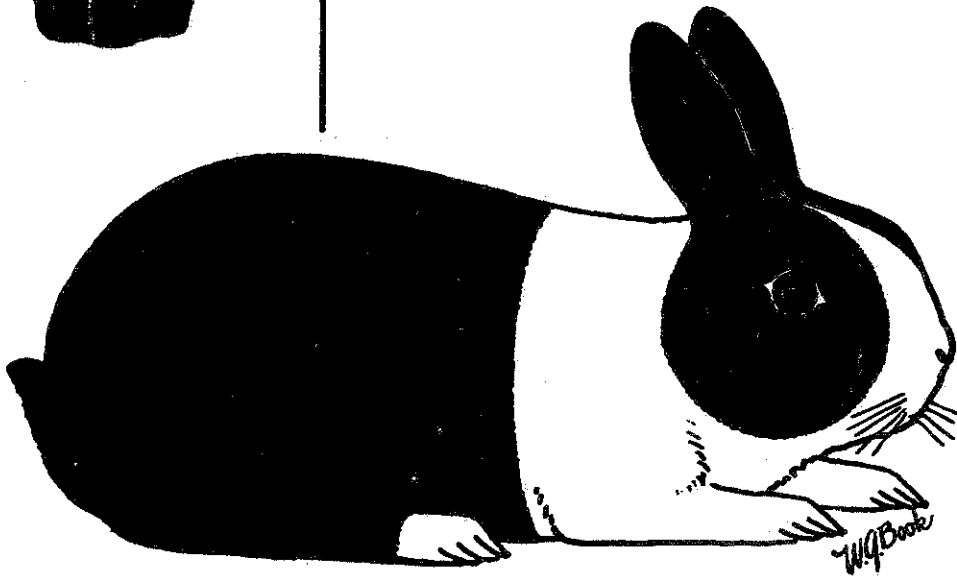

First, I'd like to congratulate the person who thought of the "guest writer of the month" article. Guest writers, we do appreciate your articles, many of us reading them over and over. I for one, have been raising Dutch exclusively for 22 years, having seen, felt and heard much of our little dutchman and still can learn much. We have many problems confronting our club which must be resolved for the "good of the the order" Dissatisfaction breeds the lost membership or as Tom puts it, the almost 50% turnover. It appears that we must be cautious in our decisions and not make a blunder like was done in the weight problem. A change for the better is sometimes necessary if it is well thought out and approved by our Directors. Not really wishing to go into coporate structure, those of you who have a business concerning stockholders know that the business runs quite well when the elected representatives of the company have a free hand to work for the good of the organization and not be inter-fered with by one or two stockholders who are natural troublemakers. I'd like the Directors to run our club with a free hand, governed by our exalted "leader" "El Presidente" If the President sees need to investigate a problem, the Standards Committee is there to do just that on the animal level itself. Any other problems should not be addressed to the D.R. Editor, but to yours and mine representative. The Board should then decide just what the problem is and can it be resolved best by opening it to the general membership, with perhaps 30% new members who don't know a light blue eye on a black isn't good or keeping it on an administrative level, perhaps where it belongs. Many of the articles submitted to the D.R. in the past few months are very critical rather than genuinly constructive. MONDAY MORNING in the RABBITRY-----Doris Leibel

Last month I told you of an experience with a newly imported Chin Dwarf. I am going to risk your displeasure and tell you of furthur happenings. These things just do not happen with the Dutch, at least my Dutch, but I'm being kept on my toes with these other ding-dong things. On Sunday evening I could tell that the German import doe would be kindling soon. She built her nest and I could see that she was laboring. Figured that next morning there would be a new litter of R.E. White Dwarfs. Well, next morning there was no change. I watched her for awhile and decided she was in trouble, so called our local Vet and asked if he wanted to perform a Cesarian, he agreed, so Susy-bell went to the Doctor. Sure enough, one large bunny that couldn't clear the pelvic region. The doe is coming along well and being watched for wound problems. Dr. Ferguson says that she can be rebred in 6 weeks if there is no discharge Think, I'll give her a bit more time than that to heal tho. Then she will be bred to the Chin buck, I don't like to see these breeding that produce one large bunny. I tell you these things for general information on rabbit raising, regardless of cont.

Monday in the Rabbitry, cont.

Breed. Prize rabbits can be worked with, they just don't have to die, when there is trouble. Some times it works and some times it doesn't. Where there is life there is hope. I'll let you know if she ever produces a live litter.....Then the next thing that made the day interesting was the discovery that one of the Chin Dwarf babies had a touch of scours, so mixed up a bit of Tetracycline in water and gave it an oral shot, it's still alive and fighting to live, An old friend, now gone, told me once that if they would eat to give them a plantain leaf, the broad leaf that we try to kill in the yard, I cultivate them. It works, is a good tonic. I've got a lot of pet theories, you know, like planting in the full of the moon etc. I rebreed in the odd week, either 3 or 5 or 7, depending on the condition of the doe. If I work her heavy, she gets an extra supply of calcium. I don't like to see the bunnies hop out of the next box for at least two weeks and closer to three. So put a brick under the front (or something) to lift up the front and hold the young in the rear of the box longer.

Trying out a new nest box with the 1/4" wire bottom, works too, in the heat. The babies are dry and cool/
