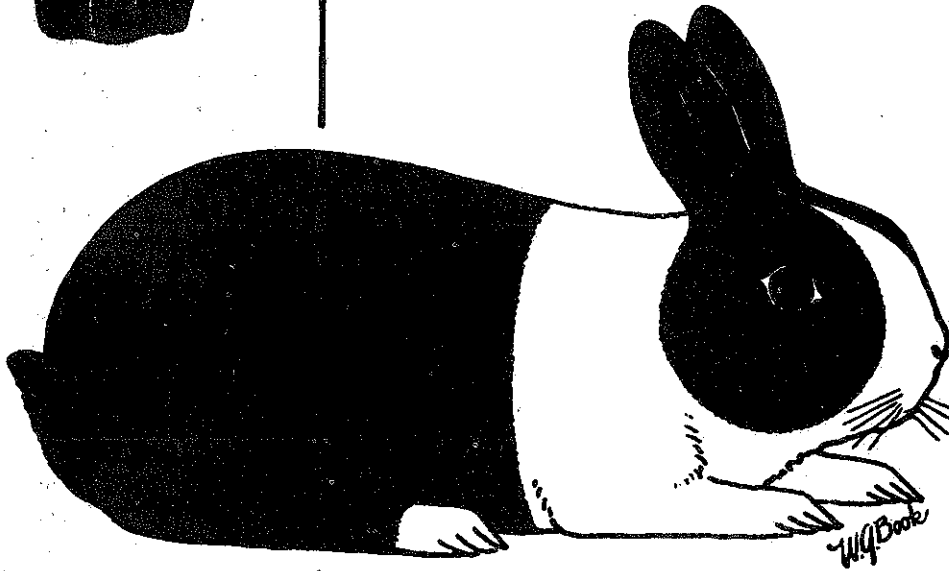

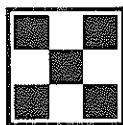

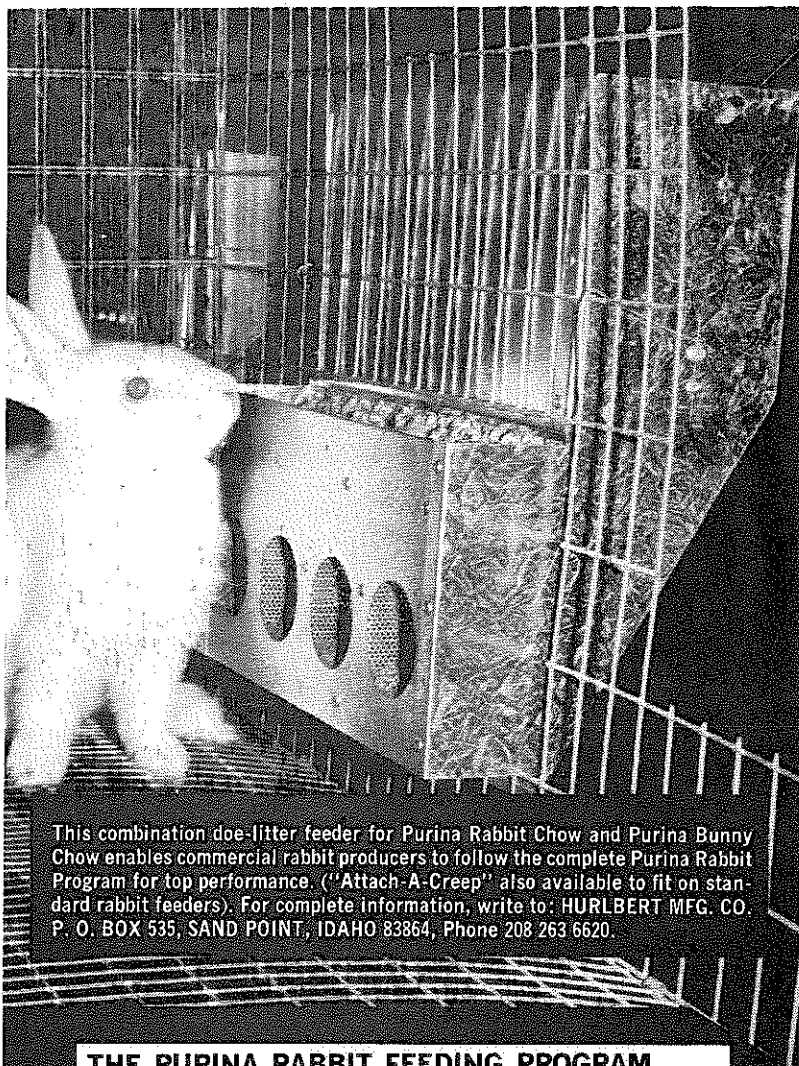

American Dutch Rabbit Club-Board of Directors Meeting, Rochester, Mn.

April 26, 1974. Called to order by President Mike Stinehelfer at * 8:30 P.M. Attending were, Pres. Stinehelfer, and Mrs. Stinehelfer. Vice-President, Roger Guetschow, Sec.-Treas. Doris Leibel. Directors, Roger Eich and Mrs. Eich, Lynn Cooper, Tom Shufflebotham and Don Reid.

Don Reid moved that we dispense with the reading of the minutes, they were published. Seconded by Lynn Cooper. carried.

Report of Officers: Secretary's Report,

1. Wants to discuss the work load of the secretary. Explore the possibility of splitting the jobs and of course the income. Help isn't too plentiful in local area.
2. Discussion on N.S.F. checks
3. Response of advertising coding in Domestic Rabbits 7 to 3 in Countryside.
4. Finally received our charter after one of Directors hadn't renewed ARBA dues, for the second time. However this Director called to wish every one well and report on the request of Tony Rast to institute the Gold Dutch standard.
5. Diane Ford had been contacted regarding our choice for Dutch Judge at Ventura. We also had received a letter from Elmer Paquette offering the California Dutch Club services regarding ARBA Dutch Club Banquet, breed chairman and Booth help etc.
6. There had been a request for cost of life membership in the Dutch Club.
7. Do we want to consider making Dutch Club displays available for local club promotion? Request on file.
8. A letter from Harry Rice was read regarding his inability to fulfill his judging assignment. The decision was made to replace him with Darrell Bramhall who was next in line in the election for judges.
9. Discussion on Convention bids for the National Dutch Show. Three bids presented this year.
