
Hi Dutch Fans,

A big THANK YOU and CONGRATULATIONS should go out to the Kansas State Dutch Club, led by Rick Lehmann. They put in a lot of effort to host the ARBA Convention and did a tremendous job.

Congratulations to all the winners and non-winners who showed in Tulsa. A good bunch of Dutch were shown.

The minutes from the Board of Director's meeting will be enclosed in this issue. You'll find that we are in the process of establishing a "Dutch Hall of Fame" to recognize those individuals who have contributed to the promotion of the Dutch rabbit. As you look over the rules, you may see something that you feel should be changed. I'm sure there are going to be some rule changes after we get the "Hall of Fame" process rolling. If you have a concern, contact your Director and express your feelings.

Once again, there was a proposal to change the sweepstakes points system which the Board rejected. If we are going to change the sweepstakes system, we need to keep in mind that the change needs to be kept simple. We have over 600 open shows each year plus the youth shows. This large number of shows requires lots of work and an easy system. Any change in the system should be written down and forwarded to your Directors prior to any meeting of the Board (held at the National Dutch Show and ARBA Convention) so we may have time to study the proposal.

The Fall Ohio Dutch Show was held November 20. The youth show had 30 shown with a nice Black Sr. Buck of Karen Shoemaker taking B.O.B., and B.O.S. went to Regina Thomas with a Tort Jr. Doe. The open show had 132 Dutch with B.O.S. going to a Black Jr. Buck of Todd Uran's, and B.O.B. going to a Steel Sr. Doe of mine. Judging was done by Larry Bengtson.

The show season will soon be over in the Midwest by mid December with a break coming until early February. The only way to improve your Dutch over the winter is to continue breeding. Take the steps necessary to winterize your rabbitry, utilize heat lamps and lights, and continue to spend time in the cold to care for your Dutch.

As 1994 is retiring, so is your Dutch Reporter Editor, as well as the ADRC Publicity Department chairpersons, Barb and Al Butler.



I have to admit, we always had high goals for her, but we never really thought in our hearts that she could go all the way. Show Stopper now has come home and is bred to her dad, to hopefully produce something even a little close to her caliber. Our kids, I am happy to report, have chosen to raise the Dutch also.

I would like to take this opportunity to say it was nice meeting all of the breeders that we have heard so much about. We hope that you all have the opportunity that we had in Tulsa.

We are indeed lucky Dutch is one of the breeds they chose to raise.

Their win at Tulsa was well deserved, and I hope they enjoy many more.



HAPPY HOLIDAYS

Hello from the Upper Midwest!

We have been enjoying a wonderful stretch of fall weather. It has been mild and sunny for many days. Today (Nov 13) brings us some wind and rain, but still mild temperatures. The rabbits sure do enjoy this. They are full of vim and vigor, and looking for the next feeding time when chore time roles around. Coats are coming in prime, you Arizona and California fanciers should see these Minnesota finishes. We expect that the weather will change soon and the rabbits are surely well clothed for it. is however, getting to be the time of the year when good winter preparations and practices show. We breed in an old drafty dairy barn, and so we have been busy covering windows with plastic to keep the snow and breezes to a minimum and to help create that insulating air that lets the winter sun in to warm us. We are able to keep the minimum temperature at freezing or just a hair above. This allows us to keep water in front of the animals and keep diseases at a minimum. In the very coldest weather we operate a couple of kerosene heaters. Last winter we were very successful and raised many winter litters. The kerosene heaters provided just enough warmth to keep things thawed. Another thing that helps us is the addition of a layer of styrofoam in the bottoms of the nest boxes. It stops the cold from creeping up into the litter. If the doe were kindling on the ground, she would have the warmth from under her nest to keep the kits warm and cozy.

The reason for all the good information is to help all of you get ready for the 1995 National Dutch Show in Oshkosh, Wisconsin, April 28-30. It is one that you don't want to miss, so get ready. Your juniors will be coming for the next couple of You will find information on National Dutch Show activities in other parts of this Dutch Reporter. RELUCTANT DOES

by M.J. (Marti) Dill

We all love the doe who lifts immediately when placed with the buck, but unfortunately many are not receptive. Also, a large percentage who are willing to accept the buck do not kindle in 28-31 days. The older I get, the more tricks I use to get does to conceive when I want them to. I'd like to share a few ideas with you.

