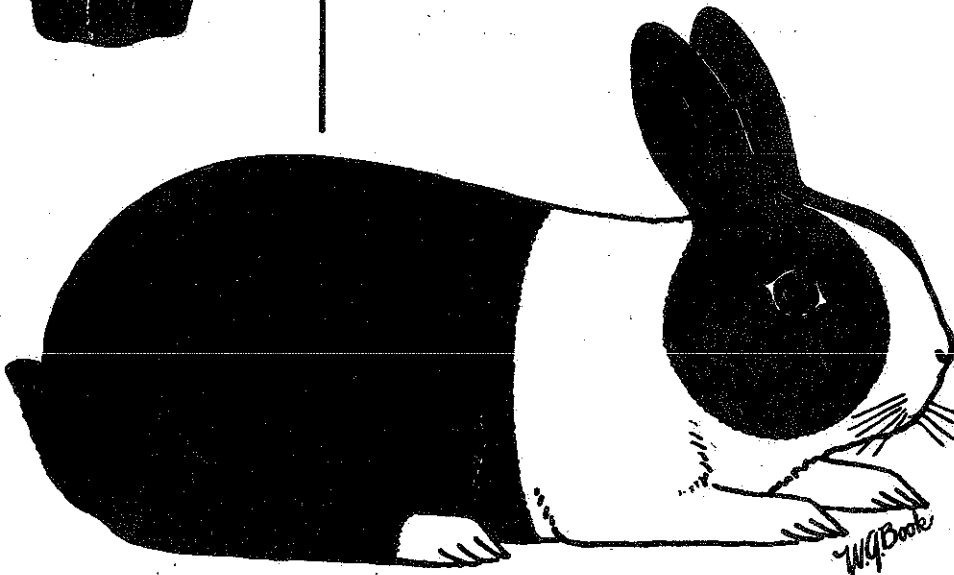

### AMERICAN DUTCH RABBIT CLUB

Minutes - Board of Directors Meeting

Amarillo, Texas - April 22, 1966

The meeting of the Board of Directors of the American Dutch Rabbit Club was called to order by President Bill Summers at 11:15 p.m., Friday, April 22, 1966.

Present were: President Summers, Secretary-Treasurer, Jessie Weinhardt, Directors Clinton Dennis, Stan Goeglein, and Don Lovejoy. Absent were: Vice-President, Jack Boughton, Directors, Don Reid, Don Guthrie and Bill Hobin.

The minutes of the meeting held at Springfield, Illinois on Oct. 27, 1964 were read and approved.

Stan Goeglein reported, as chairman of the committee for the Special Dutch issue of Small Stock Magazine that he had collected \$190.00 for advertising and had been promised about \$45.00 more.

There was no report from the publicity chairman and no unfinished business.

Since the ADRC's second choice for a judge for this show had been unable to serve because of ill-health, third choice, James Blyth was unable to attend because of a previous commitment and fourth choice, Tom Shufflebotham preferred to show, we were faced with the problem of deciding what to do about the rules which spell out the procedure of selecting judges for National Dutch Shows. It was found that the Board of Directors holds the final say on any alterations or changes of the rules, therefore a motion was made by Clinton Dennis, seconded by Stan Goeglein that inasmuch as there were only 218 entires that for this one show only, the rules be set aside and the senior judge should judge the entire show. Motion carried unanimously.

The Secretary raised the question as to whether the ADRC should carry the memberships (without charge) of members who are serving in the armed forces. It was agreed that they should be carried to the extent of receiving the Dutch Reporter.

There was a discussion of the possibility of holding dual sweepstake series for various parts of the country, but this died for lack of a motion.

It was brought up that inasmuch as the Publicity Director is now handling considerable amounts of Club funds, mightent it be wise for the holder of that office to be bonded the same as the Secretary-Treasurer. There was a motion by Stan Goeglein, seconded by Clinton Dennis that Mr. Harris investigate the possibillities locally and purchase such a bond in the amount of \$1,000 to cover his office. Carried unanimously.

