NOTICE: Proposed amendment to the A.D.R.C. Constitution and By-laws:

The sweepstakes chairperson shall provide the Dutch Reporter editor with a typed copy of each show report listed chronologically and sweepstakes standing for both open and youth divisions listed numerically; top 20 open and youth divisions as well as the top 5 youth from each district.

Please take special note of this constitutional amendment and the others published in this Dutch Reporter, we will VOTE on these items in Columbus, Ohio at the general membership meeting held at the A.R.B.A. Convention.

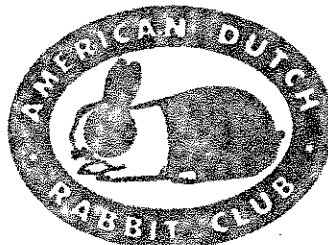

YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH

From the Desk of the Secretary.....

Enclosed in this issue of the Dutch Reporter you will find your "FINAL ELECTION BALLOT" for the American Dutch Rabbit Club. On this ballot, you will find a space provided for the office of Vice-President. You will also find that a Director is to be elected in Districts 1, 2, 3, 5 & 7. Each eligible adult member may vote for the office of Vice-President, however, please remember that you can only vote for a District Director if a Director is to be elected from your District! If a Director isn't being elected from your District, DO NOT VOTE in that area! You will also be voting for the 1987/1988 National Dutch Show Judge and 1987/1988 ARBA Convention Judge, and amendments and/or resolutions to the ADRC Constitution and By-Laws. Please exercise your right to vote! Adult members may only vote on the "ADULT" ballot!!

Remember, ballots must be "RECEIVED" in this office on or before September 15, 1986. Be certain that your ballot is postmarked in ample time to arrive by this date!!

YOUTH MEMBERS ---- A separate ballot is included in this issue just for you. This will enable you to vote for the 1987/1988 National Dutch Show Judge of your choice. I felt that it would prevent some of our youth from a possible "spoiled ballot" should they vote for anything other than the youth judges. I certainly hope that we have a better turnout of youth voters than we did in the nominations! Only six (6) youth ballots were received at that time!!

You were given the opportunity to nominate judges for the 1987 and 1988 ARBA Convention. However, you will not find these names on your final ballot. The ARBA Youth Committee is responsible for hiring judges for the Youth Department at the Conventions. We felt that having you nominate judges of your choice, it would enable us to supply this information to the ARBA Youth Committee. It is possible that they may give some consideration to those choices when making their selections.


Remember, Youth members may only vote on that ballot marked "YOUTH"!

I hope that everyone is looking forward to the 1986 ARBA Convention in Columbus, Ohio, November 3-6. It's just around the corner and definitely not too early to start making your reservations. It is quiet and hot on the desert. Shows are at a stand still. Everyone is trying to raise a few for the fall and early winter shows.

I would like to thank the Iowa people for putting on a fine show. They did a good job and a good time was had by all who attended. I really enjoyed judging the youth. There was a very nice group of youth rabbits. Thanks for letting me have the privilege of judging them.

Sorry I did not get an article in the last Dutch Reporter, but I have been under the weather for about two months. I am back to normal now and hope I can get back to judging shows again.

I have been breeding for the fall and winter shows---so far not much luck. It is sure hard to keep your buck from going sterile in the summer time. I have a row I call the "buck row" and it is in the coolest part of my rabbitry and still the older bucks go sterile on me. Right now about all the litters I am getting are off young bucks. The older the rabbit, the more the heat effects them. If any of you are having trouble with old bucks, go to the young ones, six or seven month old rabbits. You will have better results.

So much for this time. It is once again election time. So be sure and vote. Some of our members never miss voting and that's great, but what about the rest of you? VOTE!

LOOK AT OUR PROGRESS

Since arriving back from our N.D.S. in Iowa, I have been asked by many how was it. Well it was both interesting and educational. The people who attended this annual show are the most dedicated belly scratched Dutch breeders in the country. The sponsoring club members were excellent hosts with each little "whim" taken care of immediately.

