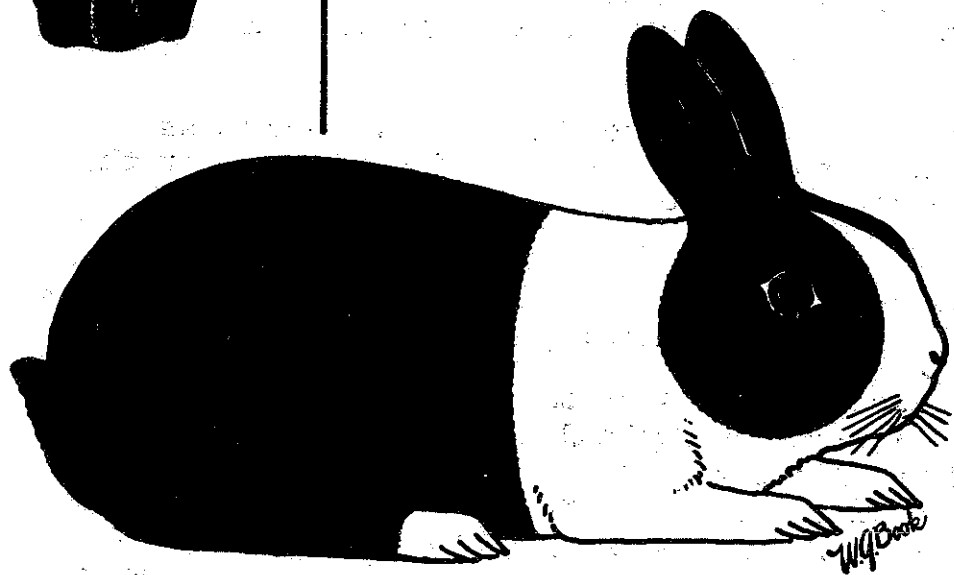

## Secretary's Message

If your D.R. is a little late this month, it is my fault. We had a delay in getting the membership listing printed. We have been having the lists done in our area, and then sending them to Kahlers to include in the D.R., but my timing was off for this issue.

The National Dutch show is April 22-23-24 in Hutchinson, Kansas. Hope to see you there. Recently received the show catalog, and it was nicely done. It looks like they are going to do it up right. I will be at my annual two week Army reserve training during this period, but will be able to get away for the weekend to attend the show. Have made arrangements to get some rabbits brought by Roger Guetschow, who I had intended to travel to the show with prior to the Army deciding that they had other plans for that time.

The Ballots for nominations will be mailed out the first week in April. This is the first time for several years that they will be sent out 3rd class mail. I know that some people complain about the service on third class mails, but normally they get through. They will certainly save the club a significant amount of money in postage expenses for the election each year. If you do not receive a ballot by May 1st, contact us, and we will send another via 1st class mail. There will be no chance of a person getting and using two ballots, however, as you MUST put your name and address on the return of the mailing envelope. The mailing envelope will be opened and destroyed prior to opening the ballot envelope, so your secret ballot will be safe and confidential. READ THE INSTRUCTIONS WITH THE BALLOT! Make your decisions wisely, and check the membership list in the D.R. to insure that your choice is a member of the Dutch club. The nominations will close May 15th, and the results will be in the next Dutch Reporter. This is the first year that we have coordinated the dates of the election with the D.R., so there will be no long delay between balloting and getting the results.

Check the show reports from your area. Some shows in certain areas list many exhibitors, and only a few members of the club. How about approaching some of these people you see at the shows, and ask them to join the club. We will be glad to send you some application blanks if you would like some.

NOW IS THE TIME to be sending in specials for the ARBA convention this fall. The catalog is printed way in advance, and to be listed you need to get your special in soon. We have one already from Wilbur Williamson, who sent in specials for both the NDS and the convention at one time. Seems like I'm always asking for something from the membership, but without your support there would be very little offered at these two shows. Sure the club puts up some specials, and the sponsoring group will help out, but it is YOUR show. Do what you can to help out.

The last few shows I have been to in our area have had better than usual Dutch entries it seemed. Was my pleasure to judge the youth entries at the Wisconsin Badger show in early March, along with Wally Wallace. It was a nice, well run show, as usual, and there were some youth Dutch there that could have done well in the open competition. A little black doe was runner-up for best in show. Its encouraging to see what some of the youth can do on their own.

Our terrible winter is over, and spring is around the corner. Have a few new litters, and things look so much better now. I guess its the old thing about being revitalized periodically. Hope things are going well with you and yours, and we'll see you at the shows.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS

After several years of both mediocre and good experiments with our rabbitry it would seem unfair not to share with the club one of our excellent experiences this past winter of having a new drainage system in the rabbitry.

