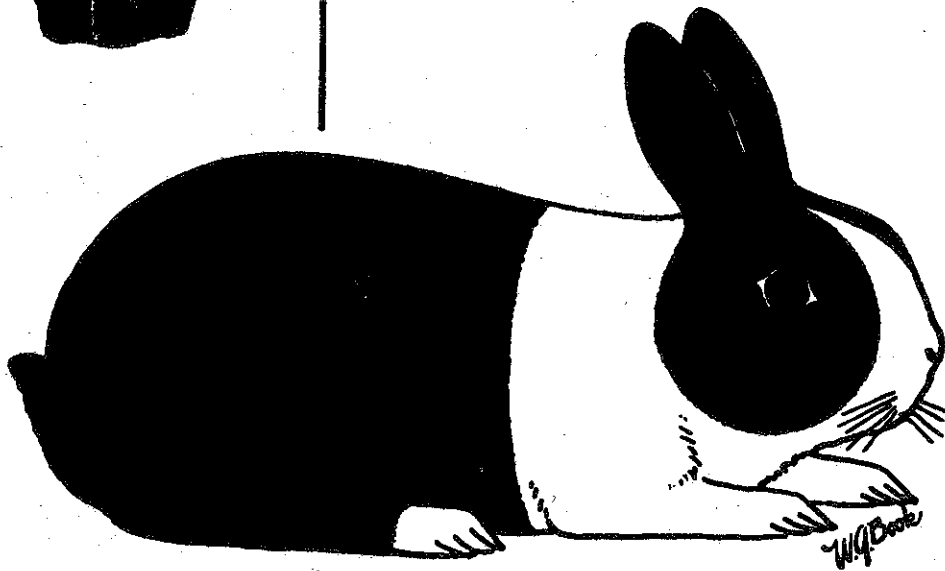

The show got underway as planned and before you knew it, the judging was completed and the Seller's Class was in progress! It left plenty of time for the visiting that there usually isn't time for! My congratulations to Dick Evenburg and Kay Stearns of Indiana. They have some real "knock-out" Dutch and their wins were sure no surprise to me. They're also pretty special people and I'm proud to call them two of my "Best Friends"! My congratulations to all of the winners, and to the rest of us, there's always next year!!

Marti Dill did an outstanding job with the Youth Achievement Contest and Quiz Bowl! I know that Marti has put alot of time and effort (not to mention money) into these projects and she deserves a big "THANK YOU"! Marti is a dedicated Dutch breeder and enjoys working with the youth. Daffy Dills Rabbitry is also included on my list of special people,.....and I've got a long list!!!!

Now it's onward to Ohio for the '86 ARBA Convention and then to Texas for the 1987 National Dutch Show. I'm looking forward to both of these events. Just maybe I'll have one "nice" one to take along for the ride!

I would like to apologize for the delay that some of you experienced in your correspondence to this office immediately following the NDS. On May 6th., I received a call from the school saying that my son was injured in P.E. and they needed permission to transport him to a nearby hospital. He is now the recipient of a full arm cast! (Being right handed, I don't have to tell you which hand it was!). On May 7th., my father suffered heart failure and was admitted to the intensive care unit. The mail continued to build up, but my only concern was with my family. God willing, and a top-notch cardiologist, he is coming along just fine! What more can you ask for? In any case, I've spent yesterday and today going non-stop to catch up on the "bushel basket" of mail that had been set aside! I've just about got it!! Material for publication in the Dutch Reporter should have been to Dianne by the 18th. Needless to say it is getting mailed on the 19th. Even though it is all typed and ready for the stencil cutter, it makes Dianne's job rough when it's not in on time. I would like to thank her for her understanding.