The judging was fast and relatively accurate. If I agreed with everything picked or placed it would be against the very nature of man or fancier. My biggest recollection of the progress in our Dutch breed was when I slowly walked each aisle looking at type and particularly color. If I might tell you my thoughts on color and type at this point - generally:

The blacks were visibly smaller in size with a little less depth (as were all the colors). The blues were as they have been for five-ten years with basically little change. The chocolates are becoming or being bred with more blacks and becoming richer in color. Much improved!

The tortoise are also being bred with black probably to improve the head/body type they so lacked for so many years. While this has improved the preceding it has darkened the shading to the point they look like sunburned black. The black fur is even around the head. Very discouraging.

Steel is the hardest color to breed and I observed that most were agouti tainted with very light belly color similar to our gray. It seems we have lost our good steel color in the past five-ten years. The tipping has now become tan or brown rather than a steel color. We must pull this back to our standard or lose this pretty color forever.

The grays have been yet shaded toward brown gray which is now our standard but getting a little deeper in shade. As one woman remarked at the show they look like a wild rabbit color. Is that what we want? I couldn't answer her! I did love the light or pale gray color, but our breeders of gray apparently didn't and wanted the change.

It was suprising to observe that the youth colors were "overall" slightly better than the open, in my opinion. All in all, it was pleasant with much discussion between members and groups. A real education could be learned if just one listened to our wisened breeders expressing their thoughts. We have progressed at the expense of a few colors but strengthened the others. We are not perfect, but we must now strengthen our weaknesses.

The following amendments and/or resolutions to the constitution and by laws are for the memberships' consideration. They will be voted upon in the next election.

*CONSTITUTION ARTICLE V:

Be it resolved that: Section 1 of the Constitution strike the sentence:
Each of the nine (9) Directors must reside in a different district.

Be it resolved that: Section 1 of the Constitution amend to read:

The elected officers of this association shall consist of a President, Vice-President, and nine (9) Directors who shall be elected for a three (3) term, by and from the membership. The Secretary-Treasurer shall be appointed by the President, approved by two-thirds majority of the Board of Directors, excluding the Secretary-Treasurer. The appointment of the Secretary-Treasurer will be for three (3) years. Any member, to be eligible for office, must be an owner and breeder of Dutch rabbits.

Be it resolved that: Section 2 of the Constitution amend to read:

The Secretary-Treasurer may be reappointed by the Board of Directors, who may also remove him/her from office, for cause, by a two-thirds majority, during any term of office. The Secretary-Treasurer will be an active voting member of the Board of Directors, except in the appointment or removal from the office of Secretary-Treasurer. The Board of Directors, therefore consists of the: President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, and nine (9) Directors. The term of any office shall begin on January 1 of the year following each election.

Be it resolved that: Section 3 of the Constitution amend to read:

The President and one (1) Director representing each district will be elected for a three (3) year tenure. The Vice-President and one (1) Director from each district will be elected the following year for a three (3) year tenure. Finally, the Secretary-Treasurer will be appointed and the final three (3) Directors each from a different district will be elected the third year to serve a three (3) year tenure. Directors may be from the same state and district as other officers; President, Vice-President, or Secretary-Treasurer. The Directors representing each district will be elected by a vote of only those members living in that district. Directors may be nominated by any member of the American Dutch Rabbit Club.

Be it resolved that: Section 5 of the Constitution amend to read:

Directors shall be elected from the three (3) districts divided as follows:

- 157 DISTRICT 1: Maine, Vermont, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, Connecticut, Massachusetts, New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio, New Jersey, Delaware, West Virginia, Maryland, Virginia, Georgia, Florida, North Carolina, and South Carolina.
- 160 DISTRICT 2: Iowa, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Missouri, Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, Tennessee, Kentucky, and Michigan.
- 134 DISTRICT 3: Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Alaska, California, Hawaii, Nevada, Utah, Arizona, New Mexico, Colorado, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, Texas, Oklahoma, and Kansas.

451* Note: No foreign member will be eligible to hold office.

*CONSTITUTION ARTICLE VI,.....add Section 2A:

No one (1) person can run for more than one (1) office at any one (1) election.

*BY-LAWS ARTICLE 111, Section 2A to read:

An annual allotment of \$500.00 (five-hundred dollars) from the General Fund shall be awarded to the sponsors of the National Dutch Rabbit Show, with further stipulation that the American Dutch Rabbit Club receive recognition for this allotment. Said money to be sent by the Secretary-Treasurer to the sponsors on or as near to January 1st. preceding the National Dutch Show for that year. Show sponsors must have all National Dutch Rabbit Show judges secured before any ADRC allocation is made.

