dutch aren't very big, so they don't have large litters like New Zealands, Satins, etc. do. Remember, only 1 in 5 or 6 is good sometimes, and you don't want a lot of culls around, so let's take small litters as a good thing!!

4. I suggest breeding a doe 6-8 weeks after a litter is kindled. Her young will be weaned and separated from her, so she'll have a little rest, but still be "in shape" for breeding. She will also be strong enough and not too tired to take care of another litter. You can wait longer than 6-8 weeks to re-breed, but she might have trouble conceiving if you wait several months or so.

GOOD LUCK!!!

Female rabbits do not cycle periodically as the majority of the other animals that most of us are associated with on a regular basis. In nature, the female rabbit is basically a seasonally anestrous (non-receptive) type animal where their reproductive tract goes dormant during the colder months of the year that have the shorter day lengths.

Man has domesticated the rabbit and we now expect the animal to breed when we desire. In the commercial rabbitry, if the doe does not breed twelve months out of the year, it is going to be very difficult for one to have a financially successful domestic rabbit operation. However, the manager must selectively cull the herd over several years to obtain animals that have the inherent ability to be receptive throughout all months of the year.

There are many techniques that have been used over the years to enhance the receptiveness of the female rabbit. Some of these techniques are scientifically valid where others have very little scientific justification.

All our breeding rabbits should be on an excellent balanced ration that contains sufficient amounts of vitamins and minerals. However, some individuals have found that the breeding performance of their does is enhanced through the addition of vitamins to the drinking water, or, through the addition of wheat germ oil to the feed on a daily basis. The wheat germ oil has been thought to be the magic "breeding potion" through the years; but scientifically the enhancement of the breeding program from the feeding of wheat germ oil is basically due to the enrichment of the diet with not only Vitamin E; but Vitamin A and others as well as the Vitamin E.

Extending the day length in your rabbitry has been scientifically proven to be a very effective way of enhancing the breeding performance and the receptiveness of does. The breeding animal should receive a minimum of sixteen hours of day light, natural or artificial, each day. The extension of the total day length can be done by leaving the lights on for a period of time. There are some research materials available that leaving the lights on twenty-four hours per day is an effective way of increasing the breeding performance of the doe.

Another factor that tends to cause the does to be non-receptive to the male animal is the colder weather. When there are weather extremes, one can usually enhance the receptiveness by placing the animal in an environment that has an elevated temperature for a period of twenty-four to forty-eight hours and the doe will then become receptive within the next forty-eight hours after being exposed to the elevated temperatures. The "solar method" is to place the does in carriers and then place in the sun, such as on the front seat of a car or truck. Thus, one gets the effect of a greenhouse.

An effective technique used in some rabbitries to get the doe to mate when desired is the use of a technique called "forced mating". This is where the doe is placed in the buck's pen and after the male starts his copulatory action, the doe's hindquarters are gently raised to a receptive position. This is a very good technique that all rabbit managers should possess; but, it is not totally fool proof as there are some problems involved. The male animals must be taught the part of forced mating, as they will often refuse to attempt to mate when the doe is restrained. Also, the conception rate is usually lower in most rabbits

by forced mating and the litter size is somewhat decreased. The value of forced mating is that once the doe is mated, it usually enhances the flow of female hormones and the doe will respond to natural matings in the immediate future (3 - 4 days).

During the cold winter months, the does are usually more receptive to the bucks on days where there is an increase in the general trend of the temperature and basically they are more receptive when there has been a two to three day warm up period and are usually more receptive in the afternoon than late at night or early in the morning when the temperatures are at their lowest for the day.

A technique that is improving each year and may eliminate the necessity of receptiveness of the doe is the art of artificial insemination. The technique of artificial insemination in rabbits is rather simple and one that may become very valuable, and common, in the rabbitries of the future. This is not a difficult technique and can be performed by most "rabbit fanciers".

Another technique that is used in some rabbitries to eliminate the problem of non-receptive does is the use of colony mating. This is where one to five does are placed in one large cage, the male and does are allowed to run together for varying lengths of time. This is an excellent way to breed virgin does and those difficult breeding does in the winter months; but one must use caution. The disadvantage of colony mating is that it does not allow specific matings of animals with specific faults and lessens the genetic selection. Another problem with colony mating is that there is a possibility for injury to the breeding stock due to the incompatibility of a buck and a doe, or does, in the same cage. With strict watching of the animals, this problem can almost be eliminated. With this technique, the does are palpated at five day intervals and the pregnant does removed from the colony. This allows the manager an estimated time of breeding for placing the nest box with the doe.

