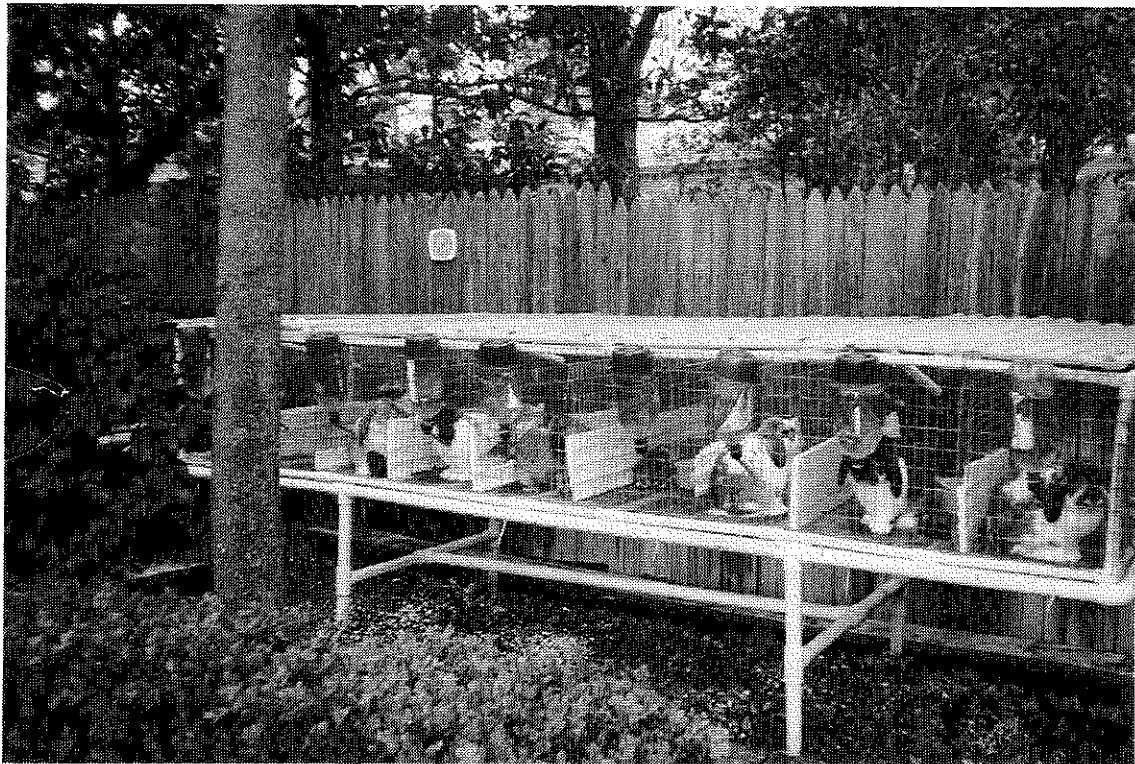

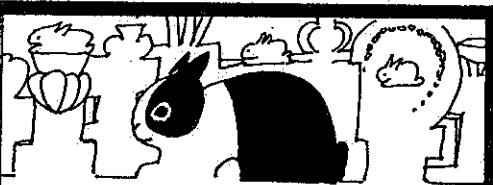

Should you have desires concerning the Standard, please be sure to contact one of the ADRC Standard Committee members and let them know.

The National Dutch Show for 1994 will be held in Reading, PA. There are articles in this issue pertaining to this show. Please make your arrangements early if you are going. I have heard this facility is just outstanding, with everything in the same complex.

Knowing the Dutch breeders from that area of the country, it will be an excellent show. I hope everyone is able to attend.

ED: Thanks, Alan. It is always good to hear of judges we are not real familiar with as being good Dutch judges. I have known Dave for many years, and have had the privilege of working with him at a number of shows. I believe he does a very good job on all breeds, and would have no problem endorsing him to anyone.

I especially like the part about considering "new" blood for our shows. Some of us have been bled dry by you exhibitors !! (Only kidding). Welcome Aboard, Dave.