Coming from a really cold climate, breeding does in the winter months when the temperature was zero and the wind chill was even lower, we found by placing the does we wanted to breed in a carrying case, and bringing them into a warmer, sunnier environment (usually my kitchen or inside a vehicle where the sun warmed) relaxed the doe/s and they bred readily immediately after being in a temperate environment.

A normal procedure that is used in the sheep breeding industry is to "flush" ewes with oats. Flushing consists of increasing the amount of oats for one week to ten days. In does, we remove pelleted feed and use steamed oats and good alfalfa hay. Yes, the hay is expensive and difficult to find but worth the effort. The oats seem to set off the breeding time clock in the doe that says "Spring has arrived, breeding time is here". It has worked for us and may help you also.

Adding vinegar to the drinking water will encourage does to breed, and according to articles I have read, increases the does number of female offspring.

Placing a doe in a cage next to the buck with a wire divider will certainly get his interest and may encourage her to desire being mated after several hours or days.

On occasion the buck you have chosen to use for breeding may be aged and will tire easily. To save his limited strength, you may want to use a younger "teaser" buck. His nipping and teasing will prepare her for the older buck to mount and breed immediately. Be very careful NOT to allow the young buck to actually breed her.

Using a table large enough to accomodate both the buck and doe for the purpose of breeding has often solved the problem of an exhausted buck. It offers the breeder complete control of both of the animals. Place the doe on the table first. Then go and bring your buck to the table. Place your hand under the doe's belly, back toward the vent, and lift up approximately 1 to 2 inches above the table. Take your free hand and grasp a few hairs of the tail. Stretch the tail

upward slightly. (I have seen breeders tie a string to the does tail and gently pull when the buck refuses to mount because your hand is in the way). The majority of bucks will be over to the doe offering their services before you can get the doe positioned. If this happens, gently slide him over to the side of her. Reposition her and allow him to mount. For safety I would suggest that you have a helper stand close to catch the buck when he falls off the doe, protecting him from a fall to the floor.

Does who still refuse to accept the buck during table (restrained) breeding may need to be teased. By simply and very, very gently stroking the vulva, most does will start to moisten. I also find that when I remove the wedge of waxy build-up between the vent and the hind leg, it often stimulates the doe.

NEW DUTCH GUIDEBOOK UPDATE

At the ADRC Board of Director's meeting in Tulsa, it was noted that it may be advisable to wait until the new ARBA Standards of Perfection goes into effect January 1, 1996 to have the new Guidebook printed. This will allow for the revised Dutch standard to be included, as opposed to publishing a Guidebook that would have an antiquated standard in less than 1 year.

The suggestion received full support of the ADRC Officers and Directors.

Any and all ads sent to Kevin Hooper will be included in the new Guidebook when it is printed. Those not purchasing an ad may still do so until the completion of the 1995 ARBA National Convention in Louisville, Kentucky. Those that already have ads may make any changes they wish until that time also. If you are uncertain of what you had sent to Kevin, drop me a line and I will send a copy of your ad to you. You may then decide to use what was submitted, or change the ad to your desires.

WOODY RABBIT

Those of you who were in attendance at the ARBA Convention may have had the opportunity to see Woody Rabbit.

Satin breeder and ARBA Judge Mike D'Amico has a set of five or six wooden, true to scale rabbits that he made to represent different body type faults. He took the picture of the Californian from the current ARBA Standards of Perfection and constructed his ideal typed rabbit based on the dimensions of this Californian

There are two things that I feel we need to concentrate on as Dutch breeders.

First, the location of the high point of the back is most often too far forward causing our Dutch to lack roundness and depth of the hindguarter.


Second, the fullness (or lack thereof) of the lower hindquarters.

The diagram below shows how the lower hindquarters should appear. Too often our Dutch cut inward, thus lacking fullness.

The results of this work shows that the ideal type (for Dutch also), have these dimensions.

DEPTH EQUALS WIDTH DEPTH PLUS WIDTH EQUALS LENGTH HIGH POINT OF THE HIP IS LOCATED AT 2/3 OF THE LENGTH DEPTH AT THE SHOULDER EQUALS 3/4 THE HEIGHT OF THE HIP

The diagram below should help you understand proper Dutch type.



