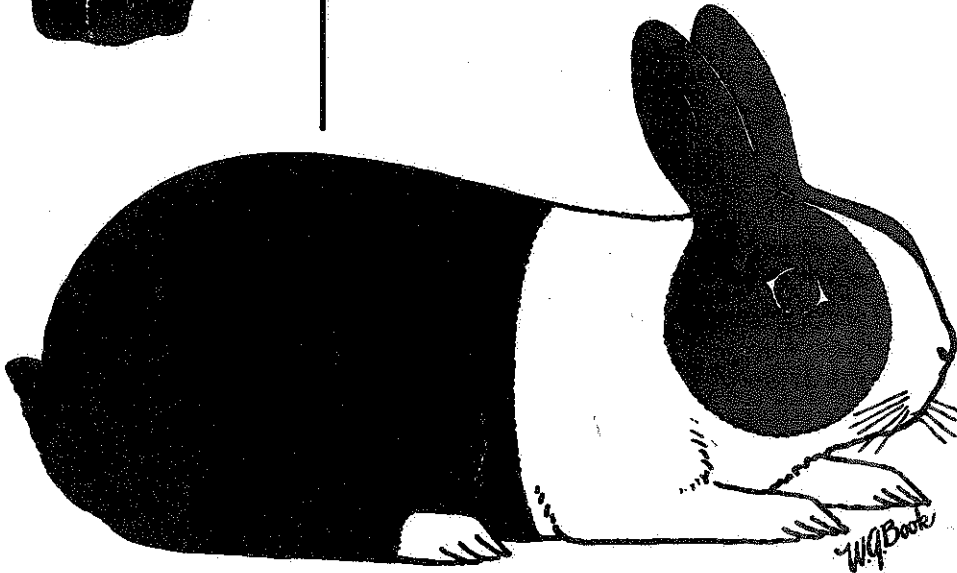

FROM THE EDITORS DESK

Had a letter from some Canadian friend telling me that a virus had hit their rabbitry and have lost over 36 rabbits to date. This brought to mind a conversation I listened to at a recent show at Edgerton, Wisc. that a group of raisers had lost a number of rabbits due to some unknown virus. IS this something that is hitting rabbitries? I had a minor splurge last summer. Lost five adult breeders and got right busy, and gave the place an extra good cleaning and disinfecting, spread lime on the ground, cleaned and disinfected all crocks, then added sulfamerazine to the drinking water for three days. I ended up losing nine adults. There were no outward signs indicating cause of death. I checked with my Vet and he informed me that it was a virus and that I had done all possible at the time. If any one can add anything to this problem send an article.
