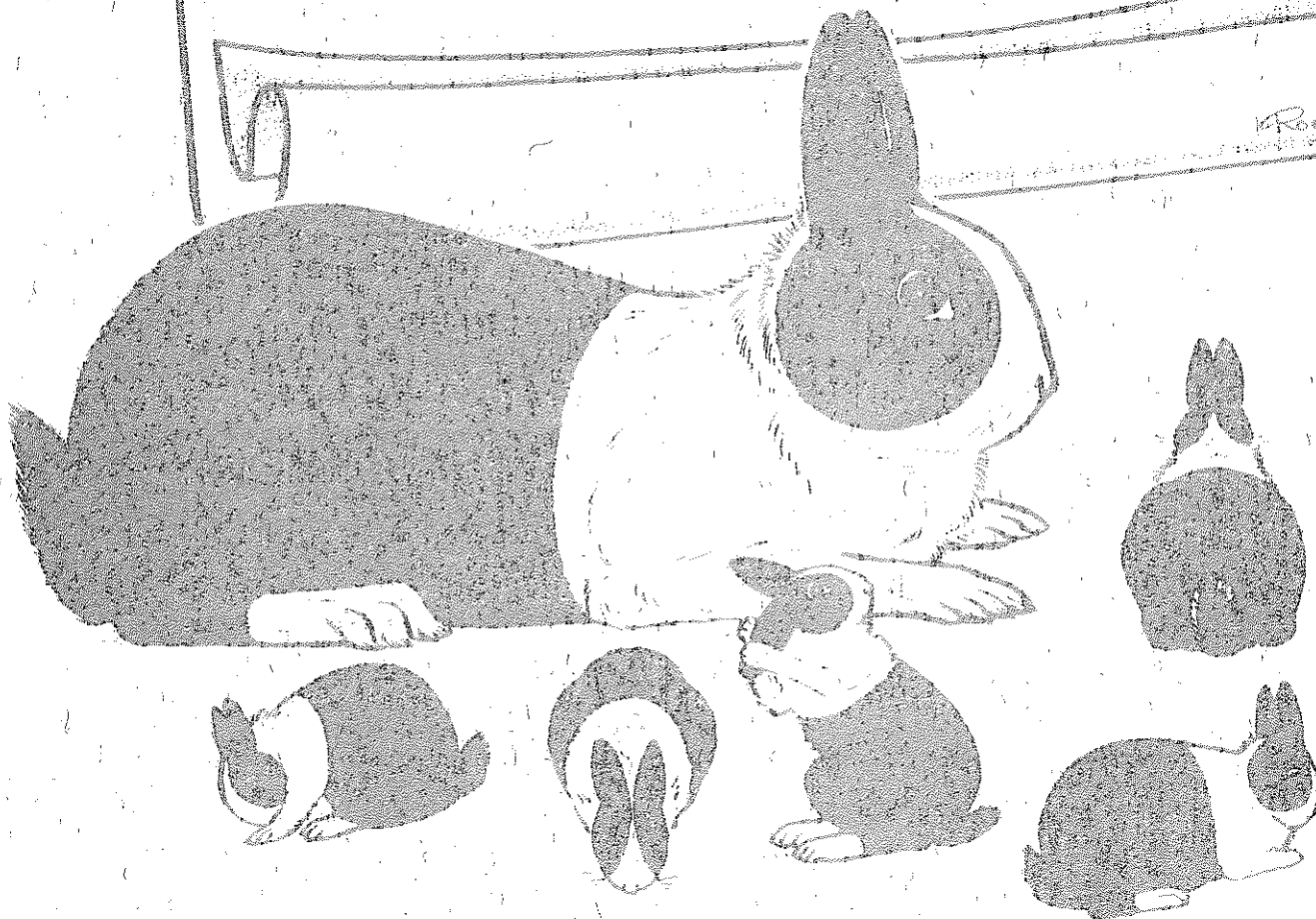

As you will note, the 1953-54 One Day Show Series has ended. Congratulations to the winners of our First One Day Show series. I would like to point out an unusual circumstance here. This is, the two trophy winners live in the same city, Beaumont, Texas. It is rather unusual too, that three of the first four high in number of points are residents of the same state-----; the Big State, Texas. We sanctioned twenty One Day Sweepstake Shows in this series. With the exception of two or three, these shows were well attended, and the number of Dutch exhibited was excellent.

