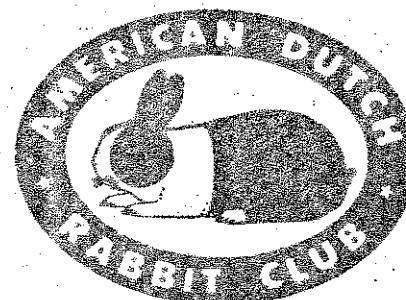

FROM THE DESK OF

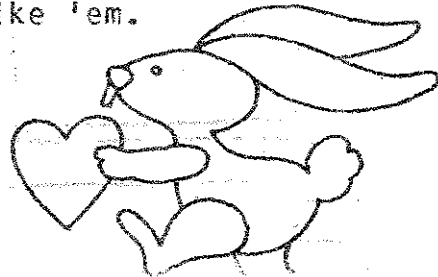


1987 certainly has started differently than most new year's in the midwestern states. So far we've only had one real snowfall and the water crocks haven't frozen to the point where we have to drag them into the house and thaw them with scalding water. If every year in Michigan was like this, I might be able to stay and forget my notion of moving south.

Last year (during Jan, Feb & March) I contracted a very bad case of RABBIT-FEVER BLUES. I think it's a disease that most of us in the colder states experience. It is caused by several things. It starts out slowly with repeated trips to the barn which are proceeded by applying two or three layers of warm clothing and a pair of wet sloppy boots. It continues to develop, becoming more severe with the thawing of multitudes of crocks. In the advance stages, the trips to the barn become more and more disappointing as you check for new litters only to find none. By late February, does that have been bred four to six times by every buck in the barn and are still just sitting there, getting fatter, are now looking more and more like a good Sunday dinner. As you are sure that it's time to put up the FOR SALE sign in front of the rabbitry, Spring breaks, anew litter arrives and the shows start up and you are saved from the deadly RABBIT-FEVER BLUES.

This year we tried to save only our Juniors for breeding stock. All of our Sr. stock was sold or butchered with the exception of four does. At this point the litters are coming on a regular basis with only a few does missing. The litters are of average size, 5-7 Dutch in a litter and the moms are doing a good job of raising them. Because we are in a cold climate and our barn is left unheated, we keep a 60 watt light bulb in a brooder lamp (taking off the wire protectors) and set it on top of the wire cage over the nestbox until the kits are about 2 1/2 to 3 weeks old. By that time they're out of the nestbox more than they are in. Out of the 4 Sr. does, 2 have kindled and two have not. The two who have continued to produce during the cold months are does that have been kept in heavy production year round. The other two are does from another breeder who only bred approximately twice a year. Because of the shorter amou of daylight hours, we keep lights on from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Fans run on timers both summer and winter. With the exceptional weather we have been having, we open the large sliding door during the day. Ventilation, in my estimation, runs top priority, only behind clean, fresh water.

BEWARE! Just received a copy of the NEW ENGLAND DUTCH RABBIT CLUB NEWSLETTER and those folks are out to make the rest of us look bad. If you haven't joined this group of fine folks, you can do so by sending \$3 to Pam Dunning, 149 Old Westford Rd., Chelmsford, MA 01824. You'll recieve one of the nicest newsletters I've seen, twice a year. Try 'em, I think you'll like 'em.

Now, on with business.....The American Dutch Rabbit Club has a new Dutch Reporter Editor. All D.R. materials should now be sent to Kay M. Stearns of Indiana. You'll find her address on this issue. As always, a newsletter can only be as good as the material that is submitted for publication and an editor can only publish what he/she receives. In order to ensure a publication full of interesting and stimulating reading material, be certain to submit your share!.....on time!!

The March - April '87 issue of the Dutch Reporter will contain the new current American Dutch Rabbit Club membership list. This list will be printed up in this office and sent to the D.R. editor for publication by March 10th. If your membership has lapsed in excess of sixty (60) days at that time, your name will be omitted from the list. Also remember that if your membership has lapsed sixty (60) days, you forfeit all earned sweepstakes points! You will find your expiration date on both your membership card and the label of each issue of your Dutch Reporter. This sweepstakes year ends with the close of the 1987 National Dutch Show on April 5, 1987. Keep your membership current and please renew promptly!

