

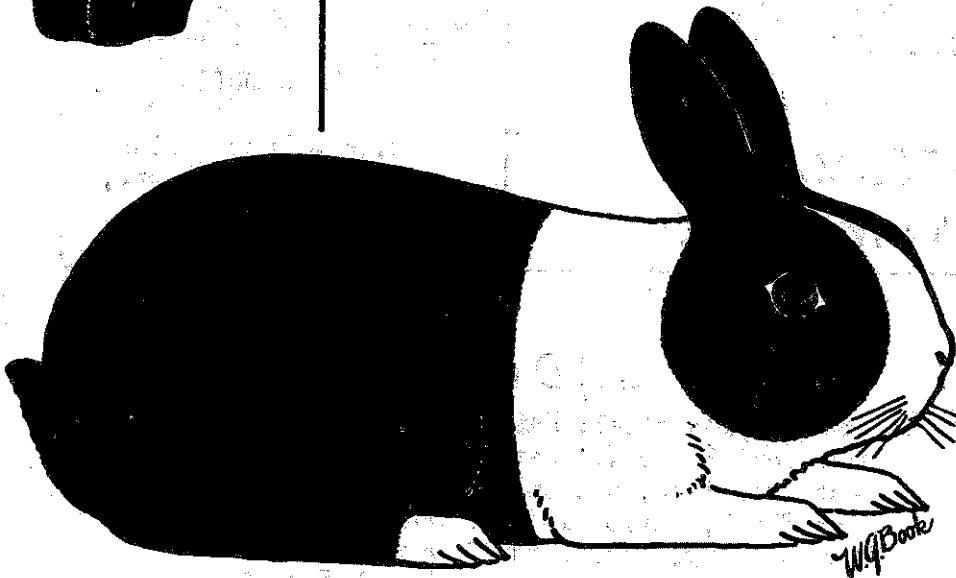

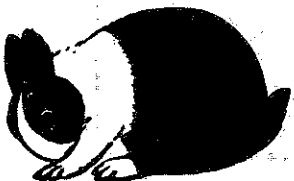

DUTCH FUROR

by J. Russell Hall

C. Jay Miller of Kalona, Iowa, writes that he started raising Dutch about 10 years ago, "just for the fun of it". He did have big commercial breeds; and after keeping and comparing feed, litters, and other aspects, he decided that Dutch were more suitable for him.

One example is that he dressed Dutch and larger breeds to sell to a commercial Super-market. The manager told him to take the larger ones (2 3/4 to 3 1/2 lbs.) to another store, because what he wanted was all 1 1/2 lb. dressed rabbits, as they always sold first.

Mr. Miller had 125 does at one time and some of them raised more than 4 litters per year. He says, "I like to see them produce." Right now he has a black Dutch doe raising 11 youngsters. He is sorry that some of the breeders want the smaller Dutch. He has had his best success with 4 1/2 lb. animals. And he writes, "Don't let anyone tell you they cannot be used for a commercial rabbit. The fellow who wrote, 'You can't beat the Dutch, and you can't eat them', don't know what he's talking about." Mr. Miller's rabbits have to pay for their keep, and the smaller Dutch just don't produce as well as a 4 1/2 lb. animal, he says.

His wife, Dinah, enjoys raising and showing Dutch as much as he does; and they have Black, Blue and Tortoise. They also have a few Black English. He wishes all Dutch breeders would register their stock. His are all Red, White and Blue. Mr. Miller was the show secretary for the National Dutch Show last spring, and he is president of the Iowa State Dutch Club.
