

### DUTCH REPORTER EDITORIAL POLICY

**NAME:** The official organ of the American Dutch Rabbit Club shall be known as the "DUTCH REPORTER".

**OBJECTIVE:** The object of the Dutch Reporter shall be to assist the American Dutch Rabbit Club promote the Dutch rabbit, encourage the breeding of better Dutch, serve as an entertaining and educational media for the membership of the American Dutch Rabbit Club and provide a necessary link between the executive body and the membership.

**CONTENT:** The Dutch Reporter shall contain only those articles, reports, news items and advertising that can properly be considered pertinent to the American Dutch Rabbit Club, its members and the rabbit it sponsors.

All material that appears in the Dutch Reporter shall be judged by whether it is educational, informative, constructive and/or newsworthy. It shall never be used for personal promotion, personal attacks or articles that would tend to reflect unfavorably upon the American Dutch Rabbit Club and/or the Dutch rabbit.

The preceeding paragraph shall not be construed to mean that articles of a controversial nature be rejected. To the contrary, controversial sparks interest thought and participation. However all articles must reflect good taste, be constructive in intent and absolutely free from personalities.

All articles used in the Dutch Reporter shall be correctly identified as to author.

**DUTCH REPORTER COMMITTEE:** The Dutch Reporter shall be the proper business of a committee of five.

The chairman of the committee shall be the editor of the Dutch Reporter.

One committee member shall be the duly appointed publicity director.

Three committee members shall be appointed from the Board of Directors by the President.

**DUTCH REPORTER COMMITTEE DUTIES:** The chairman shall receive all articles, news and reports. Any article or item that might be considered in conflict with the with the content objective of this publication shall be submitted by mail to the other committee members for ruling. It shall take a 2/3 vote of approval for it to be published.

The publicity director as committee member shall constantly and actively solicit advertising to help defray the expense of publishing a necessary and worth while Dutch Reporter.

The Board Members as Committee members shall be responsible for at least one article in each issue of the Dutch Reporter. In addition they shall solicit one article from each elected official during each calender year. The articles should be of an instructional and educational nature.

**ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS:** Should any committee member neglect the responsibilities of his office and fail to follow the intent of this editorial policy, he shall be asked by the president to resign his said office, in case of failure to do so, the Board of Directors, by a 2/3 vote shall declare the office vacant. It shall then be the duty of the president to make an appointment to fill the vacancy.

This editorial policy shall not be considered restrictive or censorship in any form. Rather it provides an outline for the editor and committee members to properly provide the type of official organ that will aid the growth of the American Dutch Rabbit Club, the promotion of the Dutch rabbit and the usefulness of the Dutch Reporter.

All Officers shall receive the Dutch Reporter by first class mail. (Syracuse 1970, Board of Directors)

#### RULES TO GOVERN " SELLERS CLASS"

One year's membership in the American Dutch Rabbit Club for winner of first place in this class, with a perpetual record of merit under a heading "For Outstanding Service to the American Dutch Rabbit Club, through donating first place rabbit to the Sellers Class at the National Dutch Show, (year listed)." Same to be recorded in future Guide Books.)

1. All entries in this class subject to sale to the highest bidder. All rabbits to be an out-right donation with no pay-back to the exhibitor and a minimum bid of \$7.50 to be set.
2. No entry fee to be charged for this class. Rabbits entered in this class may or may not be eligible to register. Donors not entering rabbits in open classes must either make arrangement with the sponsoring club for the care of the entries or provide adequate care during the show in some other manner.
3. Entries to be given to the Breed Chairman. Entries accepted until judging time which will be 9:00 A.M. Sunday.
4. All Pedigrees to be turned in to the Secretary prior to the time of Auction if possible. All pedigrees guaranteed by the A.D.R.C.
5. The Seller's Class shall be judged by both judges, working together, as one class without regard to age, sex or color.
6. Bids to be open to all during entire show. Bidding to be by written bid, giving Coop Number, Ear Number, Name of Bidder and amount of Bid. All bids to be dropped into bid box provided by Show Secretary at Dutch Club Booth. Bids will be closed just prior to judging.
7. Auction and Final Sale will be held at the annual meeting of the American Dutch Rabbit Club. The Show Secretary shall determine the highest bid on each rabbit and so advise the auctioneer. Bidding to start at the bid on each rabbit. Minimum bid, \$7.50
8. Any rules or regulations not provided in the above to be decided upon by the A.D.R.C. Board.