Another item I would like to make particular note of is the lateness of sanctions that are being received in this office; sanction applications are arriving only two (2) to three (3) weeks prior to show date. I receive many sanction requests not the check is dated MORE THAN A MONTH BEFORE THE POSTMARK DATE and the check is stamped "VOID AFTER SIXTY DAYS." The check is almost at this point when it is received! The idea of getting your request in early is to allow ample time for processing and return mailing (many times they have to be returned to the show sponsors because they fail to include the ARBA sanction number), and to give every opportunity of having the show listed in our bi-monthly publication the Dutch Reporter. We publicize "upcoming ADRC sanctioned shows" so that our membership is aware of the date and location of the show, and have the chance to exhibit their animals if they so desire. If the request arrives only a few weeks before the show date, there is no way to accomplish this. Above all, please do not send in a request for a show sanction, a new or renewal membership or a letter regarding information and then phone this office regarding the fact that you "sent it in about three weeks to a month ago and haven't received a thing"(!!!); when in reality, I just received the item and it's postmark was only three to four days before your call! ALL MAIL is dated and recorded as to when it was received. I'd like to list some examples -- please note



Most always, a sanction will be issued.

The show, banquet and room accommodations are all under one roof, the "Western Hills Motel".....you can't beat that!! THE HOLIDAY SEASON IS NOW BEHIND US AND I HOPE EVERYONE ENJOYED IT. THIS CHRISTMAS WAS A WET ONE FOR MY AREA, WE RECEIVED RAIN INSTEAD OF SNOW. I GUESS I HAVE BEEN LUCKY ENOUGH THAT OLD MAN WINTER SEEMS TO BE HOLDING OFF UNTIL THE USUAL TIME WHICH IS MID-JANUARY TO EARLY FEBRUARY TO UNLEASH THE BAD WEATHER. AS THE MONTHS OF WINTER ROLL AROUND IT SEEMS TO CAUSE A DECREASE IN THE NUMBER OF LITTERS BORN IN MY BARN AND THE SAME GOES FOR OTHER BREEDERS IN MY AREA. WE HAVE TRIED ARTIFICIAL LIGHTING TO EXTEND THE DAY FOR SEVERAL MORE HOURS HOPING TO ENCOURAGE THE DOES TO PRODUCE BUT IT DOESN'T SEEM TO WORK. I AM BEGINNING TO WONDER IF IT'S NOT SO MUCH THE AMOUNT OF LIGHT BUT THE TYPE OF LIGHT THAT IS USED. THE PAST THREE YEARS HAVE BEEN THE ONES IN WHICH I HAVE HAD VERY FEW LITTERS IN THE WINTER, ABOUT THE SAME TIME I MOVED MY RABBITS FROM OUTSIDE CAGES TO THE RABBIT BARN. I'M FOR SURE THAT I CAN'T BE THE ONLY DUTCH BREEDER TO HAVE THIS PROBLEM SO AS A DIRECTOR I HAVE WRITTEN AN ARTICLE THAT NEEDS AN ANSWER, SO THE JOB FOR YOU AS A MEMBER IS TO WRITE SOME SORT OF RESPONSE TO THE DUTCH REPORTER WHETHER YOU HAVE AN ANSWER OR ANOTHER TYPE OF PROBLEM THAT YOU WANT TO SHARE WITH THE MEMBERSHIP FOR THEIR RESPONSE. 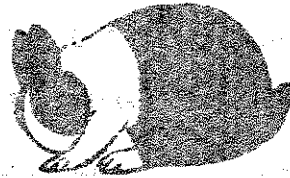
DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE:

There are numerous ways of obtaining rabbit when first starting to build your herd. One of these is to trade rabbits from your herd for rabbits from another. In the late 70's, being short of cash, I did a number of trades with fellow rabbit raisers. Some of these trades worked out and some didn't. One memorable one that didn't was at the 1977 Michigan State Fair. I traded a black junior doe for a tort buck. The black doe later won at least a dozen BOB and the tort buck was a nice pet that I ended up selling for \$3.00. One trade that worked out was at the '78 National Dutch Show, I traded a blue junior buck and \$15.00 for another blue junior buck. This buck had repeatedly tried to breed the hand of the judge, so he was quickly thrown from the table. This buck later would win classes & BOV's at major shows, he also sired several high class animals.

