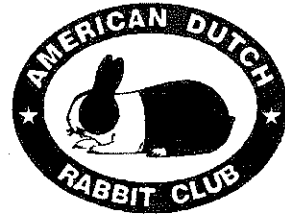


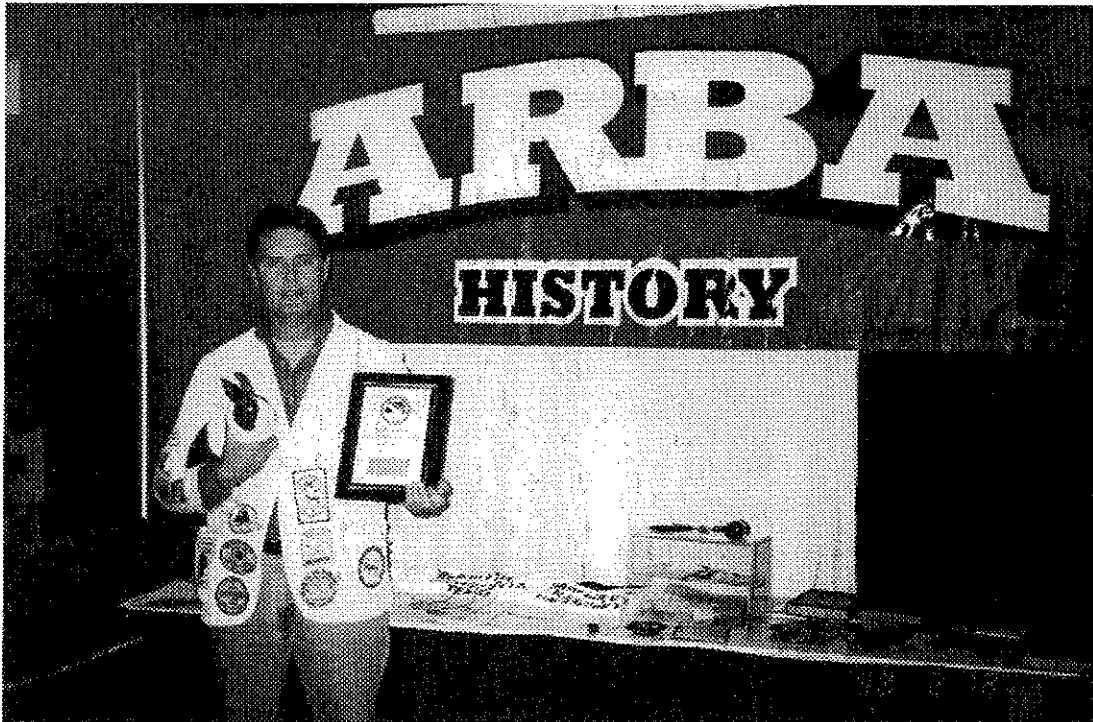

President's MESSAGE

The ARBA Convention for 2002 was a big success. The Show ran very well other than the check-in, which was a bit lengthy. The judging was completed in good time with many strong animals winning in the Dutch Classes.

The big winners for the Open were Rick Lehman with an outstanding Blue Jr Buck. This is one of, if not the best Dutch, I have ever seen. It had the roundness in every way, and was outstanding in markings. This buck went on to win Best of Group II, and was one of the final four for Best In Show. It only lacked in a bit of finish on the back of the rump to the winning Havana (a very sharp rabbit). Bob Worden had the BOS in open with a very nice Black junior doe.

The youth Best Dutch goes to another nice Blue Junior buck owned by Katie Bickelhaupt. This buck also went on to win Best of Group II, and was one of the final four for Best In Show. Best Opp in youth went to Heidi Brown with a Black junior Doe. The quality in youth was very nice, and I have been told that at least one of the youth breeders is moving up to open next year. The youth would have done very well in the open show this year in the Chocolates, Torts, and Steels. Open breeders, you have your work cut out for you!

There were not a lot of major changes or happenings at the General membership meeting, nor

the Board meeting this year. We changed the way we selected the best of varieties at this years NDS, to a voting procedure. We are looking at modifying that procedure to speed up the process. This is needed as we are using more judges since our shows have grown in numbers.

In the Board meeting, there was discussion and a decision made to try to separate the contest for the Dutch Rabbit of the Year into Open and Youth. This will begin for year 2003.