As a last resort, one can treat the does with female hormones to improve their receptiveness. Again, the use of hormones is successful; but the conception rate and litter size are not equal to the natural mating process. If one attempts one or a combination of all the above techniques in your rabbitry, one should be able to get all does bred. If one does not get seventy percent of the does mated on the first mating, there is an indication that there may be a reproductive disease present in your rabbitry.

RETAINED FETI IN RABBITS

The retention of a feti, or placentas, in the reproductive tract is probably more common in rabbits than any other animal. There are many causes of retained feti as well as retained placentas. One of the common causes is the development of a low-grade infection in the uteri that does not allow complete expulsion of the attached placenta or feti contained in the uterus. The reason for the large number of retained feti in rabbits is probably due to the nature of the reproductive cycle in rabbits in that rabbits are induced ovulators rather than having a cyclic reproductive system. The rabbit will ovulate eggs from the ovum only in response to mating. After the doe is mated, in approximately eight to twelve hours the doe will ovulate a given number of eggs. These eggs are then fertilized, by the male sperm, and attach to the lining of the uterus to develop to maturity. This is a marked change from many of the other animals in that they have "flucuating hormonal" levels. The hormonal level in the rabbit does not flucuate to a great degree unless the doe is mated. This allows for the feti to be retained and "mummify".

At the time of parturition (kindling), oftentimes the doe will empty (by uterine muscle contractions) each horn of the uterus independently. If there is a large fetus or there is difficulty in presentation of one of the feti from the uterus, it will be retained in the uterus and walled off by the protective mechanism of the body and the doe will usually not be receptive again due to the depression of the fulucatory hormonal levels caused by the presence of materials in the uterus.

If retained feti or placentas can be observed (through palpation) soon after kindling, they can be removed through hormonal treatment of the doe.

PREVENTION

Treatment of the doe with the hormone Oxytocin, within twenty-four hours after kindling, is a very effective method in preventing retained feti as well as retained placentas. The dosage is 0.25 - 0.50 ml Oxytocin U.S.P., injected subcutaneously, within twenty-four hours after kindling.

In many of the large commercial rabbitries, the above practice is routine and very successful.

FREQUENCY OF BREEDING

The hereditary constitution of the doe will determine how often the doe can be mated. One must keep in mind the productive potential of the rabbit is to raise eleven litters per year. All rabbits do not have the genetic constitution to accomplish these goals. However, they do have that potential.

Many of the commercial rabbitries, including Dutch, oftentimes will mate the does two weeks after the doe has kindled and then wean the litter when the kits are four weeks of age, allowing the doe to have a two week rest period prior to kindling again. This appears to be a more commonly accepted practice in the commercial rabbitry than breeding the does to their maximum potential of three days after they have kindled. If one is to follow this rigorous breeding program, one must selectively cull the herd so they will have the characteristics of being able to maintain the stamina of this rigorous breeding program.

The majority of the fancy type rabbit will not be able to maintain this rigorous breeding program. However, one should keep in mind the physiological process of the rabbit and realize that it is easier to get a "producing" doe mated than a "non-producing" doe. Some individuals recommend that the doe be mated and palpated pregnant prior to weaning the litter as this allows for "easier" mating and there is a tendency for larger litter sizes.

It is recommended that does being added to the herd be placed in production during the late summer months and prior to fall and winter, as it is easier to maintain the doe in a reproductive state during this period of time than by adding new virgin does to the herd during the fall and winter months when breeding is more difficult due to the decreased receptiveness of the doe.

If one should choose a vigorous breeding program, one must have outstanding nutrition and expect an increased number of mammary problems. On the rigorous mating program, the longevity of the doe in the herd will be decreased; but usually the total number of youngsters produced will be increased. The frequency of mating the doe will depend entirely upon the purpose that one has for the rabbits.

LITTER SIZE IN RABBITS by Dr. T.E. Reed

Normally, the larger the rabbit, the larger the expected litter size. The Netherland Dwarf and Holland Lop usually have litters that average from three to five kits per litter, while the commercial rabbits normally have litter sizes between eight to ten kits per litter; and the giant breeds often have in excess of ten kits per litter. The litter size can be controlled by some hereditary factors.

