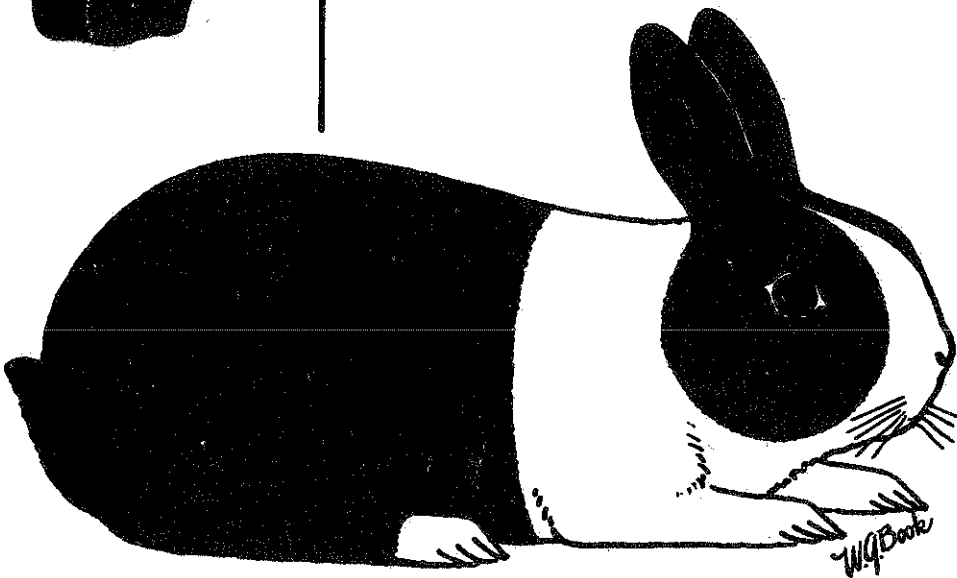

those who thought they had seen about everything. This has happened to us this fall and in talking around we learn that it is not a unique experience, but has been happening in other rabbitries too. We had four young black does that we had saved out of the spring crop for replacements in our herd. They were all about the same age, three being out of one litter, so were bred within ten days to two weeks of each other. The first doe did just fine -- she had seven babies and is raising them all very nicely. The second doe had her litter, also seven, built a nice nest and tucked her babies in snug and warm and laid down beside them and died. The third and fourth does did exactly the same thing. We were able to save most of two of the litters as we had other does bred for about the same time, but we sure would like to know what the cause of this mortality was. We have talked to Dr. Hafs who has the Dutch Rabbitry in the Reproduction Laboratory at Michigan State University and he has had the same experience, sometimes with older does who have produced litters successfully before. He has all rabbits that die under unusual circumstances posted by the Veterinary school and no one has been able to come up with an answer so far. Just another one of those things to file away with the fact of so many does carrying their young way beyond the 28-30 day normal period early this year. They are facts -- they happened but there is no explanation.