*BY-LAWS Change ARTICLE 111, Section 3A to read:

The Publicity Chairman shall be paid \$100.00 (one-hundred dollars) for each annual National Dutch Rabbit Show and American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. Convention which he/she transports American Dutch Rabbit Club, Inc. publicity items for sale at the Club booth; such funds to be paid from the Publicity Fund.

passengers and the rabbits and cavies arrive as excess baggage, will not be affected by the above. If one is going to air freight animals to the convention, they should make proper arrangements, as per the guidelines set forth in the show catalog.

TRANSPORTATION OF EXHIBITORS AND RABBITS THAT ARE EXCESS BAGGAGE

It will be the exhibitor's responsibility to find transportation from the airport to the convention headquarters and to make their own arrangements for animals that arrive by excess baggage to be transported to the fairgrounds. The convention host will NOT be responsible for transporting exhibitors or animals, other than those arriving by air freight, to and from the airport or the showroom.

Taxi service is available from the airport to the Ohio State Fairgrounds by all the major cab companies servicing the Columbus International Airport. The majority of the cabs servicing the airport will transport rabbits. There are several cab companies that operate station wagons for this convenience. The cost of fare from the airport to the fairgrounds will be \$11.00 plus an additional fare for the animals. The fare from the airport to the convention headquarters, or surrounding motels, is \$11.00 per person. The Marriott Inn does provide shuttle service from the Columbus International Airport to their motel. They have agreed to haul rabbits from the airport to the motel; but, they WILL NOT TAKE THE ANIMALS TO THE OHIO STATE FAIRGROUNDS.

The other alternative one has for transportation is renting a car. There are several rent-a-car companies available when one goes down the escalator and goes to the right. Budget Rent-A-Car is the official car rental service for the 1986 ARBA National Convention. The Ohio State Fairgrounds is approximately fifteen to thirty minutes drive from the airport.

WEATHER

It will probably be necessary for all those in attendance to bring a variety of clothing for the late fall harvest weather in Ohio. The National Weather Service relates that the weather for the last few days of October and first few days of November averages from 55° to 57° for the high, and the lows are from 36° to 38°. Last year, on November 1st, the high temperature was 69° and the low was 56°. Also, on November 7th, the high was 47° and the low was 35°. Last year there was two inches of rain the first week of November; but, there had not been any snow recorded on that date. If anyone should be interested in the projected weather forecast as the convention dates approach, the National Weather Bureau of Columbus may be reached at 614-231-5212.

EXHIBITION HALL

The exhibition hall for the 1986 National ARBA Convention will be the Bricker Building located on the north portion of the Ohio State Fairgrounds. This is a modern building that has 154,912 square feet of area for exhibition of the rabbits, cavies, (open & youth), specialty club and commercial booths.

This is a very large building; but, with the anticipated large entry, it is anticipated that the building will be fairly well filled with animals, booths, and spectators. One can anticipate that the area will be crowded unless there are a lot less animals entered than anticipated.

The central area of the building has a large area of skylights which will

REPORT ON THE SITE VISITATION TO THE 1986 AMERICAN RABBIT BREEDERS ASSOCIATION CONVENTION SITE, COLUMBUS, OHIO

A visitation was made on June 27, 1986 to Columbus, Ohio to visit the site of the 1986 ARBA National Convention and Show. The following report is provided to each Secretary and President of the national specialty clubs to be used to the best advantage possible to inform the members of their specialty club of some of the situations that exist for the 1986 convention. It is anticipated that the site visitation, and report, will be of benefit to all members of the ARBA.

LOCATION

The location of the convention will be at the Ohio State Fairgrounds in Columbus, the capital of Ohio. This is a densely populated, modern metropolitan area, that has hosted many successful animal agriculture conventions in the past. This is a very modern, up to date, state fairgrounds that is located in the eastern sector of Columbus, Ohio and can be reached via Interstate 71.