The anatomical structure of the rabbit's reproductive tract is unique. Those eggs that are ovulated from the right ovary or the left ovary will be fertilized and the feti develop in that specific horn of the uterus. The right and left horn of the rabbit's reproductive tract does not communicate with each other as in most other animals. Therefore, eggs that are ovulated from the right ovary cannot become fertilized and develop in the left horn of the uterus and vice versa. When a rabbit manager has problems with a given doe that has a litter size about half of that expected, one will usually find that the doe is using only one horn of the uteri and that the other horn is not functional due to some pathological condition. Also, this explains why some does will have a litter on a given day and then proceed to kindle again approximately five days later. The cause is due to the fact that the doe kindles from an initial mating from one horn of the uterus; and then the second kindling is due to a later mating from the opposite horn of the uterus.

Once a doe is mated, this will stimulate both ovaries to normally ovulate in approximately eight to twelve hours after the initial mating. Mating the doe several times initially will not increase the number of ovum ovulated from the ovaries. With the initial mating, there is an ample supply of viable sperm to fertilize the given number of eggs ovulated. Therefore, it is a waste of time and the buck's energy to mate the doe several times with the thought of increasing the conception rate or the litter size of the doe.

If the manager will wait eight to twelve hours after the initial mating and then re-mate the doe, this will allow for another ovulation of eggs from the ovaries and will increase the conception rate and litter size. From experiments, it has been shown that by mating the doe approximately eight to twelve hours after the initial mating, there will be an increase in the conception rate of about seven percent and the increase in litter size approximately 1.5 bunnies per litter.

The number of eggs ovulated from the ovaries is controlled by genetic factors. If one has a continued small litter size without any other explanation, one should consider adding hereditary strains to your animals that have the history of large litters.

Dear Dutch Reporter,

I want to answer the questions asked by Mary Roling in the September-October issue of the DR. First, don't be discouraged! I started with "pet store dutch" too. I had visited the Ohio State Fair to choose a breed of rabbits. I met a man named (affectionately) "Burkie", who spent most of the day with me. He taught me alot that day, and let me handle, pet and cuddle every rabbit in the showroom.

Well . . . let's just say I got the "bug"! Burkie didn't promote one breed or another, but the dutch sold themselves.

Over a year later, I sadly opened my first copy of Domestic Rabbits . . . the one with "Burkie's" obituary picture on the front.

It's been a long struggle and I've had to make alot of changes since then. Two summers ago I started bringing home blue ribbons, and last summer one of my does won a "best opposite black" for the first time, so I feel I'm getting somewhere.

"Best markings/worst type or best type/worst markings" must be the Murphy's law of dutch breeding! However, your problem with color is unheard of in purebred dutch.

To answer your question, "Do people commonly cross dwarf with dutch?" The answer is, "You betcha!" Unfortunately, it is often done unethically.

I worked for a number of years in Columbus pet stores. The pet store managers force the whims of the uninformed public on the breeder, causing financial pressure to crossbreed. It works like this. . .

The public wants their pet rabbits to have something unusual about them, in addition to being very small. This makes the dwarf and the mini-lop (or holland lop) very popular. There are no broken dwarfs accepted at shows, and the dutch trails along a poor third place in Ohio's pet shops, because they are all so similar in markings with so few colors. The pet store breeders, therefore, cross dutch and dwarf. This causes the crazy markings, small size, and rainbow of colors wanted by the public and the manager.

To give an example of how this affects public opinion, let me relate what is said in these pet stores by sales personnel. "These are pedigreed dutch rabbits, but we don't have papers because the breeder charges extra." (To a kindergarten class, on a tour) "These are pure Netherland Dwarfs. They were bred by the Dutch people in Holland by crossing dwarf rabbits with dutch." (The children nodded as they looked over a pen full of long-eared long headed, mismarked dutch, with fur that was too long and too fine, and destined to weigh 6 lbs at maturity!)

Animals bought at fairs may be quality, or they may not. What do you really know about that breeder or his or her rabbitry?

So, what will you do about those crossbred dutch of yours? Some breeders would tell you to get rid of all your old stock, and start over. I know the economics of that, and if you're sentimental . . . However, it is one good way to solve your problem. Following are my suggestions for switching over more slowly.

You have probably taken some of these steps, but I repeat them for others also.

1) Join the ARBA and the ADRC if you haven't already done so. Read Domestic Rabbits and The Dutch Reporter.

2) Read Bob Bennett's "Raising Rabbits the Modern Way".