Also in the Board meeting, Rule 15 of the National Dutch Show Rules was dropped. This had to do with requiring the Club hosting the NDS, being required to pay back the \$500 sponsorship money to the ADRC, providing they made over \$300 on the show. The rational for eliminating this rule was that there is no way to enforce the rule. We also require a financial statement to be given to the ADRC after the show is competed. We have only ever received a couple of these. We did receive money back from four clubs who hosted the show from '96 to '00. If a club makes money on the show, it would still be a good

idea to return as much of the \$500 sponsorship money as possible to the ADRC.

It looks as if the Aisbets of Wisconsin will be taking over the Publicity Department the first of December from Rick and Julie Billups. I know Angie has done a nice job on the web site, and this is a very active family, who should do a nice job.

There was a presentation of the Harlequin Dutch at this years Convention. They were presented by Jill Pfaff (Dobson). They first had to be examined a Committee of Dutch breeders. That committee did not vote to approve the presentation based on a DQ they found on the Senior Buck. This was not an easy decision for the committee as they know the effort that has been put into the development of the variety, and the fact that several of them know Jill personally. As one member on the committee stated, this was a no win situation, as there are factions for the variety, and factions against, so someone was not going to be happy. They did like both of the does in the presentation, and felt that they were very good in quality.

Jill has agreed to write a genetics column for the DR. Any genetics questions or comments that you may want to clarify or have covered should be sent to Jill. Her contact info can be found inside the back cover of the DR, under Jill's Wild Dutch bunch.

American Dutch Rabbit Club Board of Directors Meeting

The board meeting of the American Dutch Rabbit Club was called to order on Sunday October 6, 2002 at 4:45 PM in a meeting room at the ARBA Convention Center by President Kevin Hooper. Board members answering roll call were: Rick Billups, Sue Strandwitz, Pete Nelsen, Doreen Bengtson, Dawn Schwartz, and Ray Brewer.

A motion by Pete Nelson to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last ADRC Board meeting, since they had been printed in the Dutch Reporter, seconded by Ray Brewer was carried.

The financial report showed a balance of \$19,585.94. A motion by Rick Billups, seconded by Dawn Schwartz to accept the treasurers report passed.

Director Tom Dietrich arrived at the meeting.

A National Dutch Show, 2003 report was given by Howard Dunmire. They have 1000 coops available and plan to issue their catalog 60 days before the show.

In directors reports, Pete Nelsen reported that there have been 9 Dutch Best in Show winners in his area, shown by 4 different breeders.

The Judges selection committee has selected judges for coming conventions (ARBA) In order to bring members back into the selection process, the board would like to have the membership vote for the Senior judge to begin with the 2004 Convention.

The Board requested that the convention show report (ARBA, Peoria) be prepared to appear in the coming DR. (That report did appear in the July/August/September 2002 DR)

Hall of Fame was discussed and it was the recommendation of the Hall of Fame committee that the nominations for Hall of Fame be held for next year. It was the desire of the ADRC Board of Directors that the process be changed slightly. In the future all Hall of Fame nominations will go to the area director for completion. The Director will then complete the report and file it with the Secretary. Any nomination to be considered must be sent to the secretary by Jan 10 of the year of consideration.

The publicity Committee is still awaiting a volunteer to assume the duties of the office. Rick Billups reports total assets of \$6,437.80.

The President announced some of his selections for the Harlequin Dutch presentation.

The 2003 ARBA Convention for Kansas will be headed by the Kansas Dutch Breeders.

There is still a call for sponsors for the 2005 National Dutch Show.

A motion by Tom Dietrich, seconded by Rick Billups that the SS reports separate open and youth shows when listing the BOB and BOS standings. To begin Jan 1, 2003 was carried.

President Hooper reported that the ADRC youth representative to the ADRC Board for 2003 will be Megan Kline.

The Secretary is requested to send a form to NDS sponsors along with the \$500 ADRC donation to encourage sponsoring clubs to file the required financial statement.

A motion by Sue Strandwitz, seconded by Pete Nelsen that the Board remove rule 15 of National Dutch Show Guidelines effective Jan 1, 2003. That motion passed and removed the requirement that sponsoring clubs return a percentage of NDS profits to the ADRC.

A motion by Ray Brewer, seconded by Pete Nelson to adjourn the meeting was carried.