The Ohio State Fairgrounds is a very large fairgrounds with an abundance of parking. However, it should be noted to all exhibitors and visitors that there will be a \$1.50 charge for the vehicles everytime it enters the fairgrounds by paying "show pass" can be obtained the first time one enters the fairgrounds. There will be \$8.00. This will be valid during the entire convention. There will be ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule, and I assure you that individuals will not be able to make their own passes, as has been done in the past. This motel is located approximately eight (8) miles, or, fifteen (15) minutes to the north of the fairgrounds at exit 117 (Route 161/Dublin-Granville Road). However, there is an abundance of other motels at this exit and exit 116, or the next exit south of the headquarters exit. There have already been one hundred and thirty (130) reservations made at the Marriott Inn and many of the other motels in the area have already surpassed the amount of rooms set aside for the ARBA convention. From all indications, concerning the advanced registration, it appears that the 1986 ARBA Convention and Show is going to be a very large event.

Interstate 71 is a very busy thoroughfare with easy access and exit to the fairgrounds; but, one should allow ample time to go from one place to the other on these very busy thoroughfares.

Columbus International Airport

For the size of the city, the Columbus International Airport is not as large as one would anticipate. It is serviced by the following airlines: Republic, American, United, Conair, Delta, Transworld Airlines, US Air, Eastern, People's Express, Piedmont and Florida Express. Even though the number of flights per day per airline is limited, it is anticipated that one will be able to make the proper connections. However, the convenience of the connections may not be as good as one would anticipate.

It is very important to note that the air freight office at the Columbus International Airport CLOSSES AT 5:00 P.M. ON FRIDAY and DOES NOT OPEN UNTIL early on MONDAY MORNING. ALL animals that are shipped in air freight MUST BE shipped in prior to 5:00 p.m. on Friday. Those animals that arrive with

aid in the lighting of the entire hall. The remainder of the hall has an adequate supply of mercury vapor lights for lighting.

The building is ventilated with forty-six powered ventilators throughout the building. The ventilators will be controlled by the building manager; but, the show management has access to this individual twenty-four hours a day from Wednesday prior to the convention until Thursday when the convention is concluded.

Unless there is unreasonably high temperatures with an excess amount of humidity, it is not anticipated that ventilation will be a problem. However, arrangements have been made for supplementing the ventilation if necessary.

CAGING

Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. are going to use all the available American Rabbit Breeders Association cooping, as well as they have arrangements made for approximately 12,000 rabbit and cavy coops. If the entries exceed this number, it is anticipated that the total entry must be limited. Therefore, it is important that everyone get their entries in as early as possible. Whenever one anticipates an entry of this size, there are certainly problems that are going to arise with the cooping of the animals. It is anticipated that there will be a proper ratio of large cages for the need. Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. will provide an excess amount of cardboard for those exhibitors that wish to partition their cages. It is totally necessary that the caging will have to be stacked from two to four high in the majority of the building to accommodate the size of entry expected.

Each of the rabbit cages will be bedded with an ample supply of golden wheat or oat straw. There will be an additional amount of straw available for those that wish to bed further as the show progresses. The building management will allow shavings to be used for the cavies ONLY.

Each cage will be provided with two one-cup aluminum cans. These cans will be fastened in the cages by the metal clamps. It is anticipated that if the above feeding and watering arrangements do not meet with the exhibitor's approval, they should bring their own feed and water containers. Also, if the method of attachment of the feed and water cups to the cage is not satisfactory, the exhibitor should make arrangements to fasten the cups in the cages however they deem satisfactory. There are ample sources of water throughout the building and Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. will provide ten dozen watering cans to distribute the water to the individual pens.

For those that desire, feed will be provided to the exhibitors throughout the convention stay. The open rabbit show will be fed by Carnation Feed Company and the Country Mart Feed Company. The Ralston Purina Company will provide cavy show for open and youth cavies; and, Heindol Feed Company will provide feed for the youth rabbits. For those that desire, there will be signs available for the exhibitor to place on the cage if you wish to water and feed your own animals.

The major aisles in the building will be twelve feet wide, with the side aisles between the coops being six feet wide for the large breeds and five feet wide for the smaller breeds.

The fairgrounds management will clean the aisles of the building at the conclusion of each day. However, with the extensive amount of traffic, there will be an ample supply of brooms available to the specialty clubs to keep the areas clean as possible.