Sometimes things that you are going to do that don't happen in the end work out for the best. One such case was at the 1982 National Dutch Show. I had a black senior doe, who at the previous ARBA Convention was best opposite black, a buyer for this doe backed out at the last minute. So at that show about a half hour before leaving I bred her to an eye catching buck named EGO, who was owned by Goeglien & Shaw. EGO was a cross between our 2 lines and inherited the best of both worlds. The litter came in 30 days and 5 months later at the 1982 ARBA Convention two littermates were BOB & BOS. Also a daughter of the black doe produced the 1984 BOB at the ARBA Convention. So you never know, things sometimes work out! Have a Happy New Year.

District #2

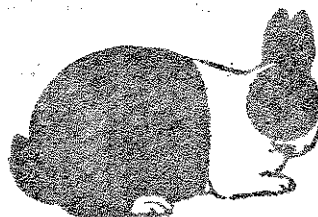

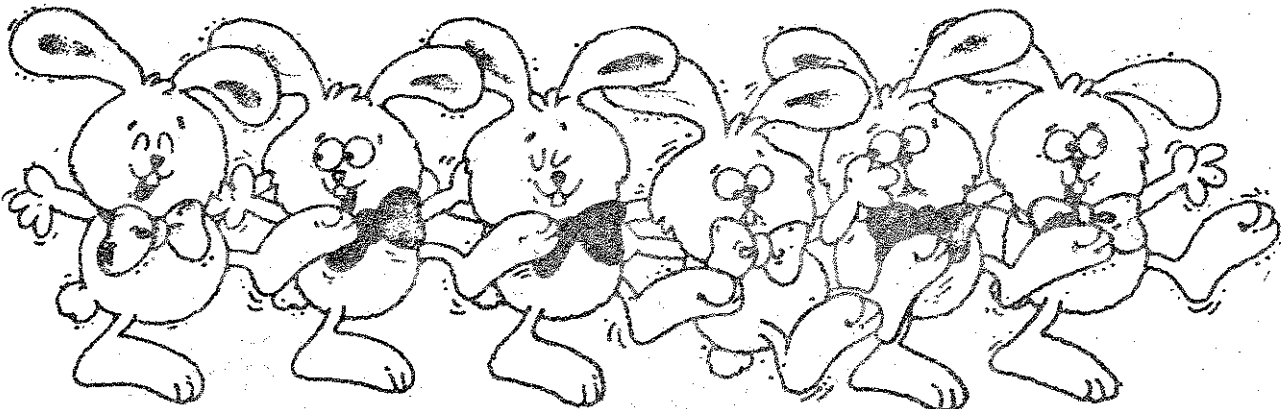
Not having much rabbit news to report since the shows were about nil during the winter, it is hard to come up with an article for my District. Next time maybe there will be something to expound on.

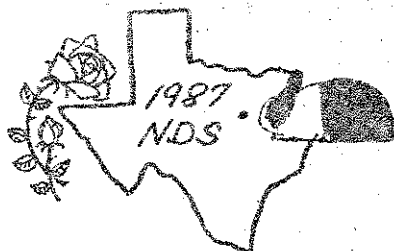

I believe that this will be a memorable show for everyone who attends, so "ya'll come" and get a taste of Texas hospitality.

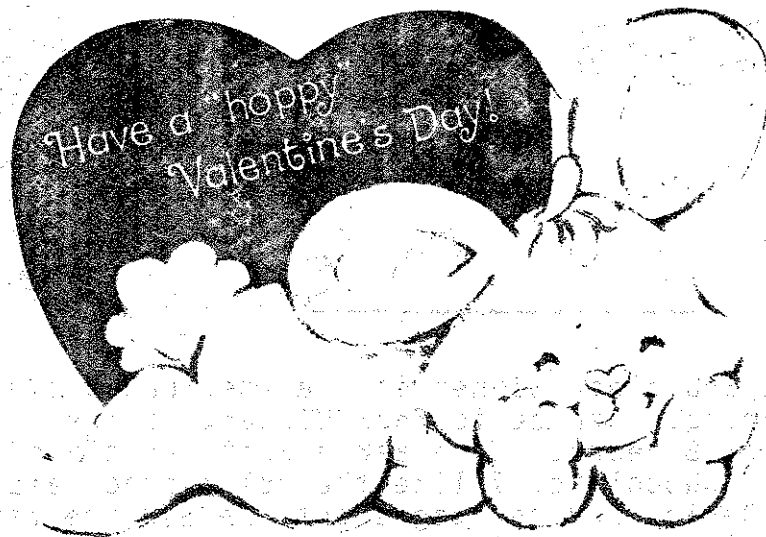

"I was attending a show in Council Bluffs . . . when I met David Paul." Chad Johannes was looking for a purebred breed to raise, met A.D.R.C. member David Paul, talked about the Dutch and was encouraged to raise them. Since that time about 6 years ago, Chad has been raising black and blue Dutch. He says, "I personally like the black the best because they have the shiniest coats."