The Secretary informed the Board that her present typewriter was about worn out

Funds for the purchase of this trophy were provided by Don Lovejoy, Stanley Goeglein and Mr. & Mrs. Clinton Dennis. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made at 12:21 by Clinton Dennis, seconded by Stan Goeglein. Carried.

Minutes - General Meeting

Amarillo, Texas - April 23, 1966

The regular meeting of the American Dutch Rabbit Club was called to order by President Bill Summers at 9:40 p.m., following the wonderful banquet furnished by the Texas Pahnandle Rabbit Breeders Ass'n. and so very ably M.C.'d by Mr. Chas. O'Dell. Present were: President, Bill Summers, Secretary-Treasurer, Jessie Weinhardt, Directors, Clinton Dennis, Stanley Goeglein, Don Guthrie and Don Lovejoy. Absent were: Vice-President, Jack Boughton, and Directors, Don Reid and Wm. Hobin.

The minutes of the previous meeting, held at Pomona, California on Oct. 25, 1965 were read and approved on a motion by Don Guthrie.

The minutes of the Board meeting held on the previous evening were read and accepted on a motion by Earl Hord, seconded by J. J. Scharnberg.

Stan Goeglein gave his report on progress of his committee toward completion of the job of compiling material for the Special All Dutch Issue of Small Stock Magazine. He reported he had collected \$190.00 worth of advertising with \$45.00 more pledged prior to this show. He announced that he had blanks with him for more ads and was ready and willing to accept any that were available from the members present. Don Guthrie elaborated a little further on the subject and the report of this committee was accepted.

Mr. J. J. Scharnberg, reporting for the auditing committee comprised of himself, L. E. Settle and Clyde Jones, informed the group that they had found the Secretary-Treasurer's books in order and the treasury in excellent condition. They reported that there was an error of 56¢ carried on the books for more than two years and they recommended that this error be absorbed in order that the books might balance. It was moved by Scharnberg, seconded by Don Lovejoy that these items be written off and not carried forward any longer. Motion carried. Report accepted.

There was some discussion as to another item that had been carried on the Secretary-Treasurer's books for some time, this being the cost of two cuts used in the last Guide Book in the amount of \$13.50 which were never paid for by the advertisers. There was a motion by Guthrie, seconded by Don Lovejoy that these items be written off and not carried forward any longer. Motion carried.

After some further discussion of the Secretary-Treasurer's report, Don Guthrie asked for the floor and stated that he felt all of the gossip regarding the condition of our treasury and the handling of this office was only hurting the club and he, for one, thought it was high time to put a stop to it. He stated that he felt the Club should get behind the Secretary-Treasurer and give her a vote of confidence and he so moved. Motion seconded by almost everyone present and carried unanimously.

The Secretary stated that there was only one bid for the National Dutch Show for

1967 and this had been placed some time ago by the Ohio State Dutch Rabbit Club. No action can be taken on this bid until June 1.

The Secretary was instructed to contact Ed Toebbe to learn if a Dutch Breed Chairman had been appointed for the ARBA Convention at Louseville.

There was a motion by Clinton Dennis, seconded by J. J. Scharnberg that the meeting be adjourned. Carried. Meeting adjourned at 10-18 p.m.

The question was raised as to how many of these did not actually duplicate trophies or plaques still with the Club and the Secretary informed them that the only two were the American Dutch Rabbit Club Trophy for Best of Breed and the Ancel R. Beaver Trophy for Best Black Dutch. There was a motion by Don Guthrie, seconded by Don Lovejoy that plaques to replace these two trophies be purchased. Carried.

President Summers announced that Director, Don Guthrie wished to resign his office, due to the pressure of other business. He also announced that should the Board be willing to accept his resignation he wished to appoint W. R. Griffith of Chattanooga Tennessee to fill his unexpired term. There was a motion by Clinton Dennis, seconded by Stan Goeglein that Mr. Guthrie's resignation be accepted and Mr. Griffith's appointment be approved. Carried unanimously. There being a two-thirds majority of the Board present, the appointment stands approved, although Mr. Summers stated that he would request a vote from those members not present.

