



A lot od discussion at the last Board of Directors meeting was centered on the shaky financial condition of our club. The Board is under pressure to find answers to our dilemma. In my view we need to do a little soul

searching in the way we allot funds. We also need to develop new innovative ways to raise money and ear mark them for specific areas. Special areas of concern in my view:

- 1 National Dutch Show allotment currently \$500.00. This money is forwarded to clubs for the purpose of running the National Dutch Show. The idea is to help sponsoring clubs that **need** the help financially in running the show. There have been times when the sponsoring club has made a large enough profit to pay some, if not all, the money back. However, they are under no obligation to do so. Maybe it's about time we ask them to.
- 2 Currently the Publicity Department has a large assessed inventory, \$4,000.00. This is a lot of money for our club to have tied up on slow moving items. It is time for our Board to assess these items for liquidation and returning these funds to our General treasury.
- 3 Our Auctions at our National Conventions have fallen on hard times. This used to be one of the most entertaining and financially rewarding areas for our club. We need to get interest going again in this area for the good of the club and its members.
- 4 Sweepstakes Ribbons Let's face it, there are a lot of Dutch showmen that don't care if they receive their sweepstakes ribbons. **Please**, if you are one of them say so when renewing your membership. Our club spends a large portion of our income on these ribbons and the cost of mailing them.
- 5 Youth, The Future of Our Club We must do all we can to encourage our Youth members. The sweepstakes ribbons are one way we can do this. I WOULD NOT RECOMMEND ELIMINATING SWEEPSTAKES RIBBONS IF THE YOUTH MEMBERS WANT THEM.

The fall show season has just begun in Ohio and we have had good numbers of Dutch. We have a couple of new breeders who have been showing in the area. It's nice to see some new people working with the Dutch, but it is up to the experienced Dutch breeders to help them to improve their Dutch and increase their interest levels. A breeder will become discouraged if he is consistently finishing at the bottom of the class and will soon be out of the Dutch business. It's no fun to go to a show and win everything... if you are only competing against yourself and a few other Dutch.

The Ohio Dutch Rabbit Club will be meeting at the site of the 1996 National Dutch Show for our second planning meeting. Much thought is being put forth to make this one of the best National shows ever.

ALERT: The deadline for donating specials or taking out an ad for the 1995 National Dutch Show is approaching. These clubs can only put on great shows with our help. Volunteering a little time to help at the show or donating a few dollars is greatly appreciated.

I am currecntly doing something that hasn't been tried in the Dutch breed for a long time. I will be having the first showing of the Blue Steel Dutch at the ARBA Convention this fall in Tulsa, Oklahoma. I am sure some of you might feel that we don't need more colors of Dutch or that we might end up with as many colors as the Netherlands. That is not my intention.

A little about the Blue Steel. It is not a recently created color. It is a color that was once grouped in the Dutch AOV (any other variety). The AOV group was done away with long ago but the genetics to produce these other colors remain. The four animals I will be bringing would make very nice Dutch no matter what color they are. The Blue Steel is just as it sounds. A Blue with the Steel gene which gives an off-white coloration near the tip of the hair shaft. Their belly color is slightly lighter than the color over the body. Several Dutch breeders saw my Blue Steel Sr. Doe when I showed her in the Steel Doe class at the Ohio Dutch Show in June of '93. Those who saw her liked the color. There are some breeders using this color in their breeding programs. I am currently producing Blue Steels, Blues, and many Steels using the Blue Steels, I believe the addition of the Blue Steel will increase the interest and quality of our Steel Dutch as well. I hope you have a chance to see these animals in Tulsa. If you have any questions that I can answer regarding the Blue Steel or any other issue in the Dutch Club, don't hesitate to call or write.

I believe everyone will find all the information necessary to submit a bid to print the Dutch Reporter shouldthey be so inclined. After looking over the number of pages and the number of copies produced plus the mailing involved, I find this to be a very competitive price. However, if anyone can find a better deal, please feel free to submit it.

I feel there are people more qualified than me to comment on the passing of our fellow dutch breeder Dr. Terry Reed. I will however make one observation on his behalf. Dr. Reed received a letter from a breeder in district II. At the time he knew two of us were running to fill the vacant position in district II. In his thoughtfulness he sent both of us a copy copy of the original letter, so that we would not be left in the dark, and he sent along a copy of his reply to the breeder. This is only one example of the many types of services he would do in order to be of assistance to everyone. Many times a lot of work is performed in the invisible area behind the scenes of our rabbit world. Dr. Reed deserves credit for his outstanding efforts on our behalf and this is how I will remember him.