JUDGING FACILITIES

There will be four rows of judging facilities the entire length of the building. The judging facilities will be back to back, allowing for two rows of judging facilities, one on each side of two separate rows. This will be a very crowded area; but, it is one that the exhibitors will have to cooperate with so that there will be able to be the total entry that is anticipated.

Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. is anticipating starting judging early on Monday morning after the opening ceremony.

At the center of the building, under the skylight will be the Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. booth, the ARBA booth and the Research and Development booth. The Research and Development raffle rabbits, that are donated by individuals and the specialty clubs, will be in an adjacent area to these booths. Along with these coops, will be the area to cage all the Best of Breed winners. This will also be the area for the selection of Best in Show. A special judging arrangement will be set up with bleachers and so forth to select Best in Show late on Tuesday afternoon. Also in the skylight area will be a very large lounge area.

Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. will allow for carriers to be stored in a safe area within the building.

ACCEPTING EXHIBITS

Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. will start accepting entries at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 31, 1986. ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED PRIOR TO THIS TIME! One will be able to enter from five different locations in the building and then the individuals breeds will be checked in at marked locations within the exhibit hall. The locations will be marked with row numbers and coop numbers for the various breeds. Coop numbers will be placed in the animal's right ear at the time of check-in. The check-out of animals will be initiated at 12:00 on Thursday, November 6, 1986 and must be completed by 6:00 p.m. The animals will be checked out in a similar manner in which they were checked in by the individual breed secretaries. It is mandatory that all the animals be removed from the exhibition hall by 6:00 p.m. on Thursday. For those individuals not wishing to leave until Friday, there will be a space secured for the animals in the Rhodes Center. The animals must be placed in the carriers by the exhibitors and fed and watered by the exhibitors; but Buckeye Shows, Inc. will provide security in that building.

Security in the exhibition hall is going to be a problem. It is MANDATORY that the fire exits be LEFT OPEN AT ALL TIMES for obvious reasons. This allows six various sets of doors that must be open. Buckeye Shows, Inc. is going to provide uniformed security, as well as, plain clothes security. Security is a problem anywhere one goes and with any item that one has. It is going to be up to the individuals exhibitors to assist Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc to maintain proper security.

BOOTHS

There have been approximately one hundred and twenty-nine (129) commercial and specialty club booths rented that will line the perimeter of the building. These booths will be supplied with scarlet and gray backdrops and dividers. Each booth will have one table and two chairs. If there needs to be any type of special arrangements for the booth, they should be made prior to the convention.

In the very near future, the decorators, as well as Buckeye Shows, Inc., will forward each booth renter a list of guidelines that must be followed. It is mandatory, through the building management, that ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD ITEMS OR DRINK be sold or given away from the booths. This will be STRICTLY enforced. Also, all materials use to decorate the booth must be of fire resistant materials. It is anticipated that the number of commercial and specialty club booths will add a great deal to the atmosphere of the entire convention.

BEST ROOM AND LOUNGE FACILITIES

There are two sets of rest rooms located at each end of the exhibition hall. There will be two lounge areas provided by Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. One of the lounge areas will be next to the ARBA booth in the center of the exhibition hall. The other will be at one end of the building at the concession stand. Brinkman's concessions will provide food in the showrooms. The show committee has assured that the prices will be moderate and there will be a variety of sandwiches, drinks and snacks available. A complete set-down restaurant is available on the fairgrounds at the southeast corner of the exhibition hall. At this facility, complete meals and beer will be offered. There are not many other eating facilities close to the Ohio State fairgrounds. One will have to travel two to three exits, either north or south, in order to obtain any fast food type restaurants. It is anticipated that there will be adequate lounging areas in the showroom.

SHOW CATALOG

The show catalog will be available by August 15, 1986. It is suggested that each exhibitor purchase a show catalog and be familiar with the various types of events available. It is an excellent catalog that has been very well prepared. Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. will provide a show results catalog to each exhibitor when checking out on Thursday afternoon.

YOUTH SHOW

The youth rabbits and cavers will be cooped in the northwest end of the exhibition hall and will have identical judging facilities as the open show. The youth lounge area will be carpeted and will be adjacent to the youth area. Ample rest rooms will be provided adjacent to the youth lounge.