STANDARD CLARIFICATION

To: Members of the American Dutch Rabbit Club

From: Kevin Hooper, Standards Committee Chairman

The following clarifications are being presented for you to review and vote on. These are not changing the breed standard nor are they creating additional disqualifications. All disqualifications mentioned are currently in effect and these proposals are written to clarify only. The five members of the standards committee have reviewed all of these and a minimum of four of the five have voted in favor of each issue. Please review the proposals as printed, vote on the ballot following all proposals, and send to: Kevin Hooper - 585 Cherrybend Rd. - Wilmington, OH 45177

Item #1. To clarify the "freckle" situation. To add the following:

Disqualification for:

"Any foreign colored area, other than called for in the breed standard, that is plainly visible while the animal is in its natural pose, or can be detected during the normal sequence of examination. (Foreign being a color other than is called for in that particular area.)

Item #2. To be added under the section of feet and legs:

"Hind toes may be separated to identify a split stop."

Item #3. Body description. Change the terminology to:

"side lines to taper from hips to shoulders."

Item #4. Regarding the order of the current standard:

A. All varieties, move the section "free from spots in the iris, or any other eye discoloration. Both eyes to match." under the description of eyes.

B. Move the pictures showing how to determine a tied front leg to the end of the Dutch standard.

Item #5. Regarding the touching of the joint of the stops: Page 116 and 118 refer to two different descriptions of stop disqualifications. Shall the following words (in boldface) be added?

"When the white portion of the footstop reaches above the hock joint." (Both pages, 116 & 118 would be changed to read as this.)

STEEL COLOR DESCRIPTION: Goal - to give the novice breeder and judges a mental picture of steels.

If all of the proposals on the steel listed below are approved, it will read as follows:

Steel: Entire colored portion of the body black, with uniform disbursement of off-white or cream coloration of some of the hair tips. Undercolor to be slate blue carried as deep towards the skin as possible. Under portion of the tail, belly, and inside of hind legs to be as near the body color as possible. Crotch marks accepted.

Faults: Lack of uniform steel coloration over the back. Brassy or yellow appearance. White hairs in the colored section.

Item #6. Eliminate the current statement "A dark uniform steel-gray"

Item #7. Current statement - "This color is brought out by of the rabbit" - would be replaced with:

"Entire colored portion of the body black, with uniform disbursement of off-white or cream coloration of some of the hair tips."

Item #8. Current statement - "Slate-blue undercolor carried down to the skin" - would be replaced with:

"Undercolor to be slate-blue carried as deep towards the skin as possible"

Item #9. The only other change to be made would be the addition of "Crotch marks accepted"

Replace current faults with the following faults (for steels)

Item #10. "Lack of steel coloration over the back"

Item #11. "Brassy or yellow appearance"

Item #12. "White hairs in colored sections"

GRAY:

Item #13. We begin our description with the "Brown Gray" term. Should we change the variety name to "Brown Gray" instead of just "Gray"?

Item #14. The second sentence currently reads: "The color of the fur at the base of the hair shaft to be slate blue, followed by a medium tan colored band, next to a thin band of charcoal brown, finished by a lighter tan tipping to the undercoat" This sentence would be replaced with:

"The color of the fur at the base of the hair shaft to be slate blue, followed by a medium tan band, next to a thin band of charcoal brown, followed by a lighter tan band, finished with uniform disbursement of black tips to the undercoat."

Item #15. Currently the description states: "The entire body should be interspersed with an even distribution of black guard hairs" This would be replaced with:

"The entire body should be interspersed with a moderate amount of uniformly disbursed black guard hairs."

Item #16. Currently the description states: "The top side of the tail must complement the body color with the underside of the tail to be the same as the belly color." This would be replaced with:

"The top side of the tail must complement the body color with the underside of the tail being as close to the belly color as possible."

Item #17. Add the following to the faults on Gray color:

"Lack of uniform disbursement of black guard hairs."