President Fred Mullinax commented in the last issue about preventing bucks from biting each other at national dutch shows. With that in mind, I would like to say that I was show secretary for the national holland lop show in Moline, II. this past spring and assisted in putting on the show. (No, I don't have any hollands.) The same issue came to light when the cooping was brought up. Solution: As I work at a corrugation plant (most of you would call it a box factory) I obtained some odd size sheets which were almost the precise size needed to push between the cages to prevent bucks from snipping at one another. Either the exhibitor should carry some corrugated board and a box cutter with him, or else the show sponsors could conceivably contact a local plant and explain the situation. With any luck by asking for these small TIE SHEETS you might even have them given to you. Most of this type of material at box plants are headed for the baler unit to be sent to a recycler.




The nice part of this is that the sheets will be the same size, which will help the appearance of your show room and the exhibitor does not really think about bringing his or her own. I also got the end rolls off the corrugator unit which meant we had large amounts of heavy brown paper to cover the tables with before setting up the cooping. As they can not use these either, your local company may also hand these over too. They start out as 5 ton rolls of paper and the last 2 or 3 inches of stock never gets used. Something to remember when confronted with a specialty coop show. Please note: such rolls are 5 to 6 feet long so you better have a van or truck to haul them home.

I recently talked to a breeder that was told by a local show secretary that they "might as well leave their chocolate dutch home since there usually isn't any shown and there would not be any competition for them." I also choked on this one. It was further annoying to hear the club did not want to sanction dutch because there was only fifteen shown the year before. I have been at this more than a decade and the rule of thumb has always been ten or more shown as being worthy of having a sanction the following year. As a show secretary I will take every entry I can get to help my own show. By the way: a breed does not have to be sanctioned in order for you to exhibit it. You are still entitled to your grand champion legs. Naturally having our sanction would help promote your breed, but I do not know what pressure we can exert on some of these clubs. We can only hope time and perseverance will cure this problem.

In the last issue I mentioned being on America on Line. Well, if you happen to have access to the internet governmental bodies and universities) you can catch me there to. GRAY DUTCH

I have been looking at a lot of the gray Dutch lately that are hitting the show tables here in California. While many of these animals are showing good type and even fairly good surface color, I am really dismayed at the large numbers being shown with little or no ring color in the middle of the back, especially up by the saddle area. My husband and I haven't kept a gray for almost a year as we have been culling heavily for ring color. While I do finally have a doe whose ring color is good, I am very frustrated as to why parents with good ring color don't seem to be throwing offspring with good ring color. It may be that our strong ring color line is getting too closely bred. Guess I'll be on the lookout for a top quality gray buck with good ring color at Convention!



A TRULY THRILLING EXPERIENCE...Jill Dobson

For some time I have wanted to write a story about my thrilling experience at the 1993 ARBA Convention. The part I have found the hardest was how to start. So I decided to start at the beginning - in 1975 when I decided to raise rabbits. My brother Scott already had Siamese Satins but I chose Dutch out of the Standard of Perfection.

There were no breeders in my area, so my family went on an outing, loading up the station wagon with my three younger brothers and me. It was a three hour drive to Cresent City, California to see Mrs. Betty Beckendorf, an ARBA Rabbit & Cavy judge very active in 4-H and FFA. I purchased a Black doe and litter of 3 week old kits, including one Tort, for ten dollars. My leader in rabbits was Mrs. Phyllis Caldwell, she ran our club like summer school and was an inspiration to me. My family was very active in 4-H over the years and my parents have been Swine project leaders. I showed in 4-H and Open shows until I graduated from High School in 1980. I was always one of those kids who set goals and was determined to reach them and had a lot of fun trying. I sold my rabbitry-including cages, and my other 4-H project animals and went to college in Portland.