The majority of the youth contests will take place in the Rhodes Center, which is a short ten minute walk from the exhibition hall. However, if one is going to drive from the exhibition hall to the Rhodes Center, it is mandatory that you pay an additional parking fee at the Rhodes Center and pay to get back into the fairgrounds, if one does not purchase an \$8.00 pass.

CAVY SHOW

The cavy show will be caged in the ARBA cages and other similar caging facilities. A special area has been set aside for the entire cavy exhibit and they will be bedded with white pine shavings. Purina Cavy Chow will be available to the breeders, as well as there will be an ample supply of "greens" available.

HOUSING

The headquarters motel for the 1986 ARBA National Convention is the Marriott Inn - North. This is a very luxurious motel and will certainly meet the needs of our convention headquarters. The headquarters hotel will provide check cashing service to the entire American Rabbit Breeders Association with the presentation of the ARBA membership card and a major credit card. Other motel housing is available in close proximity to the headquarters motel. Camping facilities will be available on the fairgrounds.

There are many excellent restaurants of all descriptions in close proximity to the motels. There are many shopping centers, beauty shops, print shops, and other stores at the headquarters motel intersection. One should be able to find any type of cuisine that they desire.

SPECIALTY CLUB MEETINGS

Specialty club meetings, as well as the ARBA open meetings, will be held in the Rhodes Center. This is approximately a ten minute walk from the exhibition hall. Again, if one should drive to the Rhodes Center from the exhibition hall, it will be necessary to pay the \$1.50 parking fee unless one has a parking pass.

The meeting rooms are spacious and have been scheduled for all the specialty club meetings. A great amount of time has been put forth in scheduling specialty club meetings so they do not conflict with one another.

ARBA BANQUET

The ARBA banquet will be held at Villa Milano. This is approximately one and a half miles from the headquarters motel. PROPER DRESS IS REQUIRED. This is a very elegant banquet facility that serves outstanding food. During the site visitation, they served a sample of what they will be serving at the ARBA banquet. The food was not only delicious; but, the portions were very large. The banquet facilities will hold a maximum of nine hundred and sixty (960) people.

A non-competitive style show will be hosted prior to the banquet during the social hour and music will be provided for a dance at the conclusion of the banquet.

The ARBA Youth Banquet will be at the Marriott Inn. They have facilities for approximately six hundred (600) youth at the banquet. This will include awarding of the special trophies and there will be a dance that follows.

CONVENTION ACTIVITIES


On Sunday night, November 2, 1986, Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. is having a get acquainted party and mixer from 7:00 to 11:00 at the auditorium at the Rhodes Center - West. There will be a cash refreshment bar available for this activity and admission is free.

At the same time, in the East wing of the Rhodes Center, from 7:30 to 10:30 there will be a Monte Carlo Casino night and admission will be \$5.00 for \$50,000.00 worth of play money. There will be many prizes and games available. There have been many exciting hours lined up for those that wish to attend.