Item #18. The current disqualifications on Gray are listed as: "Absence of ring color, absence of slate blue undercolor on belly." These would be replaced with the following:

"Absence of intermediate ring color over the colored portion of the body or the absence of slate blue undercolor on the belly."

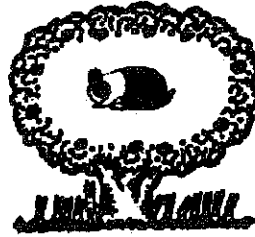

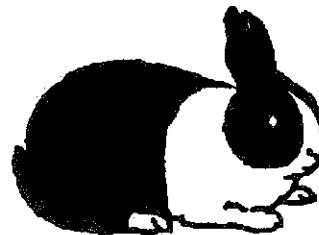

YEAR ROUND BREEDING PROGRAM

by Kevin Hooper

Most rabbit breeders who live in the cooler climates have a difficult decision to make when cold weather approaches. They can either quit breeding until warmer weather returns, hope the does will conceive and successfully raise their litters, or utilize artificial heat and light.

The serious breeder most often will want to breed through the cold weather. This will provide more animals to choose from and (hopefully) continued improvement.

The methods which I utilize to improve the success of cold weather breeding are:

I have a 24' x 24' barn, unheated, with a single level of hanging wire pens.

ARTIFICIAL LIGHT - I hook up two double florescent lights, four feet long. These are controlled by an electrical timer. (This is available at most hardware stores). I set the lights to turn on at 6:00 A.M. and they will be on until it becomes light outside. I then have them set to turn on again at 4:30 P.M. and the barn remains lit until 8:00 P.M. This provides 14 hours of light per day. Rabbits breed based on the amount of daylight. As the day length decreases in the fall, so does the conception rate. Utilizing the light through February will provide them with the optimum amount of light to enable a high rate of conception.

ARTIFICIAL HEAT - How many times have you had a doe fail to pull enough fur to keep her babies warm and thriving? A small investment could insure a living litter even if the does pull very little fur. I utilize heat lamps with infrared light bulbs. I place the lights above the cage so that the heat from one lamp hits the corners of four adjacent pens. This is where I locate my open top nest boxes. The lights are hung about 10' - 15' above the top

I also recommend keeping some fur from does that pull an ample amount to be added to those litters which are lacking in the amount of fur.

By following the above methods, it has enabled me to raise nearly every litter in cold weather. It has also helped with the survival rate from first litter does and does that do not have an ample supply of milk.

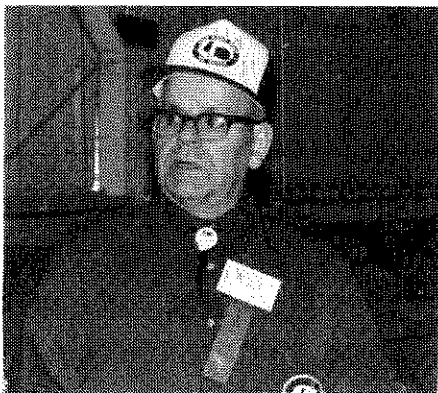
The Open Show report for the Midwest Dutch Classic that was held May 1, 1993 in Ft. Wayne, IN had an error printed in the last Dutch Reporter.

FLORIDA DUTCH

I have been in and out of rabbits for 40 years, due to several things. One of them being moving to Florida from Marshalltown, Iowa 24 years ago. Breeding and showing Californians exclusively for the past 13 years. However, 3 years ago I started looking for a second breed, the reason, first I wanted to be able to transfer Californian babies to another doe of a different breed if the litter was too large. I had tried different ways of marking transferred babies and was not satisfied with the results. Second reason, I just wanted another challenge, another breed. I haven't raised the perfect Californian yet, and doubt if I will come up with the perfect Dutch, but I, like many others, will try.