10. Discussion on ways to promote Dutch in local areas.
11. Dutch Guide Book report.
12. Report on suggested membership list included in ballots there is a printing problem.

13. Mike Stinehelfer announced his appointment of the Election committee. Carl Decker Jr. Chmn. Boyd Gannon and D.M. Raab. Doris Leibel and Roger Eich to be Guide Book Chairmen. etc. The Publicity Committee reports \$1,187.49 on hand as of April 22, 1974.

Unfinished Business: The matter of the N.S.F. check will be handled by Roger Eich.

New Business:

Regarding #1. Clarification of amount of the income to be paid for the various jobs. All mail should go through the office of the Secretary. Don Reid moved that the secretary be given a vote of confidence in the matter of appointing helpers. Roger Guetschow seconded and this carried.

Elmer Hand suggested that no Dutch Club Sanction be given to any club on the N.D.S. dates. Discussion. To be submitted to the Constit. Com.

3. Re: The Dutch Reporter. Cost of publication is constantly rising. The cost of the pictures in the Nov. Dec. issue was \$30.00. Are we ready for a bi-monthly?. A report and discussion on other Speciality Club Bulletins and it would seem all are feeling the cost squeeze. Don Reid called attention to the fact that the Constitution states, one year's subscription to the Dutch Reporter not 12 issues.

Board Meeting cont.

Don Reid moved that the Dutch Reporter be published bi-monthly. Seconded by Lynn Cooper and carried. The Constitution will not be violated.

4. The Secretary showed the back patches and reported the cost would be at this time \$5.00 each. It was felt that this would be too high to carry as a publicity item.
5. Regarding Life memberships, refer to Constitution and By-laws would require a change. Further discussion needed.

Re: Dutch displays at local shows. Board feels that cost would be prohibitive.

