It looks as though the money was pretty well distributed for winners. Louise & Lester Johnson got plumb greedy in the blacks as well as having the Best Dutch. Congratulations to them.

There were 115 Torts, second only to the blacks. We only needed 12 to tie them. That beats 92 Torts we had at Malakoff, Texas.

There was also an outstanding youth show, ably judged by Oren Reynolds. The Best in show was won by Lori Snodgrass.

The 1982 National Dutch Show was awarded to the Kansas Dutch Club. If you were at the last one they put on, I don't have to tell you how good it was.

The temperature has been in the 90's and I know you have heard this before, but take good care of thost those rabbits: plenty of water and protection from the sun. Also remember, some bucks saved now may save you from missed litters when breeding to older bucks that are sometimes sterile. Watch that feed. A Dutch fattens very easily and a fat doe is hard to settle. Also remember that a plastic bottle full of ice may save that doe who is kindling. If you haven't done so, right now cull every questionable individual. The price of feed alone is a good reason not to carry any marginal rabbits over and especially going through the summer with them is a waste of time and money.

Our next big show will be the ARBA convention at Syracuse.

### BREEDER PROFILE

We became interested in rabbits when a stray Black Dutch came to our back yard and stayed. After a while he would leave via the driveway each morning and come hopping across the patio to eat each evening, with the regularity that people go to and from their jobs. After a few months he did not return, and we missed him so we bought a pair of Black Dutch which we still have.

Arnold found the rabbits such a refreshing release from the tension of his work with computer systems design and programming, that soon we were raising French Lops, more Dutch, and Mini Lops. Besides feeding and caring for the rabbits and building cages, he can become engrossed in all the various magazines and other written material about rabbits. In the last three years, he has acquired a great deal of 'rabbit education' through reading and experience.

Arnold has written computer programs for processing and recording such informatic as pedigree records, doe performance reports, and buck performance reports. We have our office in our home, and this seems to be the most fun part of his work.

Our rabbits are housed in wire cages attached to a wood fence along the east side of our back yard and in wire stack cages with drop pans under a 10' X 20' aluminum patic cover attached to the east side of our garage. We use tarps and clear plastic sheeting to protect them in the winter, and some fans to keep them cooler in the summer. We use Fine-X feeders and ball waterers with ½ gallon soda bottles.

An active market exists for our rabbits both as pets and as breeding stock, but our biggest reward is the rabbits themselves. The Black Dutch are still amoung our favorites because of their diverse personalities. Although some are very nonchalant, one little buck always dances around the cage with his tail in the air when he sees Arnold; one of the does is a good communicator — she runs toward the person she sees to get her attention, then runs over to her feeder when she is hungry, and she will repeat this process several times unless she is fed immediately. Some of the other Dutch really demand and appreciate attention. We do not have children, but it is easy to see that some of the Dutch, French Lops or Mimi Lops would make great pets for children.

We have not shown our rabbits, but we plan to do this in the future. We would like to attend and support more shows.

# American Dutch Rabbit Club Minutes of 1981 Board of Directors Meeting

Champaign, IL

May 1, 1981

The ADRC Board of Directors meeting was called to order at 8:00 pm at the show room of the 1981 National Dutch Show, held at Champaign Illinois, May 1st, 1981. All officers were present with the exception of Directors Eich and Lovejoy. Also attending were Al & Barb Butler and R.C. Farrill. Director Eich arrived at 10:00.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read, and there was a motion made by Watters, seconded by S. Williamson that they be approved as read. Carried.

### Office Reports:

Vice-President Scott Williamson reported that the interest in rabbits in general and Dutch in particular, due to their size and challange, was good in his area. He reported that the Illinois Dutch Club was going very well, with a strong membership.

Director Geitzenaur reported that the Eastern area is doing well. There is a shortage of good breeding stock, and there also seems to be many old timers that are returning to Dutch.

Director Wierman reported that the Dutch seem to be down a bit in the Chic area, possibly due to higher costs, and the periodic cycles that rabbits go through. He also mentioned a concern about the ADRC payback for best of each variety is usually less than the entry fee.

Director Wilbur Williamson reported that the Dutch entries varied in his area, depending upon the individual show. Again a lack of good breeding stock was mentioned. He also reported a strong growth in 4H youths with Dutch rabbits. He said that there is a strong interest in rabbits in general.

Director Watters reported that although the southern entries in many breeds are down from what they had been, that the Dutch were still number 1! He said that breeders were getting fussier about which shows to attend, picking out the ones that were most attractive to them. He also reported the attendance of several Southern breeders in attendance at theis NDS.

Secretary-Tresurer Bengtson reported the recent postal rate increase has really uped the costs of mailing the sweepstakes ribbons and the guidebooks to members. The membership seems to be holding well, with 699 ballots for nomination being sent cut.