In selecting a second breed I looked at Chins, Satins, New Zealands, Champagnes, Florida Whites in the showroom and then fell in love with the Dutch. I purchased a blue Dutch doe from friend and ARBA judge and long time Dutch breeder Marvin Cummings and a black buck from a good friend Mr. Mays who has been showing Dutch for some time. This got me started as they produced a litter of six young. I liked the litter and FL2, a black buck, is a Grand Champion, as is his littermate sister FL5.

Is there a difference between Californians and Dutch other than size, markings, etc. Yes, the Dutch do not seem to get frightened or scared in the rabbitry as easily as Cals. The Dutch seem to think they are living in Alaska when it comes time to deliver their young. They keep pulling so much hair and in this hot weather I need to remove hair every morning from the nest box for about the first seven days. When they breed, the Dutch does raise their rear ends much higher than Californians.

We have a good outlet for youngsters that will not be kept for show or breeding stock. The Dutch go to the pet shops and we always have customers wanting meat rabbits plus what we put on our table.

Our rabbit shows in Florida are mostly held in the fall or winter months with entries running from 700 up. We have one summer show in an air conditioned building. Our last summer show in Orlando had over 2,000 entries. There are Dutch entries of 25 to 55 animals and we get some of the best judges from Florida and all over the U.S. One recent show had 5 of the top ARBA officers to do the judging.

The folks showing Dutch in Florida are a friendly, good natured group, helping each other in different ways. We look forward to meeting each other in the showroom. I firmly believe ARBA shows are not about rabbits and covies, but human beings too. Since becoming involved in rabbits think about all the good rabbits you have seen in the showroom. Think about all the great brothers and sisters you have met all because of this little animal with a white belt around it.

A NOVEL WAY OF BUILDING RABBIT CAGES

My daughter, Rhona, bought her first pedigree Mini Lop Rabbit less than three years ago near our home in Jacksonville, North Florida. Now we have just over forty rabbits comprising two breeds, Mini Lops and American Dutch, housed in cages in the open all year round. At first, with only a small number of rabbits there was no major problem in deciding on how to cage them. But as numbers grew, we decided upon a method of cage construction which appears to be rather novel in the rabbit world. It is this idea which we would like to share with readers of Domestic Rabbits.

We had already experimented with using PVC schedule 40 (thick wall) piping in the earlier construction of cages but we were now about to perfect the construction of multiple-cages formed with galvanized wire on PVC pipe frames, resulting in a strong weather-resistant and hygienic system of cage-building which has served us well for the past three years. These multiple-cages are durable, light in weight, clean-looking, easy to maintain and relatively cheap to construct by either the serious breeder or the pet owner who needs space for only a few animals. The form of construction is particularly appropriate where it is not feasible to have large rabbit barns.

The standard size of multiple-cage which we construct has space for eight rabbits and is made in the following way.

A basic rectangular frame measuring three feet wide by twelve feet long is laid out, using three-quarter inch PVC piping. Every 18", cross-pieces of PVC pipe are affixed along the twelve foot length using PVC T-joints, thus making a very strong floor to support the contents of the individual cage units. The usual 1" by $\frac{1}{8}$ " floor wire is then affixed to the frame using strong nylon ties. The four ends of the frame have PVC joints to take the 18" high and 3ft' wide ends of the cage. A top frame is then made of PVC piping with occasional cross-pieces added as with the floor of the cage. Later, the fiber glass roofing panels will rest on the top frame and cross pieces, as shown in the accompanying diagrams.

In effect, we now have a strong rectangular "box" frame which, once the side-wire is added, will be apportioned into eight individual rabbit cages, each effectively having a 3ft by 18" floor space, making an area of approximately four and one-half square feet per rabbit when construction is complete.

The normal 2" by 1" galvanized side wire is then wound around the outside of the frame and affixed to the floor wire with

with standard hog rings. Above every PVC cross piece in the floor we put in the wire dividers to create individual cages. The wire dividers are two layers of wire, one inch apart, to prevent the rabbits from biting one another. Seven such dividers throughout the length of the multi-cage thus provide us with eight cages.

