

Minutes, Board of Directors Meeting

The meeting of the Board of Directors of the American Dutch Rabbit Club was called to order by Vice-President Al Meier, Jr. at 6:15 p.m. Present were: Vice-President, Meier, Secretary-Treaser, Jessie Weinhardt, Directors, Don Reid, Stanley Goeglein and G. C. Sturgis, Sr.

Item # 1. The Board had been requested to change the National Dutch Show Rules, particularly Rule 6, pertaining to the mailing of the catalog for this show which now read, "The Secretary of the American Dutch Rabbit Club shall furnish a list of members with their last known addresses to the Secretary of the National Dutch Rabbit Show, who shall mail a copy of the National Dutch Rabbit Show catalog to each member in good standing." to read: "The Secretary of the current National Dutch Show shall furnish the Secretary of the forthcoming National Dutch Show with a list of all exhibitors in the current show, who shall be mailed catalogs for the forthcoming National Dutch Show. All other persons desiring catalogs must write and request same."

Item # 2. It was recommended that Rule 2 of the National Dutch Show Rules which now reads: "Bids for the National Dutch Rabbit Show must be received by the Secretary of the American Dutch Rabbit Club not later than June 1st. of the year preceding said show. A copy of said bids must be mailed to each Officer and Director of the American Dutch Rabbit Club." be changed to read: "Bids for the National Dutch Show must be presented to the Board of Directors and Officer of the American Dutch Rabbit Club prior to their meeting at the current year's show, for the next year's show."

Item # 3: Considerable discussion was held about the failure of President Summers to fulfill his duties as spelled out in the Constitution. It was pointed out that he had failed to answer correspondence from the other officers, had failed to appoint committees during the past two years, had failed to secure the cooperation of committees previously appointed, all of these things spelling out his lack of interest in club affairs, it is therefore the recommendation of this Board that his resignation from office be requested.

Item # 4: It is recommended that the 1969 National Dutch Show be awarded to the Dutch Breeders of the North Central Rabbit Club of Ludington, Michigan.

Item # 5; There was a discussion of the possibility of a re-issue of the present Guide Book with whatever necessary changes and revisions be taken under advisement

Minutes, Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the American Dutch Rabbit Club was called to order at 8:55 p.m. by Vice-President, Al Meier, Jr. Present besides the Vice-President were Secretary Treasurer, Jessie Weinhardt, Directors, Don Reid, Stan Goeglein and G. C. Sturgis Sr.

There was a motion by Al Emery, 2nd. by Barbara Walker that since the Minutes of the previous meeting had been published in the Dutch REporter, the reading of same be dispensed with at this time. Carried.

Under reports of committees, Don Reid reported on the Special Committee's action on the revision of the election dates. It was the committee's decision that these dates should be changed to make the mailing of the nomination ballot on May, to be returned by June 1st, and counted by June 10. The election ballot to be mailed on Aug. 15, returned by Sept. 5, and counted by Sept. 15th. to allow for the new officers to be notified before the AREA Convention. (This question to appear on the nomination ballot to be mailed on July 1, 1968. A motion was made by Al McKeeman, seconded by Frank Miller that this committee report be accepted. Carried.

The following letter was read into the Minutes:

April 22, 1968

Dear Stan:

I have just put a box of Publicity items in the mail to you for the Dutch Show. I am hoping it will arrive in time. Bill (Summers) and I had planned on coming up until last weekend but things just didn't work out so I am late sending the stuff but think it will get there on time. I am really sorry to stick you with it I would have liked very much to have made it back there this year.

Anyway I certainly hope you have a fine show. I know you will back in that part of the country.

I think the prices for this stuff are all on the Reporter except the back patches which I will try to get rid of for \$2.00 apiece.

Stan please let the Board know that the Publicity fund balance is \$461.50 plus money Jessie has from sale of publicity items at Convention last October and what she has from the Club money for publicity. Also plus money owed by Mac Thatcher from last year's Dutch Show from sale of publicity items that I have written him about and got no answer. I also have renewed the bond requested by the club for this year. I will send Jessie a breakdown as soon as I can get on it. Lots of luck again Stan and Thanks
Bob (Harris)

The resolution presented at the last meeting, pertaining to re-apportionment of the National Dutch Show Fund to provide funds for the AREA Convention show was discussed and it was reported that this resolution also would appear on the July 1st. ballot.

The recommendations of the Board were read and it was decided to take them up one at a time for discussion and vote.

After much discussion of recommendation one of the Board of Directors, which pointed out the needless expense to the sponsoring club, or the National Dutch Show, it was felt that this recommendation was a good one.

Further discussion of the National Dutch Show catalog was had concerning the possibility of the deletion of the names of past winners of the various trophies, in order to cut down on the required printing. No decision was made.

Discussion of recommendation number two brought out the fact that near disaster oc-

curred this year of the fact that when the sponsoring club applied for a sanction for this show from ARBA it was learned that the Van Wert Club had applied for their sanction for the same dates in June 1967 which date was earlier than we had required as a deadline for application for the following year's National Dutch Show. Much correspondence between that club, Jim Blyth's office, Stan Goeglein and your secretary's office was needful before a satisfactory solution could be arrived at. Stan Goeglein reported that it was on the advice from Mr. Blyth that we revise our rules, making the application date for the following year's show much earlier in order to avoid such a situation in the future. The membership present approved.

Considerable discussion of the Board's recommendation number three was held. It was mentioned that the President had not been present at the past four meetings (including this one), but the Chairman pointed out that this in no way influenced the Board since it undoubtedly was the fault of the geography of the location of the meetings and not the unwillingness of the President to be present. Rather it was due to concern in his failure to communicate with the other officers and to carry out the duties of his office. This recommendation met with approval.

Mr. Shufflebotham asked for the floor and asked why the Editorial Policy set up by a committee headed by Don Guthrie and presented at the Springfield, Illinois meeting in 1964 had never been published and was not being complied with. This Editorial Policy was read from the Minutes of the Springfield meeting and Mr. Shufflebotham was assured by the Secretary that it had been published in the Dutch Reporter (November, 1964) and the Chairman stated that he, personally could see no evidence that it had not been lived up to in the meantime, even to the publication of "audited financial reports".

Recommendation Number four met with approval, after introduction of Mr. & Mrs. Ronald Hathaway and Mr. & Mrs. Pat O'Brien who told of the facilities available for a National Dutch Show in Ludington.

Recommendation number five met with much interest as there has been considerable interest in a new Guide Book. The Secretary reported that she had contacted the Westville Indicator, who had published our present Guide Book with a view of a re-issue with corrections, and had received a tentative price in the neighborhood of a thousand dollars for a thousand more copies. It was explained that this, of course could not be a definite bid because it was not known if we would want to include any new advertising or simply reprint the copy in the present one. Discussion pointed out that perhaps we could help defray the cost by securing some new advertising and perhaps reprint the present ads at half price. Further research in the matter would be necessary. The chairman stated that any volunteers for the job would be welcomed.

Alan Miller, the new Sweepstake Chairman was introduced and it was explained that all shows dating after this one would be handled entirely by him. He is to figure all sweepstake points, keep records of same and mail out all ribbons and rosettes. The secretary pointed out that something would have to be worked out to cover the postage bill that he would incur, and the chairman said this would have to be included in the Secretary's Postage report.

Under the "Good of the Order" it was requested by the show committee that any entrants into the Sellar's Class should be submitted before 9:30 tomorrow morning.

The meeting adjourned at 10:25 on a motion by Al Emery, seconded by Mike Stinehelfer. Carried.
