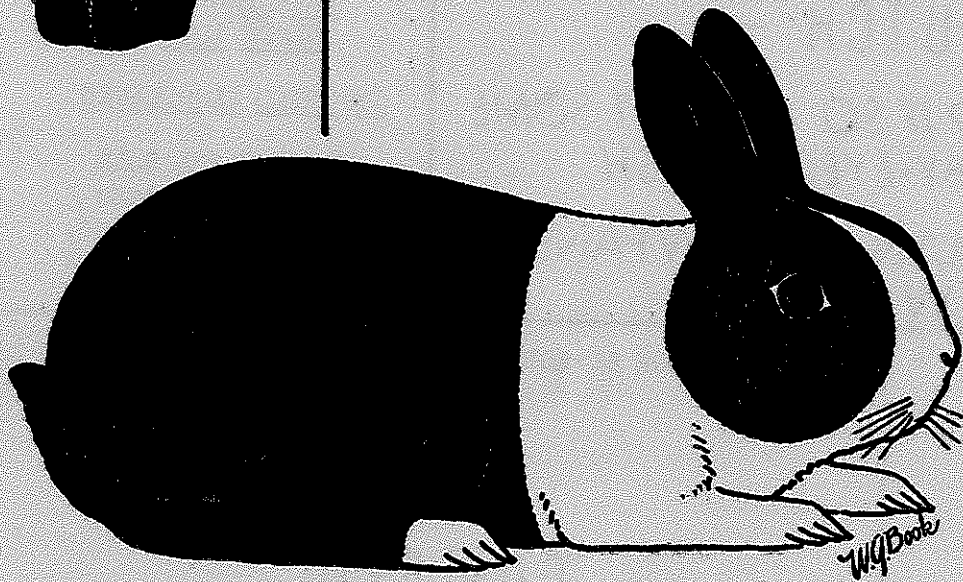

WE DON'T KNOW ALL THE ANSWERS - BUT WE TRY

I have really been put on the spot as the chairman of the Educational Committee by a few of the enquiries that have been sent to me. I am replying here to one written by Robert Jones; 421 Fulton St., Port Clinton, Ohio. Quote

"Dear Mrs. Weinhardt;

I am in the Midget (toy) dutch business. I wonder if you have any of these Midget Dutch or know of anyone who does."

I am sending my answer to Mr. Jones with a few more notations and letting the chips fall where they may.

Dear Mr. Jones:

I am the Educational Chairman of the American Dutch Club and as such, have been requested by our Secretary, Mrs. Weinhardt to write you in regards to your enquiry through her for some Midget Toy Dutch.

I presume that you are already a member of the American Dutch Club and have our Guide Book. If you have and have looked it over, you will find that there is no such breed as a Midget or Toy Dutch. You will find that an ideal Dutch should weigh 4 1/2 pounds. It also states in our standard that any deviation either above or below this weight is a departure from the standard and should be cut accordingly. Therefore if you were showing your Dutch under a judge that was judging according to our standard he would have to cut the so-called Midget Dutch for not carrying the ideal weight. Should your senior Dutch weigh less than 3 1/2 pounds you would not be able to register it as that is definitely too small for the standard. Just as a 5 1/2 pound animal would be too large for a g of Dutch. You should strive to keep your Dutch as near the standard of 4 1/2 pounds as possible. I have rec'd ads, myself offering Midget or Toy Dutch for sale and I feel that you have been misled a little bit along the way. It would be my suggestion that you purchase Dutch that are as near the standard of perfection as you can get, and if I can be of further service to you let me know. (End of letter.)

Here is the way I feel about this situation as a Director of the Club and I am saying this with malice to no one, since we own and publish the Dutch Reporter, and take ads for its support, can print any article we wish, and as Chairman of the Educational Committee, I am pledged to work for the betterment of the Dutch Rabbit and the Dutch Club, we are defeating the purpose of the Educational Committee and the Dutch Reporter when we accept ads advertising "Toy" or "Midget" Dutch. Up to this time there has never been any standard written on anything but the DUTCH RABBIT, so I ask you, isn't that what we are striving to promote? Isn't that why we have a standard committee? It is these ads that cause the confusion and are drawing the enquiries. Until such a time that there is a standard on them I feel that the Dutch Club should not cause any confusion by accepting these ads and publishing them in the Reporter. If anyone has Dutch Rabbits for sale, let them advertise them as DUTCH RABBITS as called for by the A.R.B.A. Standard.

RABBITS BECOME 'FAIR GAME'

Dateline-Hutchinson, Kas by Associated Press: Swamped with rabbits last year, officials of the Kansas State Fair expanded exhibition space to 400 hutches this year.

But already the entry list exceeds 400. And an Arizona man wants to enter 154 rabbits while a Denver man has 120 to show in the fair, opening tonight.

Virgil Miller, executive secretary of the fair, advised out-of-state and other late enquirers against shipment. As for the rest, he said:

"I hope they leave all the pregnant rabbits home."

MORE ABOUT OUR REGISTRATION SYSTEM

As there has been quite a lot of talk and several articles written lately on the subject of registration, I would like to put in my little bit.

I think we should have some plan by which we could get more rabbits registered. \$2.00 per head is pretty high to pay for registering an animal that will probably sell for not more than \$10.00. I am thinking about Dutch because I do not know anything about the selling price of other breeds. But I do know that \$10.00 is above the average price of a good Dutch in this part of the country (Texas). While \$2.00 is too high a price to pay for registering a \$5.00 to \$10.00 rabbit it is also a very small fee for a registrar to get for a service that requires him to invest \$1.00 in advance for forms and takes from 30 minutes to an hour of his time, to ear mark and examine the animal and fill out the form. I am sure these men have done much more for the rabbit business than they have gotten out of it. Under the present system of registering the registrar is under-paid for his services. At the same time the average breeder cannot afford the fee that is charged. So in my opinion we should try to find a system that would be more simple and cost less.

Personally I like the idea that was expressed by one writer where a breeder, after proving his ability could be certified to register and allowed to qualify to register any breed in which he was interested. Without having to be an expert on all breeds. For example: A breeder who had raised Dutch only, and who was interested in Californians and knew them well could register Californians, etc.

Possibly if the association would furnish an official registration blank that could be filled out, sent in and an official seal and number put on it and returned to the breeder instead of the ARDA office having to type out in full a complete new form, it would simplify the procedure. I believe that if some satisfactory plan could be found where a rabbit could be registered for about fifty cents our registrations would triple in a short time.

While I would like to see the system simplified and the fee reduced I would not want to see the bars let down to where just any old rabbit could be registered regardless of type and condition just because the dam and sire were registered. I hope that the leaders of the industry will get together soon and come out with some plan that will encourage more breeders to register all of their breeding stock and not just the outstanding ones. Incidentally, every breeder in my small rabbitry is registered now.

Another thing that I would think would be popular and I would like to hear other opinions on, is to have available a metal tag or seal to attach to the hutch of a Grand Champion. Something like a political campaign button, something inexpensive so that the hutch could be marked, designating that a Grand Champion lived here.

Hoping to see more and better rabbits registered in the future.