Don Reid told of the Flemish pelt contest idea. This could add interest to Dutch activity, pertaining to color only. Discussion. No entry fee - Publicity Department could finance. Could be an asset to the booth. Don Reid moved we have a tanned hide contest for the next show. \$5.00 for each variety to winner. Judge for open class to judge the hide class.. Clarification, Class for tanned hides in six classes. No entry fee, winner to receive \$5.00. The tanned hide would not be returned to the owner until beaten. All we'll see is the usable portion of the hide. Seconded by Lynn Cooper and carried.

Re: Gold Dutch, Hearsay from Mr. Griffith that Mr. Rast was discontinuing his efforts to have the gold dutch included in the standard. Don Reid moved that we table the discussion on the Golds, until presented through the proper channels. Following a clarification of the proper channels. Roger Guetschow seconded and this carried.

Discussion on the coding of magazine address of the secretary to evaluate the source of activity.

Don Reid moved that we accept the Publicity Committee report, seconded by Tom Shufflebotham and carried. Prices have to go up on the pedigree books.

Guide Book discussion. It will be printed in St. Cloud. Don Reid reported on the Checker Giant Club printing. The ad costs were compared and we are in line. Be sure to put earnest money down to hold the bid.. Ad prices discussed. Tom Shufflebotham moved that the breeder - booster ads be \$5.00, seconded by Lynn Cooper and carried. Don Reid cast a dissenting vote with the observation that we had appointed a committee to handle these details and we would not want to be in disagreement with authority given. The secretary commented that the Board should be in agreement. Don Reid moved that we give the Guide Book Committee a vote of confidence, seconded by Tom Shufflebotham and carried.

On awarding the National Dutch Show. Don Reid suggested that we hold it to two years in advance. Don Reid moved that we accept the Texas bid for 1975, The Eastern Dutch Fanciers for 1976 and that we would consider the bid from the Washington group for 1977 if presented properly. Seconded by Tom Shufflebotham and carried.

Mike Stinehelfer read the letter from Elmer Paquette offering the services of the California Dutch Club in helping out with Dutch details at Ventura. Don Reid suggested that we place the details of the Dutch work in the hands of the California Dutch Club.

Lynn Cooper moved we adjourn, seconded by Tom Shufflebotham and carried. Time, 10:30 P.M.

The young rabbit is nominated with a fee of \$1.00. You are gambling that it will turn out well. The second month another payment is made. or if the rabbit does not turn out as you think it should it can be dr dropped, but forfeit the payment so far.

