Don Unruh has faithfully typed show reports off and on when the going has gotten heavy. The number one daughter has faithfully done the ads and we have gotten our wires crossed on occasion, but will allow an extra month etc. to be sure that every one has gotten their money's worth. Just have to express appreciation to those of you who have taken time out of a busy schedule and written an article for the Dutch Reporter. These articles have added greatly to D.R. interest. In being completely realistic in regard to the turnover of membership, articles on rabbit raising and experiences of competent breeders are just as important as full show report for example.

I am including a copy of the Official Show Rules in this issue. One of the things that makes for extra work and it is unnecessary, is the remittance of incorrect amounts. After three years it should be pretty well known that the sanction fee is \$6.00, yet I still receive \$5.00 remittances with requests for Show Sanctions. Very rarely is the ARBA Code omitted, however according to the rules, the ARBA code is to be given at the time of applying for a Sanction. Are there really very many of you that are active in show management that don't know that you will be holding this show 3-4 months in advance? I am sure that there are a few exceptions to this, but shouldn't be very many. I think that I can speak from experience when I say that late show sanction returns are a matter of habit. If a show committee or secretary makes it a point to get these mop up details done as soon as possible after the show, and while it is fresh on the mind, there would be a lot less problems for all concerned. To be frank, it is always the same ones and this is what leads me to say that it is habit. Well! "A little give, a little take" a bit of understanding and we will progress. How's this for the thought of the day?

Quarterly Financial Report: Oct.-Nov.-Dec., 1971

Total Income, \$800.80. Paid outs are: Printing, \$20.02. Reid, travel allowance, \$25.00; Notary \$10.00. Supplies, \$20.00. Conv. Specials. \$98.20 (Specials paid to A.D.R.C. members only) to ARBA for Comb. memberships \$75.50. Sec.-Treas.-Editors fees, \$210.71. Dutch Reporter \$216.00. Publicity Share of Dues, \$92.86. Ribbens, \$216.40 and 1972 National Dutch Show portion of income, \$301.58. I ended the year with my last reconciliation of the check book at \$26.85 and the sec. fees not paid at that time. Technically speaking we are still in the red, but with supplies on hand and all bills paid. The Dutch Reporter account had in the area of 88.00 at balancing time, but since then have paid out postage and bulk mailing permit.

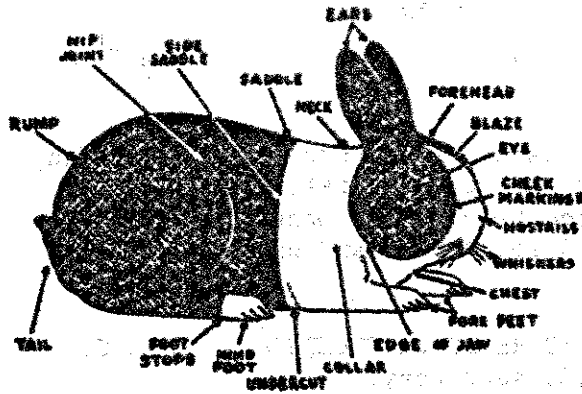

OFFICIAL SWEEPSTAKES RULES

In order to stimulate the exhibition of the Dutch Rabbit in all shows, both large & small, The American Dutch Rabbit Club has approved the following rules for any show sanctioned by the AMERICAN DUTCH RABBIT CLUB, Inc.

RULE 1 - No club can sponsor a Dutch Sweepstakes unless their show is sanctioned by the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. A.R.B.A. sanction number to accompany application to A.D.R.C.

RULE 2 - The club wishing to sponsor a Dutch Sweepstakes must write the secretary of the American Dutch Rabbit Club for permission to hold such a show. Request to be accompanied by a fee of \$6.00, which includes a \$1.00 listing fee in the Dutch Reporter and must be placed at least sixty (60) days prior to date of show.

RULE 3 - Your show must be listed in the Dutch Reporter. The advertising fee of \$1.00 to be used as Editor's fee for the Dutch Reporter.

RULE 4 - No club can sponsor a Dutch Sweepstakes unless they can accept shipped in rabbits. Rabbits may be cooped in regulation show coops and provision for food, water and adequate care must be taken.

RULE 5 - Announcement of Dutch Sweepstakes Show must be placed on the outside front cover of the catalog or the page listing the Dutch Special money.

RULE 6 - Club sponsoring the show MUST OFFER AND PAY AT LEAST \$1.00 for the BEST SPECIMAN IN EACH OF THE FOLLOWING COLORS: BLACK, BLUE, CHOCOLATE, TORTOISE, STEEL, GRAY. THIS SPECIAL MONEY MUST BE LISTED IN THE CATALOG PREMIUM LIST.