President Brady reported that the Texas entries were down, along with the rest of the Southwest area. He also brought up the fact of the large mail order companies carrying a line of rabbit equipment signaled the overall general rise in rabbits and would probably help the industry.

### Committee Reports:

The Publicity committee, Al & Barb Butler reported that the sales at Milwaukee were excellent. The noted the higher costs of mailing items due to the postal raise, raise. They reported that they have a double booth for the convention at New York. They also reported that they have added the new ARBA book of standards to their offering.

Standards committee: R.C.Farrill reported that the committee had nothing pending at this time.

Youth Committee: Wilbur Williamson reported that he had been working trying to solicit youth activity, and interest, but was receiving few answers. He and Jack Wireman presented the resolution to the Board concerning a youth membership for the ADRC. (See old business)

Guidebook Committee: Bengtson reported that we have received some advertising, but needed more to make the book a success. It has been delayed due to his not being able to devote the necessary amount of time towards it. We still have a good supply of the cld guidebook, but we still need to get this book out because of the age of the old book.

Board of Directors meeting minutes continued:

Old business:

The National Dutch Show bid of the Kansas Dutch Club was considered, and a motion was made by Wireman, seconded by S. Williamson that they be awarded the 1981 NDS, to be held in Hutchinson, Kansas. Motion carried.

The Youth membership resolution was brought up and considered. After discussion, a motion was made by Bengtson, seconded by Watters that the Board of Directors would go on record as supporting the resolution. Motion carried. The resolution reads as follows, as ammended by the board, "In the By-laws, Article 1, add Subparagraph B as follows: "All junior members of the American Dutch Rabbit Club shall pay dues at the rate of \$2.00 (two dollars) less per year than a single adult membership. They will retain all priviledges as adults except voting. A junior member shall be difined as being a youth under the age of 18 years, on the date of applying for membership." This resolution will be placed on the final election ballot during 1981 elections.

Mew Business:

The statement on the nomination ballots concerning the not voting for officers residing in the listed states was considered. After discussion there was a motion by Eich, seconded by Wireman, that the additional words be added: "unless advancing a present officer of one of the states listed to a higher office." Motion carried. There was a motion to adjourn the meeting by Roger Eich. Motion carried, the Board Meeting was adjourned at 10:00 pm.

Minutes of the General Membership meeting of the ADRC, 1981 NDS.

The meeting of general membership was opened by President Brady, at the 1981 NDS, held in Champaigne Illinois, on May 2, 1981. All officers were present except for Director Lovejoy. President Brady thanked the Illinois Dutch Club for presenting a fine National Dutch Show.

President Brady called for a reading of the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting. There was a motion by Butler, seconded by Wayne Willmann that the reading of the minutes of the previous membership meeting be dispensed with, as they had been published in the Duthe Reporter. Motion carried. President Brady then asked the auditing committee of Wenton Carlton and Elmer Guetschow report on the books. They reported that the books were in order the thefinal balances had not been totaled. They suggested that the auditing of the books be changed to be done only once a year, and that it be done on a calendar year basis.

There was a cash collection taken for the next show, with \$141.02 being collected, from members in attendance at the NDS banquet.

Al Butler spoke on the booths for Syracuse, and the publicity committees activities. They reported theat they had some tanned hides in Tortoise, but would like to receive some well tanned hides in the other colors too, for use in the publicity booths.

Les Johnson, of Kansas was introduced, and invited everyone to attend the 1982 National Dutch Show in Kansas. He reported that they had about 500 coops, all of which were permanantly set up, and that the facilities were good.

President Brady asked if there was anything else for the good of the order, and when there was not, the meeting was adjourned.



The advertising total as of today June 1, 1981 is \$747.50 now, I quote from the March April issue of the 1976 DUTCH REPORTER:

The final cost of the guidebook came to \$2,319.82 including tax. The printer stayed within their bid price, even though it took us almost a year for completion. This price is higher than we had originally figured but the increase in cost is due to the increased size of the book. Because we had so much advertising, we had to expand the size of the book proportionally. The advertising totaled \$1,632.50, so the cost of the book to the club came to \$687.32. This figures out to be 77% per copy full price, or 23¢ per copy after subtracting advertising. The club was able to put out a nice product at a reasonable cost only because the membership gave their full backing to the project. Over 1/5 of the members helped out with their advertising, which from what I have heard of other publications of this sort, is fantastic. It might interest you to know that the last guidebook (1969) cost the club \$796.34 after advertising is subtracted, or a cost of 38¢ per book printed. So after 6 years of inflation & rising costs, we were able to get our new book for less money, (including 24 pages of additional copy) because YOU CARED ENOUGH TO SUPPORT YOUR CLUB. See how easy it is to be successful when we (I think that says it all! Doreen) all work together, THANKS AGAIN.