Delete Rule 6 of the American Dutch Rabbit Club National Dutch Show Rules.....

Substitute: The Secretary of each National Dutch Rabbit Show shall mail a copy of National Dutch Show Catalog to each exhibitor of the previous National Dutch Rabbit Show and those members requesting a catalog.

FROM PRESIDENT, DON REID

STATE OF THE UNION MESSAGE

February 7, 1971, Doris Leibel, Myrt Greis and myself made the trip to Weinhardt's in Manchester, Michigan to pick up all the American Dutch Rabbit Club's records and supplies. Doris rented a U-Haul trailer and had it hooked up to her station wagon. She will probably give you more details in her message.

The February 1971 D.R. stated that there would probably be in the neighborhood of \$700.00 turned over to the new Sec.-Treas.. A check for \$600.00 was turned over and Mrs. Weinhardt stated that the books were not complete at that time but she had enough left to pay the Publicity portion of the income for the last quarter of 1970.

I understand that out of this \$600.00 we still owe for first place trophy for the 1968-69 sweepstake series. All ten trophies for the 1969-1970 Sweepstake series, about \$313.00 for the sponsors of the 1971 National Dutch Show, then earmarked funds for the ARBA Convention (1971) portion of 1970 club income. Then our mimeograph machine needed an overhaul and that was \$134.00. I understand that Doris was completely out of paper, stencils, etc. That was \$223.00 and \$31.00 for ink.

At our last meeting a question was asked as to how much it would cost to publish full show reports. Your Board decided to have full show reports printed if they were turned in at the proper time on a trial basis. Your Board will get a complete report, cost wise at their next meeting---I will mention that our January 1971 D.R. cost \$82.00.

Our new Director, Pat Herman brought up the fact that we get \$5.00 for sanction and \$1.00 for listing which goes to the Editor of the D.R. Then we give trophies, rosettes, ribbons etc.. PLUS about  $\frac{1}{2}$  page for average D.R. full show report which is WORTH \$10.00 as an ad. If any member can figure out how we can keep from going broke with a deal like this, I would sure like to hear their ideas so I can bring it before the Board at next meeting. We are also aware of the increase in postal rates in the very near future.

Do not be alarmed at above figures. We are not broke yet and our Board will not let this happen. I am happy to report that our Publicity Committee will continue for next two years and we will have same Election Committee for next year. Our Standards Committee is a standing committee with Elmer Paquette as Chairman. Mike Stinehelfer is Chairman of Constitution Committee and he and his committee are working on changing our Constitution and By-laws to take the Election procedure out of the Secretary hands. I am sure that he would welcome any suggestions. I am a bit disappointed in not hearing from more members in regard to awarding one point for B.O.B. and  $\frac{1}{2}$  point for B.O.S. The Board could make this change in our Sweepstakes Rules if we get MORE REQUESTS.....I know that several Breeds have done this.

Dear Mr. Vice-President ADRC:

In my conversation with Don a couple evenings ago, I indicated that I would extend my version of proposals for a constitution and by-law revision of the ADRC; thus I make the following proposals to be considered with those of your committee. Since I realize the present rules that guide us are open for improvement I volunteered to at least give my views, which are as follows.

#### CONSTITUTION CHANGE PROPOSAL

Article II, Object change to read;

To promote the breeding and exhibition of Dutch rabbits in all varieties as recognized by the American Rabbit Breeders Association. To provide a center of information and advice on all matters pertaining to Dutch rabbits. To cooperate with all rabbit agencies, especially the American Rabbit Breeders Association.