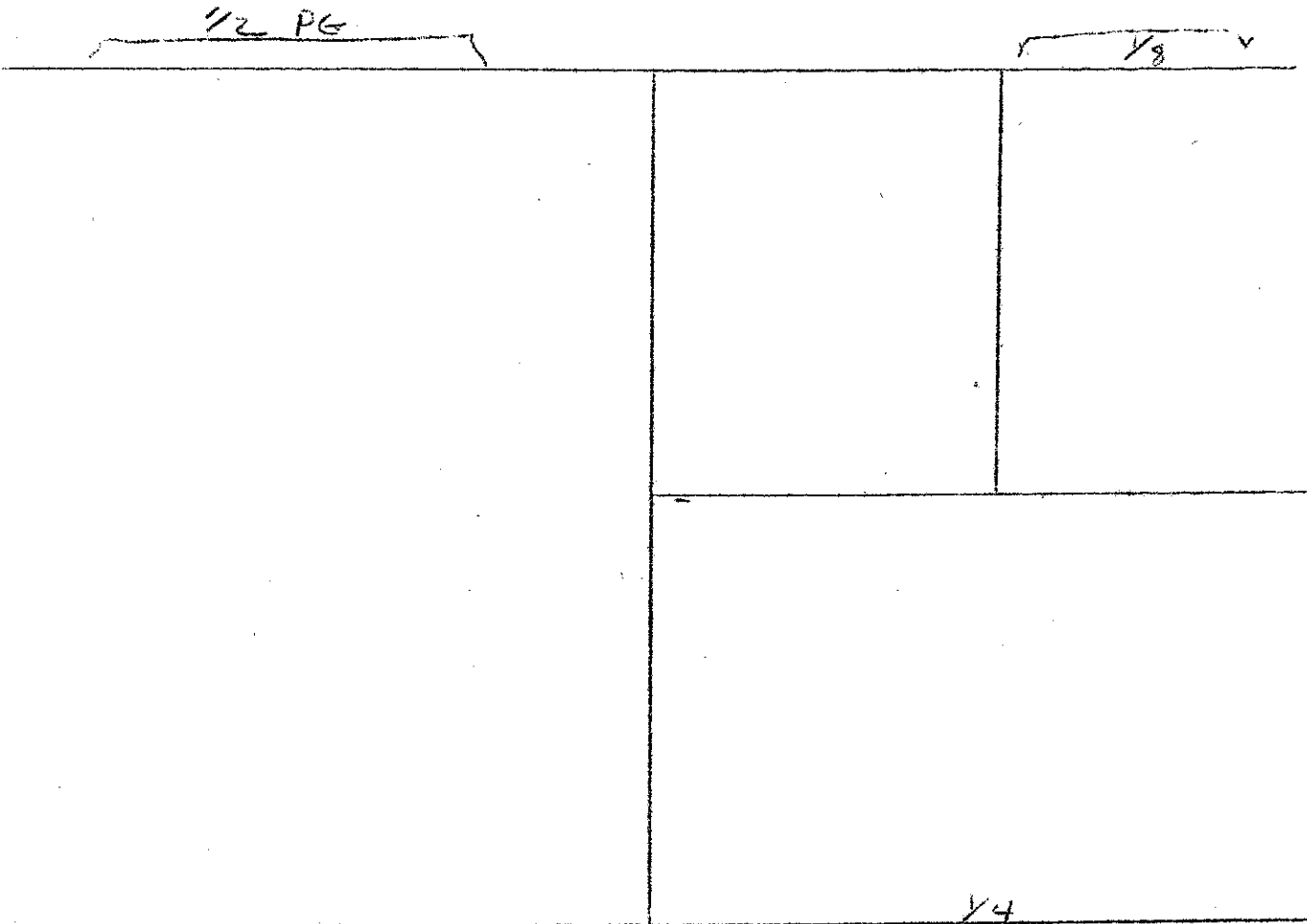

Nominations for this award must include a show record giving the number of animals in competition. This can give the small raiser an opportunity to gain recognition for work well done, because it will not be the number of points garnered, but the winner, that "cuts the mustard". The ability of the raiser to maintain condition and quality.

Al Seeman has been and is a credit to the Dutch Fancy. Let's see if we are "big" enough in our thinking to honor others that have done a good job of promoting the "BEAUTIFUL DUTCH" by their good will and by the example that they set.....Doris

It seems that this past summer has been difficult for all of us and once more the work is starting to move out.

I am in the process of cutting back on the number of rabbits that we have been supporting. Two breeds have all ready been phased out, there are three breeds to go.

When I first started with this office one could plan on a bit of a let up over the summer months, but not so this year, the work keeps piling up and the battle is being fought. In visiting with a good friend recently, I commented that we had to keep the grass roots of this rabbit activity green or the top would die out, meaning that we had to keep the rabbit activity going on the local level as well as the national front. He gave me an answer that will stick with me to the effect that the new Dutch raiser going to the shows all over the country needs communication with each other. It hit me that I haven't been seeing the trees for the forest. I have been so determined to build rabbit activity in my own area, that too much time has been given in this aspect of the over all picture. Now we are at the point here that the new raisers are active and doing a good job. Most of them are on their second and third year and that is a good sign. Our youth activity, through the 4-H has broadened to include ARBA rules etc. in showing activity, we have reached a meeting point, as it were.

There have been those that have acoused me of not "caring" but if I did not "care" I wouldn't have taken this job in the first place. There would have been many times I would have given it up, but, am still "plugging" along.

I have been asked if I was a candidate for reelection. After a good deal of soul searching and a good hard look at what activities I will have to give up in order to do a good job in the rabbit world, I say "YES" I will be a candidate for reelection and I place myself in your hands.
