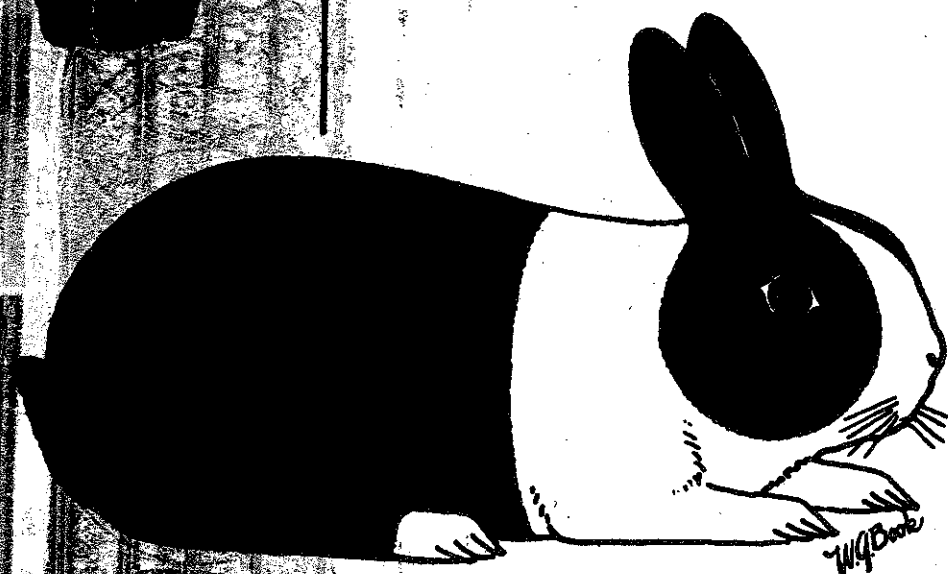

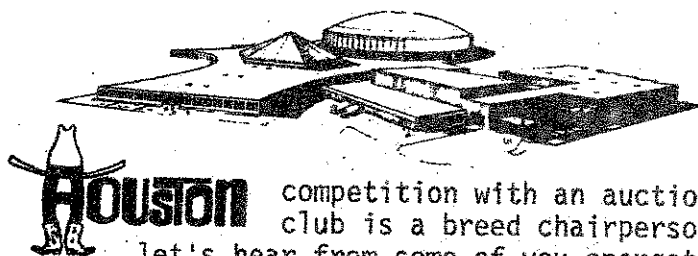

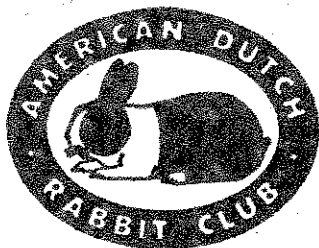

FROM THE DESK OF THE SECRETARY

The weather and humidity are running neck and neck in our area....muggy, sticky, still, heavy and HOT! We're doing our best to keep our Dutch cool, but it hasn't been too easy. Air conditioning in the rabbitry would be nice -- the bunnies would love it! However, after the first electric bill, I would probably have a stroke....and it "wouldn't" be from the heat!!

The final election ballots will be mailed out on or about the first of August. We are electing a President and three Directors. We will also be voting on the judge/s for both the '86 National Dutch Show and the '86 ARBA Convention. There will also be amendments and/or changes to the Constitution and By-Laws. Please look these over carefully and vote either yes or no in the space/s provided. Remember, when sending your ballot in, add your return address to the outer envelope. This envelope is discarded before ballots are opened, but it is needed to verify that you are a valid voting member. If your name does not appear on the envelope, your ballot becomes void. Regardless of who you vote for, or what changes or amendments you vote for, take the opportunity to VOTE! Remember, ballots are sent out third class mail and should arrive within "about" two weeks of their mailing date. Often, when a husband/wife membership is involved, one will receive their ballot a few days to a week before the other receives their's. "I have no idea why this happens"!!!!!! Ballots are sorted down by state and placed in zip code order. They are then bundled and sent out "all at one time"!! If you haven't received your ballot by the end of August, first look at your membership card to make certain that your membership was current when ballots were mailed. If it was, notify this office and another will be issued immediately!

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

* Many members write asking when their membership expires, or state that they didn't receive any expiration notice. Your membership expiration date is listed on your membership card and also appears on the label of "each" issue of your Dutch Reporter. If you receive your D.R. via first class mail, you will also find your 1st. class expiration date on the label. (eg: 02/06/86 FC 02/86) The first set of numbers is your expiration date, February 6, 1986. The second set means that your First Class mailing expires in February of '86.