Growing up with lots of animals to care for is how I first became interested in Veterinary medicine. In 1983 I graduated and became a licensed Animal Health Technician and moved to Winston, Oregon where I fulfilled a lifelong dream of working at Wildlife Safari, a privately owned wild animal park. Once settled in my new career I was able to get back into my favorite hobby, raising Dutch. I joined the Douglas County Rabbit Breeders and Northwest Dutch Club. During this time I had the opportunity to reacquaint myself with breeders in Oregon and meet new friends in Northern California, like the Mead's- George, Rose and Katie, Jim and Fran Schettler, and Jill Giron.

In 1987, I was ready for a change and moved to San Diego County, California where I met Peggy and Jannah Felt, Joanne Purpus, Dr. Paula Johnson and Allen Barr. Together with help from Gene, my husband of 5 years, we started the Sun Valley Dutch Fanciers (S.V.D.F.) in January 1988 and have since grown to over 50 members. I have enjoyed being President of S.V.D.F. for five years and serving two terms as a director of the California Dutch Club. I believe it is important to get involved because clubs don't run themselves; it takes people who are dedicated and committed, which is also the key ingredients in raising Dutch. Right now I am taking a break from club leadership to devote more time to my recently acquired position at the San Diego County Department of Animal Control's Florence Riford Medical Center. My profession has allowed me to better care for my rabbits. Dr. Reed's articles in the Domestic Rabbit have been valuable information that I have collected over the years in a notebook of rabbit medicine.

My rabbitry currently houses only Dutch for showing - Black, Blue & Tortoise . I have 30 pens for breeders and 20 for juniors. The number I show varies from 6 to 20. Part of the fun raising and showing Dutch Rabbits has been all the nice people I have met and become friends with over the years. My best friend in Dutch has been Joanne Purpus. We have traveled together, traded breeding stock, been partners on a few animals and have worked together to build S.V.D.F. into a successful Dutch Specialty Club. At one time Rick Lehmann happened to live near me for a few years and we enjoyed trading bloodlines and competing at the shows. When Rick moved to Seattle in 1991 he left his herd in my care until he was settled and I took advantage of his great herd bucks (sound familiar?), including animals from Mark Pecaric, Scott Williamson, and Andy Barton. There have been several other breeders who have influenced my herd. Marti Dill, past President of ADRC, had a significant influence on my herd. In 1989 I purchased a trio of grays from her. While I no longer raise grays those animals are the foundation to some of the blacks I have now.

Mr. Leonard Weir, who passed away in '92, traded with me in blacks & torts and has the distinction of winning BOB, BOS and Best In Show at the 1969 ARBA Convention with a pair of Blue Dutch. (At this 1993 ARBA Convention I had a similar experience, read on for the details). I wish Leonard could have been here this year to see my success, but I feel he is in good company with other Dutch breeders having a great time telling stories.

My thrilling experience at the 1993 ARBA Convention held at the Puyallup, Washington fairgrounds started with a 22-hour drive from Southern California. In the crisp early morning of the first day, the Miskell family (Denise, Amber, and Brian) and I hiked from the youth barns across the fairgrounds to the open barns to get checked in. The fairgrounds glittered from the frost and fresh paint. This was quite a contrast from the 80 degree weather we had left the day before.


I helped George and Maxine Parmer, old friends from the Northwest Dutch Club, with the youth show. Dr. Reed judged 129 high quality Dutch. I was very happy to see youth members from California do well, especially Jeremy Hunzie, Amber Miskell, Jennifer and Tiffany Whalen, all who have purchased animals from me. It feels great to help young breeders do well! The first day of convention was such a success.

The big day for me was the open show, I entered 10 of the 246 animals judged by Dr. Reed and Scott Williamson. It's always fun before the show to talk to all the breeders from across the country and all the rabbit sales and swapping that goes on. Ken Emerson and I traded my pair of blacks for his beautiful pair of Torts. I had been wanting Torts from him since we first met at the 1991 ARBA Convention so this was a golden opportunity.

I was ecstatic when four of my animals placed first in their classes, while two others placed fourth and one seventh. Things started to get really exciting when both judges went over all the first place animals and began announcing the Best Senior and Junior and Best & Best Opposite of Variety - three of my rabbits had won!. Then before I could catch my breath the judges announced my little blacks were Best of Breed and Best Opposite! I nearly fainted!!