THE IMPORTANCE OF GENETIC VARIABILITY IN YOUR HERD

The term Genetics seems a scary subject for many rabbit breeders but there are tremendous amounts of research going on in many types of animals that can help us better understand genetics and improve our breeding programs. This is very fortunate because it is hard to find research dollars just for rabbits and their genetic problems.

Endangered species like the Cheetah and California Condors are examples of research models that we can all learn something from. Parallels can be made between populations of a species and individual herds of Dutch rabbits.

When the total population reaches a bottleneck where only a limited number of breeding animals become the foundation of a breeding program there is a loss in genetic variability and all the animals eventually have the same genetic makeup. This is known as inbreeding depression because these animals lose their ability to adapt to changes in their environment or stressors

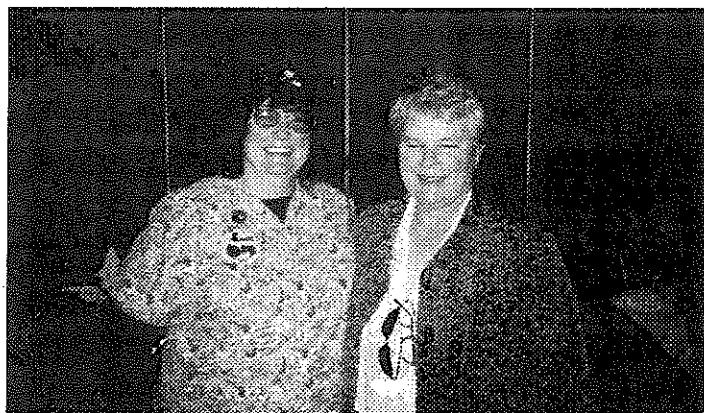
including disease resistance. An additional result from long-term inbreeding is loss in growth rates and overall size. These changes can be seen in only three to five generations.

Another risk in losing genetic variability is that mutations can become ingrained into a bloodline. Mutations are random changes in genetic make up. When a mutation occurs it may involve a regulatory gene that does not become apparent in that individual but after several generations of inbreeding with the mutated animal's offspring bred together, that genetic change may become apparent because some of the animals produced carry at least one copy of the mutated gene and when bred together they

produce some offspring with two copies of the mutated gene.

Most times mutations have deleterious effects; I mean recessive traits that cause health issues and general disqualifications. Some of these genetic defects include missing dewclaws, crooked tail or abnormally short tails, buckteeth, monorchidism (only one testicle), split penis and blindness.

There is value in line breeding and inbreeding but also there are risks in long term breeding of closely related animals without bringing in new blood to avoid inbreeding depression. The key is to keep a balance of genetic variability in your herd.

YOUTH JUDGE COMMENTS

It was both a privilege and an honor to be one of the youth judges at this years National A.R.B.A. Convention in Peoria.

The best opp. sex black jr. doe and best of breed blue jr. buck were both outstanding animals, proven by the B.O.B. Dutch winning its GROUP as well. Big congratulations to all the youth for a superb display of Dutch.

My table help was excellent and the rabbits all made it up to the table in a timely fashion, which really helped keep the show moving.

Of the classes I judged, the blue jr. does were the deepest, with a number of super animals. I

would say that body type has continued to improve and a number of younger junior animals will be topnotch with a little more development.

A couple of things to look out for... strive to keep good straight legs on your Dutch and don't forget to work towards proper color. Watch for the ring -color on those Grays. The Steels needed more consistency in their variety as a whole.

All in all it was a very enjoyable experience and hope to have the privilege to judge them again in the future.



Judging the ARBA Convention

It was an honor to judge the open Dutch at this years ARBA Convention. I was not sure how I would like judging at the Convention, as obviously I could not show my Dutch. I knew I would not even be able to walk up and down the aisles of Dutch, or even stand and look at someone's great junior that they thought was the best they ever had. I could not even look for any that I may want to buy until the judging was over. Would I enjoy that?

Yes, I did enjoy that. No, I wasn't able to show, but I was able to see everyone's best. It was a lot of fun! The classes weren't quite as large as some we have had in the past due to several breeders not making the trip.

The Black Senior Buck class was solid. There weren't many in this class that were in great condition. There were a few which were awfully nice that just needed some cleaning up. I carried them as high as I could, but their condition just was not where it needed to be to carry a strong class.

The Black junior doe class was very deep, with about 8 does rising to the top. These does all were nicely balanced. The top three were very close. Each had their faults, but were all very nice.

