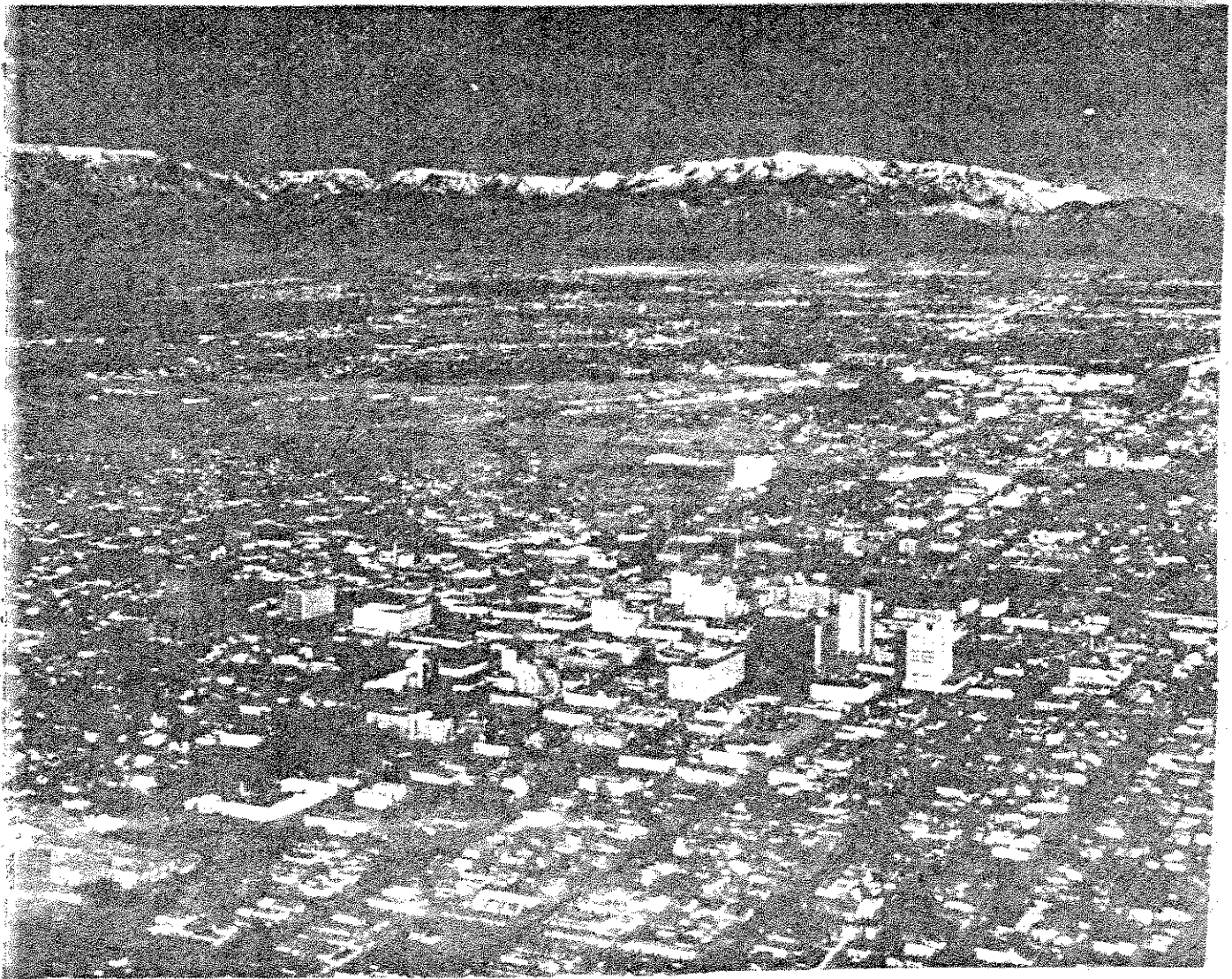

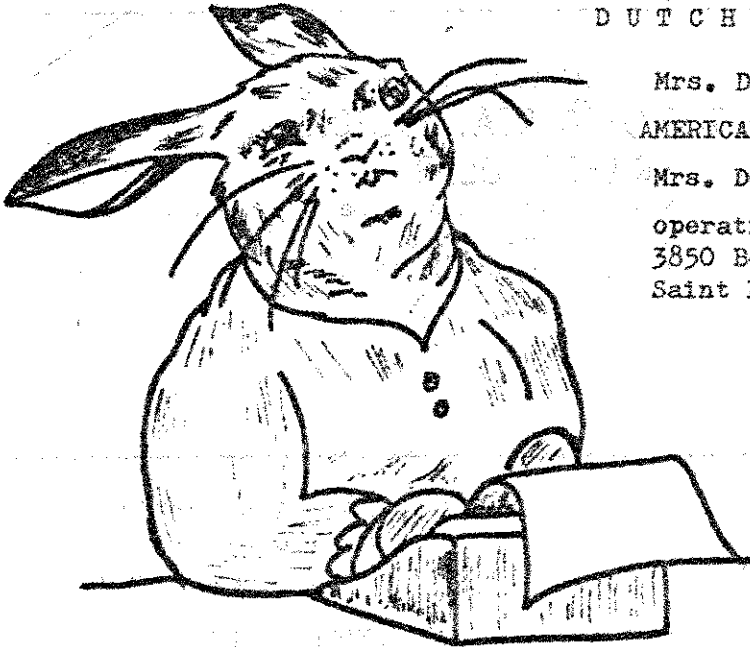

Friends: Well, here we are, at Convention time. This has been a hectic period of time. So much to be learned and much to do. One of the things that I have learned is that one can't be in two places at the same time, yet have managed to attend a few shows and take a few judging assignments. Had a period that saw me a bit behind, but am catching up

once more and it wasn't too bad. For the benefit of our new members, Your Dutch Reporter is sent third class and there have been instances where it has taken a month for delivery. It is not uncommon for it to take three weeks. There is provision for First Class mailing. If you wish your D.R. First Class, please send TWO DOLLARS and your stencil will be placed in the 1st class section of the file.

We now have a stencil count of 613 members and this is up to date. Dutch Showing activity was down at the beginning of my term as your Secretary, but it is slowly on the increase. I feel a "swell" of Dutch Activity, remember, "YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH". Remember, new members are the life blood of any organization and I note an increasing number of new members coming in that have been recommended by existing members.

There will be a financial report at the Convention. I am in the process of replenishing supplies. We are out of ribbons, membership application blanks, membership cards, Dutch Reporter paper and ink are getting low and all of this will change the financial picture.

You will note that the increase in dues did not pass and this will mean that we will have to cut corners where ever possible. Postage is becoming an increasingly larger item. The cost of the Dutch Reporter is on the increase and the question of full show reports may have to be considered once more. We have to discuss incorporating at the Convention Board meeting and this will help on D.R. postage as we will then qualify for non-profit mailing permit.

I am bringing the trophies for the 69-70 and 70-71 series with me to this convention. If I do not hear anything to the contrary in regard to the published standings the trophies will be given out. This will save us in the area of \$40.00 in postage.

Hobby has 'hare-raising' life with lots of good luck

STROUDSBURG — An ability to expertly blend tortoise and hare has helped Carl Decker breed national champions.

The champions are pure rabbit and those with tortoise-colored coat are only one of six classifications, yet raising them is a complex hobby.

It is a task at which Decker, of 935 Clay Ave., excels. He returned from the National Dutch Rabbit Show in Baltimore, Md., last weekend with three of the four top trophies in the show.

His total of 12 trophies for 24 rabbits entered made him, by far, the most successful exhibitor.

Zenith of Patience

The triumphs also represent the zenith of 18 years of patience and diligence, during which he has become a self-

taught geneticist.