All that remains to be done is to construct the roof. We use wavy fiber-glass roofing sheets which can be purchased in hardware stores in 12ft lengths or shorter lengths, depending on the actual size of multi-cage being constructed. A single roof of this size would be too awkward and heavy to lift, so we cut the 12ft length into several equal lengths and make sure that it overlaps the multi-cage at the front and back as well as at each end of the cage to allow rain to drip away from the interior of the cages. We then make a frame of PVC piping for each section of the roofing sheet and secure it to the sheet with self-tapping screws. Then each section of the roofing sheet is hinged at the back of the multi-cage using long nylon ties rather than metal hinges (which quickly rust and are expensive to purchase). So we end up with several individually opening roofs along the length of the cage, each of which is now fitted with a single swing-down arm of PVC pipe which locks on to the top of the frame when the roofs are lifted for feeding and cleaning tasks. (See accompanying diagrams).

The final task is to make the PVC stand to support the multi-cage. We use a stronger pipe since it has to bear the weight of the multi-cage, rabbits and equipment. We found that $1\frac{1}{4}$ " pipe is best for this purpose, providing us with adequate strength and yet the ability to cut the pipe with a good pair of PVC pipe shears. The stand is easily built as shown in the accompanying pictures. It is about 2ft high, exactly the same length and width of the multi-cage and supported on four PVC pipe legs with some necessary cross-bracing to provide for greater stability.

We mount the main cage on the support stand and tie it down securely with long nylon ties so that the multi-cage cannot slip off the support stand through lively movements of its occupants! The result is easy access to the rabbits since the roofs open at a very convenient height to service the animals' needs, although we do find that the construction of a simple "board-walk" in front of the cage gives added height and helps to avoid excessive stretching.

We use disposable styrofoam insulation panels, cut to size, to

slide between the partition wire to prevent bucks from spraying one another. These are quickly exchanged for clean ones when they become urine stained or when the animals scratch them excessively.

It's worth shopping around for the best prices for PVC piping and fittings since prices vary quite significantly. A cage constructed as described above will comfortably house eight medium or large-sized rabbits at a cost of somewhere around one hundred dollars, which we consider a reasonable investment given the attractive appearance, durability, ease of construction and light weight. There is nothing to rust apart from the double galvanized wire and we have found that the glued PVC joints remain firm provided that they have been properly glued with PVC cement.

We have also built successfully a double-sided cage using the same basic construction methods. It currently houses ten American Dutch rabbits and it has proved as durable and economic as with the first size of multi-cage. The dimensions are 10ft in length and four feet wide with five rabbits on each side in cages which are approximately 2ft by 2ft in size. Access on one side of the cage is by lifting the roofs (as on the first cage described above) and on the other side by the more traditional doors cut out of the side-wire. When the frame for this double-sided cage was being constructed, we said "This will never work!" - it looked so big and awkward - but as it steadily took shape, we could see that not only was it workable but also very pleasing in appearance and very economical in terms of construction costs.

The only problem we have noticed is that the white PVC piping does get discoloured with the rabbits' strong urine in their regular "bathroom" spots. Otherwise we find that a regular weekly pressure washer with an adapter for the garden hosepipe keeps the cages looking spruce and fresh. We have recently invested in a propane -burning torch which works from a 20lb. propane tank and does an excellent job in cleaning the wire of loose hair from time to time, although care is needed not to expose the PVC piping to excessive heat.

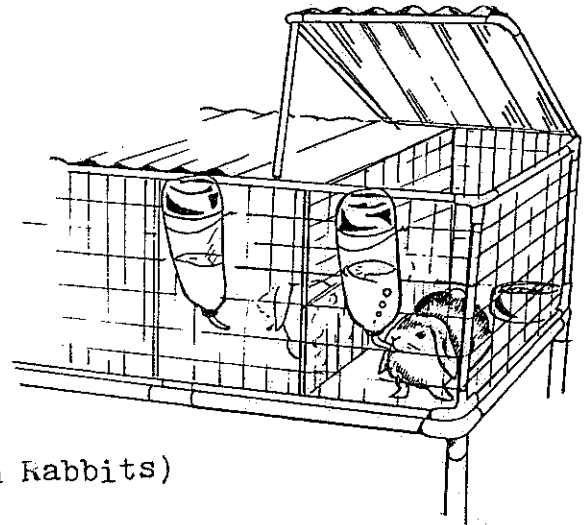
The smallest cage so far constructed is just for three rabbits (using 3/4" PVC piping and 1" piping for the support stand) and there have been a lot of interested pet rabbit customers requesting cages of similar size because it is so light and easily portable to different yard locations.

