## DUTCH RUMBLINGS

As we approach the month of July we are again faced with the task of protecting our Dutch from the terrific hot days ahead, during the next few months the heat will take it's annual toll of rabbits so prepare now to take every possible precaution for the comfort of your Dutch from now until fall. One of the most effective methods I have found to combat the heat in my hutches has been the use of a one-gallon crock of water in each hutch, changing the water two or three times daily. I have on occasions where the weather has continued very hot for several days, used ice in the crocks. I realize this method would not be very practical for the breeder with a lot of rabbits, but for the average fancier, he will find this means of supplying comfort for his rabbits very worthwhile. It will not only lower the temperature inside the rabbitry, but the rabbits will drape their bodies around the crock and in this manner derive a great deal of comfort from it's cooling effect.

Word comes from our Breed Chairman for the A.R.B.A. Convention at St. Paul, Minnesota, the Millers, that they are looking forward to a very large entry of Dutch again this year. 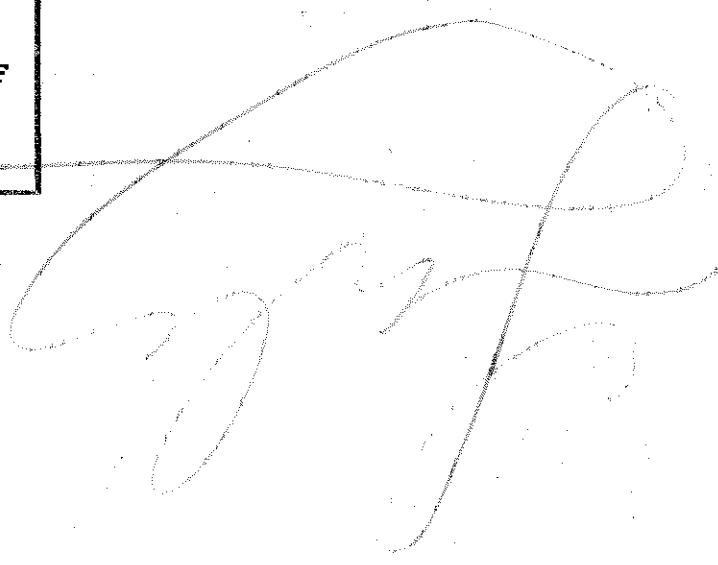