Article V, Officers, Section 2 change to read;

The officers shall be elected from and by the membership by mail ballot and be determined by the majority. Any member to eligible for any office must be a minimum of 21 years of age and must be an owner and breeder of Dutch rabbits.

Article V, Officers, Section 4 change to read;

Vacancies in office shall be filled by appointment by the President from a state other than those of existing officers.

Article VI, Discipline, Section 4-5-6 change to read;

Any officer, shirking his duty or letting his membership lapse or terminate the breeding of Dutch rabbits, shall have his office declared vacant.

Article VI, Discipline, Section 7, delete;

Section 1 of the same article is sufficient.

#### BY-LAW CHANGE PROPOSAL

Article I, Dues, change to read;

Membership dues shall be an amount necessary to negotiate the business of this club. No person shall be enrolled as a member until such dues have been paid. Any members whose dues are in arrears sixty (60) days shall be dropped from the rolls. He shall be thusly notified by the Secretary-Treasurer. Any suspended, expelled or dropped member shall have all club privileges terminated.

Article II, Duties of Officers, Section 2 correction; Word Vacation should be vacancy.

Article II, Duties of Officers make an addition;

All officers on expiration of their term of office shall transfer all material and documents to their successor.

Article III, Section 4 Delete.

Whereas I failed to give the Constitution and By-laws of the American Dutch Club a real thorough study, I realize that many failures are likely, for this I ask to be excused. on the other hand if I was of any help I am glad to have given this some time. Is ADRC incorporated? Are there any Incorporation records and with whom?

SECRETARY'S MESSAGE

On February 7, 1971 I feel that I officially started my new job as Sec.-Treas. of the American Dutch Rabbit Club. This is the date that records etc. were transferred from the Weinhardt's to myself. A sincere "thank you to the Reids for their hospitality over the weekend of the 7th and to the Weinhardt's for their cooperation. I think that the financial status of the club has been pretty well covered by Pres. Reid in his article and I don't feel that too much can be said until the final accounting has been rendered by Mrs. Weinhardt. I fully intend to publish quarterly financial standings in the D.R. and do whatever is required of me per the Constitution and the Board of Directors. This has been a hectic three weeks as I have felt that much work has to be done on the records, I can see that much has been done, but more remains. Since I have added the words "address correction requested" I receive back the undelivered D.R. and there are more than I had expected. Some are due to typographical errors in making out the stencils and some due to changes of address that haven't been changed on our records, for one reason or another. These are the mechanics of the job and as time goes on I hope to "run a tighter ship" This can't be accomplished overnight tho, so anything you see that needs attention, please let me know, I'll do the best that I can.

As Pres. Reid told you finances are tight. As the money accumulates I will release it for each project pending. The winners of the 69-70 sweepstakes series will be receiving their trophies within a month, money permitting. Dutch Reporter expenses have been especially heavy with the increase in size of the publication. It is possible that we will be able to take advantage of the Non Profit Organization mailing, due to the willingness of Gordon Fry to share his experiences with the post office with Pres. Reid and thus to me. The post office isn't too willing to grant these privileges without some resistance, however Mr. Fry's research helped immeasurably. Who among you might know if we are incorporated and where? I have asked this question in several places and as yet the issue is clouded. In order to apply for the non profit status I will need our articles of incorporation and the last most recent 3 or 4 financial statements. It is possible that we may find a source of printing supplies at a reduced cost and if this works out the expenses will be cut further, but I don't think it will get us completely out of the woods.....I am sure that these problems will work out once we can keep accurate records.