RULE 7 - A printed form for listing the winners will be furnished the secretary of your show by the secretary of the A.D.R.C. THIS FORM IS TO BE FILLED OUT AND RETURNED, ALONG WITH A LIST OF THE DUTCH EXHIBITORS, names and addresses, TO THE SECRETARY OF THE A.D.R.C. WITHIN FORTY-FIVE (45) DAYS FROM THE LAST DAY OF THE SHOW. IF NOT RECEIVED WITHIN FORTH-FIVE DAYS, THE POINTS ON THIS REPORT WILL NOT BE COUNTED IN THE CURRENT SWEEPSTAKES SERIES. A TEAR SHEET OF DUTCH PREMIUMS AND SPECIALS MUST ACCOMPANY THIS REPORT.

RULE 8 - Sweepstakes points shall be accumulated by members in good standing as follows: six times the number judged for first, four times the number judged for second, three times the number judged for third, two times the number judged for fourth and one times the number judged for fifth.

NOTE: SHOW SECRETARIES, DO NOT FIGURE DUTCH SWEEPSTAKES POINTS. This is done by the A.D.R.C. secretary.

RULE 9 - Member winning the most accumulated points shall be declared the winner of the series and shall be awarded an engraved trophy (cost to be a minimum of \$15.00 plus engraving). Member accumulating second most points shall be awarded an engraved trophy (cost to be a minimum of \$10.00 plus engraving) members winning third through tenth shall receive a small engraved cup or trophy.

RULE 10- This Dutch Sweepstakes shall close with the National Dutch Show.

RULE 11- No other sanction for a Dutch Sweepstakes Show shall be given for the date that the National Dutch Show is held within a radius of 500 miles of the location of the National Dutch Show.

RULE 12- Interpretation of and amendments to these Dutch Sweepstakes Show Rules by the Board of Directors of the American Dutch Rabbit Club shall be binding on the Dutch Sweepstakes Show.

RULE 13- Please, judge in this order: Sr. Buck, Sr. Doe, Jr. Buck and Jr. Doe. Colors to be judged in the following order: Black, Blue, Chocolate, Tortoise, Steel and Gray.

The following lines, along with requirements in RULE 6 MUST BE PRINTED IN THE SHOW CATALOG OR PREMIUM LISTING.

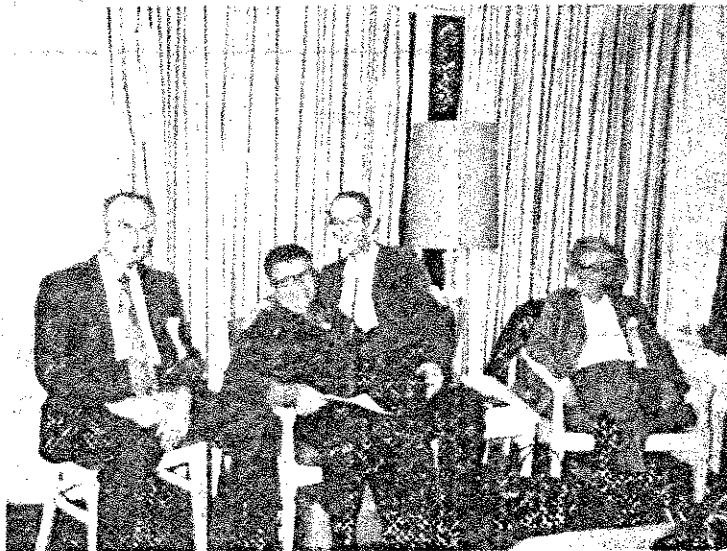

Tattooing Rabbits by Jack of Jack's Bunnies.

Each and every breeder has his own way of tattooing his rabbits, but now and then can come up with a little tip to help others. First I put India ink on my letters or numbers in my tongs. Then I clamp into the ear. Next I run my thumb over the new tattoo rubbing in the ink. I keep a small container of vaseline handy and coat the new tattoo with it. I have my first mark to lose as yet and this rabbit can go to a show from then on and not get eliminated because the ear number can't be read. My thumb takes out excess ink and leaves the tattoo only. The vaseline preserves the tattoo with a coating and it is ledgeable. I say if the new tattoo is smeared with ink when the rabbit is shown, it should be eliminated as not ledgeable.....

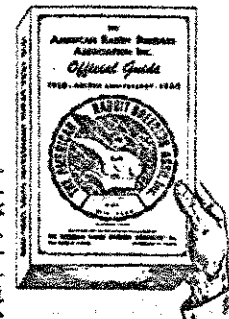