Chad and his mother are members of the A.D.R.C. Youth Committee. As part of the duties of the youth committee, Chad spends many hours at shows talking with other Dutch breeders, encouraging them to join the A.D.R.C. and become involved in the club. Chad is also the President of his 4-H club, belongs to the Youth Bowling Assoc., works on the school newspaper and is active in the church.

Chad tell us that he feels they have several 'rabbit related' problems in his area of the United States. The first problem as he sees it is the shortage of sanctioned shows in Nebraska. Number two would be the lack of promotion of the rabbit in general and Dutch specifically. He and his dad are working in this area. They are expanding fair classes to include pet rabbits, giving them a market for poorly marked Dutch. This also helps make the public aware of the value of rabbit meat. He has promoted rabbits in shopping centers, displaying his Dutch and encouraging youngsters to join 4-H.

Besides having promotional problems, Chad has had a few difficulties in raising Dutch. A good blue doe who had kindled on two occasions, raised the litter until three weeks of age, only to kill them had to be disposed of to make room for a doe with better mothering ability. Chad also has a limited amount of cage space so his odds are decreased when trying to get that Best of Breed winner.

In closing, Chad says the thing he's learned most in raising Dutch is that "If at first you don't succeed, try, try again!" He says this "is a definite MUST". Oh, how we can all agree with that statement.

## WHAT ABOUT COW HOCKS?

The editor of any publication can only print materials if they receive them. It seems everyone has an opinion on everything, but hesitates to express it. Not so with me, and I believe anyone that knows me is aware of that! So, here is something for our new editor to print.

It seems cow hocks is a major complaint amongst the Dutch people. It is very true that this problem has almost gotten out of hand in certain herds, and I know for a fact that many are trying to correct this delima.

For the past year or so, I have heard that the fault of the cow hocked rabbit lies with the judges for not disqualifying the animals that have it, or at least making some comments concerning this during the judging. As a judge, and breeder, I believe this is a false statement!

The problem lies at home. As Dutch breeders, we are to be promoting our breed and trying to better it. If you see some rabbits you consider are cow hocked, why complain about it to the judge after he lets it go through? Why not approach the breeder who has the problem and talk to them about it? 95 percent of the people raising rabbits are open to constructive criticism, and it wouldn't matter to the other 5 percent if the judge did say his animal was cow hocked. They would say the judge didn't know what he was talking about.

If a person is going to keep showing an animal with a spot in its eye that was disqualified by one judge, just because the next one might not catch it, what makes you think a person will stop showing an animal that gets disqualified for cow hocks?

Where do you draw the line for a cow hocked rabbit? Do we have to carry a protractor and measure the angle of the hind legs on the Dutch? If the stops show when the animal is sitting, does that constitute cow hocks? Do the hock joints have to touch when the animal moves down the table? You tell me!

As cow hocks is a judgement call, the determination by the judges may vary from show to show, or judge to judge. There is no specific guidelines for determining cow hocks, so each person has their own opinion of what cow hocks is. The ARBA Standard of Perfection defines cow hocks as "hind legs that turn inward at the hock, causing the foot portion to turn outward from the body". This could technically include about 99 percent of the rabbits shown today. Must all rabbits "track" like a Checkered Giant?

Consider this. As we are trying to emphasize cow hocks in our Dutch, why does our Standard only say the following about feet and legs, "the feet, legs, and tail should have the proper length and size to balance and harmonize with the compact body"?

Now consider this!! Everybody get out your ARBA Standard of Perfection. If you don't have one, borrow the guy's next to you. (If you don't have one, you should get one.) Now turn to page 21 and look under General Disqualifications (All Breeds). Start reading and tell me where you find Cow Hocks listed as a disqualification. Are you to page 206 yet? I couldn't find it either, so I made a call to the ARBA office and one to Oren Reynolds. It seems the cow hock determination falls under "Abnormalities". This states "Any deviation from the

normally accepted condition of the body structure". Where does that leave us?  
At a stand still!

