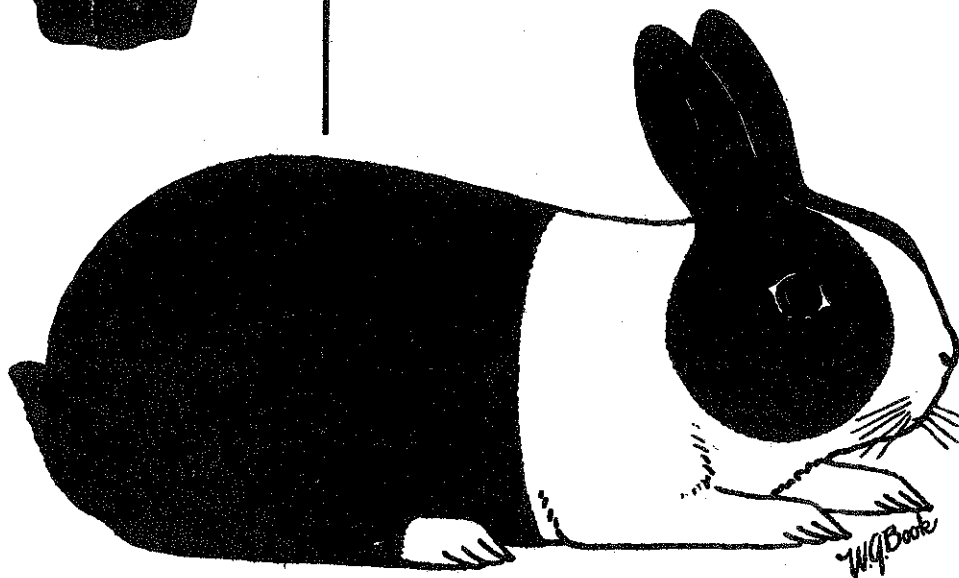

SECRETARY'S CHIT CHAT

Never mind what the date at the top of this page says! This is November News and it is as fresh as the November news in any other magazine.

The 1966 ARBA Convention is history -- and from where I sit it went down the drain. It's a good thing I was psychic and lined up some help ahead of time and then solicited some more on the spot or I don't know what would have happened. We arrived at Louisville and found Don Weeks swamped trying to check in Dutch with only one assistant. We weren't able to do much about that, aside from taking care of our own rabbits. Next morning I found that not only was I expected to take charge of the secretarial work of the judging, but there was no one to take charge of our booth and nothing to put in it except what I had happened to take with me. I solicited the kind services of those old dependables, Art and Helen Osmon to do something to make it look as if we had a booth, which they did and I want to express my deepest appreciation for their help, right here and now. Others who deserve a real big hand from the membership are Barbara and Jim Walker of Columbus who stuck right with us during the day and a half of judging, with Barb taking charge of the judging sheets and Jim carrying rabbits (also tending to most of the feeding and watering chores during the entire Convention), "Mac" Thatcher, Jodie Croker and Mary Stohrer, who also did their share of carrying. Joe Gognat was our "trouble shooter" with the Convention committee, but even he could not prevent or correct one serious problem. One of our judges (Don Lovejoy) failed to appear so Don Reid was faced with the impossible task of trying to run

We did have a Dutch Club dinner on Wednesday night, again thanks to the efforts of the willing Osmon's -- and afterwards talked Dutch and Dutch and more Dutch until the wee small hours.

Again one of our young Dutch breeders as honored by receiving the award of ARBA "King" and I'm sure we can all be proud of Greg Williams of Streator, Illinois.

I'm sure you will receive full coverage of most aspects of the Convention from other sources, but I do wish to compliment Don Reid on the fine effort he put forth for our Dutch in the judges conference. He pointed out a few things that have been needing to be pointed out for some time.