I want to thank all of you who have written in complimenting the format of the Dutch Reporter. It appears that the articles are well received, some of you, telling how these articles are read at your meetings. I also know how important show reports

are to some of you, others tell me that all they care about is a report of sweepstakes standings and the points received at a given show. Perhaps this is an issue that should appear on the ballot for majority rule. In any event I will do whatever possible to carry out the wishes of the majority of the ADRC members through the Board of Directors. WHAT DO YOU FOLKS WANT? THE DUTCH CLUB IS ON THE "GO"

#### YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH

DUTCH RABBIT SHOWMANSHIP by Patrick P. Herman. ADRC Director.

Basically, a good showman is aware that the primary purpose for showing an animal is to assist the Dutch bunny in making a favorable impression on the Judge. However, we the Dutch fanciers should not stop there.

First, individually we should be properly prepared to enjoy the Dutch Rabbit Show in it's entirety. To some of us this means that both the exhibitor and the exhibit are clean and well groomed. This includes the trimming of the toe nails and the removal of all foreign matter from the exhibit. Under no circumstances does a good showman remove off colored hair from his exhibit once it has arrived in the showroom.

A good showman always cooperates in any way possible with the judge, recording secretary, fellow exhibitor or anyone connected with the show. Likewise, he is courteous at all times, particularly to the judge and competing exhibitors and if it becomes necessary for him to handle his own animals or of a fellow showman he does not do so while smoking nor shortly after he has indulged in an alcoholic beverage. He never lets the slightest hint to the judge that he has an animal still in consideration for the championship.

A good showman is a modest winner and a gracious loser. The winner or runner up honors always offers congratulations to class winner or championship winner.

He never asks for any special privileges, such as the favor to review the records of the recording secretary or an early show release, likewise if he wins any specials, he never takes them on his own, rather he awaits proper resentation from the designated show representative.

The showman, who conducts himself under these rules can always leave a concluded show with a merry heart and peace of mind that are anxious for the next Dutch Rabbit Show. Showmanship, is sportsmanship and goodfellowship without any deviation. It is the perfection in ourself that we express through the exhibition of our Beautiful Dutch Rabbit.

DUTCH CLUB GUIDE BOOK and STANDARDS of PERFECTION by Tom Shufflebotham.....

I have been asked to write an article on the Dutch Standard and give my interpretation of it. This is to big an order for one issue. I feel that this should be interesting to judges, breeders and exhibitors, both novice and old timer. I hope it provides a spark to bring out ideas for future issues of the Reporter.. I will write something each month until completed..

I beleive that our Guide Book is the finest ever written on any breed of rabbit, by any Speciality Club. It is worth a million to both beginners and old timers. I do beleive, however, that most of our members do not take full advantage of its contents. My advice to all members, read it and learn it from front to back..BE AWARE.....

I do not mean the articles on breeding etc, but rather to its by-laws and constitution and our Standard of Perfection. Review them quite often and learn them, you will make better breeders and better members and help to make a better club. You will find out that nothing has been left out of our Constitution and By-laws. Our Standard of Perfection is explained so thouroughly and illustrated. Every good member should learn how our Dutch Club should be run, how it has been run, how it is being run. Take interest in our club and help to run it. Don't let it be a ONE PERSON CLUB. Review Article #2, Section #1 page 10, DUTY OF OFFICERS, I feel sure that you will come to the conclusion that some of the requirements have not been carried out. Section #3, Financial Reports, Section #4, Dutch Reporter. This has often been a sore spot with many of our members, including myself, since our meetings are semi-annual and the Reporter is the only National means of communication and information. Our members should be kept up to date on the Clubs doings. Since many of them drive hundreds of miles to these meetings, They should reach there with an idea of what is happening and what has happened. It should be educational and informative. Few will agree that we have had any of the cooperation as called for in Section #4.