For a judge to determine what is a deviation from normal structure leaves him or her wide open for criticism from every direction.

There is no doubt cow hocks is a major problem within our breed. What we must do now, is correct the situation ourselves. Don't leave it up to a judge to do it for you! All we, as judges, can do is use our best judgement in trying to relay the severity of this situation to the breeders. We cannot breed the problem out of your herd for you. As stated, the problem lies at home.

Dick Gehr:

I would welcome, enjoy, and appreciate responses from you Dutch breeders as to what you consider cow hocks, and where the line should be drawn.

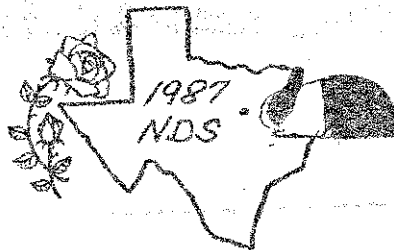

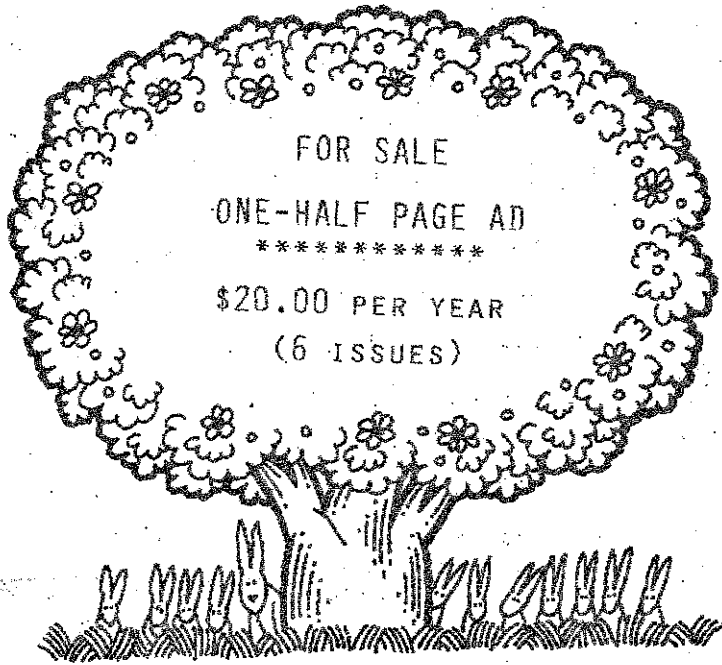

### METRITIS IN RABBITS

This is a very common condition in rabbits that can often be very discouraging to the fancier as well as the commercial operator. Metritis, or simply uterus infection, can be frustrating and cause financial loss due to the decrease in conception rate, abortion, and loss of an individual productive unit as well as a valuable genetic entity from the rabbit herd.

Metritis can be technically described as the presence of any inflammatory process in the uterine tract. This condition has almost become endemic in several rabbit producing areas of the United States. Due to the incidence of this condition in the rabbitry, one can see find signs of decreased conception rate in the producing herd below the seventy percent (70%) average on first conception. The size of the litters may be erratic and can vary from the normal average to very few kits per litter as well as causing a variation in birth weight of the kits born. Depending upon the type of infectious agent and the severity, one can also find the sign of abortions anywhere from twelve to twenty-four days into the gestation period. The presence of this condition in the herd can also cause an increase in the number of does that will totally fail to conceive and these does must be eliminated from the herd due to the lack of production. Agalactia, or lack of milk production, can be another very common sign that is associated with metritis. This is particularly true in the first week after kindling.

Metritis can be caused by the presence of any type of bacterial or inflammatory agent that is present within the uterine tract. The most common organisms associated with metritis in rabbits are those of the Pasteurella sp., Staphylococcus sp., and the spirochete that normally causes vent disease.

Rabbits become infected with metritis primarily through one of the following three methods.

1. Genital contact. This type of metritis is disseminated through the herd by using a male that has contacted the infectious agent through mating a doe that is infected. The most common types of metritis transmitted through this method is the type of metritis caused by the Pasteurella sp. and the spirochete infections. However, virgin does have been found to be infected with these types of infectious agents.