* If you are questioning an error in the sweepstakes, please contact Vicki Hertel. The show report forms are sent to her and she is best qualified to answer your questions regarding any errors that you feel have been made. When they are sent to me, I must then forward them to Vicki. This takes additional time and will delay a response regarding your question/s. Vicki's address is Rt.2, Box 238H Forest Grove, Oregon 97116.

* Ad renewals may be sent to me, but again, in order to avoid delay, please send all Dutch Reporter ads and editorial matters to our Dutch Reporter editor, Dianne Williamson. Dianne's address is 6588 E. Ashlan Clovis, California 93612. She may be reached by phone at (209) 294-7394.

* For those questioning the new edition of the Guidebook,.....I feel certain that Scott Williamson will have something in this issue on it's publication date. Scott is in charge of the Guidebook, and any questions you may have regarding this matter should be sent directly to him.

* The deadline for specials to be listed in the '85 ARBA Convention catalog was reached before a "Breed Chairperson" was appointed. Carolyn Roller phoned this office with notification that they would allow us only a "few days" to comprise a specials list and make the catalog. Due to this fact, a list of specials was made up using only the money collected from those in attendance at the ADRC luncheon in Orlando, Florida, an unused youth special from the '84 ARBA Convention and the annual ADRC allotment. A specials list was sent to Carolyn via "express mail" the day after her phone call in order to ensure delivery within the deadline. There was a notation added to the list allowing the ADRC the right to substitute awards of equal or higher value in place of those listed, and also to add additional specials. I am asking for donations to "ADD" to the specials list for the '85 ARBA Convention in Houston, Texas. It's too late to have your name listed in the catalog, but I will keep the membership updated with all incoming specials and the donors through the Dutch Reporter. I am sorry to say that I have not taken any courses in hieroglyphics!! Please, when sending correspondence to this office, be certain that it is legible! There are "many times" that I must go to the ARBA yearbook to see if you are listed in order to spell your name correctly or get your correct address.

Sometimes I receive only a check for the amount of membership. The check is in the name "John & Mary Doe". I issue the membership for John and I receive a reply stating "it was supposed to be a membership for Mary, I don't have any interest in rabbits". I no longer guess....I just return the fee sent and ask for the necessary information. It delays the membership process, but is through no fault of this office. Sanction requests that are not accompanied by a "proper" ARBA show code number are automatically returned!! Many requests are sent with a note saying we will send our ARBA number when we receive it!....this is a "NO-NO"! No ADRC sanction will be issued unless an ARBA number is included in the request form. Again, be certain that you have written your request legibly. If I can't read it, I don't know who to issue it to or where to return it! It takes just as long to write something in legible form as it does to chicken scratch it!

Sanction requests should be submitted as early as possible. This is to ensure that there is ample time to return it when the necessary information does not accompany the request and also to have it publicized. "Many" requests arrive only two weeks to two days before the show! I also receive many sanction requests ON and AFTER the show date. These are processed ONLY depending on the circumstances. For example, I received a request for a youth sanction in March for an "April" show. The request did not have the correct fees, it did not contain an ARBA show code number and they listed no show secretary name or address. Only the show sponsor, show date and the person who sent the note appeared on the note. This was returned for necessary information, along with a request for a valid ARBA sanction number. I asked that the information be submitted and I would process the sanction immediately upon it's return. The information, along with a show report (?), (written on a sheet of paper) and returned to me on July 5th., OVER TWO MONTHS AFTER THE SHOW DATE! This sanction was returned again,.....UNPROCESSED!! Those youth that did exhibit at this show would not receive any credit for points earned regardless as the '84-'85 sweepstakes has already come to a

close and points tabulated. Furthermore, ADRC sanctions are not issued after the show date in cases such as stated above!!

I receive "bundles" of correspondence daily. It takes some time to process it all, but it takes less time if it arrives with all the necessary information needed and is in legible form.

Until next issue, keep yourself and your Dutch cool,.....and have a really "SUPER NICE" day!

FROM DIRECTOR ROGER EICH

The hot summer days are at hand once again and many breeders seem to be making comment about the length of the young rabbits ears. The circumstances surrounding the environment of the young rabbits the first four weeks of growth seem to have some effect on the ear growth.