We have never seen or heard of this particular method of cage construction demonstrated elsewhere by rabbit breeders or manufacturers

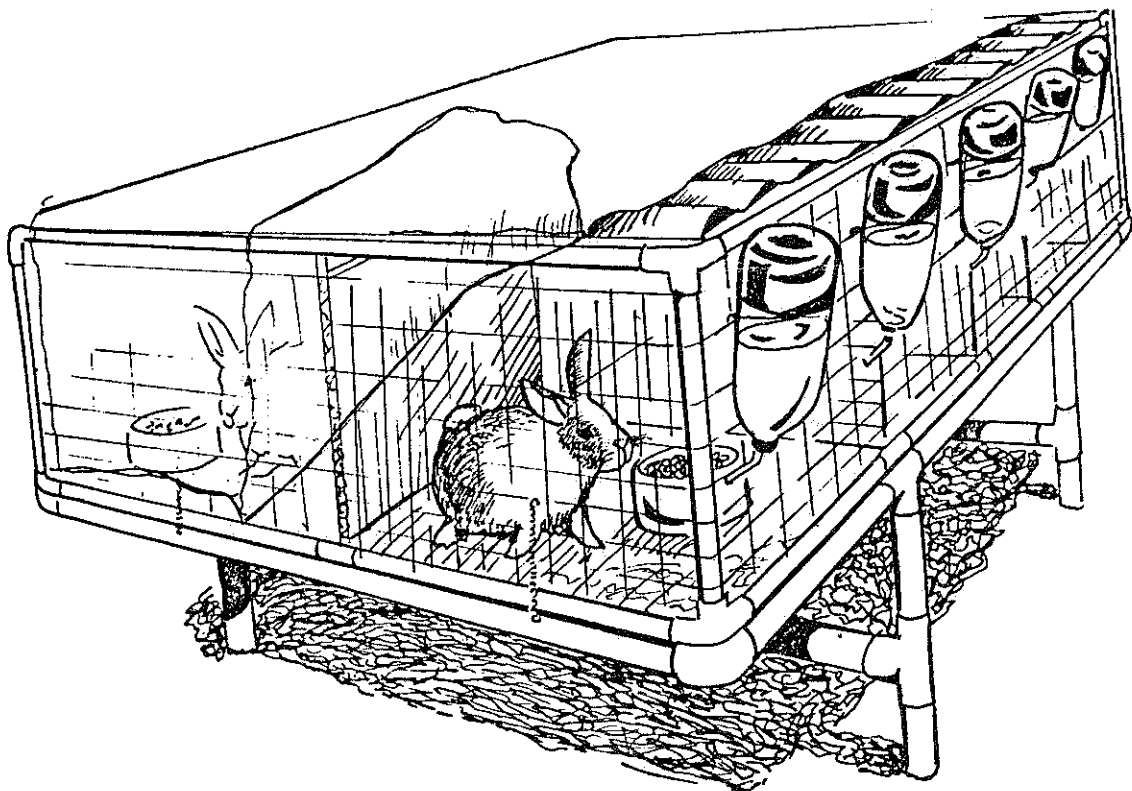
of rabbit equipment and supplies. It has many advantages for owners of pet rabbits and for the serious breeder who has restrictions on building a large covered rabbit barn or who simply prefers an "outside" rabbitry. As well as being strongly constructed, it is economical, visually attractive, easily portable to different locations (being much lighter than wooden constructions), hygienic, virtually maintenance free, and evidently appreciated by our furry friends!