2. Systemic infection. These types of uterine infections are due to the animal being systemically infected with some other type of bacterial disease, such as "Snuffles", and the bacterial agent is carried through the blood stream to the uteri where it localizes and causes metritis. This type of uterine infection is usually seen where there is a high incidence of "Snuffles" in the herd. This can then cause a uterine infection and this infection can then be transferred through the mating act to other animals in the breeding herd. The most common types of

bacterial organisms found in this type of transfer is the pasteurella sp. and the Staphylococcus sp.

3. Post-kindling contamination. This type of metritis is caused by the contamination of the uteri with a variety of bacterial organisms during the kindling process. This type of contamination is enhanced due to the presence of a retained placenta or a retained fetus during the kindling process. This type of metritis can be caused by a variety of organisms and one that can be very devastating to the rabbit person through the loss of good producing animals from the herd due to not being able to get these does bred in the future.

#### NECROPSY FINDINGS

An animal will show, upon necropsy, a variety of signs depending upon the type of bacterial contamination of the uteri. One can find a gross amount of pus in the uterus (pyometra) to almost a normal uterus with just a small amount of fluid contained within. Other findings will show portions of the degenerated placenta of fetus that has been retained during the kindling process. To determine the exact cause of the metritis will entail the use of good culturing techniques.

#### TREATMENT

Treatment of metritis will depend upon the type of organism that is causing the problem and the method of infection. Uterus infections that are caused by the Pasteurella sp. organism will be very difficult to treat with any type of antibiotics and one should rely primarily upon the elimination of the Pasteurella sp. organism from the herd and the prevention of systemic Pasteurella sp. infections in the herd.

The common metritis caused by the spirochete infection is relatively easy to treat with the use of proper dosages of Penicillin G and the proper treatment program. This information should be obtained from your local veterinarian.

#### PREVENTION

Prevention is probably the most important item in the control of metritis in one's rabbitry. Many uterus infections can be controlled through the prevention of systemic bacterial infections in the herd through good management practices. This would include excellent ventilation and culling measures to control Pasteurella sp. in the rabbitry. One should be certain to use only males and females that show no external signs of inflammation of the genitals at the time of breeding. However, in some of the latent spirochete infections, it is totally impossible to detect the presence of the infection without culturing the organism. If spirochete infections are diagnosed in the herd, it is very important that one maintains a good preventative program through periodic treatment of the bucks and



regular treatment of the does post-kindling to control this condition.

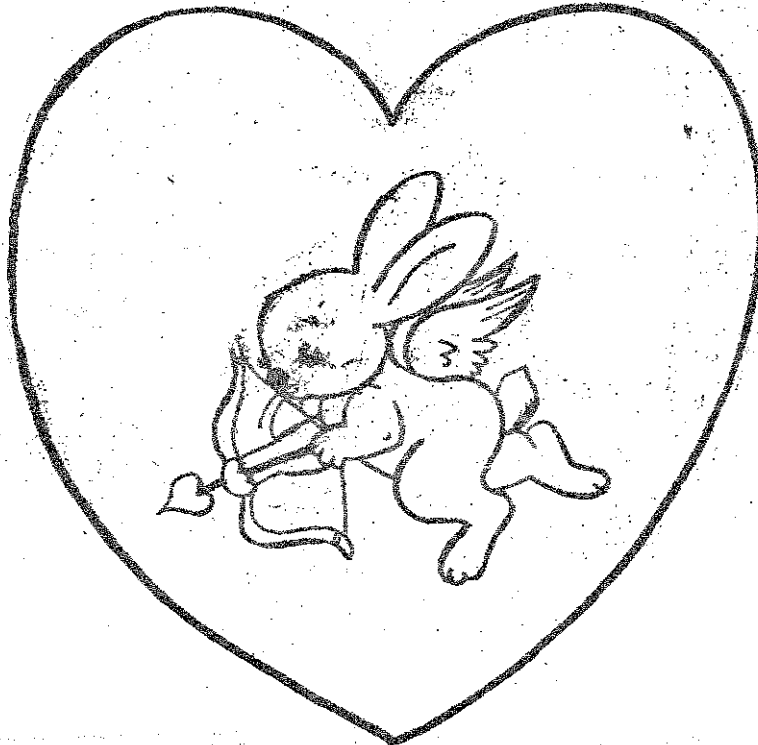
The reduction of retained placenta and feti in the does is a very important item in reducing the incidence of metritis in the herd.