The nomination ballots were sent to the Election Chairperson for opening and counting. As of April 27th., we had a total membership of 736. Of this count, 228 were youth. I find it "very hard" to believe that "ONLY" 94 ballots were received in this office!!!!!! We received 25 ballots from the membership that were able to vote only for Vice-President and ARBA and NDS judges; 10 ballots were received from District #1; 6 ballots from District #2; 19 ballots from District #3; 16 ballots from District #5; and 8 ballots from District #7. Three ballots were received after the May 15th. deadline and 1 was received from an individual that was ineligible to vote, therefore making a total of 4 void ballots. For our membership's information, as the ballots came in, the outer envelope was checked to make certain that it contained the member's name and complete address. The name was then run through to be sure that the ballot was from an eligible voting member. The envelope was then placed in an envelope according to district as determined by the address. The outer envelope was removed. Those members that had a return address that didn't allow them to vote for a Director were placed in a separate envelope with the outer envelope removed. Those return addresses that determined that you were a youth member were placed in yet another envelope. After the May 15th. deadline, the ballots were packaged and sent to the Election Chairman. When the ballot envelopes are opened, the Election Committee may find spoiled ballots if you voted for a Director outside your District, etc. I'm not certain, but it seems to me that this is the least amount of nomination ballots cast since I have been in office! I have heard many remarks regarding the new Director by District! (You have to have at least five votes to be eligible for the office of Director (10 for Vice-President). I'm uncertain what happens if there isn't enough votes to place a candidate on the ballot for any certain District?) Some of those that I have spoken with feel that as a member they should be allowed to vote for all offices without any district divisions. However, it was voted on last year, passed and went into effect. If you have any questions, suggestions, or would just like to voice your opinion, please put your comments in the form of an article and send them to the Dutch Reporter Editor for publication. Regardless, the fact remains that "very few" members participated in the election. This is your club!! Please exercise "your" right to voice "your" opinion and vote for the party of "your" choice!!

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

1986 NATIONAL DUTCH SHOW, MAY 2-4, 1986
DES MOINES, IOWA

President Williamson called the meeting to order at 9:10 P.M. with nine Officers answering roll. Those present were: President Williamson, Vice-President Wireman, Directors Eich, Dietrich, Billups, Carlton, Geitzenauer and Williamson, and Secretary/Treasurer Hart.

A motion was made by Jack Wireman and seconded by Roger Eich that we dispense with the reading of the minutes from the last meeting as they were published in the Dutch Reporter. MC

Secretary Hart gave some statistics on the memberships and sanctions processed this year through April 28, 1986. There have been 215 memberships processed with that broken down to: 33 Renewal and 35 New Youth Memberships; 19 Renewal and 8 New Husband/Wife Memberships; 80 Renewal and 40 New Single Adult Memberships. There were 296 sanctions processed with 78 being Youth and 218 Open. Total Membership as of April 27, 1986 is 730. The ADRC has 34 judges in their membership.

Director Williamson asked how many members may not have rejoined possibly due to the Guidebook not being out on time. President Williamson stated that it was uncertain how many did not renew due solely to the Guidebook delay and said that we should look forward rather than dwell in the past. Director Carlton stated that some of the new members get discouraged with the difference in judging and may possibly cease membership.

Secretary Hart gave a current copy of the financial status of the American Dutch Rabbit Club to each Board member. A financial report was given with the total funds available as \$7005.10. The audit committee gave their report and found the books to be in order and current. A financial statement of the Dutch Reporter account was also submitted to the audit committee. Jack Wireman made a motion seconded by William Geitzenauer that we accept the audit committee's report. MC

Lowell Simonson and Dale Zentner met with the Board on the judge assignments using three judges for open and one for youth. They stated that they would like the Seller's Class held on Saturday if at all possible. It was decided that many would not be able to participate if it was held over until Sunday morning.

Al Butler gave a report on the Publicity Department and stated that sales in Houston were way down. This may have been partially due to the fact that the Dutch booth was quite a distance from the breed. There was discussion regarding photos of the publicity items being taken for publication in the D.R. or in pamphlet form. Many members do not know what the merchandise looks like. A Publicity Department financial report was submitted for D.R. publication.