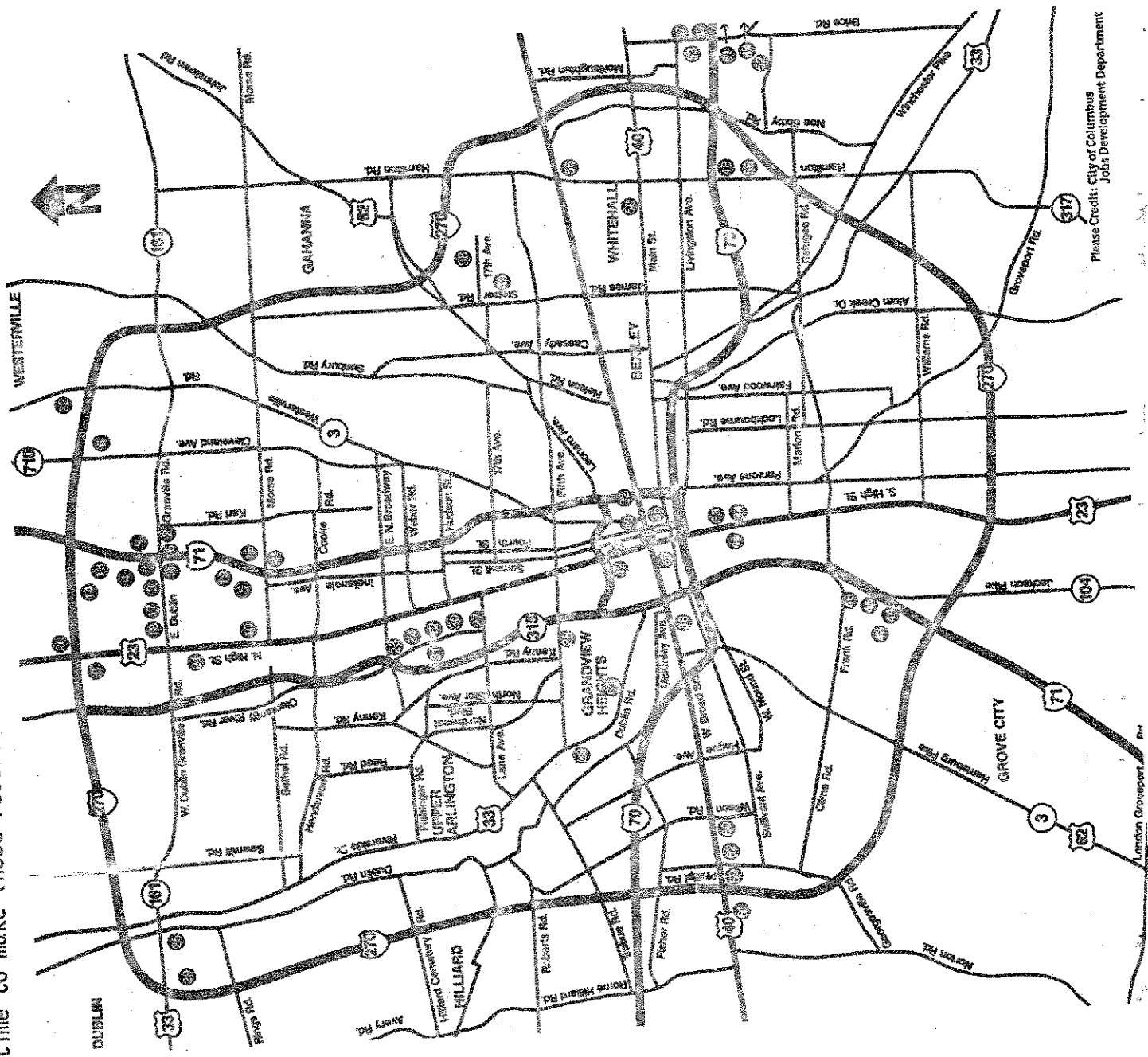

It allowed ample discussion between the host of the convention and the President and local District Director of the ARBA; and, allowed for an explanation of some of the areas of concern from experience of past site visitations. I am very happy to report to you, the specialty club members, that this has been a very well planned ARBA Convention. There are over one hundred individuals involved in working to make this the best convention ever. There has been much time, effort, and thought put into the showroom, the housing, the banquets, the meetings, and many of the other activities for the benefit of the animals and the exhibitors. With the anticipated size of the entry, it is anticipated that there are going to be some problems and some inconveniences to some members and some specialty clubs. One area of concern is the ventilation of the exhibition center. The ventilation will be adequate unless we get extremely warm weather with high humidity. However, arrangements have been made to keep this problem to a minimum. With a large entry, there is bound to be a limit on the amount of space. I feel confident that it will be somewhat crowded in the judging area; but, this is the price one must pay for the size of convention we are anticipating. All possible ways to conserve space is being implemented.

There will be a very large participation in the youth activities. This, again, will present some problems; but all possible measures are being taken to resolve these problems. I am very impressed with the preparation of the convention at this time. In addition to the convention committee, there are over one hundred additional ARBA members that are assisting the committee in preparation for the convention. This is very important. I assure you that this office, as well as Buckeye Rabbit Shows, Inc. will continue to work together to resolve any problems that may arise between now and the convention. I certainly hope if there are any specialty clubs that have any special needs or concerns that they advise us immediately. Thanks again for all your support and hope this report will be of some assistance to you and the members of your specialty club.