Early this spring, we mated three does (sisters) to one of our herd bucks and they all kindled in two days with live litters of 8, 8, and 7. The offspring were very nice, in fact so nice, we decided to try the same mating again. However, this time they kindled within three days, but the weather was hot (85° & 95°). The living litter sizes were 8, 9, and 6. The basic difference was the nest boxes we used. With the earlier litters, we used open top wood nest boxes, 8" high, 13" long, and 8" wide. This time we used only one of the wood type nest boxes for the doe with 8 young. For the does with 9 and 6 we were trying out some new metal boxes my feed supplier gave me. It had the top covered about 1/2 of the way and a tapered type opening the rest. The floor size of the metal boxes was identical to the wood ones, but did have a removable bottom with small vent holes in it.

At 2 1/2 weeks of age while the weather was still very hot, we removed all the nest boxes and made the young stay out on the wire floors. At that time the doe's young with the ventilated boxes appeared to have shorter ears than the ones raised in the wood box. At that time I didn't think too much about it. At weaning time, we saved 11 from the three does, tattooed them and put them in developing pens. It wasn't till this week when I was delivering a fellow some new cages that the ear length subject arose again. I could hardly wait to get home to check on those eleven we had put in the developing pens. The results were very easy to judge. In fact I picked out four with longer than normal ears and every one of them was born in the wood box. This was very interesting to me. Not absolute proof, but worthy of mentioning.



I have spent the last few months getting around to Dutcheries. It seems that the doe conception rate is very low for June/July and everyone is feeling low wondering why. In that I am involved with 4-H, I remembered that given 85° plus days for 3-5 days in a row, bucks will go sterile for 30-60 days, maybe longer.

We in this section had extremely hot weather the end of April, when the average temperature is about 63°. For three days it was summer, between 90-95° in April. Well it must have done real harm! As best as I can make out, May and June breedings have a 95% conception rate normally, yet this year it was about 30%. It goes to prove to you that males like it cool for one reason or another!

But let us not forget what they did for our breed. The improvements they made in their own herds gave us all something to notice and strive for. They helped put the Dutch in the limelight when Best in Shows were being chosen.

Although they are only with us in memory now, their leadership and accomplishments will remain as long as there are Dutch rabbits. Both of these men reached goals that most of us only dream of. But I am sure that at one time, they had the same dreams. Their's became reality, and if we follow their example, ours can too.

Al told me at one time that the only way to get a better Dutch was to keep at it and at it and at it. Hopefully, by doing this and striving for the quality and excellence that Tom and Al both achieved, I will approach their standard, and my goals. You will both be remembered always, as time goes by.

M.S.Lord Nelson, black doe, born July 6, 1977. Has achieved to my knowledge a record of National Dutch Show awards. Unsurpassed by any other Dutch in the history of our club. Truly a remarkable animal. The late Mr. Shufflebothom, with our club since it started, could not recall any Dutch, especially a doe who participated in Four National Dutch shows, and had a record as high as hers. The beauty of it all was she not only was a show animal but also a great mother. She raised at least two litters a year between shows. It could have easily been five nationals but I could not make the show in 1979. Still in her prime, I'm sure she would have done well in the awards, especially the fur class, as she was never beaten in this class, three times Best Fur. Note also the judges that placed her, some of the best. You be the judge, here is her National Dutch Show record.

1st in a class of 42 Senior Black Does, Best Black(137),
Best Dutch and Best Fur all colors(43 class)

1980 York, PA, 400 entries, Judges Williamson & Pugh,

(80 class)

1981 Champaign, Il, 413 entries, Judges Carr & Bengstrom,
1st in a class of 33 Black Senior Does, Best opposite Black,
(122 Black) Best Fur all colors(47 class)

1982 Hutchinson, Kansas, 300 entries, Judges Holcomb &
Williamson, 2nd in a class of 24 Black Does.

At five years of age, along with her son & daughters, she shared a major part in winning Best Display of Blacks. When beaten, it was always a long decision and the judges remarks were beaten on stops, both times.

If M.S.Lord Nelson isn't in your mind the best Dutch ever shown, receiving nine National Dutch Show trophies, she will always be in mine.

* All members receive "one" issue of the Dutch Reporter after their membership has expired. Since the last Dutch Reporter was printed and before the labels for the July/August issue were run off for the editor, 116 memberships were deleted from our files. You may want to check "your" membership card to see if you were one of those memberships that have been depleted from our files!! I was certainly surprised at the "names" of some that had lapsed in April and "have not renewed"!!