President Williamson stated that we still need a Constitution and By-Laws and Guidebook Chairman. If anyone is willing to take on either of these responsibilities they should notify President Williamson or a Board member.

The Dutch Reporter Editor has been in contact with a party in regard to publishing our bi-monthly newsletter the D.R. However, the cost of such would be doubled and we would still need an editor to assemble and type what is to be printed.

Discussion took place regarding the mimeograph. There have been some problems with the one we now have. There was also some thoughts given in regards to copy machines. However, the cost of a copier would be quite high. Director Eich stated that the editor is a very important part of the Dutch Reporter and we may not gain anything by sending it out to a professional. The Board agreed to table the idea at this time and look into other possibilities. President Williamson advised that his wife would continue the responsibility of the Editor's job until a suitable replacement could be found.

Director Dietrich gave a report on the Seller's Class. Wenton Carlton made a motion, seconded by Roger Eich that only three unit entries per person will be allowed for the Seller's Class. This can be three individual rabbits or three trios. The Seller's Class Committee will reserve the right to disallow an entry and give an entry deadline. MC

Vice-President Wireman stated that he wrote an article for the D.R. concerning the membership committee and suggests that each member try to recruit a new member. President Williamson said that we may want to give some thought to a membership contest. However, this would be an extra load on someone taking on this job. This was tabled at this time.

UNFINISHED OR OLD BUSINESS: NONE

NEW BUSINESS:

A bid for the 1987 National Dutch Show was presented by the Texas Dutch Rabbit Club for April 3-5, 1987 in Euless, Texas. Roger Eich made a motion, seconded by Jack Wireman that their bid be accepted. MC

Vice-President Wireman had some questions regarding the way the Dutch are judged as per our Guidebook and the ARBA Standard of Perfection. President Williamson suggested that he contact the Standard Committee Chairman regarding this issue. Vice-President Wireman also asked for a donation of a pair of Dutch for the Research and Development raffle at the '86 ARBA Convention in Ohio. Director Dietrich promised one quality Dutch for this event.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Director Eich and seconded by Director Carlton. MC

Marti Dill gave a report on the youth committee. She stated that the youth were a real energetic group and she has received help from many with the youth program. She stated that the Achievement Contest should have three divisions rather than the two now available. This is due to the wide age span. She said that some of the questions weren't appropriate for seven year olds. President Williamson acknowledged Marti Dill's work with the youth and also stated that she took the ADRC Guidebook and made it a reality. He expressed the sincere thanks from each member of the American Dutch Rabbit Club and Marti Dill was applauded for her efforts.

Director Dietrich gave a report on the Seller's Class and stated that it would be held immediately following judging, time permitting. He stated that he would accept entries until 2 PM. He stated that only quality animals should be entered and the committee reserved the right to limit the entry. Only three units per person would be allowed and a pedigree must accompany the rabbit/s.

The National Dutch Show Committee expressed their thanks for all those coming and wished everyone a good time. They expressed their hope to have the show and Seller's Class completed and the showroom closed by 5PM. The banquet will be at 6:30PM with a trophy presentation afterward. The Committee also expressed that they would appreciate it if adults would watch the the youth judging from the bleachers provided rather than in the youth area. They stated that the NDS Secretary, Eric Mixdorf has done much work towards this NDS and they wished to recognize him for his efforts.

Secretary Hart was then asked to read the minutes of the Executive Session. A motion was made and seconded that they be approved as read. MC

President Williamson stated that the Texas Dutch Rabbit Club would be the hosts for the 1987 NDS and asked for donations.

Al Butler gave a Publicity Department report and stated that it would be published in the Dutch Reporter.