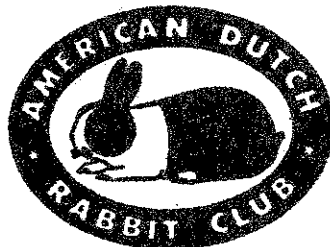

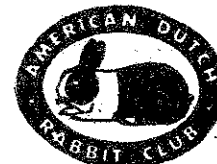

Jeffrey attended his first National Dutch Show this past May in Des Moines. Jeff listed as one of his goals, attending the National Dutch Show and purchasing better stock in blues, chocolates and steels. I'm not sure if Jeff got those blues, chocolates and steels but I see that he did purchase a dandy Tort. Jr. Buck from another youth member, Eric Meyer.

Jeff is a very active young man. He is the Historian for the Fur & Feathers 4-H, is a member of the Suncoast Youth Rabbit & Cavy Raisers and the Sarasota Boys Club. He is also an acolyte for the Miakka United Methodist Church.

Jeff told us in his ADRC Achievement Test that he raises all six varieties of Dutch plus Satins, English Angoras, French Lops, Mini Lops and Netherland Dwarfs. He especially likes the Dutch because they are a nice size rabbit for children. His main problem with his Dutch has been the cheek markings and getting the saddle straight, problems we all seem to have. He also had difficulty getting does to kindle more than two or three to a litter. He solved this problem by culling those does out of the herd.

We asked Jeff how his rabbitry was operated. He told us that his mom and sister also have rabbits so they take turns watering and feeding. He spends a lot of time brushing his rabbits and teaching them to pose.

MEET



TODD URAN

Todd recently graduated from Bryan High School and Four County Vocational School. At the present time, Todd works for a Florist while he decides what direction he would like his education to take. He has more than enough experiences in many varied directions. This past year Todd was involved in 4-H, acting as both President and Secretary-Treasurer of his club, was the Rabbit Chairman for the Jr. Fair Board, was a member of the FFA, is a member of the Ohio Dutch Rabbit Breeders, Hoosier Dutch, A.R.B.A. and the Williams County Rabbit Club. He is a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church. This will be Todd last year as a youth member of the ADRC. Over the years, he has compiled an outstanding list of wins with his Dutch, attending over 20 shows this past year. Todd was selected the 1st place Sr. Division winner for the American Dutch Achievement Contest in 1986.

Todd's parents are always at the shows with him, giving moral support but the job of breeding, cleaning, culling and selecting those rabbits for the show are strickly Todd's. Todd raises all six colors of Dutch but enjoys experimenting with the various color combinations and shadings. His favorite variety is Tortoise. Todd learned about the Dutch rabbit from older breeders in his area and then spent time reading more about the Dutch. Problems, Oh yes, like any Dutch breeder, Todd has had trouble with wolf teeth, off-colored eyes or spots in the eyes, cow hocks and odd colors. "More recently, I have had trouble getting does to breed and raise their kits." To correct his problems with teeth, eyes and cow hocks, he culled very strickly and purchased some new stock from reliable breeders. Todd's rabbitry is just that - Todd's. He says that dad helps in the building of cages and mom lends a hand when I can't be there.

We asked the youth the Pro's & Con's of raising Dutch. Todd explained that some of the Pro's are also the con's. "The markings and color can be fun and also become very discouraging at times." Haven't we all felt that same way at some time? He especially likes the Dutch because of it's size and good nature. Todd would like to become a judge and at this time is working with a few other breeds to increase his knowledge of all breeds. He has Dwarf Hotots and Holland Lops.

When asked about how the Dutch Club could be improved, Todd answered that he feels that we need to promote the Dutch by making the public aware that a great club is in existence, the American Dutch Rabbit Club. He feels more people need to know that our club and its members are there to help both new and old breeders with their problems. He also feels we need to enlarge our youth program.

Todd will be showing his Dutch with adults shortly and I'm sure he will be giving them a run for the roses.

GOOD DUTCH TYPE CONSISTS OF A NICELY ROUNDED BACK, BEGINNING ALMOST IMMEDIATELY BEHIND THE HEAD AND PROGRESSING OVER THE SHOULDERS, LOIN AND RUMP TO TAIL.