* This office has issued 476 sanctions since January 1, 1985 and through June 30, 1985. 117 have been Youth Sanctions and 359 Open Sanctions.

* Since January 1, 1985, and through June 30, 1985, I have processed 308 memberships; 134 new memberships and 174 renewals. Of the new memberships, 62 were youth and 72 were adult single and H/W. Of the renewals, 39 were youth and 135 were single adult and H/W memberships.

* Postage paid from this office since January 1, 1985 through July 1, 1985 was \$563.60. Of this amount, \$92.22 was for mailing the January/February issues of the Dutch Reporter and \$37.46 was for the mailing of the nomination ballots. Deducting these amounts, normal postage was \$433.92 for a six month period. The six month period was a total of 181 days. If you subtract 26 days due to "no mail on Sunday", this is an average of \$2.80 per day in mail!

* Interest on our checking account since January 1, 1985 totals \$80.46.

* Our Money Market Account, (Contingency Fund) has had \$206.88 added to it's total. This is interest earned and credited From January '85 through June '85.

* In March of '83, this office purchased 10,000 DR covers (various colors all in black ink) for a cost of \$228.65. This is \$22.865 per thousand or .0228 per cover. This office just purchased 12,000 DR covers at the same printing office for \$323.95. These covers were all done in cream color paper with brown printing (as requested). Please note that brown ink cost is higher than the standard black. However, the cost of these covers was \$26.995 per thousand or .0269 per cover. This was an increase of only \$4.13 per thousand more over a two year period! Not bad huh???

Feeding Ground Extruded Soybeans

A rabbit supplements test conducted by 4-Her Paul Dill

We are in an area where dairy cattle are one of the main sources of farm income, along with a variety of field crops. Soybeans are a popular food additive in the feeding of these high production cows. They are a crop that is a high protein source, usually 36%, and cost approximately \$10 for a 60

pound bag. A sixty pound sack will last the rabbit hobbist almost forever.

On the 6th of November, 1983, our Red Satin doe, Amelia, had a litter of eight; four bucks and four does. She successfully raised the whole litter. On January 29th, we separated the litter into two pens; one with the bucks, the other with the four does. This was the start of a three month project for 4-H Veterinary Science. The purpose

in doing this project was two fold; first to see if the addition of ground extruded soybeans would improve the fur quality and second, to check for any negative reactions with this high percentage feed additive.

Group I (the bucks) were on full feed. Group II (the does) were on full feed and soybeans, approximately two tablespoons per day. To start the feeding of the high protein soybean, acidophilus capsules were added to the feed every fourth day. Acidophilus is the product used in starting yogurt cultures and can be purchased in most Health Food stores. We have found that when we use acidophilus before traveling with or shipping the rabbits, they tolerate the stress much better.

A daily log was started, making notes of any changes we saw in the two groups. On day one, we weighed all of the rabbits, giving exact weights of each rabbit and an average weight of the group. The bucks averaged four and one-half pounds while the does weighed in at three and seven-eighths pounds. On the fourth day, two does had diarrhea and were treated with a Neo-Terramycin Scour medication. Day seven, all were weighed again and we found that both groups had dropped slightly in weight. (Our conclusion was that it was due to the stress of separation from the doe.) Up until the 14th day the does had pushed through their feed dish to get to the pellets, leaving the soybean. However, on the 14th day, they ate both the pellets and soybean. At weighing time on the 14th, it was noticed that the does had less pottiness and slightly better fur. Soybean was being fed at one tablespoon per head, and increase of one-half tablespoon per rabbit. By the 29th day, Group II (the does) were starting to gain faster than the bucks and the soybean was once again increased, this time to one and one-half tablespoon per rabbit. At that time the whole rabbitry was routinely treated for coccidiosis. Day 36, the does are very anxious to eat the soybean and will now push the pellets away to get at the feed additive. By the 42nd day, the does are still showing better fur, a smoother Satin fur, while the bucks fur has a coarser texture and slightly wave, showing signs of still having baby fur. The acidophilus is now only given if any evidence of diarrhea is observed.

By the 49th day, the bucks still weighed more but the does were starting to gain on them. Once a month pictures were taken of both Group I and Group II. The first month it was difficult to see any difference in the pictures. The 61st day the bucks were separated into individual cages. The boys were starting to feel their "oats." The does were separated into cages of two per cage.