Jack Wise discussed the '87 NDS. He stated that everything will be in the motel. There were no room rates available at this time but they should be reasonable. The showroom/motel is 7½ miles from the airport. There is also limousine service to and from the airport to bring your rabbits in. Six Flags over Texas is only approximately 12 miles away. The Texas Dutch Rabbit Club is planning on some excellent specials. The banquet will be a good ole' Texas BBQ that should be enjoyed by all!

Vice-President Wireman gave a report on the Ohio Convention. The Ohio Dutch Rabbit Club is your breed chairpeople for this event and they wish to invite everyone to come on down!

President Williamson gave the entry report for the '86 NDS: There were 464 Open entries and 167 Youth, with a total of 631. This is the largest entry for any NDS!

There being no further business, Mickey Farrill made motion to adjourn seconded by Alan Miller. MC

Without the participation and efforts of all of the above, the "Seller's Class" would not be possible!!

Well here it is, the middle of April. In Minnesota the snow is gone, the rabbits are all in molt (mine also) and the National Dutch Show in Iowa is only two weeks away. But worrying about it won't make their fur improve any quicker. As long as I am on the subject of fur, maybe what works for me, may work for someone else. As I mentioned in my last article, I have clean fresh water and lots of it available at all times. It seems to make a difference in their fur. Also cleanliness can't be stress enough--a clean pen, water and feeders. Even the hair that floats around the inside of a building collects dust that the rabbits must breath. Unemptied pans or dropping pans will add ammonia to the air. Ventilation helps, but you still have the odor and fumes in an unclean place. Cleanliness!! Cleanliness!!! I can not say or stress it enough. I have never seen a rabbitry too clean.

Let's stop and put our selves in this position, you are locked in one room, waste, dirt, and bad air. Think what it would do to you mentally. As we all know rabbits are basically very clean. The mental breakdown of a dirty, uncared for pen, dishes, pans, etc. must be devastating to them. Then we load them up in the middle of the night, drive them 200 miles or more to a show, and can't understand why another rabbit that was not marked as well or didn't have better type beat us. But look again at the first place rabbit's condition, color and fur. Remember it is not just what they eat and drink that keeps them in condition, but the conditions where they live and the air they breath. I have placed well many times with a poorly marked rabbit that was in good condition and lost as many times because "I failed the rabbit" not because the "rabbit failed me!"

IN SEARCH OF NUMBER ONE

by Phil Shivers

When getting a large litter, I have found my does separating the bunnies into two different places in the nest box. By watching her closely, I have found that she feeds first on one side then the other. However, if I put them all back in one spot in the nest box, I would lose one or two bunnies. So I cut a piece of 1" x 2" to place across the floor of the nest box if its a large litter and the doe seperates the bunnies. I place the 1 x 2 in the box so the bunnies can not get back together. Also I divide the bunnies for size so the larger, stronger ones remain together and give the smaller of the litter an equal chance. I also never cull the nest box because of marking or color. I have found that by letting nature take its course, I end up with a rabbit with a better all around immune system. Try this and let me know how it works for you.

TYPE **FIRST CLASS**

TO BE COBBY IN TYPE, COMPACT IN FORM AND LIMB. GOOD DUTCH TYPE CONSISTS OF A NICELY ROUNDED BACK, BEGINNING ALMOST IMMEDIATELY BEHIND THE HEAD AND PROGRESSING OVER THE SHOULDERS, LOIN AND RUMP TO TAIL. SHOULDERS SHOULD BE ROUNDED AND SLIGHTLY NARROWER AND LOWER THAN HIPS. RIB SPREAD SHOULD BE SO THAT THE SIDE LINES CARRY STRAIGHT THROUGH FROM THE SHOULDERS TO THE HIPS. A GOOD DUTCH SHOULD HAVE NICELY ROUNDED HIPS, VERY SMOOTH, ROUNDED UNDER VERY GRADUALLY AND SMOOTHLY. THE DUTCH SHOULD RETAIN THE COBBY, STOCKY APPEARANCE WHETHER IT WEIGHS 3½ POUNDS OR 5½ POUNDS.