3) Attend as many shows and meet as many rabbit people as possible. As you get to know people, find one breeder who is respected by all, and who is willing to give his or her time.

4) Don't be in a hurry! Get to know rabbits and dutch. Try to pick the winners before the judge announces them. Then find a buck and two does to start your herd. Don't buy rabbits at shows. Don't try to buy a winner for the shows. Look for a buck that used to be one of your breeder's best, but now with lots of sons and daughters that outshine him. If he outdid himself for your breeder, he can also do it for you. Pick a senior doe that has outstanding reproductive success over one with great markings. Then ask your breeder to pick a junior doe with promise. Buy all stock from the same breeder for awhile. Pick someone with a good reputation, a clean rabbitry, and visible record keeping. Keep in mind that distant relatives often produce the best litters. Animals with multiple litters can be strengthened by close breeding if it is done skillfully, while animals with only one offspring (horse, cow, human) are more easily damaged by it. Watch out for those "killer" qualities such as cow hocks or undercut hips, though!

5) Take your new rabbits and pedigrees home and treat them like GOLD! That's what they are. You will be surprised how much difference pure, pedigreed stock makes in your success.

6) From your first pedigreed litter, keep a buck, even if it's not that good. Next summer, when the heat may cause temporary sterility in your older buck, the younger one will survive the weather better, and may serve as a "stand-in" to keep your does busy and slim!

7) Keep careful records. From your pedigreed stock, "keep the best-sell the rest". Sell ALL of your non-pedigreed offspring. Resist the temptation to save and use that one nice rabbit to "mix in". With your pedigreed stock, work on type first, while keeping markings within reason. Type stays "nailed down" better than markings once it is established, so it's easier to refine the markings on a good type rabbit than it is the other way 'round.

8) As your non-pedigreed stock grows old, replace them with pedigreed animals. Phase out your old stock this way.

9) Keep making it to those shows! Keep learning!

A good breeder, who is willing to help you learn, is your most valuable asset. Don't be afraid to ask silly questions. . .

Bob Shaw, of Ashley, Ohio, has done this for me. I always enjoy the hours spent in his bank barn with him and his fine dutch! He has never sold me a "bum steer" . . . er, rabbit! That sparkle in his eye as he shows off one of his beauties is surely a contagious disease! (Thanks Bob . . . and Ruth!)

Good luck with your Easter breedings in January! I know how hard it sometimes is to get an early "catch" for those pet store Easter bunnies! If you're in Columbus, stop in. Hope to meet you at the spring shows in Ohio!

SO YOU THINK YOU KNOW IT ALL! by Bill Geitzenauer - "A purebred rabbit has a pedigree of 3 generations and must be in all three generations one breed." WRONG! Any rabbit can have a pedigree - after all, its just a paper showing that rabbits' family tree and some of those hanging on to the tree could be of different breeds - such as the pedigree of a newly proposed breed, possibly the beginnings of a Jersey Wooly, Dwarf Hotot or Broken Satin.

"The disease whereby a rabbit has a heavy thick white discharge from the nose is snuffles, cureable by injecting penicillin with streptomycin." WRONG! According to RABBIT PRODUCTION by Cheeke, Patton and Templeton, "Rabbits can be treated for snuffles with a number of antibiotics. This treatment at first may appear to have been successful. The sneezing stops as does the discharge, but as soon as the rabbit is stressed, it breaks with the disease again and this time is very difficult to treat."

TO BE COBBY IN TYPE, COMPACT IN FORM AND LIMB. GOOD DUTCH TYPE CONSISTS OF A NICELY ROUNDED BACK, BEGINNING ALMOST IMMEDIATELY BEHIND THE HEAD AND PROGRESSING OVER THE SHOULDERS, LOIN AND RUMP TO TAIL. SHOULDERS SHOULD BE ROUNDED AND SLIGHTLY NARROWER AND LOWER THAN HIPS. RIB SPREAD SHOULD BE SO THAT THE SIDE LINES CARRY STRAIGHT THROUGH FROM THE SHOULDERS TO THE HIPS. A GOOD DUTCH SHOULD HAVE NICELY ROUNDED HIPS, VERY SMOOTH, ROUNDED UNDER VERY GRADUALLY AND SMOOTHLY. THE DUTCH SHOULD RETAIN THE COBBY, STOCKY APPEARANCE WHETHER IT WEIGHS 3½ POUNDS OR 5½ POUNDS.