Last summer we used a trencher to dig in the footings for a new addition to our home. This gave us an opportunity to use the machine in the back yard to lay some plastic drain tile. Then early this winter we installed six runs under our rabbit pens and connected them with the yard tile. We emerged the plastic pipe under the rabbit cages about 14 inches, covering it with pea gravel, then 2 inches of dirt. We also tapered the ground 18 inches on each side of the tube so every bit of the urine eventually drains away. I tried to make sure we had a run near the back of all the cages as this is where most of the urinating takes place. I have found through experience, the best way to insure yourself a bunny will use the back of his cage for this is to put a little urine on a rag or brush and rub some on the particular area of the clean cage you want them to use for their dirty chores. We usually locate this treatment in the corner that we do not want to use for setting a nest box. Our reason for this is that rabbits will continue to insist on urinating in that corner once they become accustomed to it and this will foul up the nest box in a hurry.

It may interest you to know that I can pour out five gallons of water under my cages and it disappears in seconds. We also noticed that the roof ventilating fan, which is controlled by a humidistat set at 47%, runs about one half as much as it did before the liquid was tiled away.

Our barn is kept at 40° controlled by a thermostat and the production for the cold winter was very good.

Certainly this is not all the answers to idealistic conditions of a rabbitry as most of us are aware that sanitation and sufficient clean water are a must and should be given top priority.

A BREEDING METHOD FOR THE SMALL BREEDER  
By AL MEIER, JR.

This article is intended primarily for the fancier with limited facilities who, quite possibly, wants to distinguish himself as a Dutch breeder rather than a Dutch "raiser."

The system of breeding Dutch as outlined in the following paragraphs is, I think you will find, contrary to some of the more common bits of advice tossed out from time to time. The ultimate goal is to produce a maximum number of show-quality animals from a few does. If you want to be merely a raiser of Dutch, you can obtain a bunch of mis-marked does, turn them loose in a barn with a buck and from time to time, as months pass, open the door and pick out a couple for the coming show. This is not any more absurd than the advice most freely given; select animals with good type and color and the markings will take care of themselves. This will, in time, give you a fine collection of good-typed, good colored junk. If good type and color can be maintained, or improved, by selection, why then cannot the variables within markings be eliminated by the same method?

#### SELECT FOR MARKINGS

My system of breeding is to select for markings, thereby not putting more variables into my breeding than already exist. How many variables in type could you possibly have other than a tendency to ranginess or flatness? The hybrid of the two closely approximates good type. The number of deviations from good head markings alone more than out-weigh these two extremes of type. Poor head markings can have any of the following faults: blunt blaze, rough blaze, hourglass blaze, narrow blaze, broad blazes, high cheeks, low cheeks, odd cheeks, square cheeks, wavy cheeks, angular cheeks, hooks and drags and full necks and dirty necks. This is quite an impressive list, and yet many breeders ignore them hoping that by selecting for type and color, the genes controlling all these little variables are going to get lost someplace during gestation.

Before going into explaining what to buy, I'd like to say a few words on from whom to buy. (These remarks are aimed at potential breeders of Blacks or Blues, as these are my only interest from a breeding standpoint.) My advice is to buy from a color specialist, or at least from a breeder who keeps his colors pure if he raises all the colors-this is something difficult to be sure of because of the temptation to keep that good show specimen no matter what his breeding.

Blacks and Blues are compatible crosses, but I can see no advantage in Blue blood in Black, although a Black cross can be beneficial in Blue breeding, but only if the color seems to be diluting too much.

#### HOW TO START

Now finally as to how to start: Now matter how much you have to invest, allot 60% of it for the purchase of the most outstanding buck you can find.

He should have the very best cheeks and stops procurable - don't make any concessions on this, don't buy the best buck you happen to see on a given day just because this is the day you decided to go out and buy a buck. Horse-breeding farms buy mares to suit an outstanding stallion, not a stallion to suit the mares they happen to have gotten a good buy on. Look over the breeder's other stock to note if these qualities seem to be general throughout the majority of his animals. (The guy might have gotten him by opening that barn door mentioned a few paragraphs back.)

In addition to the outstanding cheeks and stops, the more other good markings you can combine on the same animal the better (don't necessarily look for the perfect animal--he's always the one that died in the nest box!)

I would buy one doe from the breeder of the buck and would pick up two more does from two different breeders of good typical stock. The reason for doing this is to give myself a little better chance of making a click. These does should have at least good, well-shaped cheeks.

The four best young does are saved from these matings and retained for breeders, only one of which should be retained from the doe of the same line as the buck--the other three must be better than their dams. The old does are then disposed of and the young does are bred back to their sire. The three best young does of these matings are retained along with the best-producing doe of the dams; if a good young buck is produced in the litters, he is also retained for breeding to these four nucleus does. If a good buck is produced, now is the time to recover some of your investment in the old buck. Line-breeding is now at an end and from now on the program is one of in-breeding. In the event no outstanding young buck is produced, you can line breed one more time and then save the best young buck produced, along with the four best does.