Our President has been very patient and lenient in not making some changes as is provided for in our By-Laws. I am still interested in whether I am to be one of the judges at our coming National Dutch Show in April, Should have known this three months ago. It is very evident that something should have been done long ago.. One more thing that I think should be mentioned since I am talking about not knowing, the results for selection of judges for the Dutch Show. I feel that it is indeed an honor to judge any of our two big annual shows. I have attended 64 of them, either as a judge or an exhibitor. I do feel that judges that are nominated for these honors should not let his name appear on the ballot if he is not sure at the time he will be able to fulfill his appointment, a good example of this was our last show at Mason City. When both judges failed to appear. No exhibitor knowing of this until arriving at the show room. This situation happens too often, is not fair to the Exhibitors that voted for them., nearly all of whom have different ideas of of different judges, some they like and some they dislike, however, regardless of who the judge is we should support the show, there a lot more people at every show whom I am as anxious to meet as I am the judge. It's the good fellowship, which you cannot buy, that has kept me going to shows every chance I get. To illustrate this point, there is an article in Small Stock Magazine, January issue, written by Fuddy Duddy that fascinated me, relative to a couple of impromptu judging sessions and post mortems, which helps to promote such fellowships and are part of most show happenings and these two took place outside of the Judges Conference. One of the subjects was the color of the Blue Dutch, and a good session with the Checker Giant boys, it was quite lively, with no holds barred, then upstairs to the judging table of the Dutch, where the final post mortem on the Dutch took place. I feel that those present would have to say "it had to be one of the most educational features of the convention and everyone that was part of these two bull sessions would have to admit that it was time well spent and that they all learned something worth while about Checkers and Dutch. Now I know who Fuddy Duddy is. I know that it is not Harry Rice but one of my old sparring partners. Now you other fellows guess who this mystery writer is.

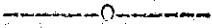
Dutch Club Guide Book, Tom Shufflebotham

Now about the Dutch Standard that I started out to write about, nothing is missed or discussed more than this. It all starts after the judging. He is blind as a bat, he's a no-good bum, hes slipping. He don't know the standard, he's every thing but a good judge, he does have a few friends left, those that got the Blue Ribbons, the Judge has to stand for this because some know-it-all exhibitor paid a buck to get his opinion of his rabbit and it's not the same as his. Being a Judge myself, I wonder if he ever raised "hell" with his doctor after he paid him well to find out what was wrong with his child. Perhaps a life hangs on that opinion. Did he ever stop and figure that this rabbit judge had spent as much time in getting his Judge's license as his doctor spent in getting his degree. Figure it out, You'll be surprised. A Judge should not be sophisticated and thinks he knows it all just because he is a judge, but he should know the standard of perfection on the breed, be able to make remarks on every facit of the rabbit from it's nose to it's tail, so that he will be able to explain to the exhibitor the reasons for his placement. Their is only one standard of perfection, that is what he should be guided by, not his likes and dislikes. It would be well for all judges and breeders to study and ~~study our~~ standard of perfection as written and illustrated in our own Guide Book. Let's us start with the original standard from which we took our standard, that of the the United Kingdon Dutch Rabbit Club. Let me point out one mistake in our own Guide Book, that is the name of our rabbit is NOT an American Dutch as pictured. It should be the Dutch Standard of Perfection. It is not an American creation. This is the Standard we started out with, ADRC Standard, 1944 Guide Book.....

Study these standards, there is very little difference. Then review our 1970 standards, there is quite a difference. Next I would like to discuss our color, disqualifications and one's man opinion of interpretations. The history of our standards is quite a study, the changes that have been made and at time I wonder by whom. I feel, myself that the original saandards were good enough. I am sorry to hear of the death of one of our oldest breeders and a charter member of the 1934 reorganization and a winner of Best Dutch at some of our Dutch Club and Conventions, that do not appear in our present Guide Book, because at that time no one was keep- ing any records.

There was one mistake in our present Guide Book, Winner of the "POP" Sauters trophy in 1966 was Tom Shufflebotham, our deceased member is Mr. Charles Williams, who passed away on Dec. 9th. He was 79 years old and died suddenly at home of a stroke. Mr. Williams was a very good friend of mine and did a lot for the development of the Dutch in this country and was an early importer of Dutch.....