You received a form for sending your ad to Mr. L. E. Settle to be placed in our new Guide Book. These ads are very reasonably priced - and I am sure you can find one whose space fills your requirements. Large or small, try to send an ad for the Dutch Guide Book. This book will be published with the proceeds from advertising, so it is very obvious that your ad is needed. We shall again have a membership list printed in this new Guide Book. The list will contain names of members in good standing at the time the book goes to press. So please make a note of this, and keep in good standing, as I am sure all of us want to be included in this list.

Some members may want to have a picture used in their ads in the Guide Book. All cuts must be furnished by the advertiser. If you have a picture you wish to use, and do not have a cut made of the picture, Mr. Settle can have the cut made for you at your expense. Write to him about this matter.

I wish all of our members could have been at the A.R.B.A. Convention at York. It is easy to forget in these busy days; however, I am doing my best here to send out reminders.

The Dutch Show Report of the Convention Show was printed in the last issue of the Dutch Reporter. As our publisher already had the issue ready to go out, she at my request, was kind enough to "pull" some pages out of that issue and insert the Convention News. There was not space to include the Sweepstake points on this show, and the name of the winner of the big \$75.00 Dutch Pot. Here it is: Mr. Henry Parasczewski of Wilmington, Delaware was the winner of the pot. He won this pot with 239 points. Best Dutch was you by one of our "old-timers", Chas. O. Lewis of Roslyn Heights, N.Y. but Charlie did not make the "news" headlines with his winning, as we expect "Chas O. Lewis" to be right in there winning, year after year. If he has any kind of cooperation from the weather man on conditioning his Dutch fur - he has the Dutch to win. Remember, Mr. Lewis was so close to winning Best Dutch at the 1953 Convention that he had Best Opposite Dutch. Congratulations, Mr. Lewis. The Best Opposite Dutch honors went to Dr. Galle E. Fissum, of Dayton, Ohio. Congratulations, again, Dr. Fissum. Doc is always with us pitching at the shows - and has always had his number of wins. Here is an ardent Dutch fan, if there ever was one. Glad to see Fr. Fissum looking well again, after his bout with illness last spring.

I do not like to make "personality" comments in my column - but I know you will excuse this one occasion, and it is an occasion to welcome two well-known "youngsters" into our Club; none other than Mr. John C. Fehr of Indianapolis, Indiana, and Mr. Ed Stahl of Holmes Park, Missouri. These gentlemen are "hep" to trends, and I am glad they saw fit to join the multitude in crying out "You Can't Beat The Dutch."

Several members have inquired as to the date ending the Club's sponsoring the A. O. C. class. At this date, no certain date yet has been set. We have been assured that the Book of Standards to be published will be in print March 1, 1955. Of course when this book comes out, our A. O. C. class goes out, and any previous date would have to come from within our organization. As yet no previous date has been set. So, all we can say, TODAY, is that we are still sponsoring A. O. C.

YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH

WHERE - FROM 1954 CONVENTION?

Some of the "old-timers" say that our Dutch are the best they ever have been, but according to the judges remarks at the A.R.B.A. Convention at York, Pa. we have a long way to go yet, to achieve that goal of the "perfect Dutch".

Although only a few were disqualified, it was noted that judges Shufflebotham and Leisenring almost always had much to say about type and color, such as "too long in body", "rough on rump", "poor color", "peaked head", etc.

From these remarks we can see that we breeders will have to breed closer to the standard and cull more rigidly in order to obtain those "flyers" or near-perfect Dutch for which we are striving.

A quotation from the Belgian Hare Guide Book which might also apply to Dutch is as follows: "Type breeding is the bread and meat necessary for the rabbit to live as a breed, whereas color breeding is the dessert that tops off a full and satisfying meal."*

YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH

COLOR DESCRIPTION OF GRAY DUTCH RABBIT

A uniform clean gray, to be evenly interspersed with black hairs. Ticking to be even over head ears and top of body. Fur to carry distinct ring color when blown into, and free from any brassy and sandy tinge. Avoid any semblance to that of the wild rabbit color. Under color next to skin to be slate blue. Belly to be silvery white in color, free from any sandy or brassy tinge. Disqualify for undercut showing on surface of belly color. Underside of tail to match belly. Top of tail to match body color. Avoid any tendency toward sandiness or brassiness.
