In presenting this article the first question that I consider of real importance is this: Why is it that there are so many Dutch breeders who do not belong to our National Club? It is true that we have a good number of members which does take in all the well known fanciers, but we are not satisfied with this representation. We are for both small and large alike, well known or unknown make no difference. We have four or five Dutch clubs, and I really believe that if all of us called Dutch fanciers and otherwise would get together in one club and give our cooperation to that club we would have all the other breeds backed off the map.

Our national convention is almost upon us, and here is food for thought for each and everyone of us. What are you and I doing to put Dutch across in the manner in which it should be accustomed to? Are we doing our best, or just letting George do it, while we of one club sit back and criticize those of the other organizations. This is no time for childish play, for there is only one way to succeed and that is to forget petty differences and work together. We can't all think alike but we can all work with the same objective. If some of the boys thought as I do at times I know people would think ill of them, rather than just Dutch crazy.

In its present status I cannot praise the American Dutch Club too highly, or plead with those who are not members to join, and show us who are already members that you can do a great many things as well or better than we can, or at least present your ideas for consideration, for I have not seen any constructive ones turned down to date. We have always room for good members and workers, and fellows if we Dutch fanciers just get the push behind us, who knows, but what the next convention will be just for Dutch.

Now for a few remarks on the breeding and judging of Dutch. I have seen in many of our shows Dutch placed first that have real high cheeks, these given preference to those that ran into the whisker bed, although well rounded. The standard says to cut severely for the latter fault. The high markings are far more difficult to correct than the low markings as most every Dutch breeder knows and will agree. When you start to get high cheek markings and keep breeding to them I personally find that one starts to get white ears and white hairs. My thought is why penalize a rabbit that is equally as good, if not better, from a

show standpoint, and is known to be much better from a breeding angle. This is one of the things that hurt our breeding of low cheek markings, and nine times out of ten starts out on the wrong basis and gets disgusted because of the fact that he is getting so many white or nearly white, rabbits from his newly acquired stock.

In conclusion I will give a few of the things that I do not do, possibly it may help others, and that is why we offer these constructive articles. I may be wrong as some may say, but I am only going by my own experience and I am told that it is the best teacher. I don't breed from an animal with white ticking, no matter how good he or she is, but most particularly if it is a buck. Never breed from an animal with spots in the eyes. Don't try to get as many litters as you can in one year from one doe. I never breed from an animal that has three bad faults, as I find that by so doing you add fault upon fault. Never breed from an animal that connects to the front leg. In other words cull out all the above and try to improve on the few good ones you may leave. I find that if I breed to poor ones it will always show up in the second or third generation, only with added faults. You know fellows, it is hard enough to breed good ones without accumulating more bad ones. It is true some will say that I do not know what I am talking about, or possibly worse, but it is also true that I am not raising Dutch to send to the show and have them sent back to their pens by the judge. Remember that it is possible to beat the exhibitor, but you just can't beat the Dutch. May I close by saying please don't forget to support those who help you, namely, "this rabbit journal."