The blue Senior doe class was one of the weaker classes that I judged. There was one who was the top, a couple who were the middle, and then the rest. The color and condition of the seniors was not where it needed to be, but I blame some of this on the fact that it was a very hot summer, and an early convention.

The Blue Junior buck class was very good, and very deep. There were three

very sharp bucks in this class; with the top two being one's who I felt would be strong candidates to win that day.

The Chocolate Senior Buck class had some nice bucks, but once again only a few were in condition. The Chocolate junior doe class was very deep, I liked the top 16. But there was not one clear winner who jumped right out. This was the toughest class to judge.

The Tort doe class was like the other senior classes, nothing really in good condition, but some solid bodies. The tort junior buck class had a lot of variance in body styles and type.

The steel classes were small, and ones again lacking in that one animal that jumps right out to you.

The Gray doe class was strong with several good does throughout the class. The Gray junior buck class was also pretty good with the top ten being pretty strong bucks.

Things we need to work on as a breed. Color! This is especially true in the chocolates. Our Choc color has gotten lighter. This can be seen in not only the coat, but in the eyes! These two seem to go hand in hand. We need not only a darker coat and eye color on our chocolates, but a bit shorter coat.

The Tort color was not bad as there were only a few dark ones. We need to get/keep the bright orange over the top however. Many are a dull orange/smut over the top. Shading color was not as dark as it has been in the past however.

The Steels varied in their color, with only a few that I saw coming close to what the standard requires as ideal.

The Grays were overall pretty good in

surface color. The banding could still be more defined, but it is much better that it was several years ago.

Hindquarters. We need to work on the fullness of the lower HQ. This was still a common fault that I found on all colors.

Depth - I know Scott commented on the depth of the animals as well, wondering why there were quite a few that were too low or flat. Here is my theory on this.

I know here in the Midwest, many of the judges shove the animals up, punch them up, or squeeze them, to make them show more depth. If these animals that don't have the naturally deep bodies are winning under these judges, then more breeders are going to be keeping and raising this type of Dutch. The ones who are naturally deep, and do not have to be punched up, do not do well when posed/handled in this manner. Remember, the front feet should be under the eyes, or rear portion of the jaw, while the front of the back foot should be perpendicular to the stifle (round portion of the hip or the side of the animal.) Squeezing/shoving/punching only gives them artificial depth, and does not help the breed or the breeder in the long run.

The winning animal had the natural body and roundness that we are looking for in our breed. I hope you had the privilege to see the winner.

"I thank you and Percy would thank you if He Could"

My good friend Bob Bergene took my only entry "Lehmann's B24" AKA "Percy" (named by my son Cameron when the buck was born in late May of 2002) to the 79th annual ARBA Convention in Peoria, Ill. I was not able to leave Kansas City until Monday night and the convention started on Sunday. I had promised to do a television program for KCPT- TV19 on Saturday and also had just started at new at a new radio station. I was obligated (and being paid J) to do a radio broadcast that weekend so Monday night was when I planned to leave - after Michelle had come home from work and both Cameron and Madison had been fed and tucked in bed. While preparing dinner for the family, the phone rang and it was Bob - acting quite surprised that I was still home. I told him I was leaving soon, he told me I'd better hurry because I had to pick up my trophy...because my Blue Jr. Buck (B24) had just won Best of Breed - what took place after that, truth be told, is somewhat of a blur. I remember yelling something in excitement and thanking the "Almighty" that the restroom was unoccupied! Also remember thinking that I'd better get that macaroni and cheese off the ceiling before Michelle sees it (which I still have to get around to doing - it's a good thing that the people in my household rarely look up). The trip to Peoria that night sure went fast. IT was the shortest six-hour drive I have had -adrenaline is amazing stuff.

Well, at least I was there for the

Best in Show that was held on the floor of the arena with hundreds of folks in the arena seats. My Dutch was in Group Two. Now, Percy is normally a very calm buck who likes to be petted but, sometime during his convention experience, he discovered he was a stud (rabbit puberty) and wanted the other rabbits in his group to know it. I was pacing back and forth and praying that he would behave himself. On the show table, he kept opening the door on his holding pen while the other eight rabbits sat in their pens quietly until the Judge removed them for judging. Doreen & Eric Bengston were on the arena floor with me, their familiar presence kept me a lot calmer than I would have been without them there. Doreen had her camera and was taking pictures when she noticed my rabbit's behavior, turned to me and said, "He's a lot like his owner, isn't he?" I nervously laughed as I kept one eye on my Blue Buck who had now decided that the Checkered Giant that kept hopping by him need to know who the BOSS was! I remember thinking 'if he does break out, that Checkered Giant will turn him every which way but loose (to quote that great American linguist, Clint Eastwood!). To say I was excited when I won, would be a complete understatement of my feelings...all those years of hard work and strict culling in a small rabbitry had paid off. That's when the full realization of what had taken place over the past couple of days finally hit me.