Meeting adjourned at 10:35 on motion by Dennis, seconded by Goeglein.

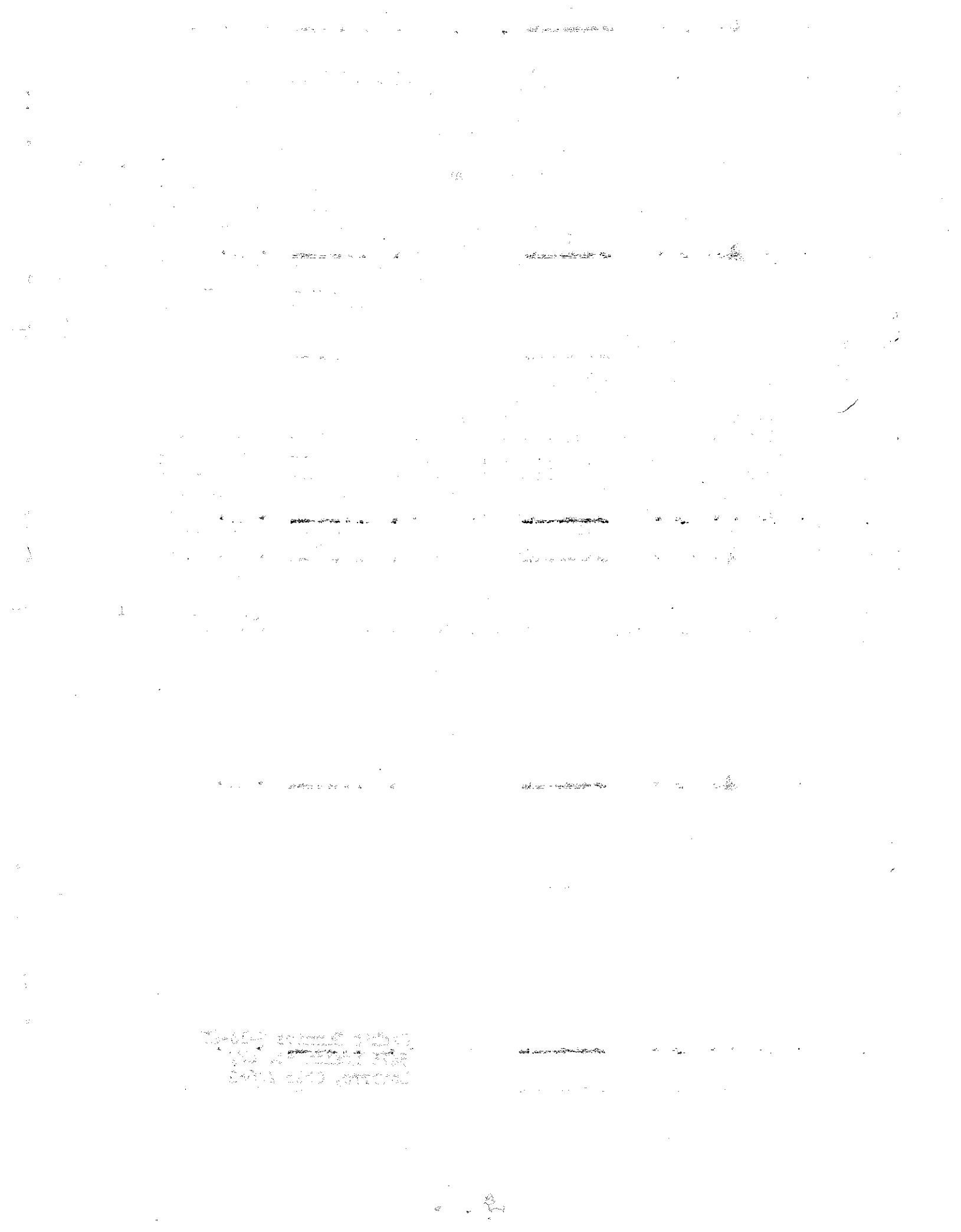
