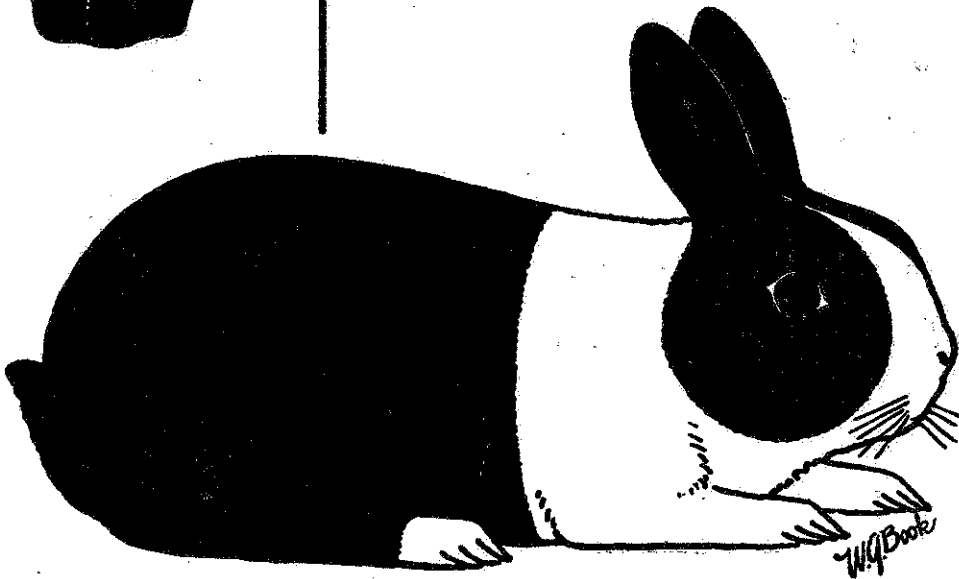


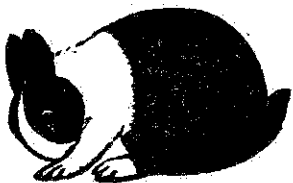

SECRETARY'S CHIT-CHAT

This is going to be short and sweet and right to the point. I haven't any more time than the rest of you for writing articles and digging up old waxes - so this is it for the month of June.

Within the next ten days the ballots for nomination for officers for the year 1959 will go into the mail. IF YOUR DUTCH REPORTER IS STAMPED "YOUR MEMBERSHIP EXPIRED LASTE MONTH" YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A NOMINATION BALLOT! If you want to stay in the active section of your American Dutch Rabbit Club, and pay your dues, your ballot will be mailed to you in time to get it to the election committee before the deadline which is August 1st., 1958. Let's have a big ballot return so that your officers may truly be the Club's representatives and not just the representatives of a small handful of members who were interested enough to take the few minutes necessary to cast their votes.

You will find in this issue all of the show reports for the 1957-58 sweepstake series which ended with the National Dutch Show at Wellington, Ohio, except two. I have one of the missing reports but have never received a catalog for that show. The other report has never been returned to me. If no response is received to my letters to these two clubs the series will be wound up with the publication of the July issue and the standings as published in this (June) issue will stand as final. I have already gone to considerable effort to try to get these reports, and/or show catalogs and I feel that in all fairness to the membership at large, no further time should be allowed.

I want to thank all of you who have already responded to my request for new or re-newed advertising since the publication of the May issue and hope that this will serve to jog the memories of some of the rest of you who want to send in a new ad but let it slip your mind. We are going to need quite a few more in the next few months to keep up with our record. DO IT NOW!

How is your summer production? If the score in our rabbitry is universal the fall shows are going to show larger Dutch entries than ever before. I took time to count noses this morning and find that we have 94 babies from today's litter up to five weeks old, with at least a half dozen does still to come in and two that managed to produce only one baby each, bred back to come in within the next three weeks.