In my opinion, it is imperative that the rabbit managers use good preventative management practices to assure the reduction of retained placenta and feti. This can be accomplished through routine injections of a mixture of Oxytocin and Penicillin G within twenty-four hours after kindling.

To the fancier, particularly to those individuals that are breeders of the miniature or "large-headed" animals, this is a very important management technique to include in your herd management program. Specific dosages and information can be obtained through your local veterinarian.

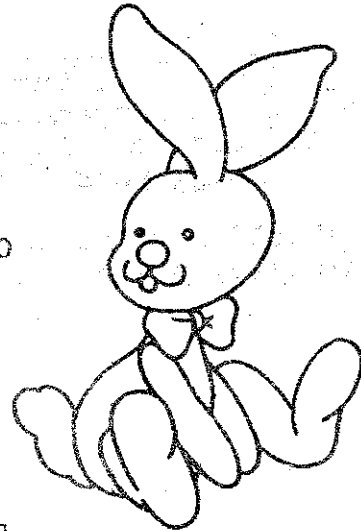

# Bunny helps sniff out suspects

A state trooper taking his daughter's rabbit for an off-duty hop in his North Raleigh neighborhood surprised three burglary suspects — after they had surprised the rabbit — at a neighbor's house.

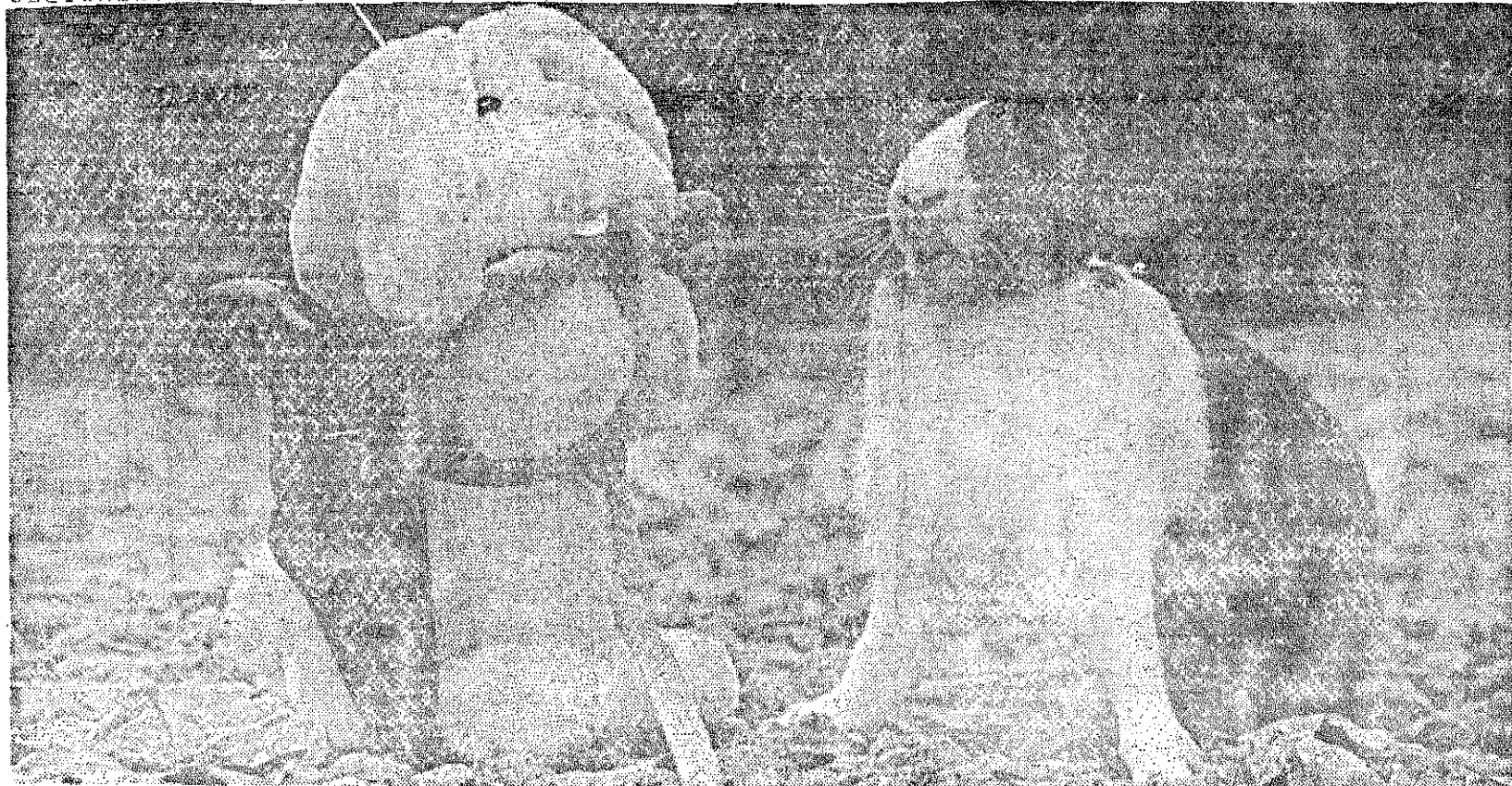
Sgt. C.A. "Dan" Danieley Jr., who is chief of security for Gov. James G. Martin, lives on Mine Shaft Road. The black-and-white rabbit, named Oreo, belongs to Danieley's daughter Marlou.

