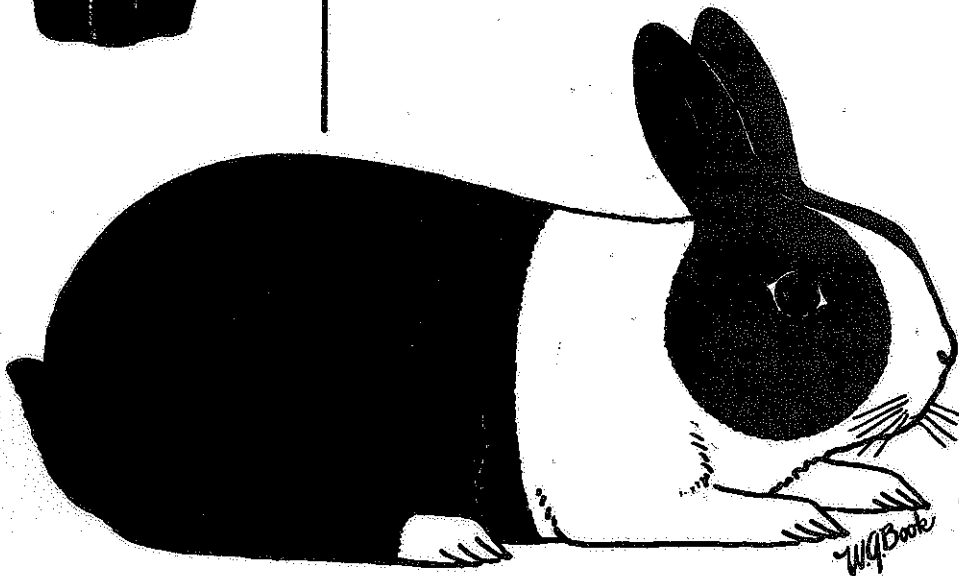

In this long overdue report of activities of the Publicity Department, I will try to discuss our publicity items offered in each Dutch Reporter and the efforts being made to make these items more attractive and representative of our rabbit.

First of all, allow me to apologize to any of our members who were inconvenienced by receiving their orders late. Business required that I go to Tucson, Arizona on a 2½ month trip and due to a mix-up, I received no mail from the middle of March to the middle of June.

Arizona, in the spring is beautiful, but I very much regretted missing the Dutch Show and I couldn't even find time to visit any of the Dutch breeders down that way.

Anyway, things are returning to normal, the rabbits are back home and I am itching to get back into competition again with these big ugly Torts.

Regarding the publicity items, we will soon be able to offer a new arm patch replacing the black ones presently offered. It is my intention to make the rabbit on this patch more representative of the ideal Dutch and dress this patch up a little.

The back patches are gone and won't be re-ordered until after the new arm patches are out for a while and we see what the response is. These back patches are badly in need of a rabbit redesign also and I, personally think we can offer something much better for the money.

I have discontinued the Dutch jewelry temporarily as we had a lot of breakage and again I believe we need something more truly representative of the animal we are striving for.

I am working toward a way to reduce the price a little on the silver and bronze lapel pins. Any of you who don't have one of these is missing a bet as these are beautiful and a real quality piece of jewelry.

Our stamps, pedigree books and mats are of course still available and are the best of any I have seen.

We will soon offer the new Special All Dutch Issue of Small Stock for any of you who missed it. If you did, better get one as it is a beauty and we all owe a big vote of thanks to Stan Goeglein and all the contributors.

In the next 6 months we will step up our magazine advertising a little, not much. I still think our best advertising is our fine little rabbit and our equally fine Club members.

BREEDER OF THE MONTH

Every successful Specialty Club must have one dedicated person to tie all the loose ends together and keep the show on the road, so to speak. Lots of hard work, long hours, much criticism and little praise is unfortunately the inheritance of the person who assumes the responsibility of all the unwanted jobs plus lots more. We of the American Dutch Club have our dedicated person. Her success in the job she has chosen for herself is evidenced by the continuing success of the club, one of the best, if not the best going. Therefore, it is appropriate that as our first Breeder of the Month, we honor Jessie Weinhardt, our club secretary and the voice of the Dutch Club through the pages of the Dutch Reporter.

Jessie and Bill, her husband and partner in all rabbit raising activities make their home in Manchester Michigan where their over 150 hole rabbitry is housed in an old barn. She describes their hutches as "catch as catch can" while still dreaming of that "ideal rabbitry". One hundred Black, Blue, Chocolate, Tortoise and Steel Dutch intentionally and Gray occasionally by accident as well as Californian Satins, Red New Zealands and Florida Whites make up the population of this rabbitry presently and Jessie has worked with most of the breeds of rabbits over the years. Having been a registrar since 1946 she feels that it is necessary to raise a breed to know it properly and as new breeds come to her area she usually tries a few.

While always looking for that perfect one in the nest box, "Weinhardts" breeding program is presently concentrating on a lower mortality rate as it seems the best one always dies in the nest box and the Weinhardts have a lab business to supply.

In addition to being the secretary of the American Dutch Rabbit Club and a member for 13 years, Jessie is a member of the Ann Arbor RBA, State Line RBA, a director of the Michigan State RBA and life member of that club having received that organizations coveted "Master Breeder Award" in 1963.

Weinhardts make most of the shows in their area and especially look forward to the Michigan State Show, the Columbus, Ohio show in september, the double show at Berea, Ohio in October and the Indianapolis show in the fall. You will usually find Jessie in attendance at the ARBA Convention and the National Dutch Show.

Besides all of her rabbit activities, Jessie has raised two sons and now has 5 grandchildren and has been foster mother to 66 children, whom she still thinks of as her family, while preparing them for adoption and new lives. She is presently mother to a delightful 10 year old boy. Quite an achievement in her 35 years of marriage.

Looking toward the future of the Dutch Rabbit and the Dutch Club, she would like to see less interbreeding of different colors in Dutch and more attention paid to type. She would like to see all the fine articles on Dutch that have been published in the Dutch Reporter and other magazines compiled into one book, perhaps with illustrations to be sold to the public and don't be too surprised if this remarkable lady does that one of these days.