The greatest part of this whole

experience were the kinds words and congratulations from folks all around the country. People from everywhere, not just Dutch breeders, came and asked me if they could see Percy.

Because of the problems in the past with rabbits "disappearing", Bob Bergene suggested I tie Percy's cage shut with two plastic wire ties. He happened to bring hundreds of them with him. At first, I resisted - still clinging to the feeling that nobody would do something like that - but I finally relented. As soon as I tied it shut, four East Coast judges stopped by and asked if they could see him. I, of course, proudly obliged, cut the ties and put him on a show table. These old timers, with approximately 75 years of judging amongst them, looked Percy over, turned to me, thanked me for the opportunity to see him and told me that he was the finest example of the Dutch breed they had ever seen. I will never come close to thinking or believing that but it sure was a thrill to hear it! Every time I put Percy back in his cage and tied him in, some other kind people would come over, congratulate me and ask for a peek. I cut so many of those darn plastic ties off his cage that, after a while, the area around his cage reminded me of those restaurants you go to where they give you all the peanuts you can eat and then you get to throw the shells on the floor. That's what it sounded like and felt like but I loved every minute of it!

In addition to my terrific experience, I also got a chance to

go see the youth Dutch as well and I'm sure glad Katie Bickelhaupt showed in Youth! That Blue Jr. Buck of hers, which won Best of Breed in Youth and was also a Group winner, was one beautiful rabbit!

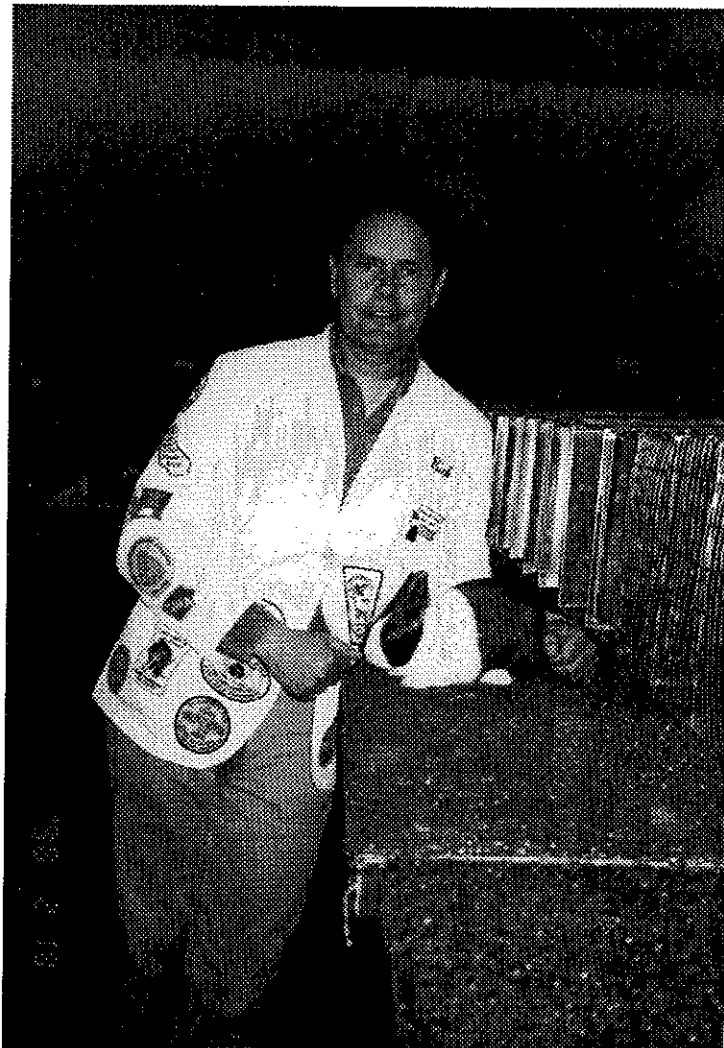