The BLUE STEEL VARIETY

At the 1994 ARBA National Convention in Tulsa, OK a proposed new variety of Dutch was viewed by the ARBA Standards Committee for the first time.

Kevin Hooper presented the Blue Steel Dutch.

In this issue of the Dutch Reporter you will find a ballot for you to vote whether you want the American Dutch Rabbit Club to recognize this new variety, provided it passes two more official showings to the ARBA Standards Committee.

As a member of both the ADRC and ARBA Standards Committee, as well as a breeder and exhibitor of Dutch, I have concern over the acceptance of another variety into the Dutch breed.

My first question would be what benefit this variety would be to the Dutch breed? I do not see where it can enhance or benefit any of the varieties already recognized.

My feelings are that 6 varieties are ample, and we should concentrate on perfecting those before we initiate any other varieties. The problems we face with the Steels and Grays presently should give anyone enough challenge to work with.

By the admission of the breeder-sponsor there will be varying shades of this variety. Kevin states that they will breed true, then states that breeding Blue Steel to Blue Steel will produce mostly Blue Steels and some Blues. I would ask if Grays and/or Blacks could be realized by mating Blue Steel to Blue Steel, depending on the ancestry? My concept of breeding true was that the litters were all of the same color as the parents.

I would be anxious to know the feelings of other Dutch breeders and judges in regards to the acceptance of another variety. It is too bad we did not have the chance to discuss this subject via the Dutch Reporter prior to having to take an official vote on it. The feelings of other breeders and judges may have shed some light for those that are unsure of their feelings.

I hope everyone realizes that if the vote is in favor of accepting the new variety, it cannot be changed if two more presentations to the ARBA Standards Committee are successful. However, if the vote is to reject the new variety at this time, it can still be introduced later.

Sorry Kevin, nothing personal. I just wonder if the ADRC really needs another variety to cope with at this time.

The Blue Steel

The first showing of the Blue Steel Dutch was accepted at the 1994 ARBA Convention. There are three more steps that must be taken before the Blue Steel would be accepted as a recognized color of Dutch.

The first step is that the members of the Dutch Club must vote to decide if we, as Dutch breeders, wish to have this as another variety. That ballot is in this issue with the ballot for judges for the 1996 National Dutch Show and ARBA Convention. We must have a majority of those who vote approve the Blue Steel if the acceptance process is to continue. Then the Blue Steel will have to be displayed and approved at the next two ARBA Conventions by the ARBA Standards Committee.

The Blue Steel is just that, a blue with a steel gene. If you can picture our current steel which has a black base color and replace the black base with that of a blue, then you have our Blue Steel. The Blue Steel will have a visible undercut just as our steel has. The belly color will be of a lighter shade than the top of the animal, but it will be very visible. The bottom of the tail will also be like that of the steel, very similar to the belly color but a shade lighter. If I was to select a variety from another breed that was similar, I would say that it resembles an Opal Mini-Lop, but with a higher gloss to the coat. The Blue Steel color will vary slightly from animal to animal because, unlike our black dutch, we have various shades of blue. As we put the steel gene on these slightly different shades of blue, we will have a little variance in the color. The working standard of the Blue Steel calls for a medium dark blue, just as our blue requires.

Once again, I have introduced this color for a few of reasons:

The Blue Steel can be bred with blacks, blues, steels, grays, and blue steels without any negative affect on those colors.

I think it will create more interest in our Steel Dutch. While working with Blue Steels, you will get steels, as well as blue steels, blues, blacks, and grays depending on what it is bred to.

It will breed true. Breeding Blue Steel to Blue Steel will give you mostly blue steels and some blues.

Several current well known breeders who don't raise steels or grays have said that if they are approved, they would raise this color.

If you are worried that all of these Steel genes will give us more stray white hairs in our Blues and blacks, don't. The Steel gene has nothing to do with stray white hairs. You will not get any more white hairs using a steel than you will a black.

I have no intentions of introducing any other colors. The Blue Steel will boost interest in the Breeding of the Dutch Rabbit.