We will be happy to answer questions or correspondence regarding this article and hope that this particular construction method may be of interest to all lovers of rabbits who are concerned about the provision of good housing and sanitation for their animals.

Kevin:

Will not comment on 1 and 3 since I have changed the wording on these since sending them to you. (see enclosed). Have changed the wording from dark charcoal gray to black because genetically, physiologically it is black pigment. What we see is the effect of the band against the black to give the charcoal black or charcoal gray appearance.

Problems I see in #2 are: 1st sentence - The entire body is not black it is the colored portions only. near the tip -- I assume you mean the band -- is a yellow pigment. There are no gray pigment cells in the Dutch rabbit. I also object to the term gray being used because of the confusion that could result when people think of the gray Dutch, ie the true wild type agouti dutch. After all our gray dutch is actually brownish in color. Do you want a Steel Dutch to be gray - as is the brown gray Dutch ??


4) Disqualification for an agouti ring pattern --- The term agouti in the technical sense means the wild type agouti (ie our gray) and you will never see in a steel the multiple ring pattern of the agouti because of the action of the Steel Extension gene (E^S). If you are trying to say that even seeing one ring is a disqualification you will have to disqualify ALL Steels. They do have one band and therefore one ring will clearly be seen if you blow into the fur. The slate blue inner color also forms what might be called a ring color when the fur is parted just as it does on a Gray Dutch.

Sorry but I see nothing in #2 that provides a description that a novice breeder could understand.

I won't even go into a gray standard description argument except to say that I agree that the rings should be identified or at least refer to the glossary description of an agouti. I do agree with you that the entire steel and gray controversy is the fault of grays not being correctly colored. My suggestion for the wording of the disqualification would be: Absence of full ring coloration on any part of the colored portion of the body would be a disqualification. Coloration that so closely approaches that of the steel so that the distinction from the steel is not easily distinguished should be disqualified.

With so much to worry about when breeding Dutch until someone can prove to me that freckles are 1) inherited and 2) worth worrying about I vote to worry about freckles at a later date. I would think that your suggested disqualification would be covered in the section that states that colored spots in white areas is already a disqualification.

The following is a description of the Steel Dutch. It is not meant to be a description as would be used for the new standard, but is a real and true picture wording of the Steel Dutch. I would hope that the Standard's Committee would keep this picture in their mind as they write the new Steel standard.

STEEL DUTCH

The Steel Dutch is a genetic agouti showing the outermost band of light color on the black tipped secondary guard hair. The secondary guard hair is black and shades gradually to blue gray (slate gray) at the base. The band near the tip of secondary guard hair ranges in color from off-white to cream. The long primary guard hairs are not banded and are black at the tip and shade gradually to blue gray at the base. The shorter soft fur fibers are not banded and are black shading to blue gray at the base. The overall effect of a good colored steel is flat black (non glossy) and is obtained when the background color is black highlighted by the off white band and an even mixture of black primary guard hairs. The overall color will gradually lighten down the sides to the belly. The belly color and the underside of the tail may be of a lighter shade than the rest of the body but should blend with the dark body color. Undercolor is slate blue (blue gray) carried down to the skin. The steel must show a definite undercut. Medium tan lap spots are permissible.

FAULTS

- 1) Banding not evident on the back or any other colored portion of the body.
- 2) Overall bassy, yellow, or brownish appearance .
- 3) Brown or light colored belly fur that does not blend with the dark body color.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

- 1) Steel animals that so closely approach the coloring of a gray dutch that the distinction from the gray is not immediately and obviously evident.
- 2) Steels in the following colors: Chocolate, Tortoise, Lilac, Fawn, Blue.

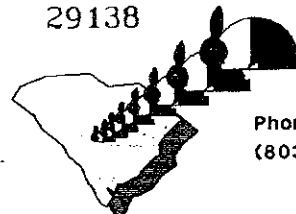