It all began in 1952, when Decker was working in the personnel office at Worthington Mower and searching for a hobby which would take his mind off the human problems he dealt with daily.

A fellow employe, Fred Davis, of Cherry Valley, had the answer: Raising and showing rabbits.

Having tried more conventional hobbies such as stamp and coin collecting, Decker was eager for something more unique and soon found rabbit breeding "a tremendous outlet."

Davis started him off, giving him a pair of tortoise-colored Dutch rabbits. A year later, he bought a trio of blue Dutch and a trio of black Dutch from two Ohio breeders known for their success in producing high quality fur.

Since then, he has done almost all his own breeding, rather than relying upon purchases from other breeders.

Success came early. Decker's rabbits won out over 100 others as best of breed in 1953 and 1954 at fairs in Allentown and Reading.

From that point, it has been painstaking process of breeding to strive for near perfection in 11 genetic traits.

With a 31-day gestation period, rabbits would have five litters per year under unchecked conditions. Decker limits this to a semi-annual process to keep his fares in top condition.

Evertime he mates a buck and doe, he is trying to improve at least one trait that will add points when the animal is judged.

FROM THE MAILBAG.....

My daughter ordered a trio of registered Black Dutch. When the papers arrived, we realized they are only pedigrees, not registration papers. The registry number is not filled in. The parents and grandparents have registry numbers. How do we go about obtaining registration numbers for these? Are all registered rabbits just rabbits that have had a pedigree on?

I'm quite confused. Our registered dogs, horses and swine papers are the only thing we're familiar with and they are altogether different than these rabbit pedigrees.

My daughter is a member of the ARBA and also the American Dutch Rabbit Club. Possibly being a member of these clubs is what it takes to register rabbits.

Can you give some answers. Thanks so much for your time.....

Answer by Doris.....

It appears that there is confusion between a pedigreed rabbit and a registered rabbit. This confusion is compounded by breeders that do not realize the difference and advertise registered rabbits when in effect they are only pedigreed. In fact many high priced rabbits are sold with no pedigrees and the new breeder wonders how cum zit... One wonders why good Dutch for example that have umpteen legs for Grand Champion are never graced with the title of GRAND CHAMPION.....I noticed in our publications that Chris Bagge had made a Dutch Grand Champion, "good for you, Chris" Back to the subject:

A pedigreed rabbit is one with a record of its ancestry. A good pedigree is one with color and weight listed along with faults. This pedigree is then presented along with the animal to a Registrar. Upon examination and if there are no disqualifications the animal will be registered. The registration number will be tattooed in the right ear and a certificate will be issued. To have an animal registered one has to be a member of the ARBA.... I have felt for many years that the ARBA has one of the best registration systems in the livestock field. BUT it is only as good as the people carrying out the rules and regulations.

I notice that there is an increasing number of Dutch being registered and this is a good sign as it means that the breeders are breeding only from the best, perhaps I'd better qualify this with the observation that this is the way it should be.....

When the new breeder starts to demand a good pedigree, this is when things will shape up. We have just gone through a period of another breed being able to register with only the words "Imported " behind the pedigree. Now perhaps the European Countries have another system, but these animals come to the American Shores with no record, but a band, for example, and just what does that tell a serious breeder?????? I'm sure that there are many things that I do not understand, but I'm thinking and wondering. Are we in a period of "buyer beware?" or is it the theory that there is a sucker born every minute? Are we past this stage and will we now start to clear the decks and improve what has been brought here. If I were to import Dutch, is this the way it would go? Why do we feel that something from afar is better than what we have in our backyard. Well!!!!I don't know, just a thinking.....dl.

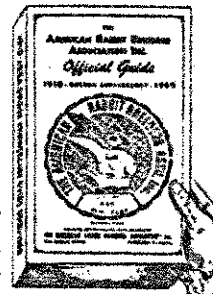