From here on, the program calls for nothing but strict selection for the complete Dutch. I personally never retain anything that will not at least register, and nothing is kept that has poor type.

You may have gathered by now that the whole basis of such a program is in rigid culling and the gradual elimination of as many variations from marking faults as possible. A point to remember about all markings is that the shape of the markings is of primary importance and not the amount of coverage. In a choice between heavier, well-shaped markings and lightly marked animals, the choice is always with the heavier.

The mention of shape in markings reminds me of a thought I have had for sometime; that is, the word "type" in the Standard would better be replaced by "shape". This might stop judges from judging for type as if they were selecting cantaloupes.

# HOW HERSHEY'S CHOCOLATES HELPED ME GROW

(NOTE: This article was David's entry in the Washington County 4-H Public Speaking Contest for which he received the reserve champion award. He recently demonstrated the Dutch for his 4-H rabbit club. David raises chocolates and torts but demonstrated all 6 colors by using some of his father's and brother's Dutch. His speech concentrated on chocolates as a tie in with the Easter season, however, he is equally fond of his original torts named Don and Nelle - after guess who?)

The Easter season is coming, and I remember hearing a discussion last year about the cost of chocolate going up, and hearing a news commentator say that chocolate Easter bunnies are becoming an endangered species. I want to tell you today about a chocolate bunny which has lasted me for 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  years.

In 1972 I was with my brother at the Hagerstown Fair, when he was choosing a new Dutch rabbit for his 4-H project. Black Dutch have always been his favorite. I had never seen a chocolate colored Dutch before, but I fell in love with a little doe that was there. Before I even got her home, she was named "Hershey." In the spring, Hershey produced 5 little chocolate bits and my rabbitry began rising in population.

For awhile we only raised a couple of litters a year. In 1974 we had 12 bunnies to sell at Easter! Boy! We thought we were really in business! It was fun to be able to hang out a sign that said, "Rabbits for sale."

That winter, rabbit project meetings were held at the Extension Office. At one meeting some State leaders came to talk about new project material and rabbit shows. This sounded very complicated. We had never thought much about rabbit shows except at the Hagerstown Fair. Whoever heard about legs of a grand champion, sweepstakes points, and those sorts of things?

It certainly didn't apply to us. Anyway, out of curiosity we went to the Montgomery County 4-H Rabbit Show, just to look. We didn't take any rabbits. It was an education. We found that you can learn a lot about rabbits at a show. Then you start to think, gosh! My rabbit could have beaten that one. That thought, folks, is the first symptom of rabbit show fever!

1976 was a good year for me. I took my rabbits to 14 shows. I participated in judging and showmanship contests. Would you believe there is an honor known as "Rabbit Prince?" I won that title for Maryland, then again for a 5 state region, and finally was number 2 in the national contest.

One of my favorite things to do is to go to a rabbit show. I look forward to seeing the friends who are always there. (CONTINUED)

I especially like to watch the judges at work. You can learn a lot about the different breeds by listening to the judge's comments. We think "You can't beat the Dutch," but I would like to be a judge someday and then I will have to know all the breeds. Some judges make a special effort to explain things to young breeders.

It's been interesting to watch the people at shows, too. Some people want to talk to the winner and find out how he does it. A few would rather get mad and stomp around. Others are just quiet and don't say much either way. They just accept things the way they turn out. What some forget is that the judge is paid to give his opinion and that is just what he does. You should try to learn from his comments.

I like to talk to the other rabbit breeders, especially the "Old-Timers". Most rabbit people are friendly and it's not too hard to go up to one that you don't know and start a conversation.

Some people don't have the patience or the interest to breed a winner of their own. They'd rather buy theirs. But there's no better feeling than to have raised your own winner. I now have 9 does, including 4 generations which began with Hershey. One of her daughters won Best of Breed and Best Colored Fur at the Hagerstown Fair in '75. It was Hershey's grandson who won Best of Breed, Best Colored Fur and Best in Show there in 1976. At the State Fair, he was Best of Breed and Best Opposite in Show. Now I'm trying to develop a winner for the 1977 shows.

About a year ago, a 4-H Rabbit Club was formed in Washington County and this has made a big difference in the Hagerstown Fair. For years, there were only about a dozen 4-H rabbits at the Fair. Last year there were 144! (Including 69 Dutch)

Through the rabbit project, any 4-H'er can have the fun and experience of raising an animal. You can learn care of animals, breeding principles, judging, showmanship, sportsmanship and responsibility. Sometimes there are rewards also in show premiums and trophies. I've won 16 trophies this year.