Later in the day, the Best In Show was chosen. The room was packed and I barely managed to get my little black junior buck cooped. Then came the long wait as the judges went over all the best of breed animals. Luckily some nice Dutch breeders, Rose Mead, Fran Schettler, and Ken Emerson waited with me. I had not completely recovered from the shock of winning BOB & BOS. Personally I didn't think a Dutch had much of chance - I am happy to say I was wrong! Jill's Lil' Buddy won Best 4 class and brought home the biggest trophy (three feet tall) that one of my rabbits has ever won! The Best 6 class went to a Black Satin doe that was also chosen Best In Show but I didn't mind a bit.

Now that I have regained my composure and some humility, I have lots of people to thank for helping me win this great honor. Special thanks and recognition to my parents Calvin and Phyllis Pfaff, Mrs. Betty Beckendorf, Mrs. Phyllis Caldwell, Marti Dill, Rick Lehmann, Mr. Leonard Weir, and Joanne Purpus. And a thank you to all the people from Washington State Rabbit and Cavy Shows Inc. who worked hard to host this convention. Also George & Maxine Parmer who secretaried the Dutch and gave beautiful trophies which I am enjoying and have proudly shown off to fellow employees and other rabbit fanciers. I wish everyone could have a similar chance to feel like all their hard work has paid off. People have asked me what my secret is but there really isn't a secret - for me it has been a test of patience and perseverance. My best advice is "Do it because you enjoy the challenge, the rabbits and the people".

Dear ADRC,

Just read the DR thru, and I thought Bob and I should renew our membership! Please find the check and the renewal slip enclosed.

I would like to comment on some articles in the DR. I also will miss Dr. Reed. Dr. Reed helped Bob and I with a few medical problems over the years and ponder if the replacement Vet will have Dr. Reed's ability and talent in medicine of rabbits. He made the comment about the "blue"'s undercolor in the DR. I don't know where I read it but I remember an article saying that a blue will never be penelized if the blue is a deep rich blue over a medium blue. And that it is realy this Dark deep blue that "we" want. I have been shocked lately at the amount of lite blues (that may realy be mediums) placeing quite well at the local shows. (Some are even our rabbits). I guess Bob and I would like to know what is prefered, or what is the standard of now says. After all the standard places 10 points on color. That is 1/10th of the rabbit. In the rabbitry, they must have good color and I have found that color is quickly washed out by using poor crosses. I would like to hear from Dick on this matter if he has the time to address it because he is a very good Dutch judge. I'm thinking that 10 points can not be overlooked, it is like the rabbit has a massively wavy saddle.... think about it-the rabbit wouldn't place. But one will place a poor colored rabbit well. It is puzzling....

The other question so many had was to why people didn't vote. I wrote a lenghtly letter to Kevin hooper about this. I wonder if he received it or remembered it at all. The reason people didn't vote is that the "wording" wasn't any clearer. I didn't even understand what was being said, or if the point was to make it read clearer that it wasn't. (In my opinion). But, I also asked other local breeders what they thought and they said the same as I, that they were agruing between themselves what was being said and or changed. Doesn't sound to me like anything was made clearer to me?. I will not vote if I do not understand what I am voting for. Would you? There is also the other view point- if people care that much about what is being voted upon- those who care the most will vote. to but couldn't. What ever is passed (or guessed not passed in this case), Bob and I will follow. After everything is said and done people will breed what they personally like anyways.

This year my five year old daughter Jackie will be putting up some dutch on the open table. She fell in love and is taking care of a blue dutch doe we purchased from Andersons'. She is due in a few weeks, maybe Jackie will be on her own in youth next season (Aug. of 95). She knows a Show rabbit from the others because they have a tatoo in the ear, She makes sure all are played with, some run loose on the porch. She is also an "EXPERT" PS. ALL DUR RABBITS ARE THTOCOU!

rabbit catcher! Probably because she is so close to the ground?! She catches rabbits for other people at shows when they hop out of carriers even! Then she tells them to check if they are alright and didn't hurt their leg or teeth (if they fell far). She thinks she is a Dutch Bunny Mother. Her big sister shows the Hollands. I like a good Holland just like any other breeder but I don't love them. Bob and I love the Dutch. We have now learned to tollerate those rabbits that are a bit pinched in the HQ's. We have always sold them as soon as possible, because I personally can't stand that look. But, they win, not so often under Dick but other judges just expect ALL dutch to be that way. Yuck!