The soybean had been increased to three tablespoons per rabbit and the does' fur had really begun to take on a bloom. It became apparent by the 63rd day that the feeding of soybeans would have to be done in two dishes as they were digging through the dishes, hunting for the soybeans and leaving the pellets.

Things had been going relatively well with the study until this point. However, on the 78th day we noticed that we were having difficulty with all the animals in the rabbitry. They seemed to be dying from what resembles

felt that it was brought on by the rabbit choosing the soybeans in large amounts while refusing the pellets which caused an imbalance of the required vitamins. The other animals showed hemorrhaging of the intestine and cecum — due to the bad feed.

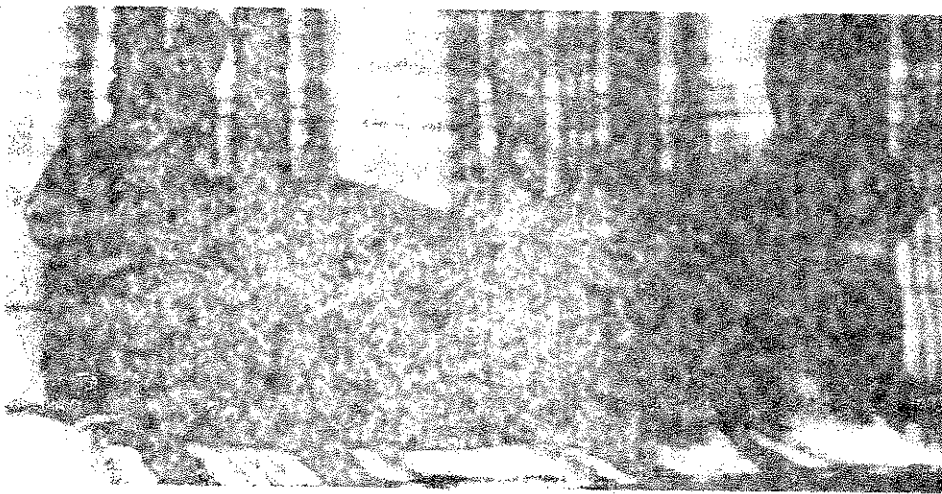
The 85th day weights were taken but we were unable to average weights due to the loss of the doe in Group II. Day 90, our final day. Group II (the does) had far superior fur quality and firmness. Two animals were sacrificed for pelts and anatomical study.

tolerate the high protein very well with the assistance of the adicophilus to get them started.

We learned through this process that the amount of soybean **must be limited** to eliminate the problem of vitamin deficiency. We also learned that we had does that would not conceive because of the excess fat due to the free feeding of the soybean.

Soybean that has not been extruded (heat-treated or cooked) **can be toxic** to rabbits. We also found a by-product that is made while the soybean is being cooked, we called it "soybean bones." It was a real treat to the rabbits and only has a 16-18% protein level. This food by-product might be used as a cheaper food source for the commercial rabbit raiser.

The length of the study was very good even though we had difficulty with the entire herd during this test period. I do not feel that a study of this type can be fully evaluated in a short time span, such as one month, nor do I feel that it is complete with the one three month test that we ran. There are too many variables in each test. We would like to run this test again, even though it is very time consuming. We would divide the groups into two bucks and two does in each test group as the bucks may have had better weight gains due to their sex.

nucoid enteritis, adults and young (4-10 weeks). The feed smelled unusual so we contacted the feed company. They verified that they were aware of the problem. We changed feed immediately and added acidophilus again. The 82nd day, animals were still dying. Day 83, three dead frozen ryers and a live doe out of the test group were sent to a laboratory. Along with the animals, feed samples were sent. The food samples were tried on the laboratory rabbits, with the same results — refusal to eat it by the fifth day. The live doe was necropsied. She showed deterioration of the musculing round the heart and into the leg muscles caused by a deficiency of Vitamin E. It was

Summary

We had a very positive result in the area of obtaining better quality fur with the use of limited and free choice ground extruded soybean meal. We continue to use it on a weekly basis with the entire breeding and show herd, feeding approximately one tablespoon twice per week. We also found that the added protein assists the doe that is having difficulty producing enough milk for her kits.

We had a positive result in the rabbits ability to utilize the 36% protein without severe complications resulting in soft, shapeless stools or coccidiosis. They seemed to