Having Hershey has been rewarding and has led to many experiences that have helped me grow right along with her family. Hershey has 5 fat little chocolate bunnies in her nesting box right now. My kind of chocolate bunnies are certainly not an endangered species! And I recommend them to you. My Hershey's chocolates are good for you! They'll help you grow!

(Ed's Note: Our Thanks to David and also to Dan Rohrer, Jr; David's father. Dan sent this in with a letter of his own and so the following is part of that letter.)

I should tell you that I feel a little bit guilty because you're always asking for articles and I love to write. I do a lot of writing in my work but that's required stuff. For pleasure I put out a 6 page monthly newsletter for another club I belong to.(CONT.)

As a starter, I have enclosed my son David's speech which he prepared for the County 4-H public speaking contest last Sunday. His original version had a lot more detail but had to be considerably trimmed down and polished for ease of spoken word and time limitations. Unfortunately the original version doesn't seem to be around so I've sent the speech version. The reader should be aware, however, that this was prepared to be said not read.

I'm now turning over a few thoughts of my own and promise you an article very soon.

## CAN WE ALWAYS BELIEVE?

In answering some inquiries from both new and prospective Dutch breeders this writer thought it best to respond in a manner that would allow all to participate. The following information is the expressed opinion of the writer.

I was recently asked the following questions during correspondence:

1. IS WRY NECK GENETIC? I have found that the A.R.B.A. Guide Book lists this disease as maybe of bacterial or parasitic origin and possibly nest box injury. It is possible that the above are true but one of my lines has produced, in 4 generations, one buck in each generation that has either died or lived after contacting the "disease". Also noted in the third generation a young doe of 4 months who did contact the "disease" if it can be called that and died about 4 weeks later. Thankfully this writer carries four lines of breeding and is not mixing this line nor selling stock from it. As with many rabbit diseases enough money has not been brought forward to do any elaborate research into this and other ailments. The bottom line of this problem is that experience has at least proven to me that even though some other cause other than genetic could produce wry neck it did not in this writer's experience. Again proven by 3 lines that are "clear" irregardless of placement in the rabbitry. No, a cure could not be found but the "disease" is not always fatal as #2 generation buck contacted wry neck at one year old. He is now 3½ years old and still a fertile buck.

2. WHAT TO DO ABOUT HUTCH BURN IN THE EXTERNAL GENITAL AREAS OF MAINLY DOES BUT POSSIBLY BUCKS? This writer in collaboration with Carl Decker has proven in the last 15 years that a syringe applicator purchased in most feed stores for Mastitis in cows is 100% effective in clearing this up in no more than 3 days. The white applicator costs about \$1.50 and a teaspoon of cream should be liberally soothed on twice a day. In that the tube's output is shaped like a wooden match, it should be inserted into the does genital organ opening about ½ inch and the cream squeezed in. Our A.R.B.A. Guide Book does not recommend anything specific as being able to cure but does mention dry lanolin as being of benefit. The Mastitis syringe can also be used on any open wound and have even used it in the eye or eyelid without adverse affect.

3. DOES THE COLOR OF THE DOE'S VAGINA INDICATE THE PROPER TIME TO BREED THE DOE? Even though this writer disagrees with Dr. Ram Prasad (Staff Veterinary, Merck, Sharpe and Dohme Research Lab) we in the industry have found that a deep shade of red (Magenta) is in most cases conclusive by experience that the doe is ready to be mated. Actually more research must be done in this area using a test group of animals to prove the incident rate. I believe it would show higher than normal incidence.

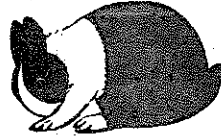

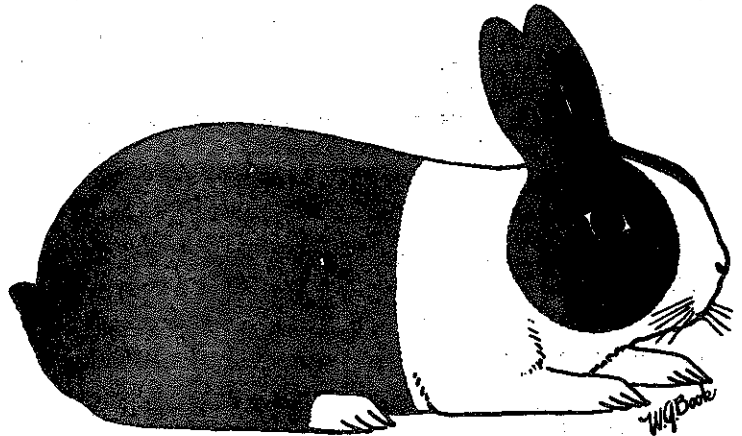