We are busy now breeding like crazy for the Dutch Nationals next Spring in our back yard! It is only 1 hour and 15 minutes a way! Hopefully with persistance will have a few to put on the table and I hope not be laugh ed at. My saddest observations (Bob's also) is that at some of the local shows that not all the dutch breeders in the state (or midwest) don't come to the close local shows. I understand they have a life outside of rabbits, but we greatly miss the competition. At one show I was the only breeder there. Bob drove truck that day, so I drove alone and came back the next day with bob and then there were more breeders, but not much. I asked some breeders why they don't come and they say nothing looked great, mystuff didn't either, as Bob can also say his steels were kind of molty looking this spring, but we came anyways. It just doesn't look good when there is a low number of Dutch at the show, it is sad. I guess from what Bob and I have learned is that some breeders won't come if they feel they can not win. For some that is more important than promoting dutch! seen some new youth breeders recently, but have the hardest time getting open breeders to stick with it. The markings drive them nuts. I look at it as a challange and it keeps me interested. I thank God for the Anderson's (inyouth), because they often place some of their animals in open. Those kids have great dutch.it is pretty sorry when BOS doesn't win you a leg. Those kids help the open when they compete!

Bob and I are also going to miss Dick from judgeing our juniors at State Fair this year. We were told by the show committee not to bring young rabbits, so we broght none. I can't risk any rabbit being stolen this year like what happened last year at state fair. Three other rabbits were stolen besides ours. We have to save them for the Nationals or for futre parents.

Last year the was a blue buck sneezing a green discharge from his nose, and he was right next to our champion. I was always under the idea that those rabbits would be removed, I was wrong. Our champion always breathed funny after that. Too many risks. I won't put my friendly dutch in risky situations any more. I love the competition of state fair because Roger Guetschow and Larry Bengston are usually there, and the dutch usually number in the high 90's. (it is also the only time one get' any money for showing). Bob and are happy with our decision and it makes us look forward even more to the State Convention and the Dutch Nationals in spring!



This nomination ballot is to be returned with the FINAL ELECTION BALLOT for Officers and Directors. The FINAL BALLOT for the election of the 1996 ARBA Convention judge and the 1996 NDS judges will be included in the first issue of the Dutch Reporter for 1995.

Please be advised that the YOUTH ballot is for the National Dutch Show Judge consideration only. The show sponsors are not required to hire a specific Youth judge, but they are requested to give as much consideration as possible to the Youth's choice whenever possible.



SUBSTANCE

In my weekly travels from coast to coast judging shows, whenever I have had the opportunity to judge the Dutch breed I have noticed one thing. Our breed is fast becoming one of a miniature stature. There is no substance to the Dutch animal anymore.

I am not suggesting we raise large, massive animals with large bone, I am suggesting however that we get away from the "TOY" Dutch that I am seeing.

Sure, these little animals show very well as Juniors. I can attest to several that have won major awards, BOB, Best 4 Class, etc. as Juniors on many occassions. Problem is, these occassions were about 8 or 9 months apart.

Raising the smaller animal that shows well in the younger classes is not, nor will it help our breed and breeding programs in future years. I can remember when I got started in Dutch, it was not uncommon to see a 6 or 6 1/2 pounder. We didn't want these animals for showing, but they sure made good breeders, and their offspring had some substance. I wish I would have paid closer attention to the likes of Doris Leibel, Don Reid, Al Seeman, etc. back then, and kept some larger animals for breeding. It is very possible to have a larger animal (5 - 5 1/2 pounds) that still maintains the desired type: cobby in structure and compact. Look at the French Lop. Here is an animal that I have seen go in excess of 15 pounds that still calls for, and on most occassions, maintains a COMPACT structure.

Recently I have had conversation with several breeders that complain about not getting decent litters, or how hard it is to get their does bred. In most cases, after showing me some of their stock it is of the smaller stature with very fine bone. Too refined in structure.

Take a good look at the Dutch crossing the table nowdays. Our breed calls for a 4 1/2 pound IDEAL weight. I would venture to say that if you weighed every Dutch at a show, you would be very lucky if 10% of them weighed 4 1/2 pounds.

I think it is time we started getting our breed back up to the appropriate weights (and classes). Let's put some SUBSTANCE back into the Dutch breed.