"I was out walking Oreo to his usual spot to do his usual thing" the night of Dec. 16, Danieley said Monday. "I was just chewing my tobacco waiting on Oreo. Then I heard the leaves rustling in the back yard.

"It spooked Oreo. He pulled on the leash and tried to bolt for our back door. He was squeaking. I finally had to pick him up and hold him close."

Danieley said he saw three young men trying to enter a vacant house and, finding it empty, move on to the house next door.

"Then I saw these three guys walking up on my neighbor's back porch," he said. "I just froze right there. One of the guys reared back and put his hand through the window and crawled through to let the other two in through the sliding glass doors."

Danieley calmed Oreo, called the Raleigh police and grabbed his I.D. and his gun. The teenage burglary suspects "cleaned out the house in 10 minutes," he said. They had taken a stereo, speakers, microwave oven, VCR, telephones and some food from the freezer.

Two of the three teens drove away, and Raleigh police officers caught them near Crabtree Valley

Mall. Danieley caught the third, who had been left behind at the scene.

"I nailed him before he knew what was going on," Danieley said.

Police said they recovered about \$4,000 worth of property that had been stolen from the Charles L. Critzer residence on Mine Shaft Road.

Robert Eugene Harris, 18, of 1712 Fountain Drive, and Libby

Jerome Randall, 17, of 1521 Westchester Road, were charged with second-degree burglary, according to arrest warrants. The identity of the third man arrested could not be confirmed Tuesday.

"I know all my neighbors and their cars, and I'm acutely aware of what's going on," Danieley said. "We have a real good community watch here. We'd not had this happen before. It's really an isolated incident."

Danieley is a volunteer firefighter with the Six Forks Fire Department. At the department's Christmas banquet Sunday night, he was presented with a stuffed bunny holding a pistol and handcuffs.

"He did a good job," said Freddy Lynn, Six Forks fire chief. "If it weren't for him and the rabbit, those people would have lost a lot of things."

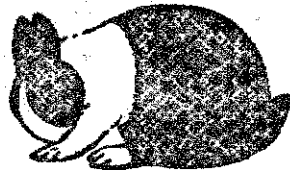

### TYPE

TO BE COBBY IN TYPE, COMPACT IN FORM AND LIMB. GOOD DUTCH TYPE CONSISTS OF A NICELY ROUNDED BACK, BEGINNING ALMOST IMMEDIATELY BEHIND THE HEAD AND PROGRESSING OVER THE SHOULDERS, LOIN AND RUMP TO TAIL. SHOULDERS SHOULD BE ROUNDED AND SLIGHTLY NARROWER AND LOWER THAN HIPS. RIB SPREAD SHOULD BE SO THAT THE SIDE LINES CARRY STRAIGHT THROUGH FROM THE SHOULDER TO THE HIPS. A GOOD DUTCH SHOULD HAVE NICELY ROUNDED HIPS, VERY SMOOTH, ROUNDED UNDER VERY GRADUALLY AND SMOOTHLY. THE DUTCH SHOULD RETAIN THE COBBY, STOCKY APPEARANCE WHETHER IT WEIGHS 3½ POUNDS OR 5½ POUNDS.
